The ornamental design for a shoe horn, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a shoe horn showing my new design, with the shaft of the device being shown broken away to indicate indeterminant length; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

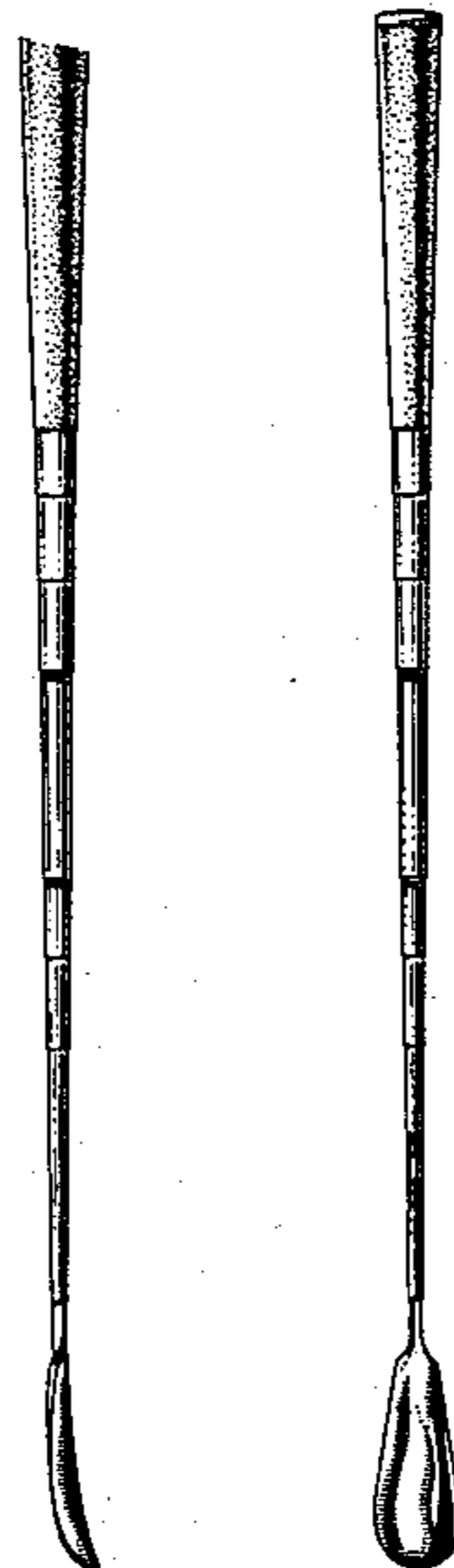

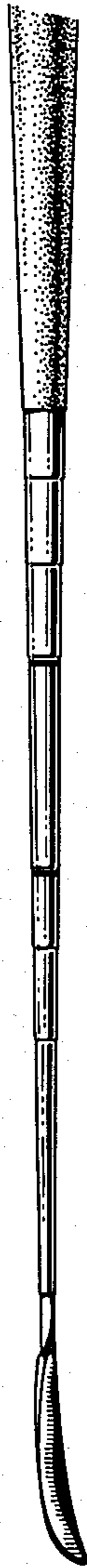
