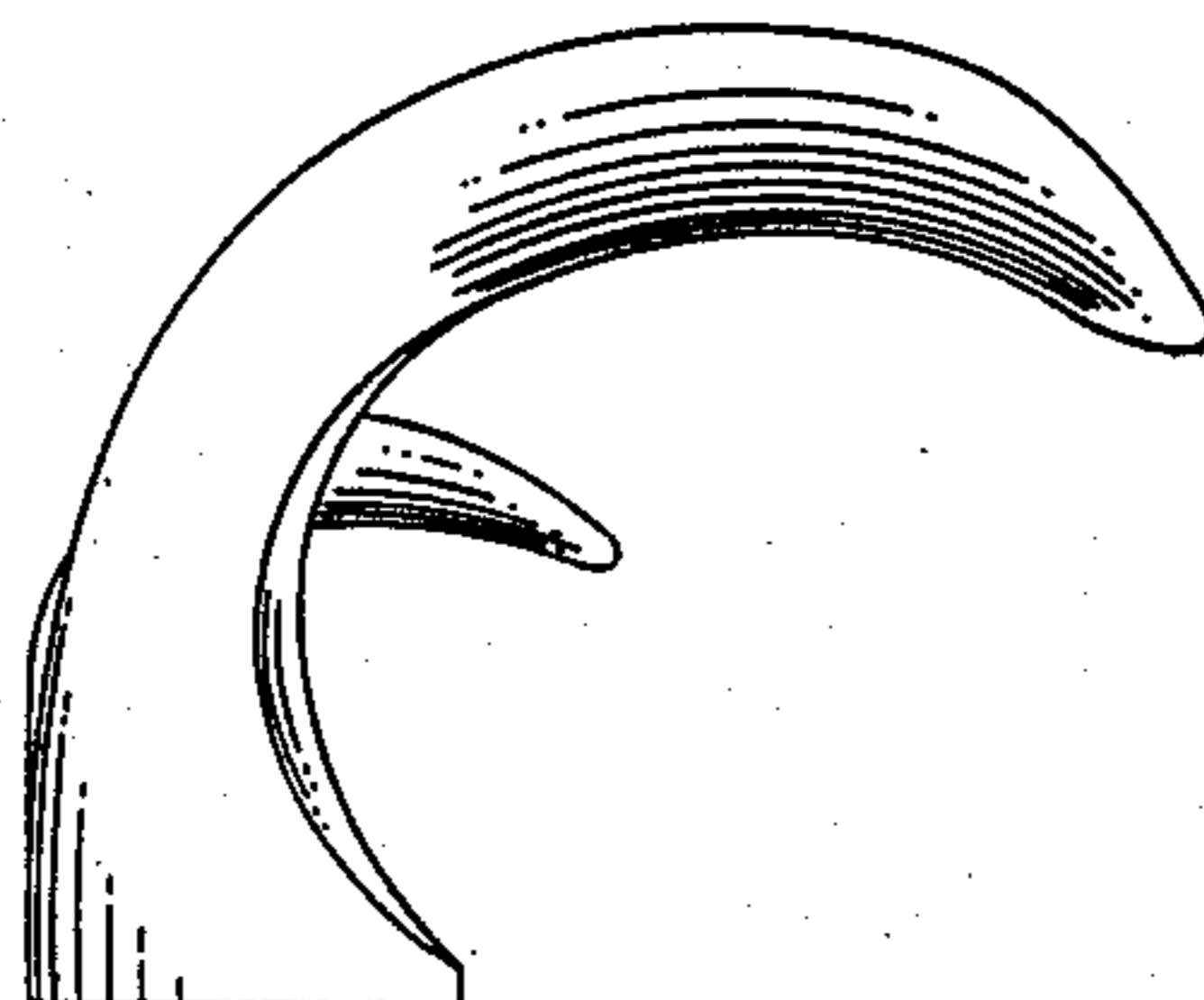
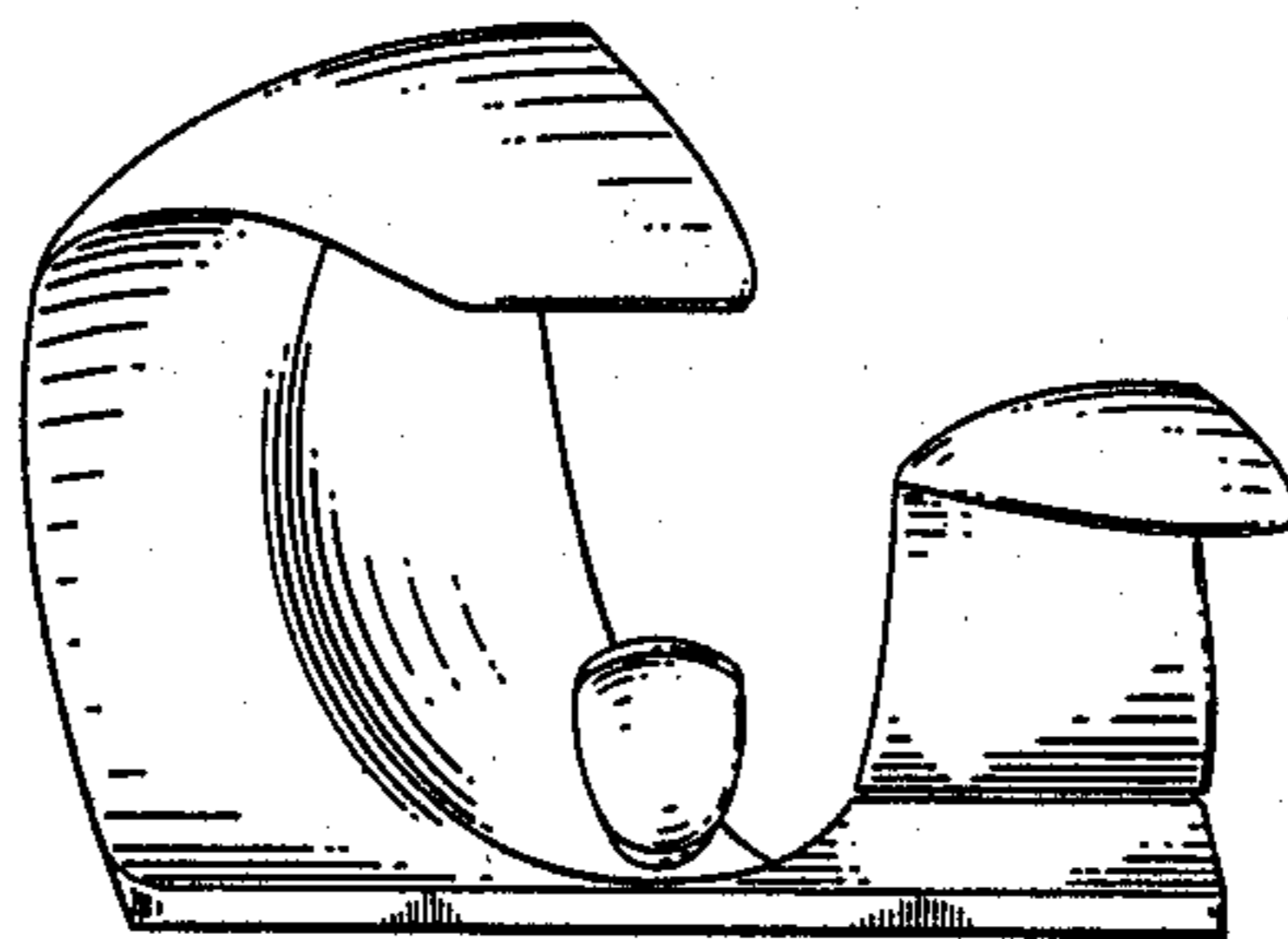

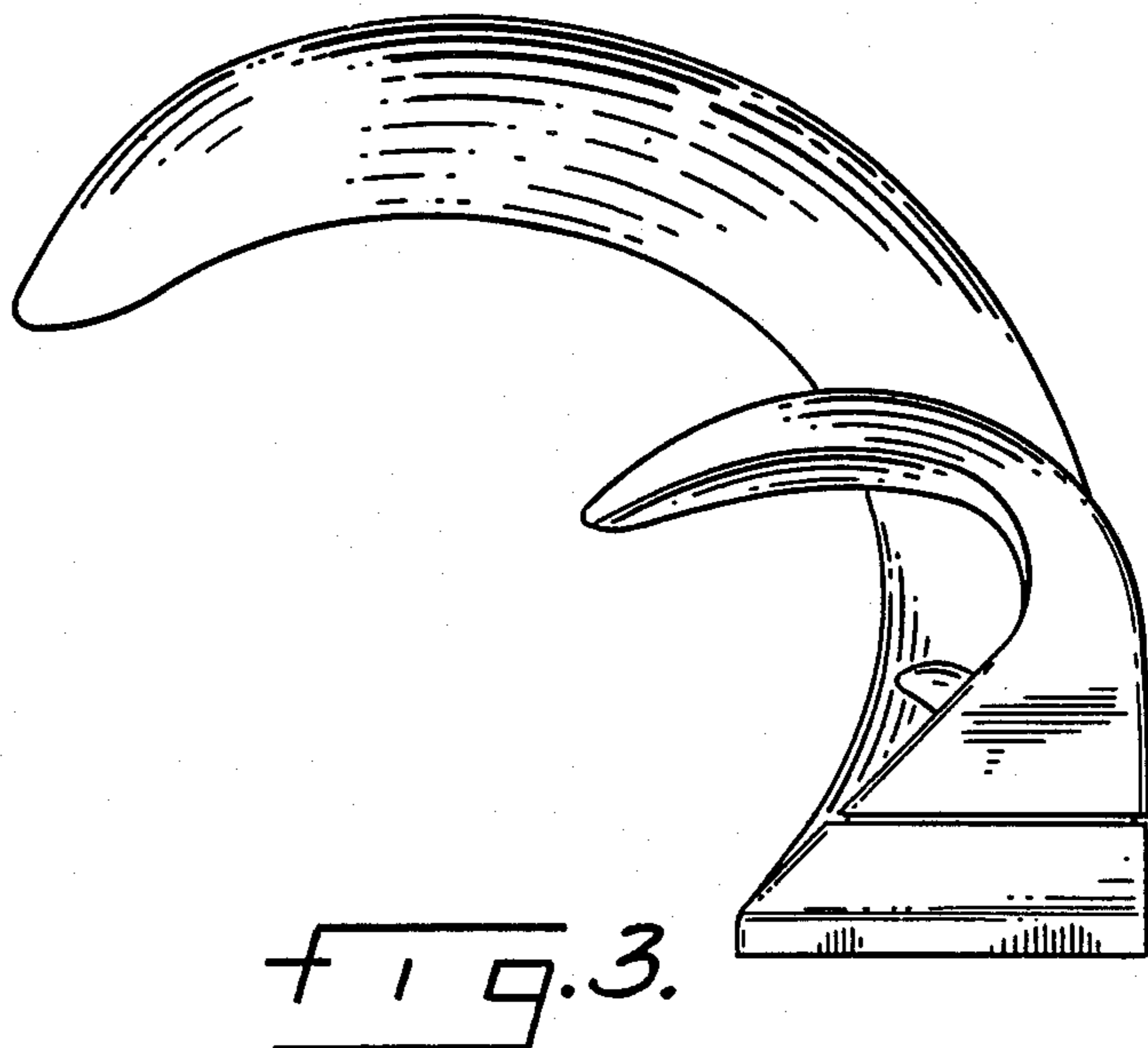
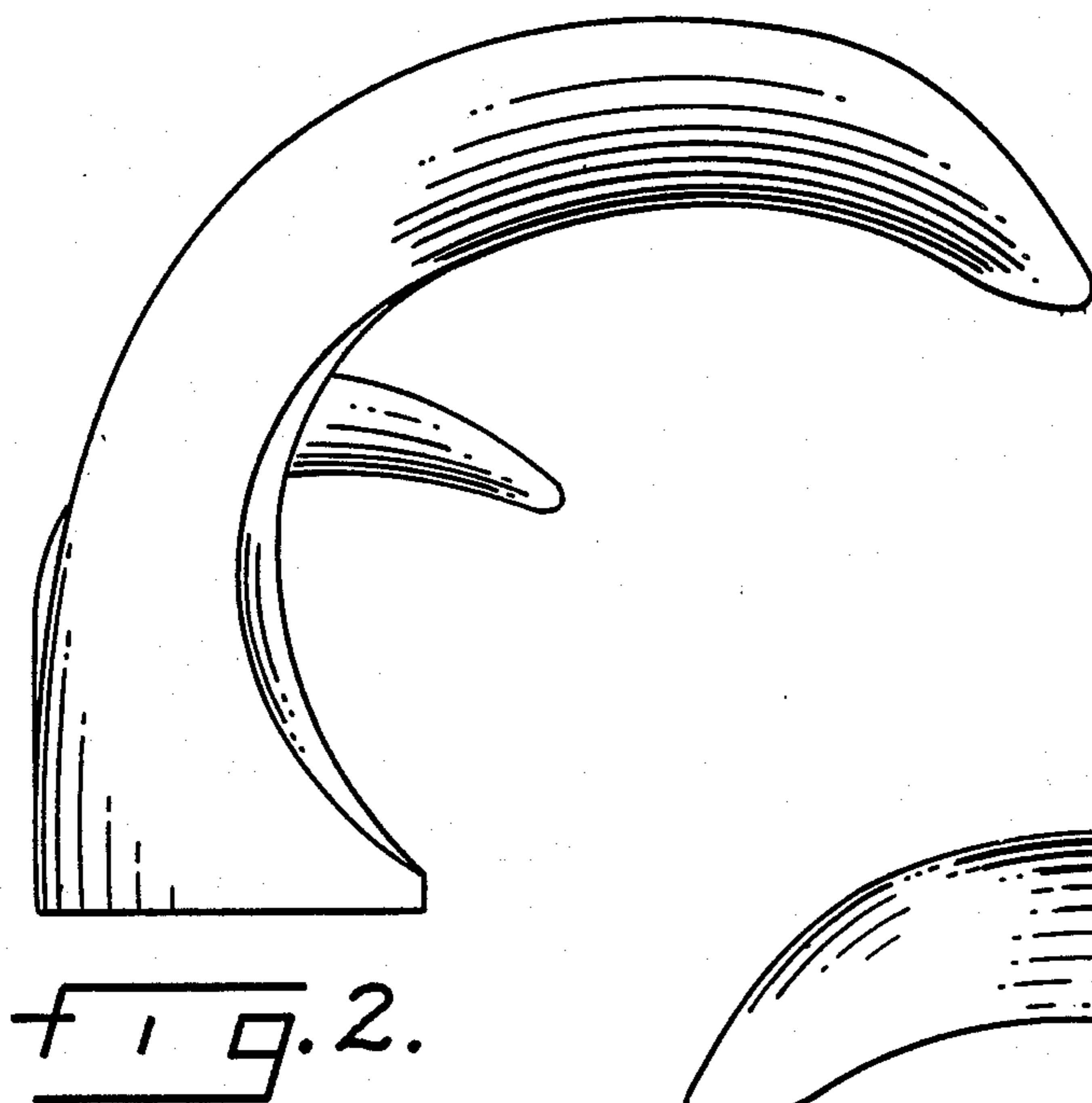
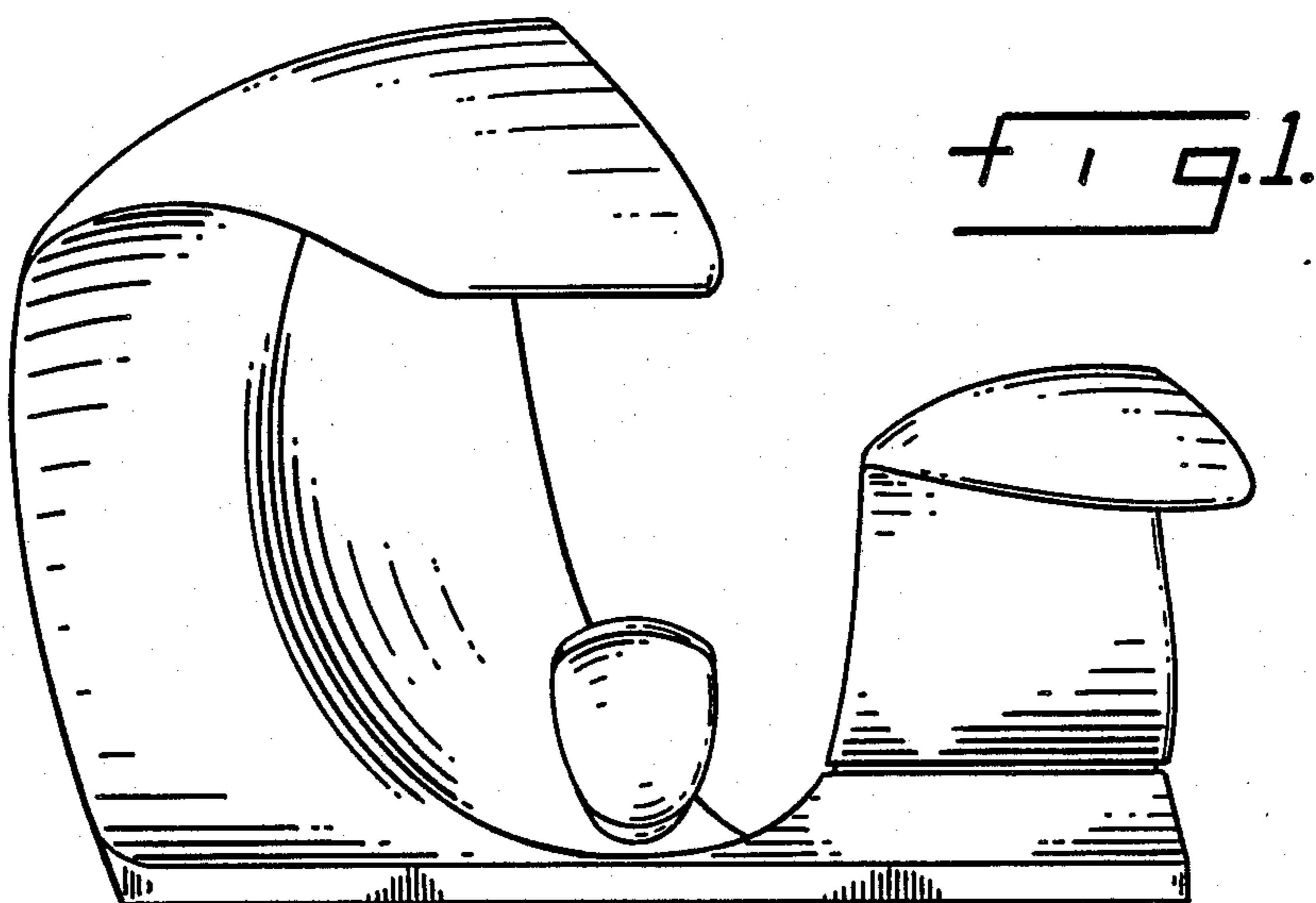
[57] CLAIM

 FIG. 11 is a rear view of FIG. 7.





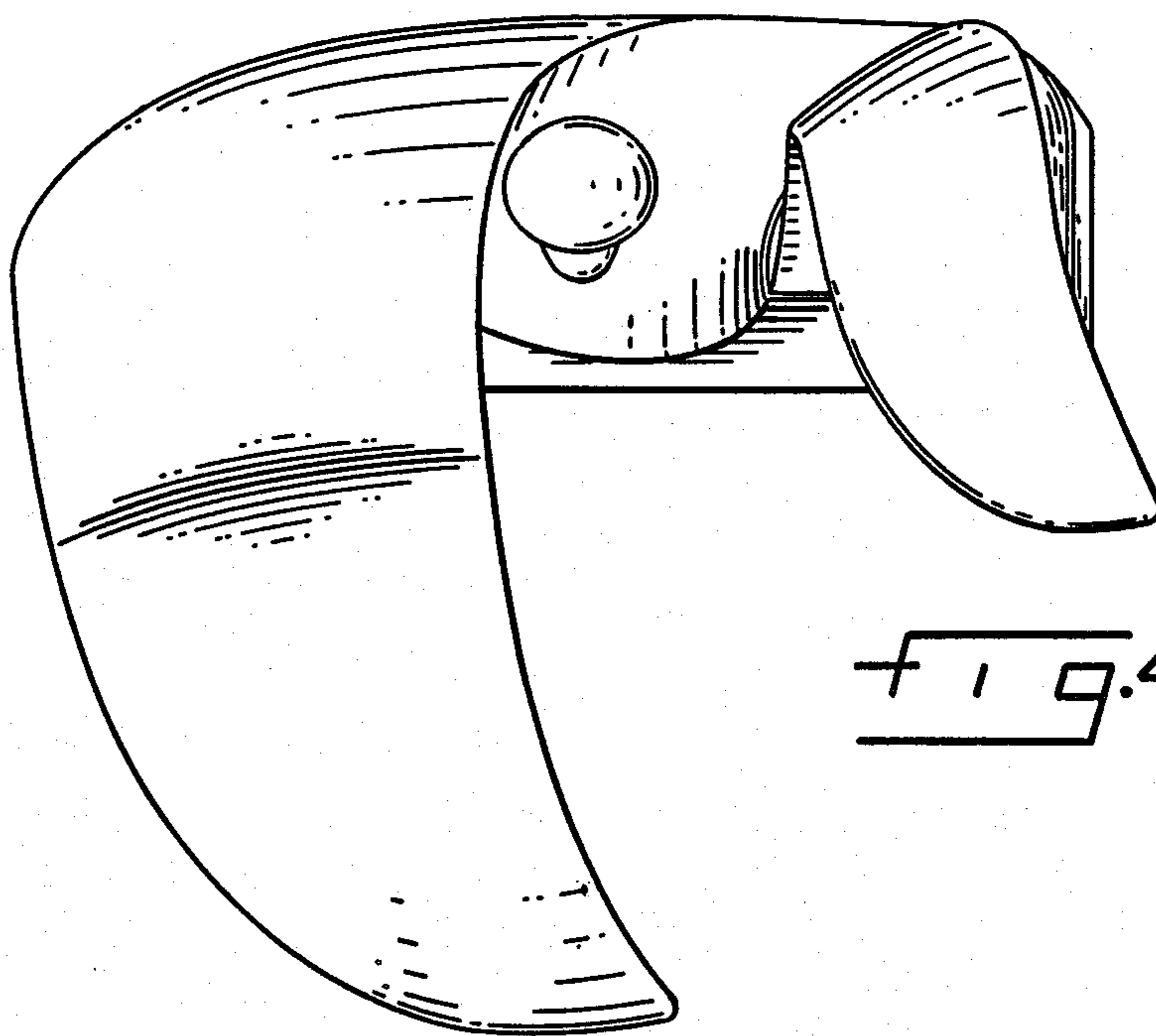

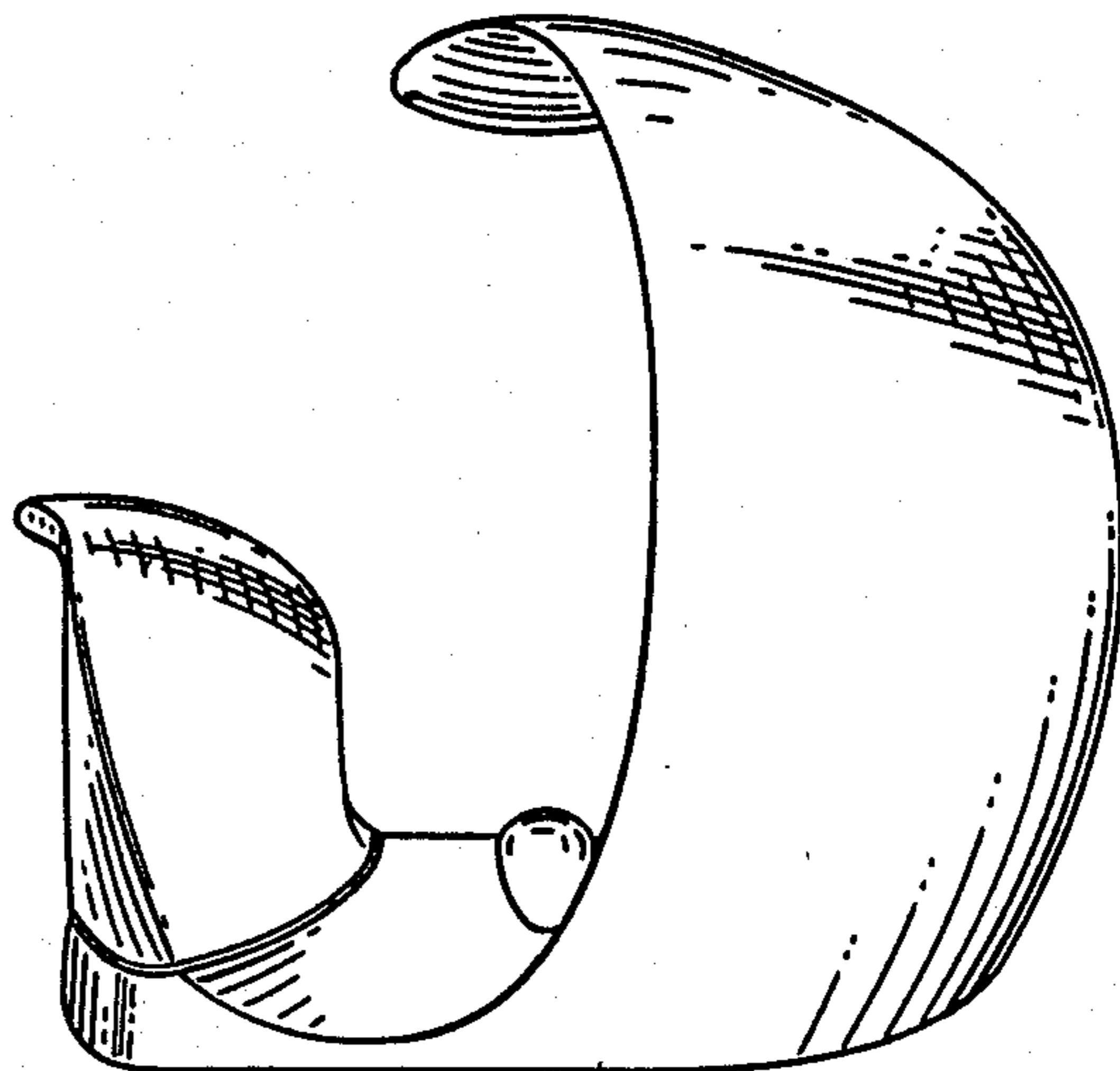

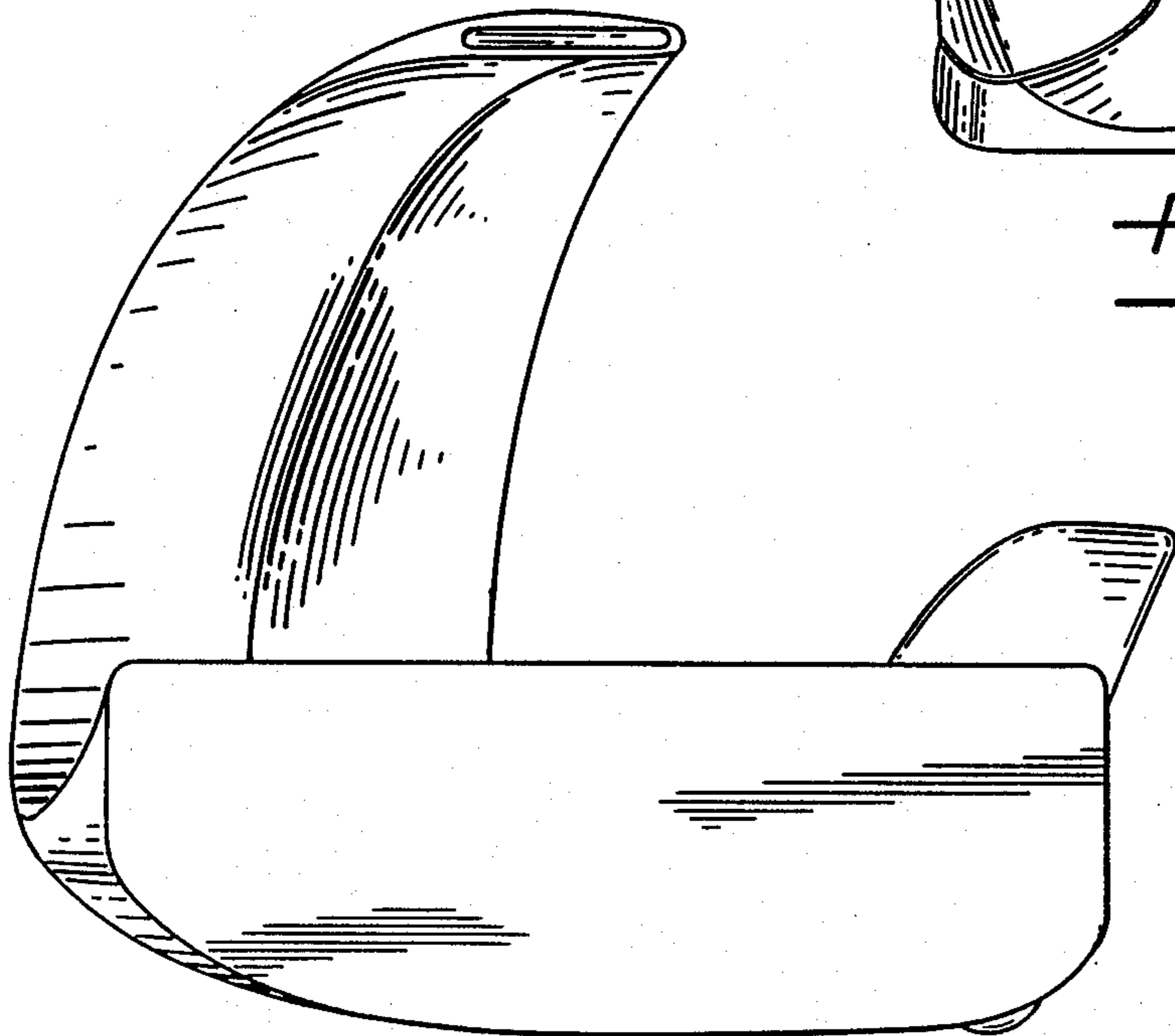

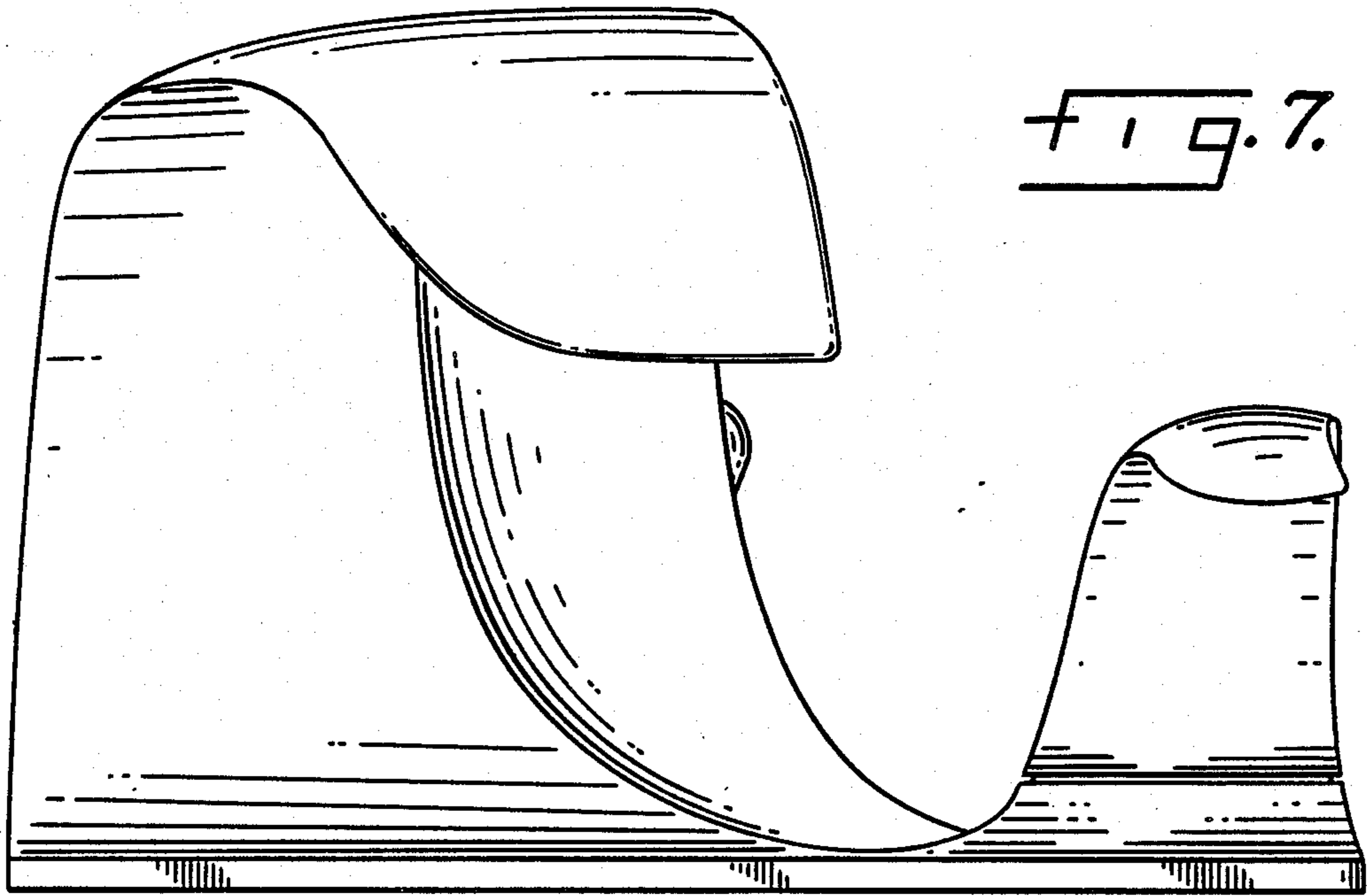

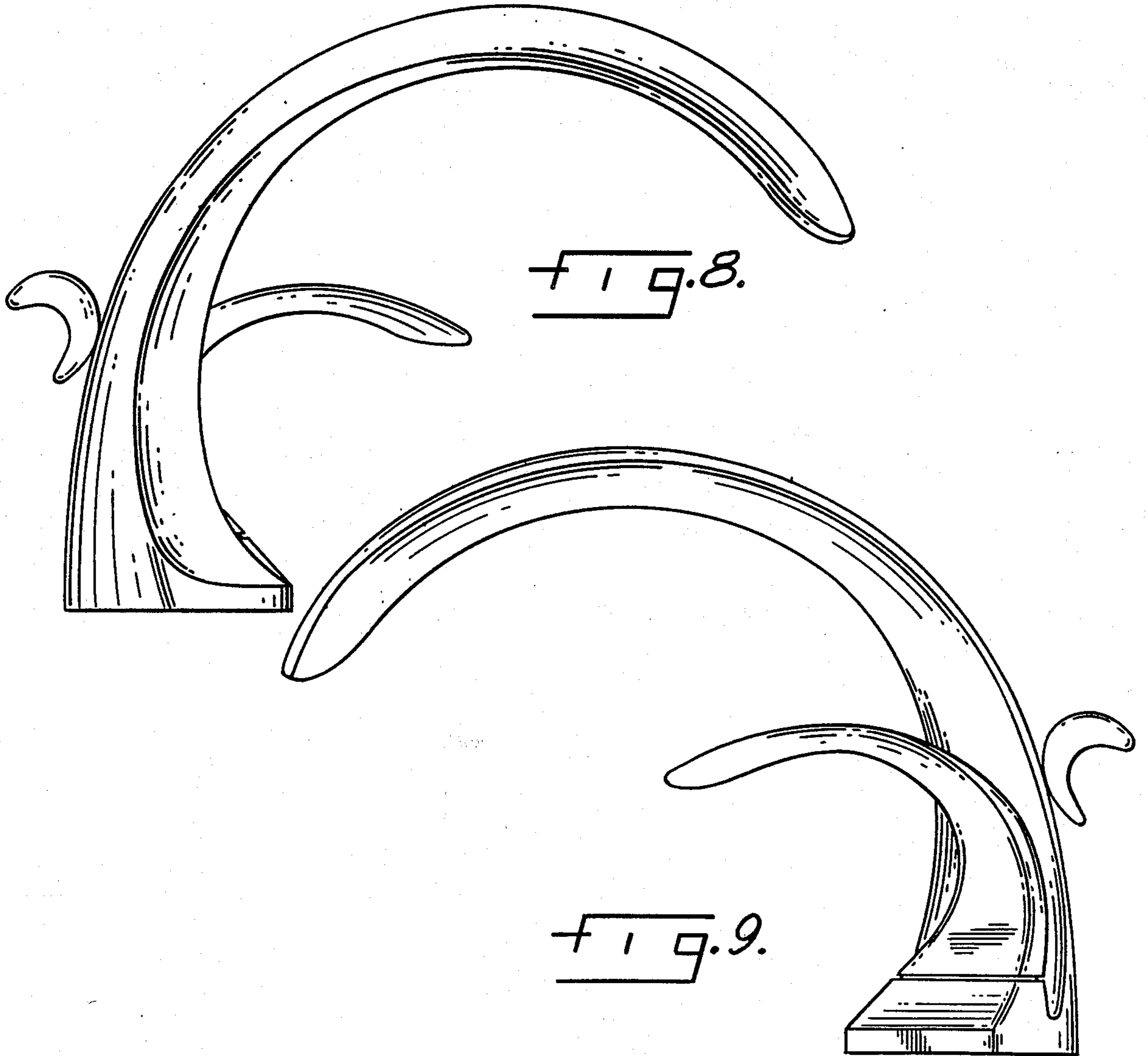

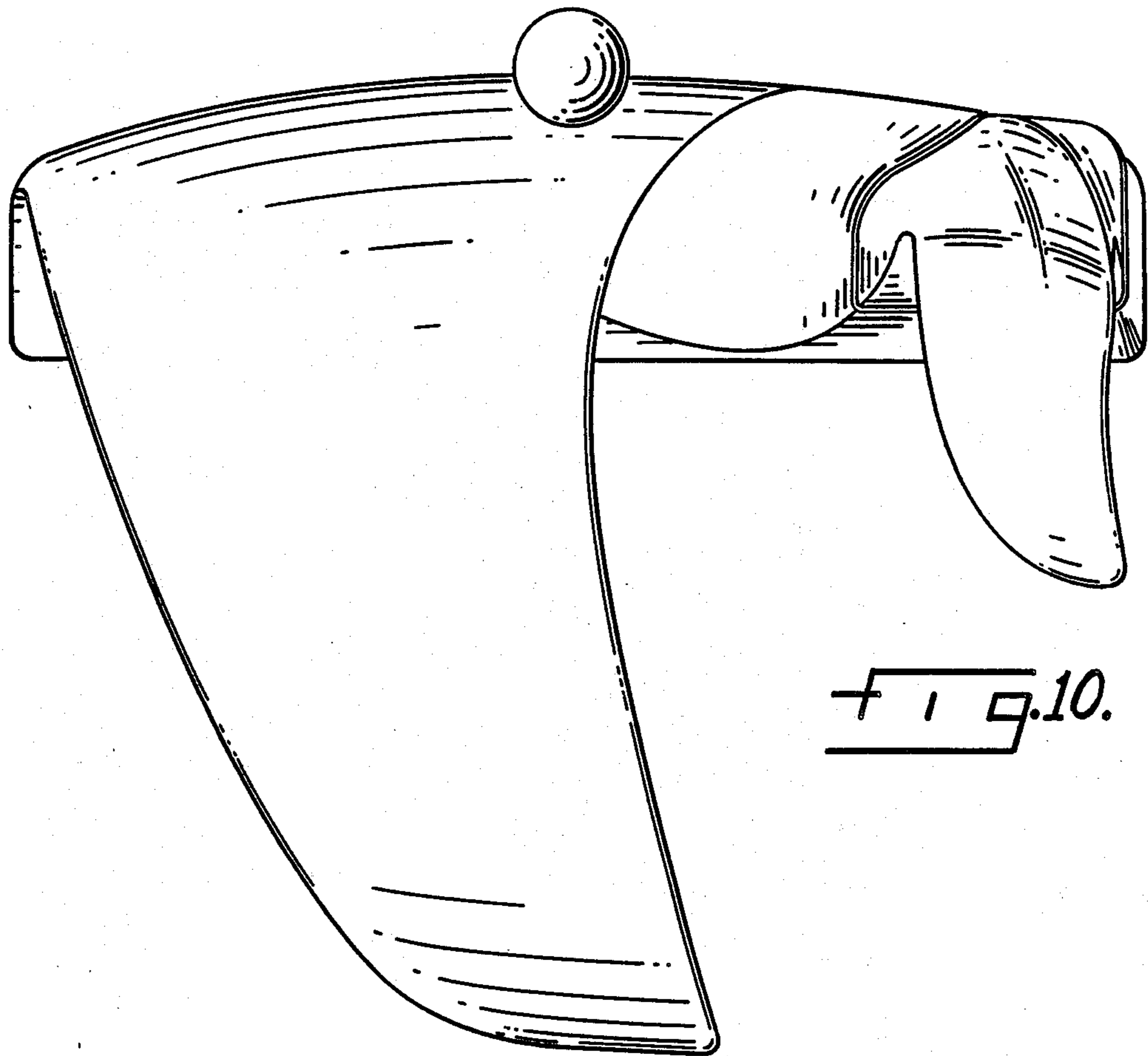

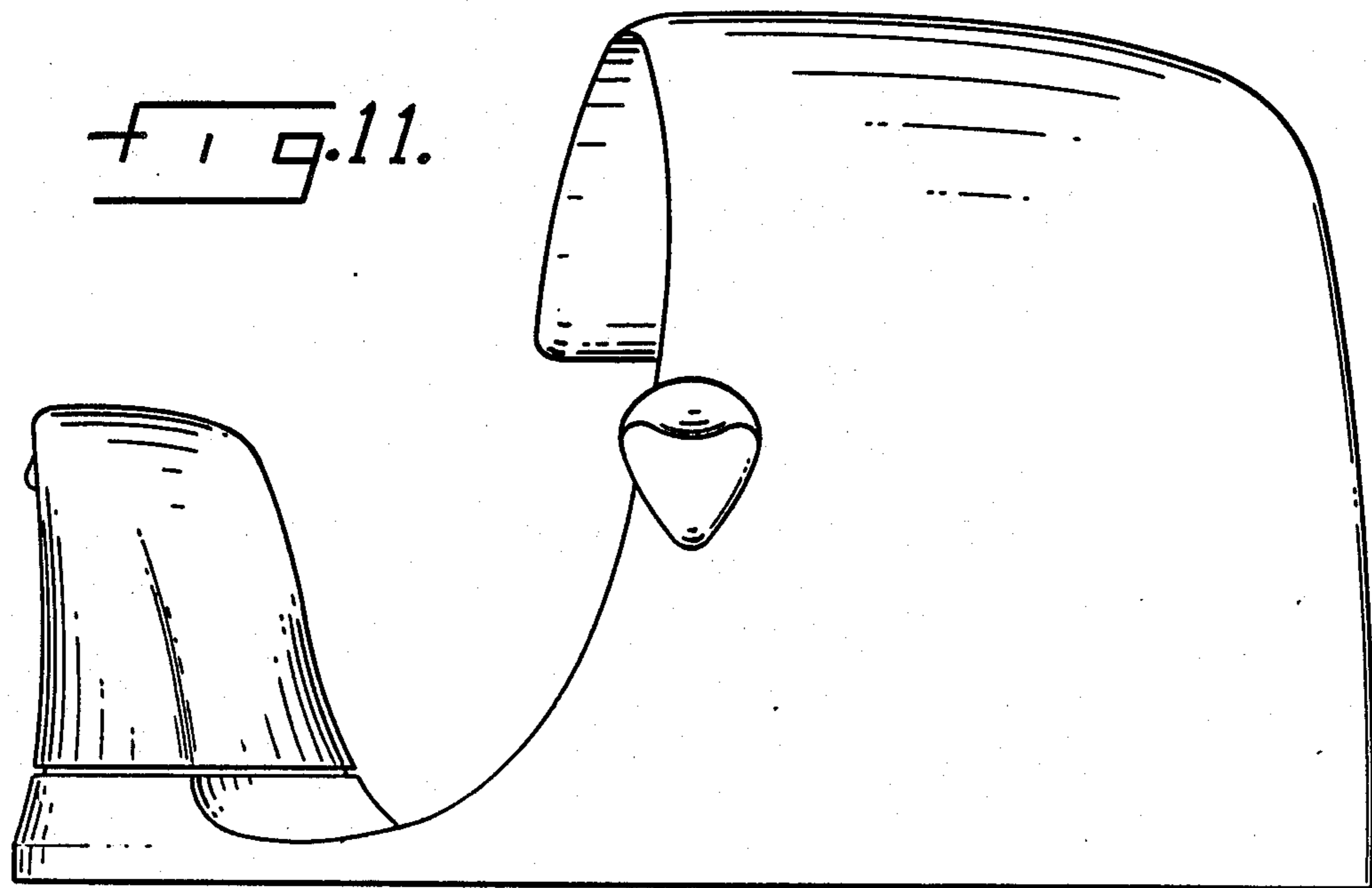
