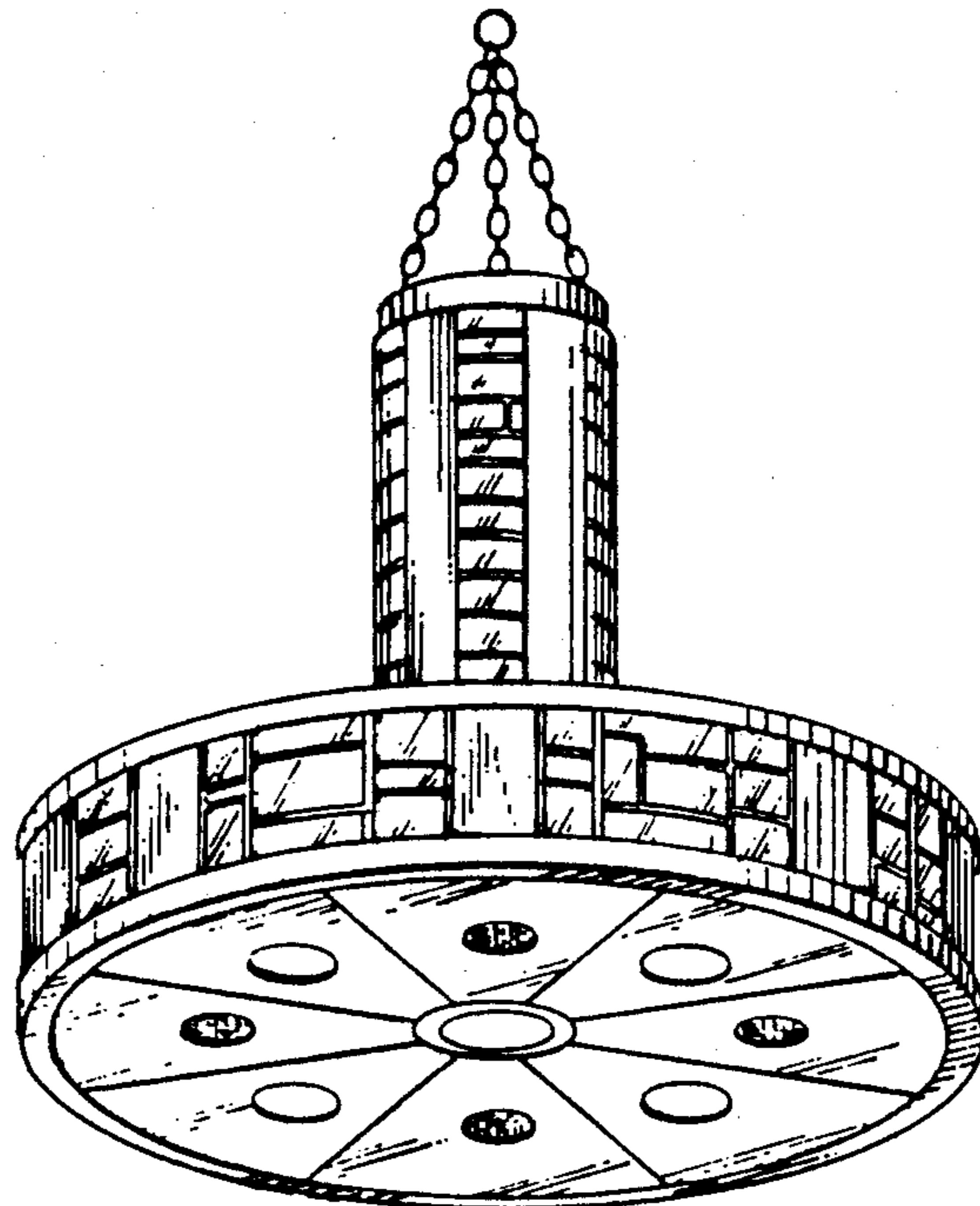
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined suspended lighting and ventilating fixture showing our new design;

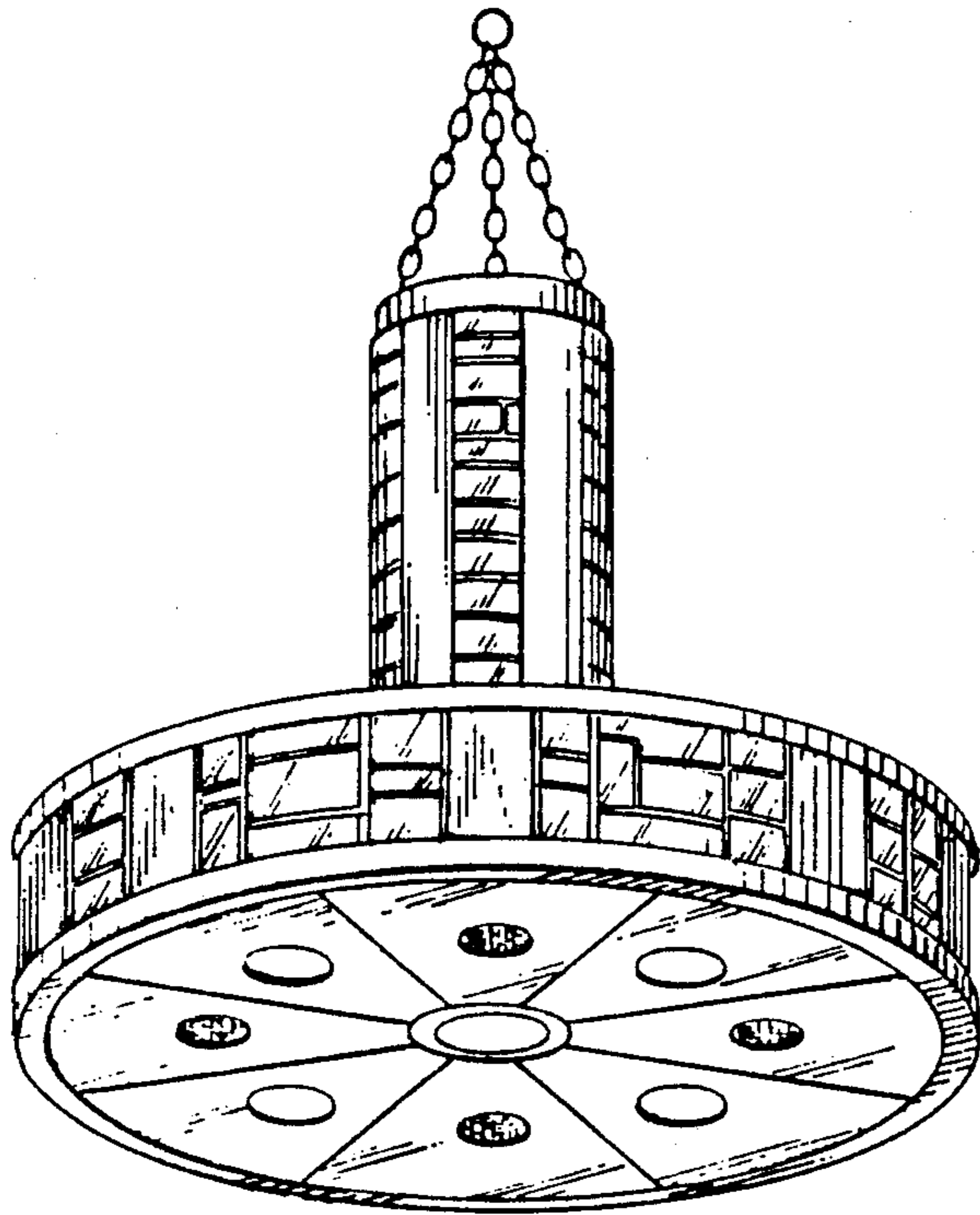

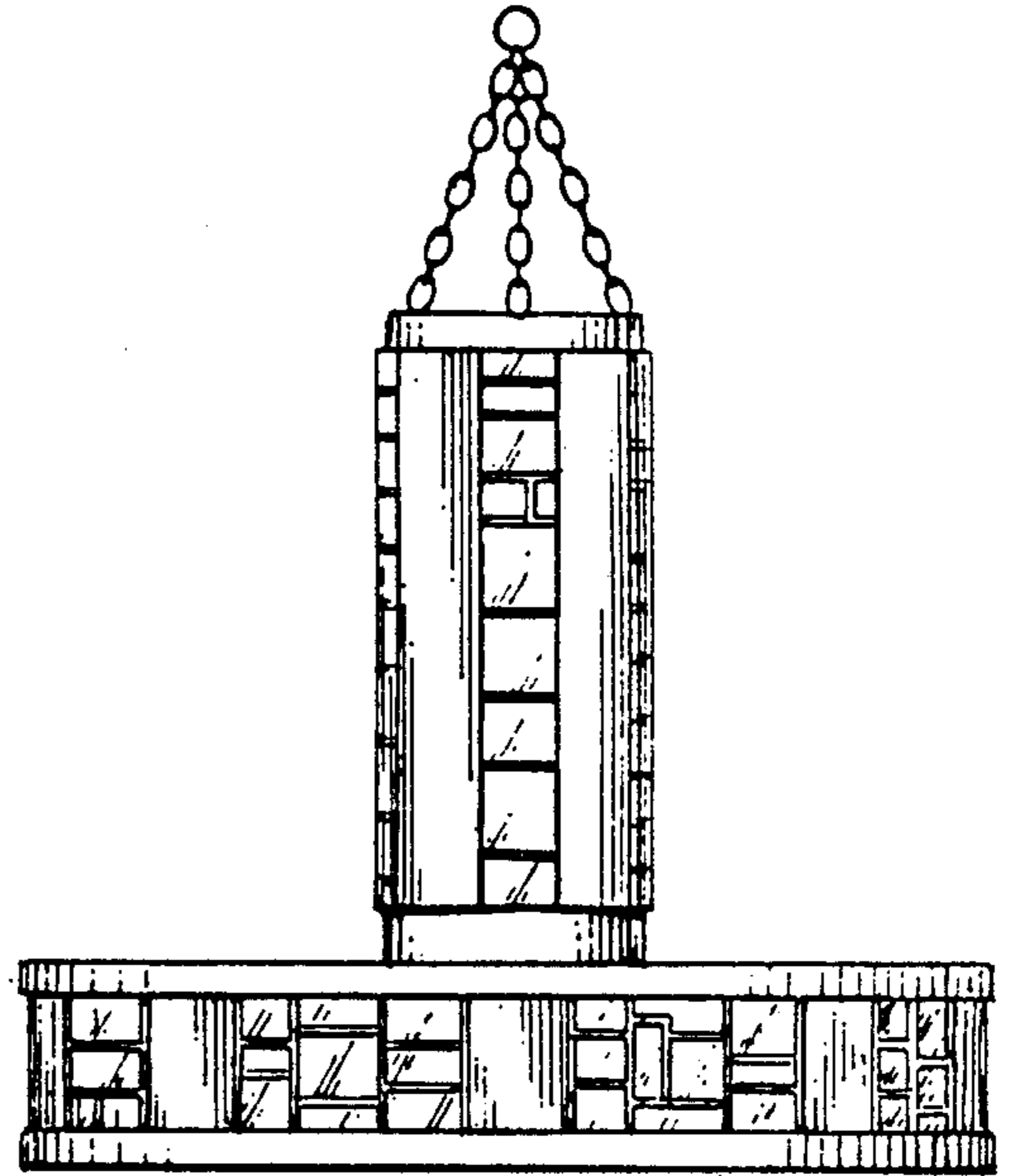

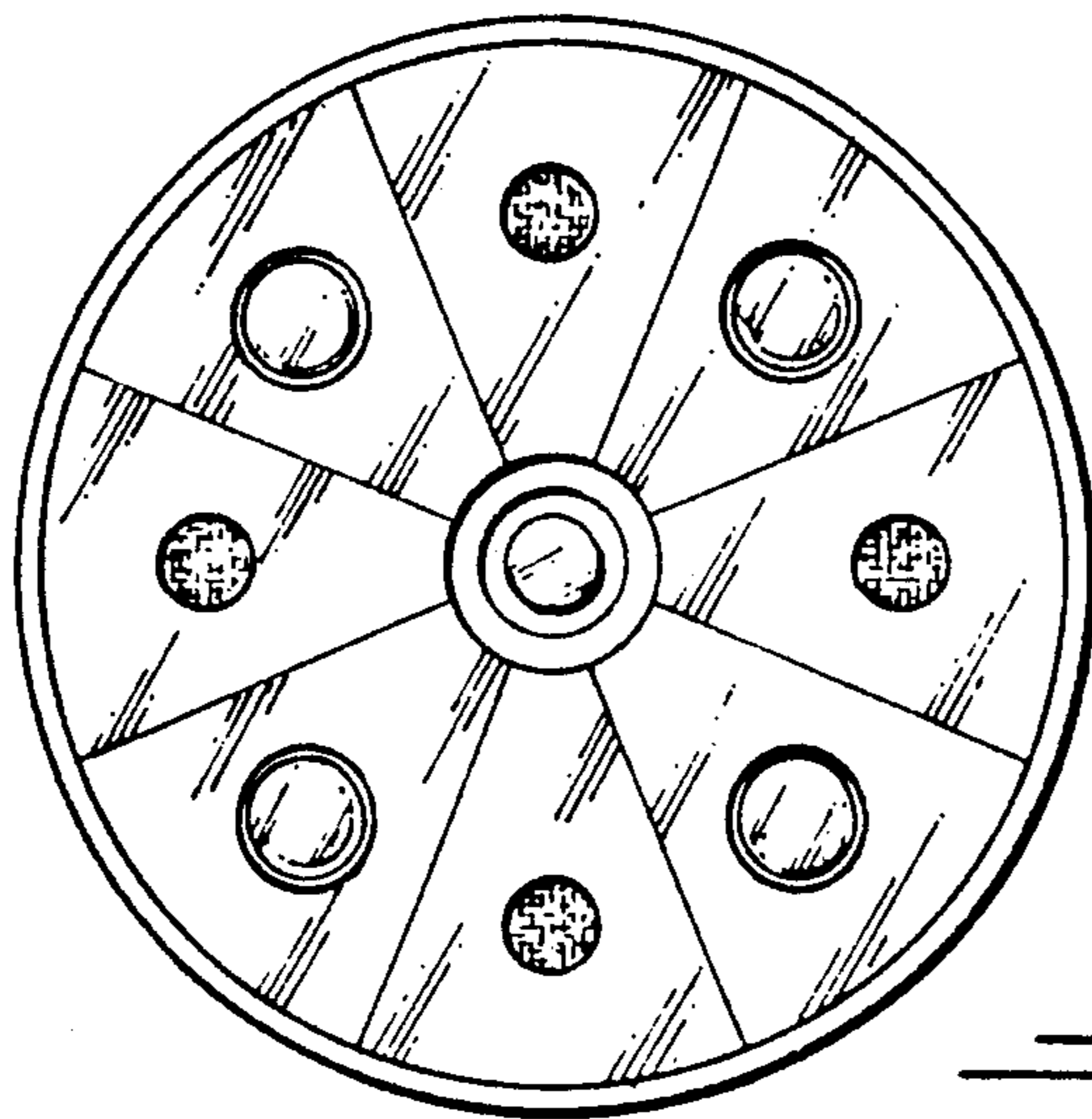

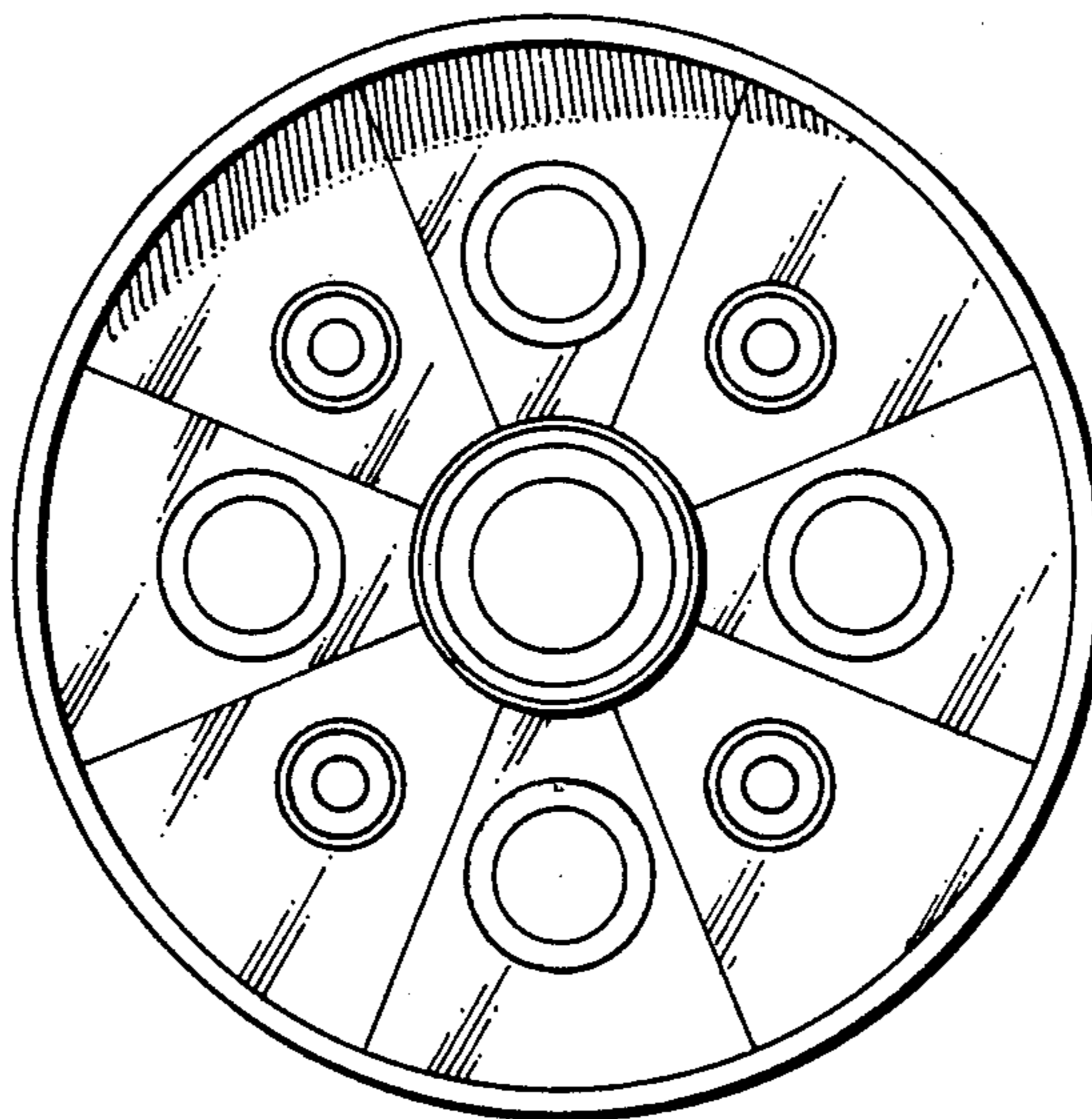
