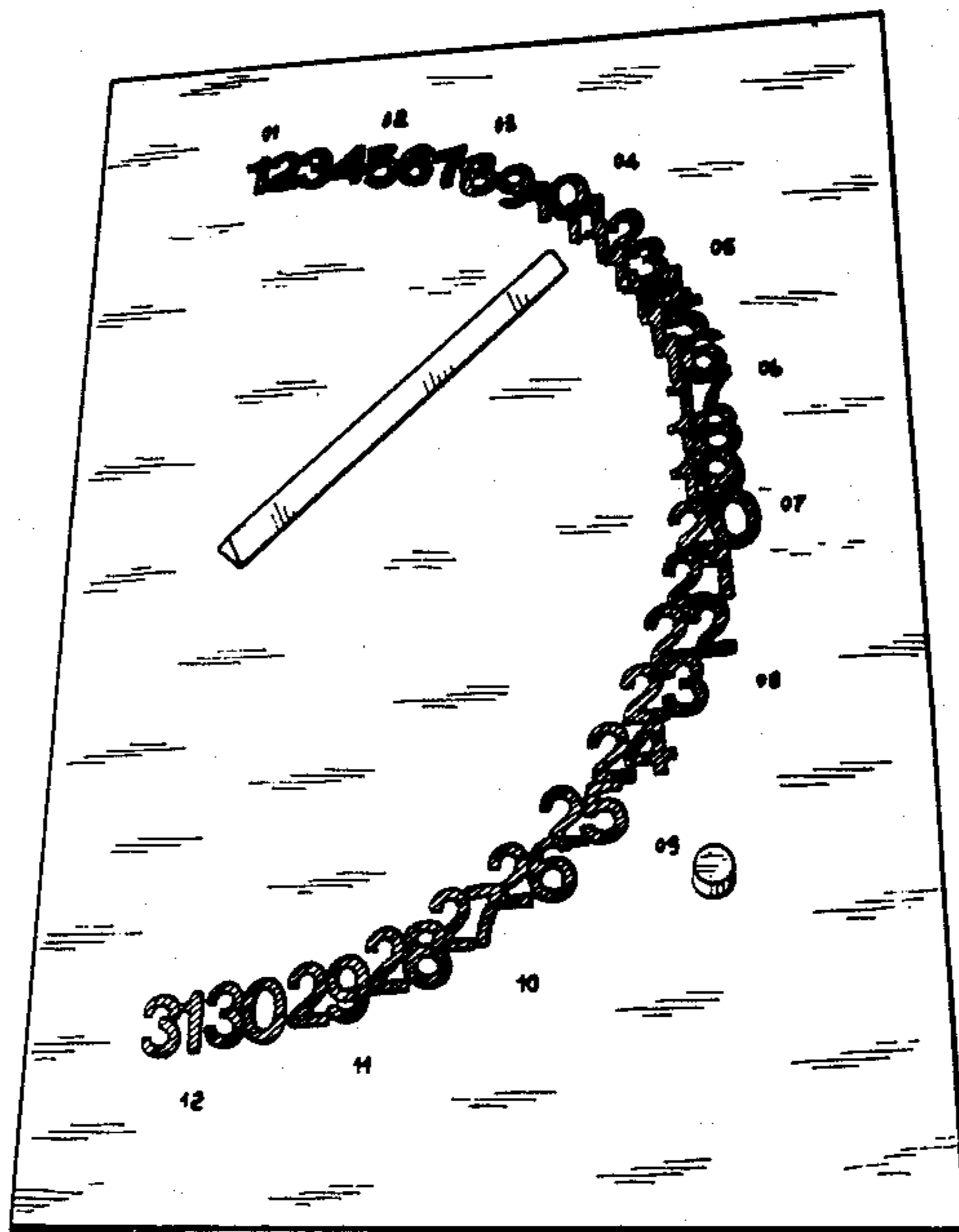

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for perpetual wall calendar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a perpetual wall calendar showing my new design on an enlarged scale; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. The undisclosed rear surface is conventionally flat and unornamented.



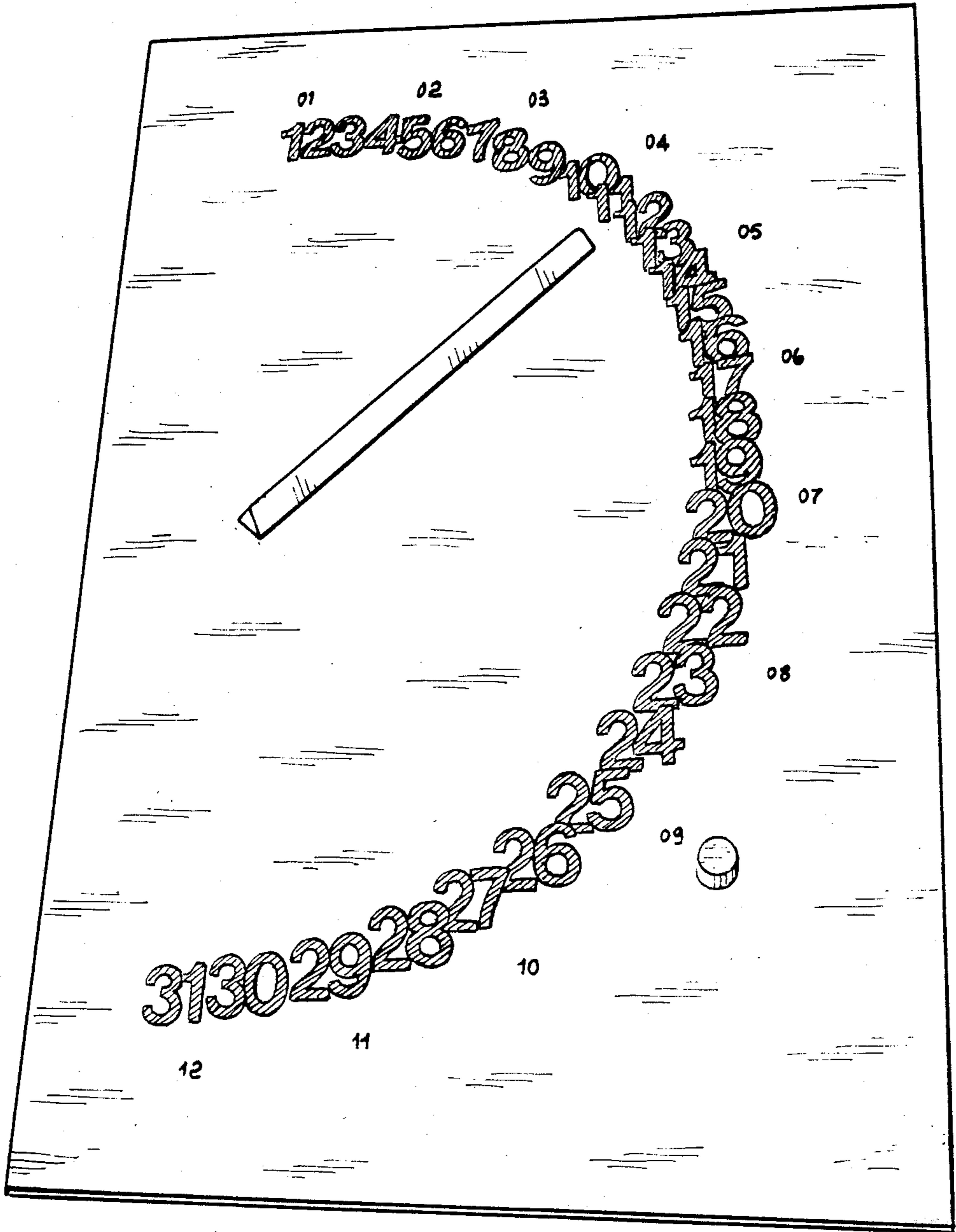

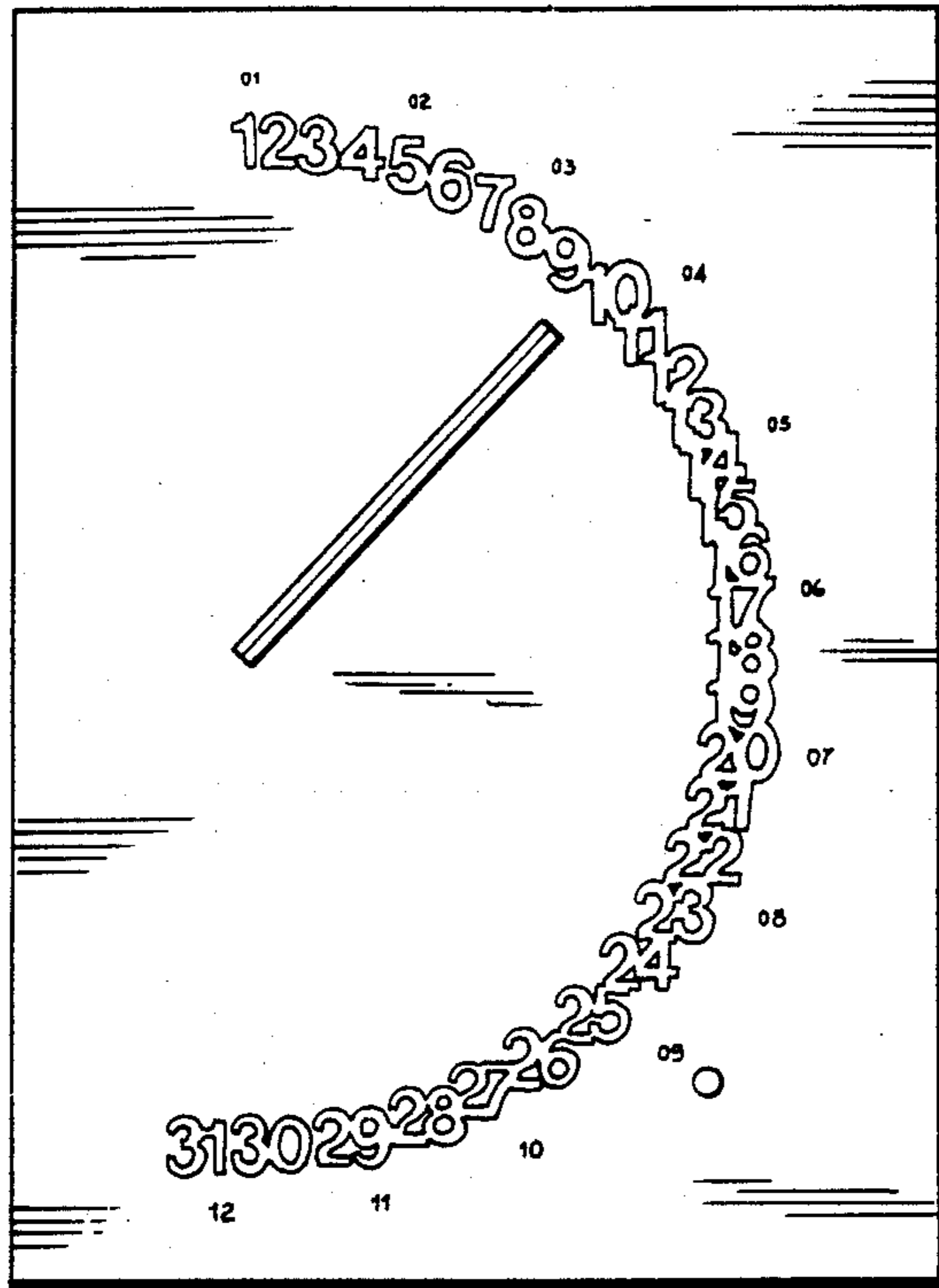

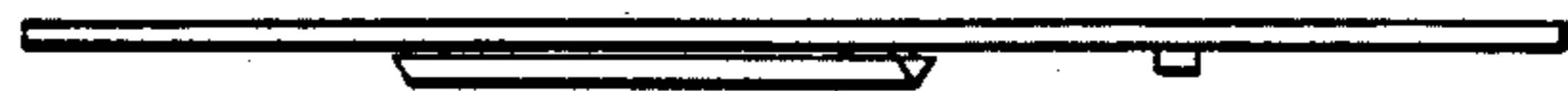

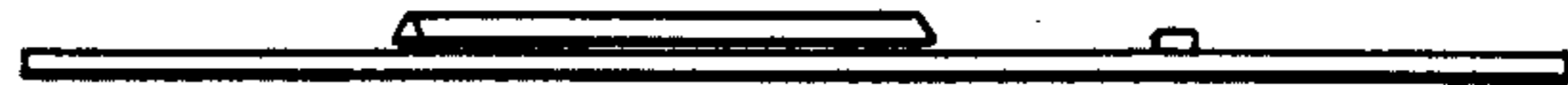
