FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pin for locking or stopping a sliding window sash showing my new design;

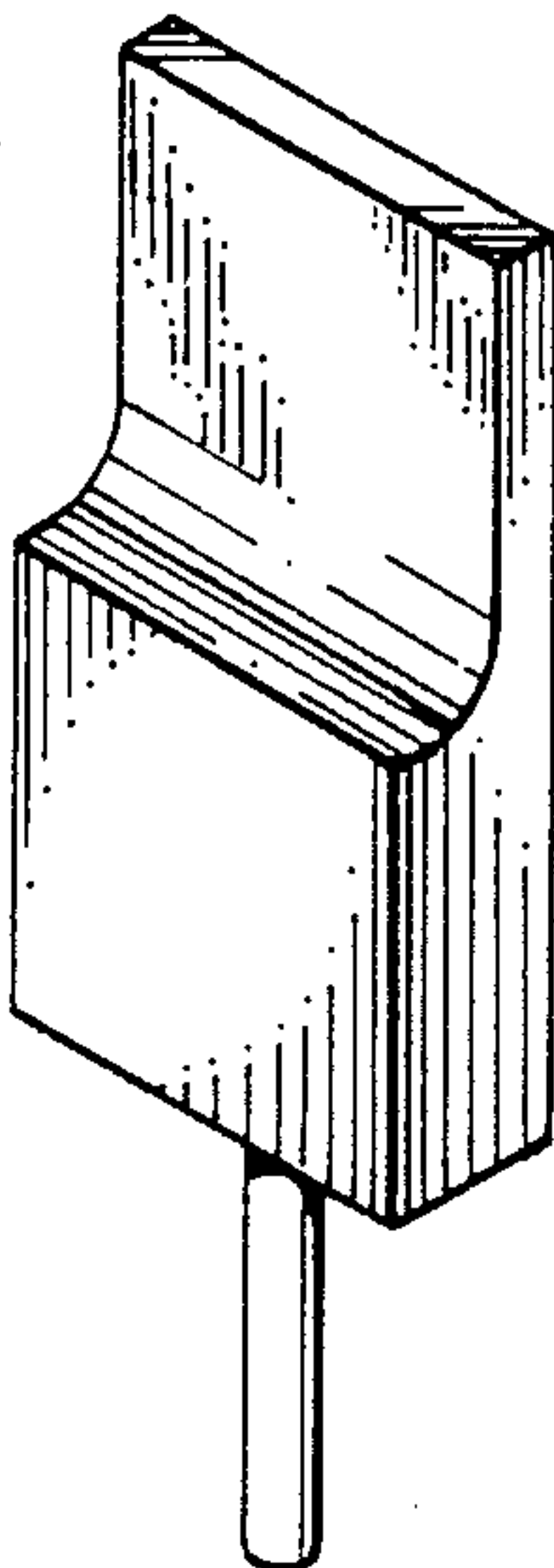
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



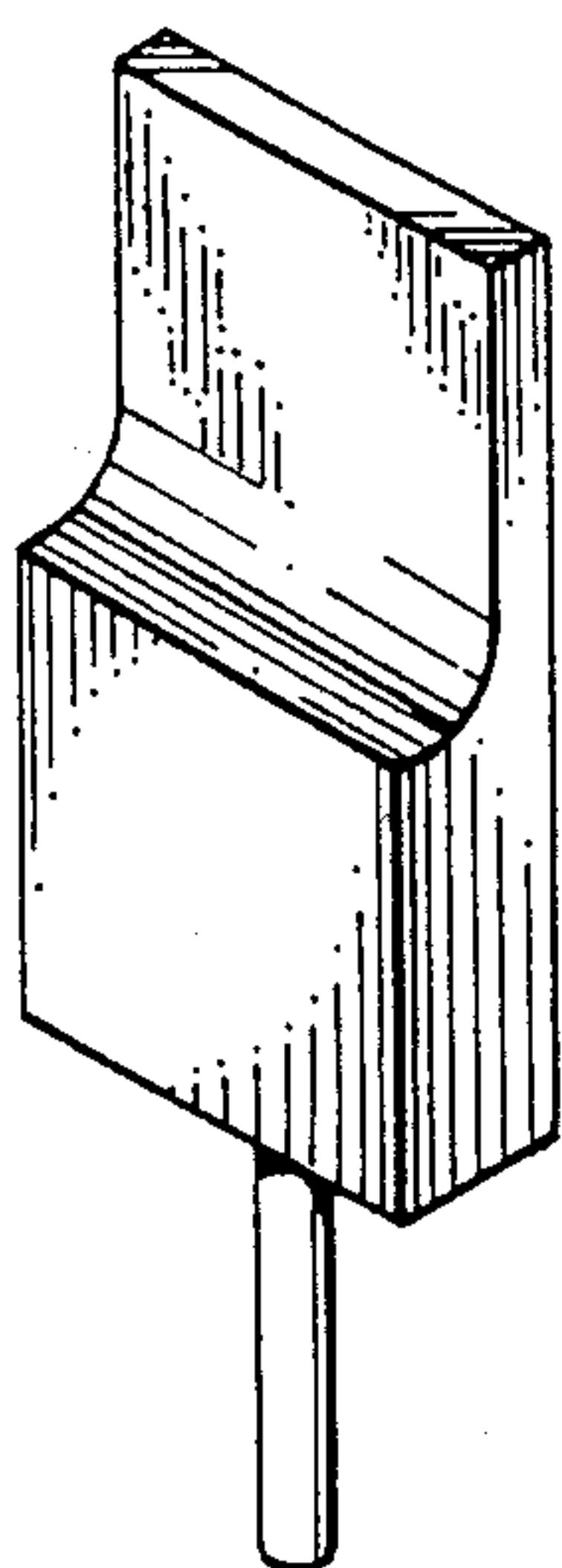

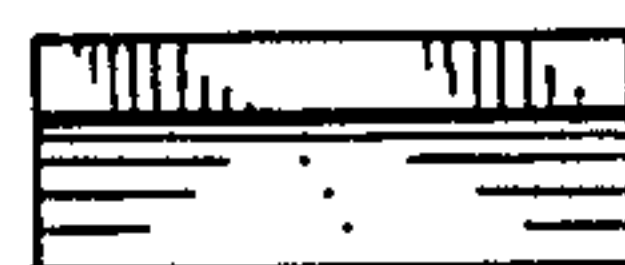

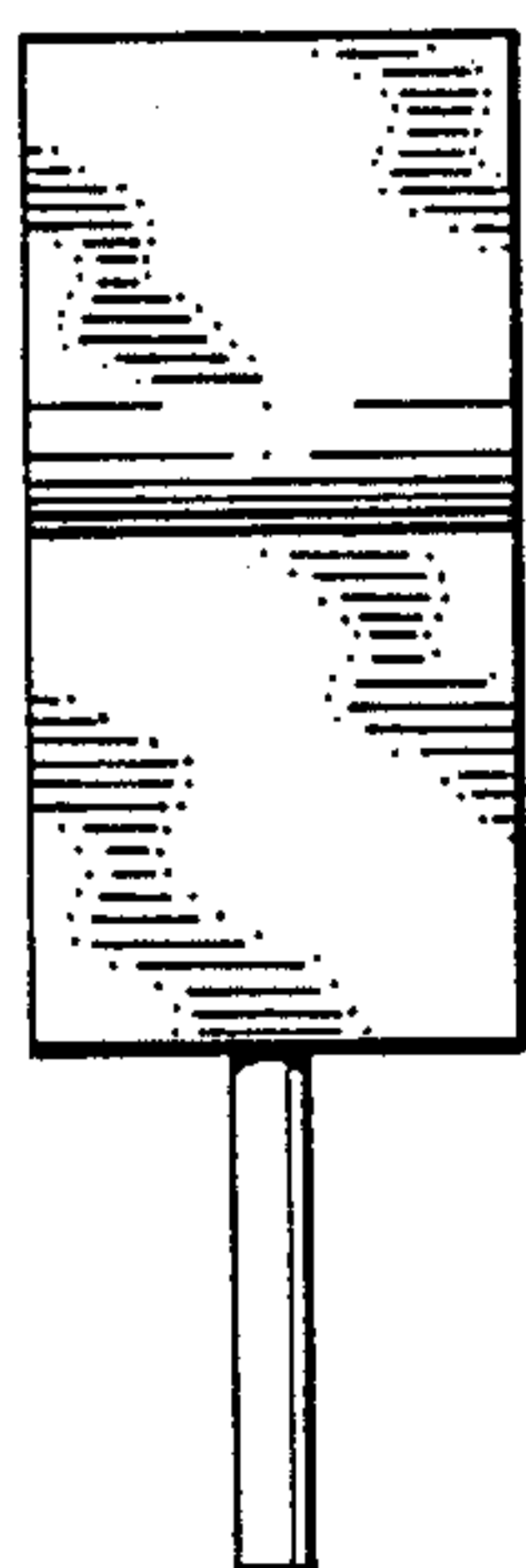

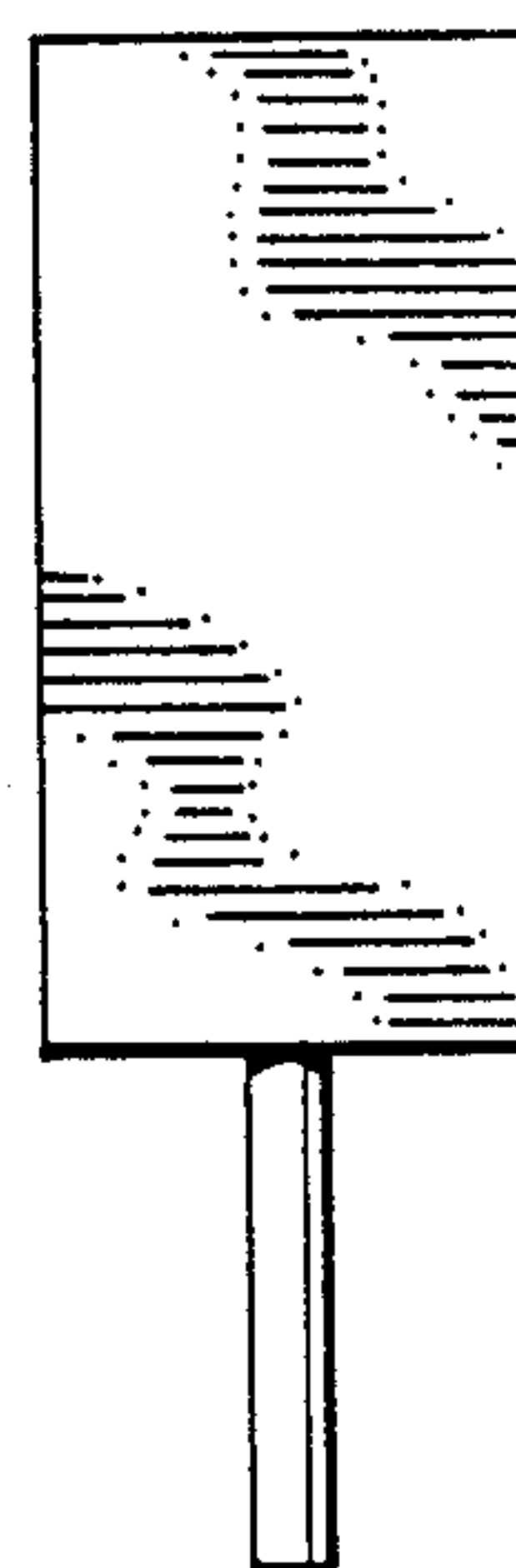
