FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

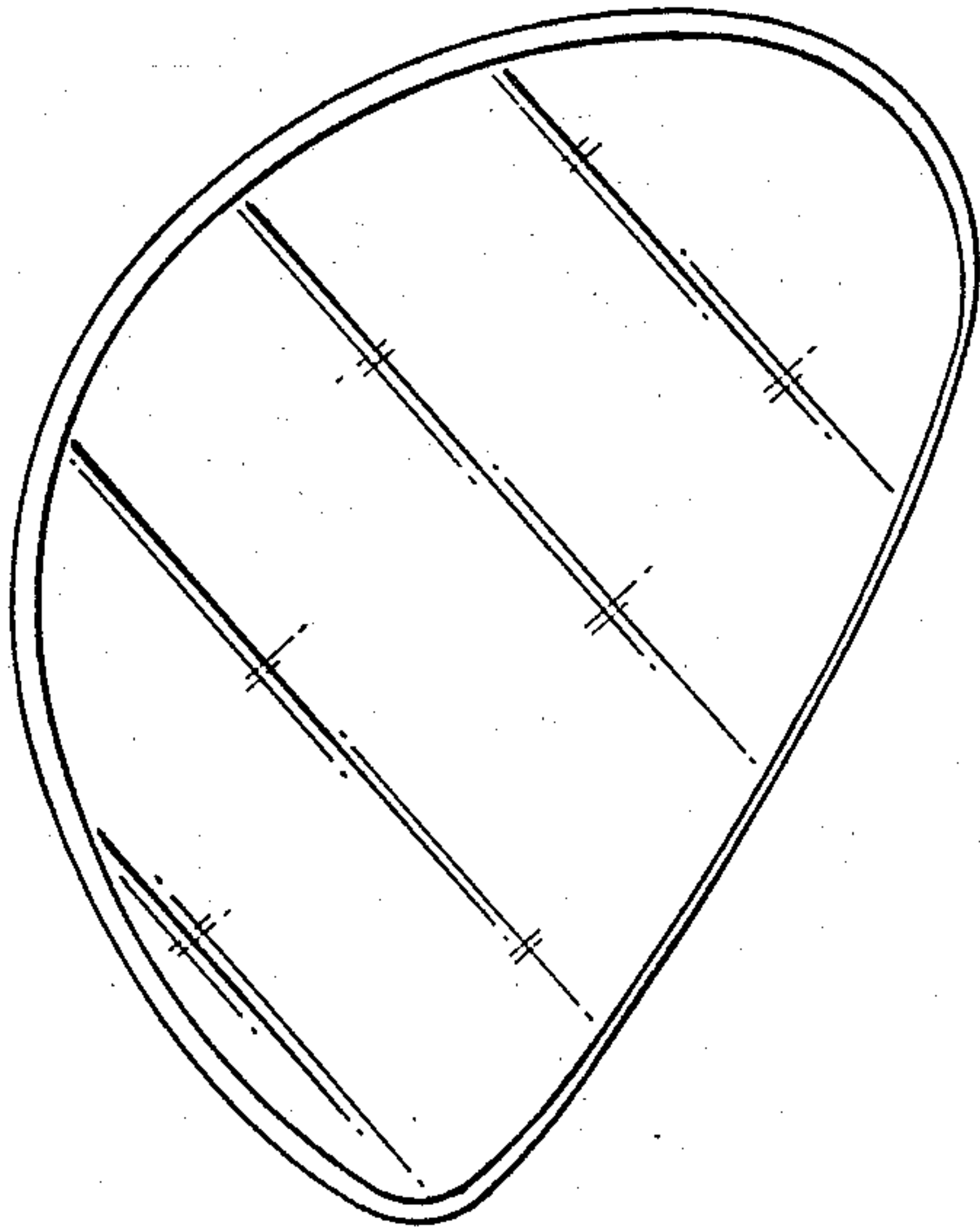

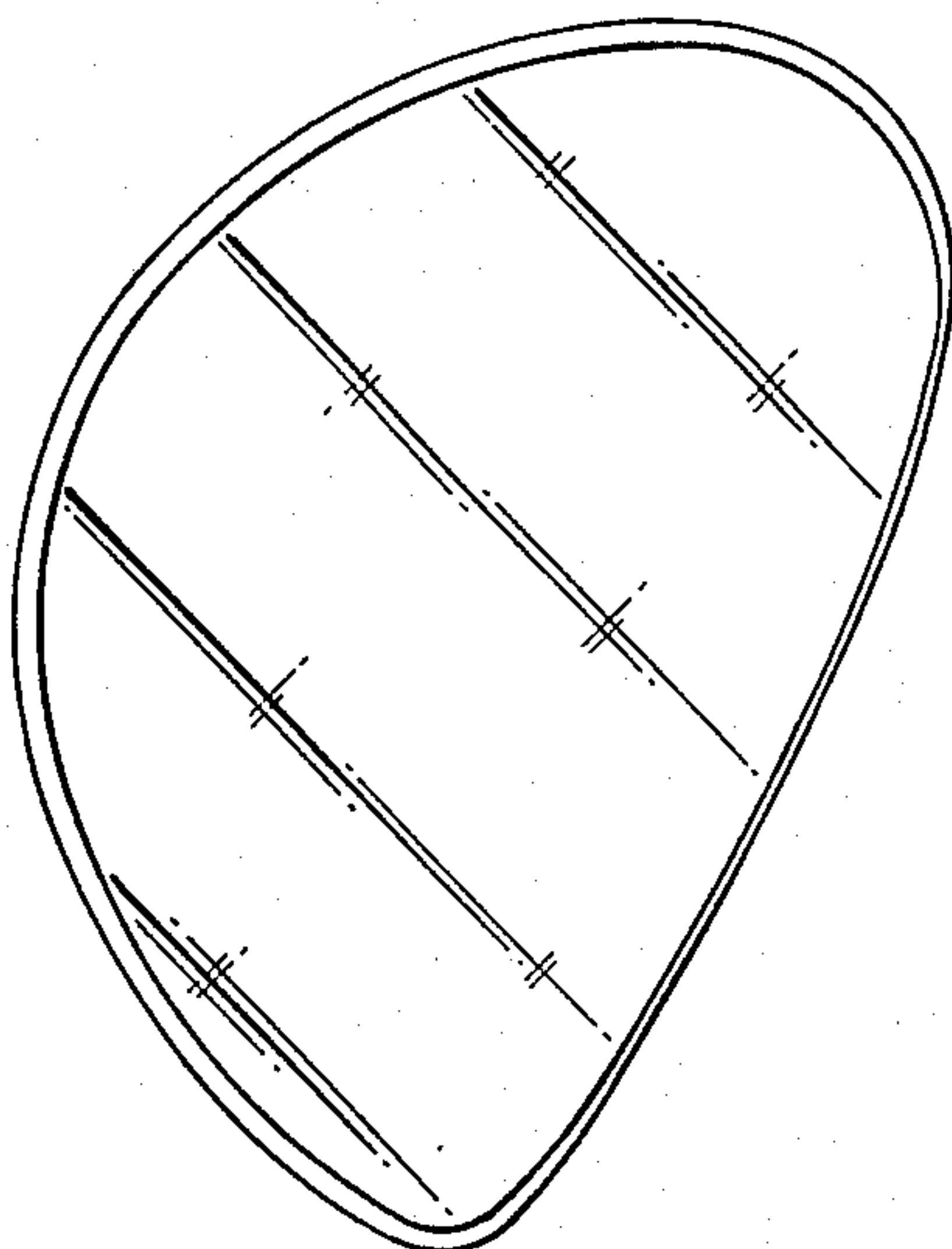

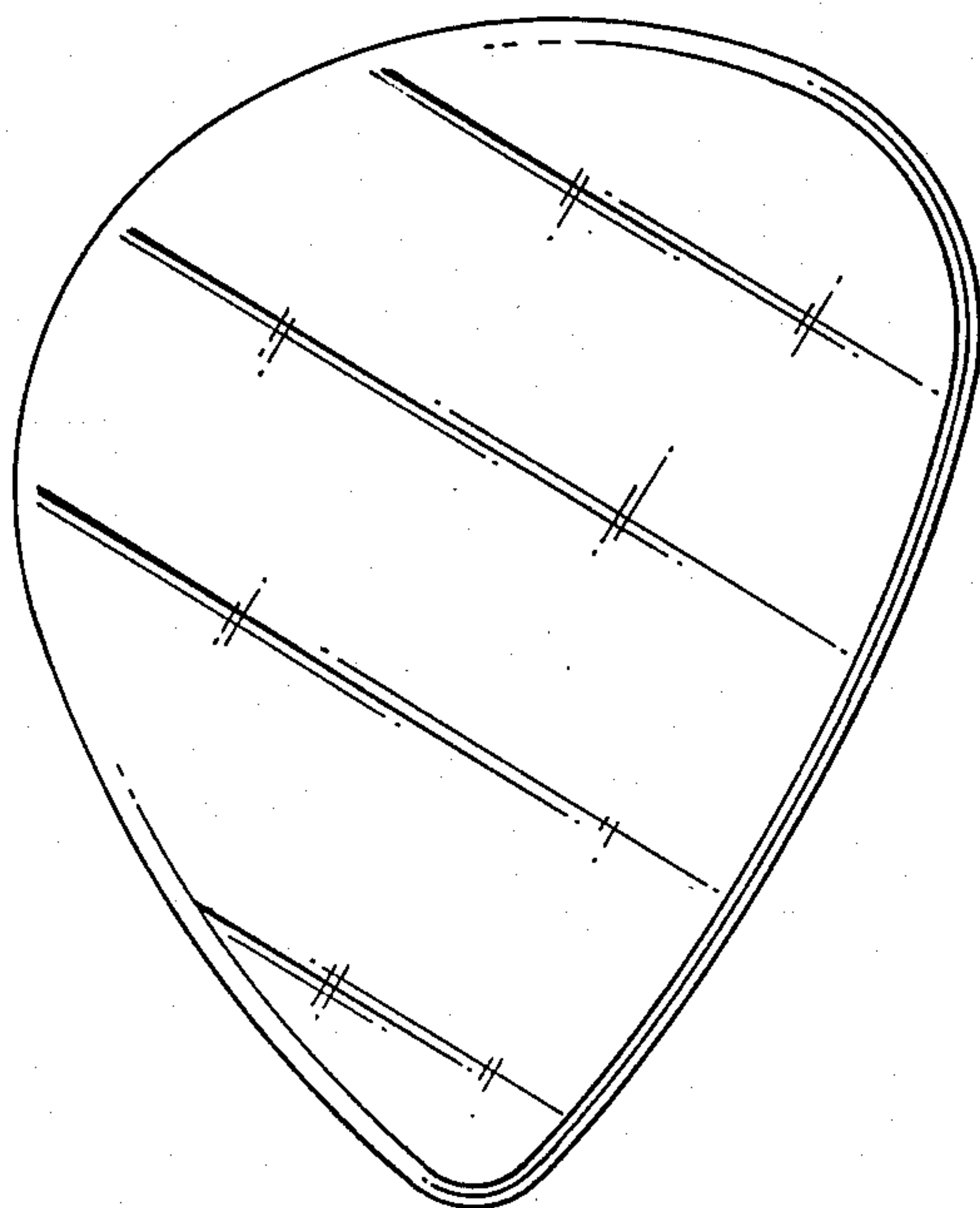

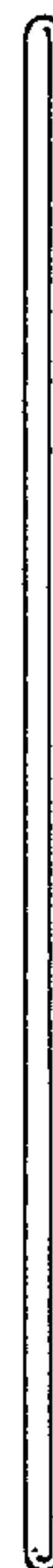
