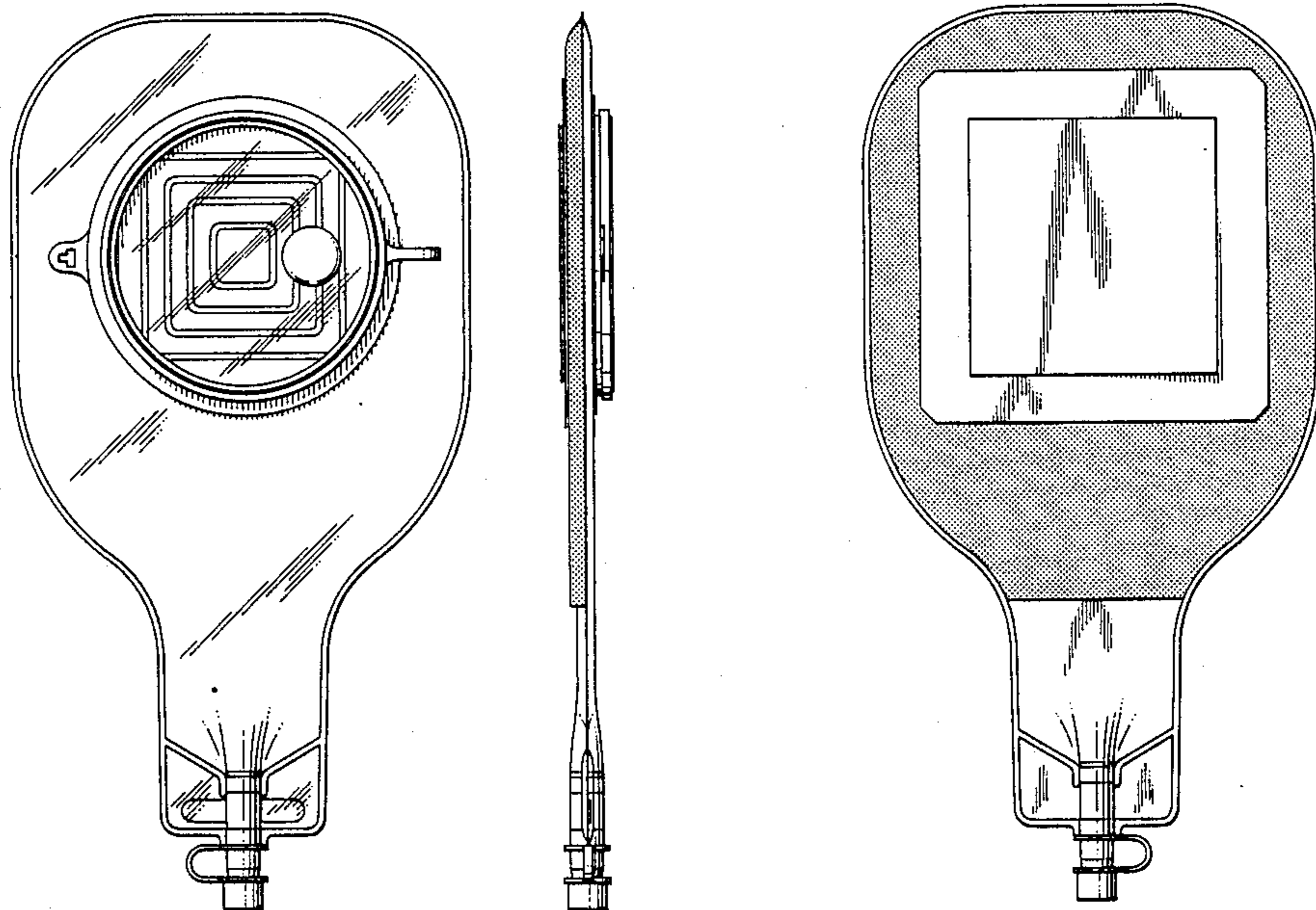

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wound care pouch showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, with the cover removed.



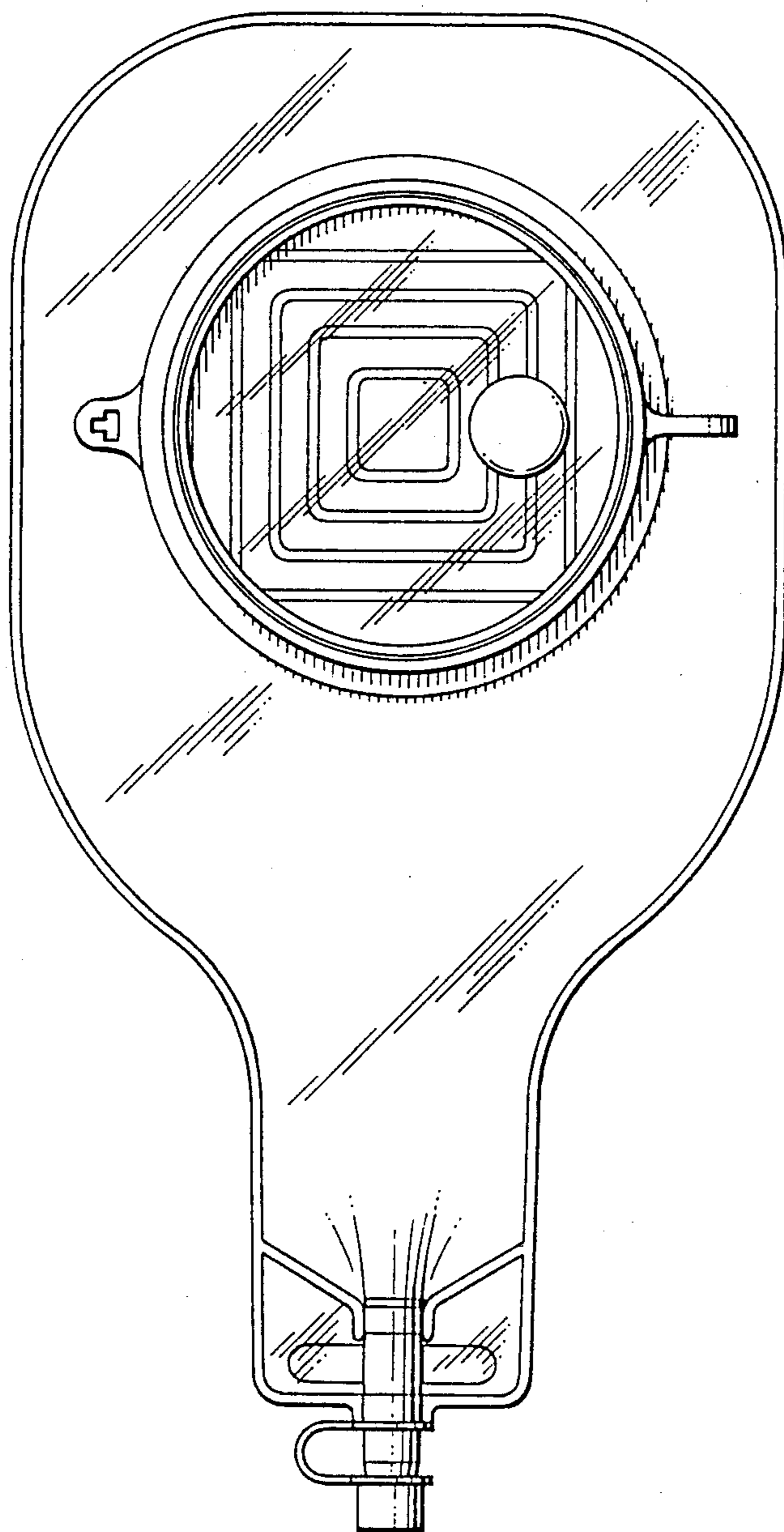

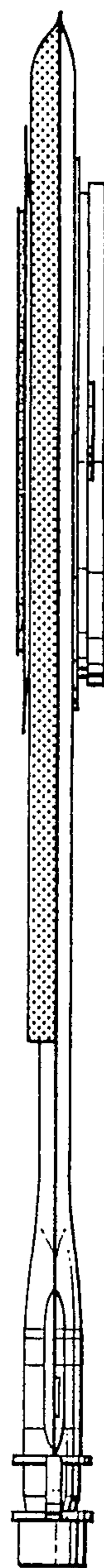

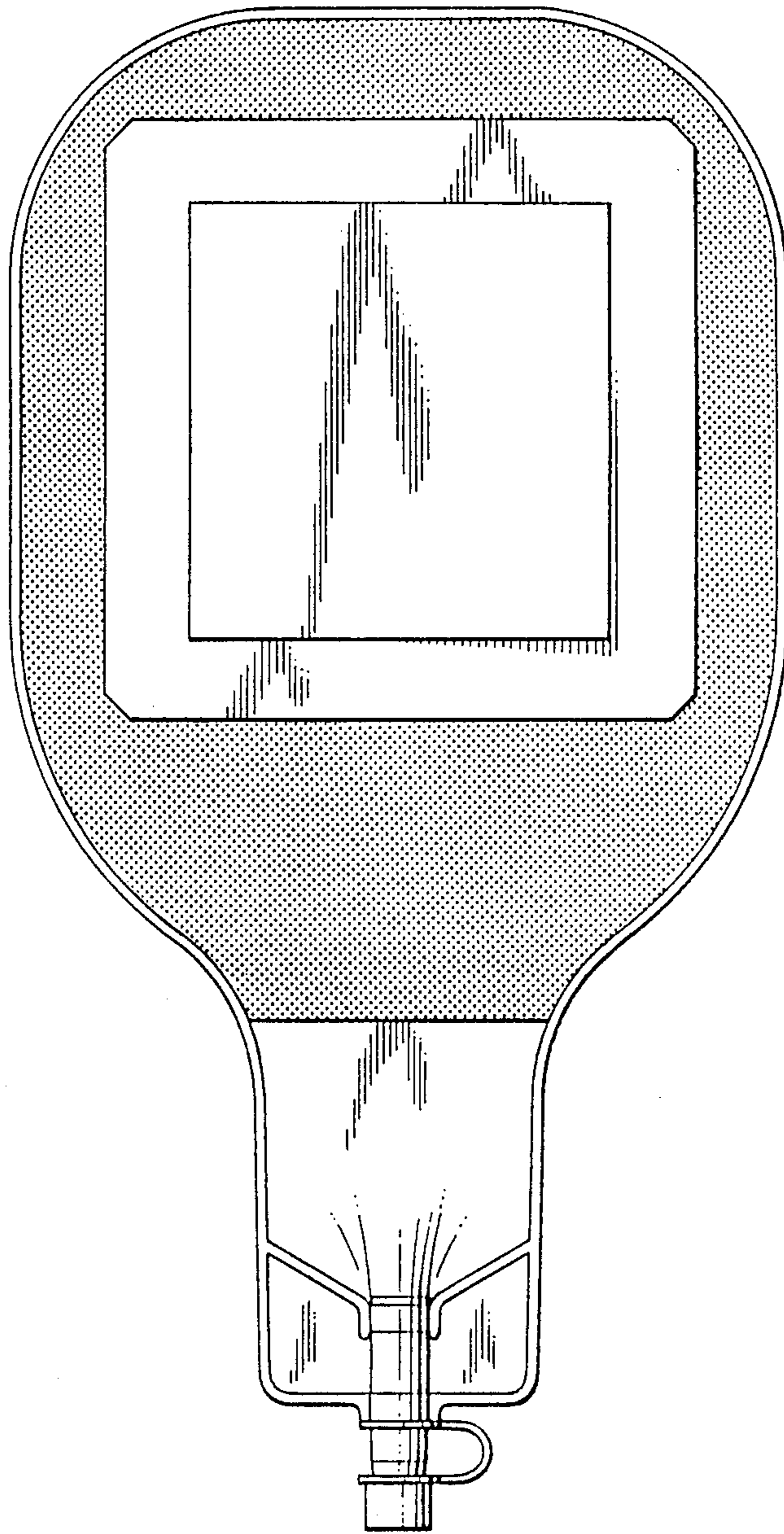

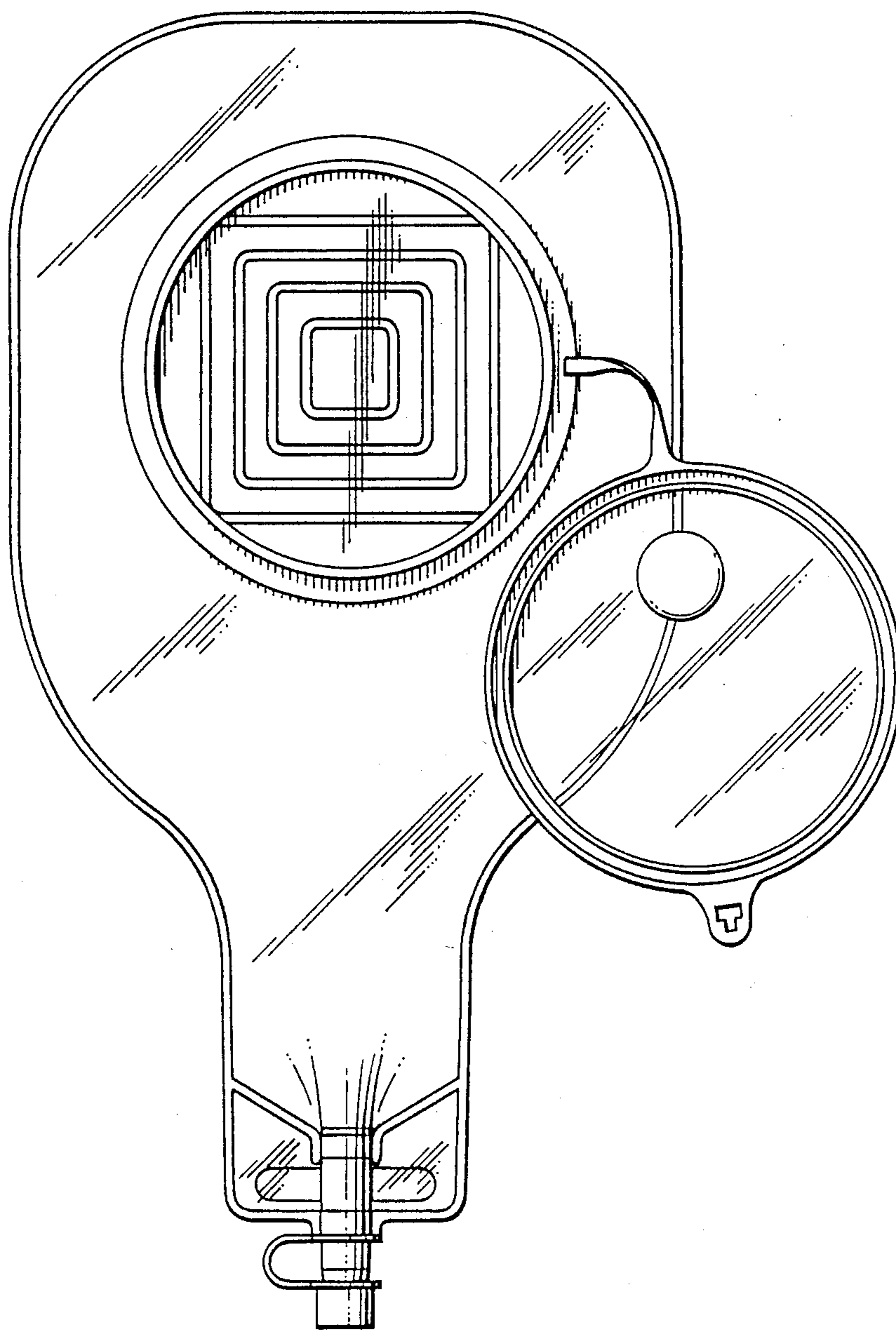
