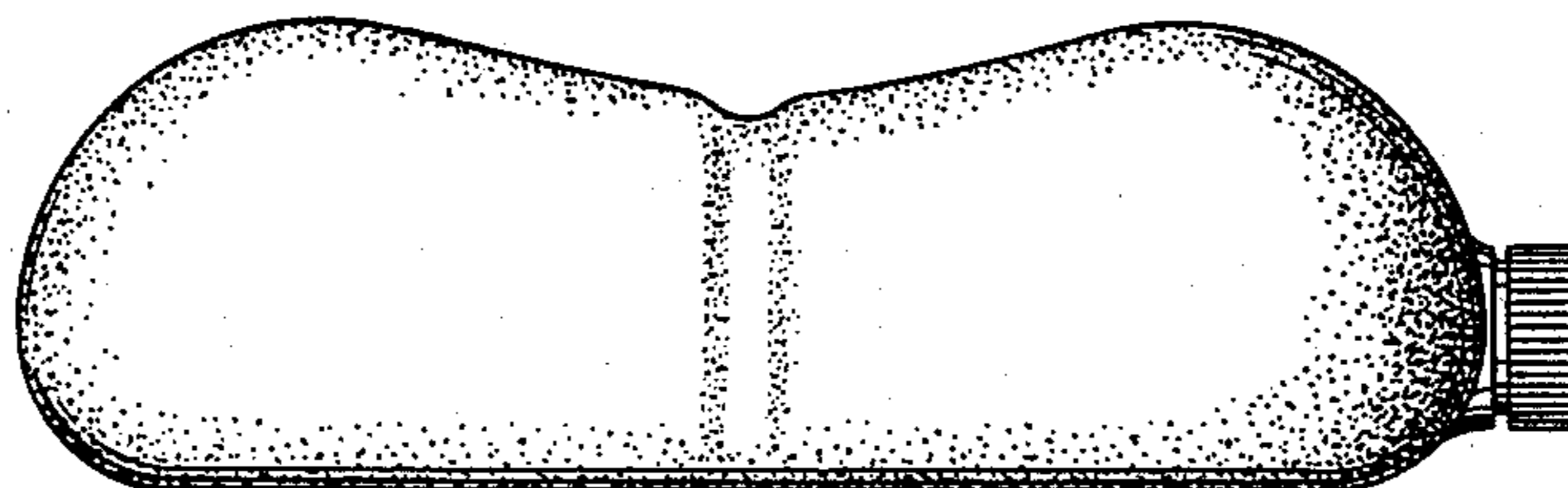
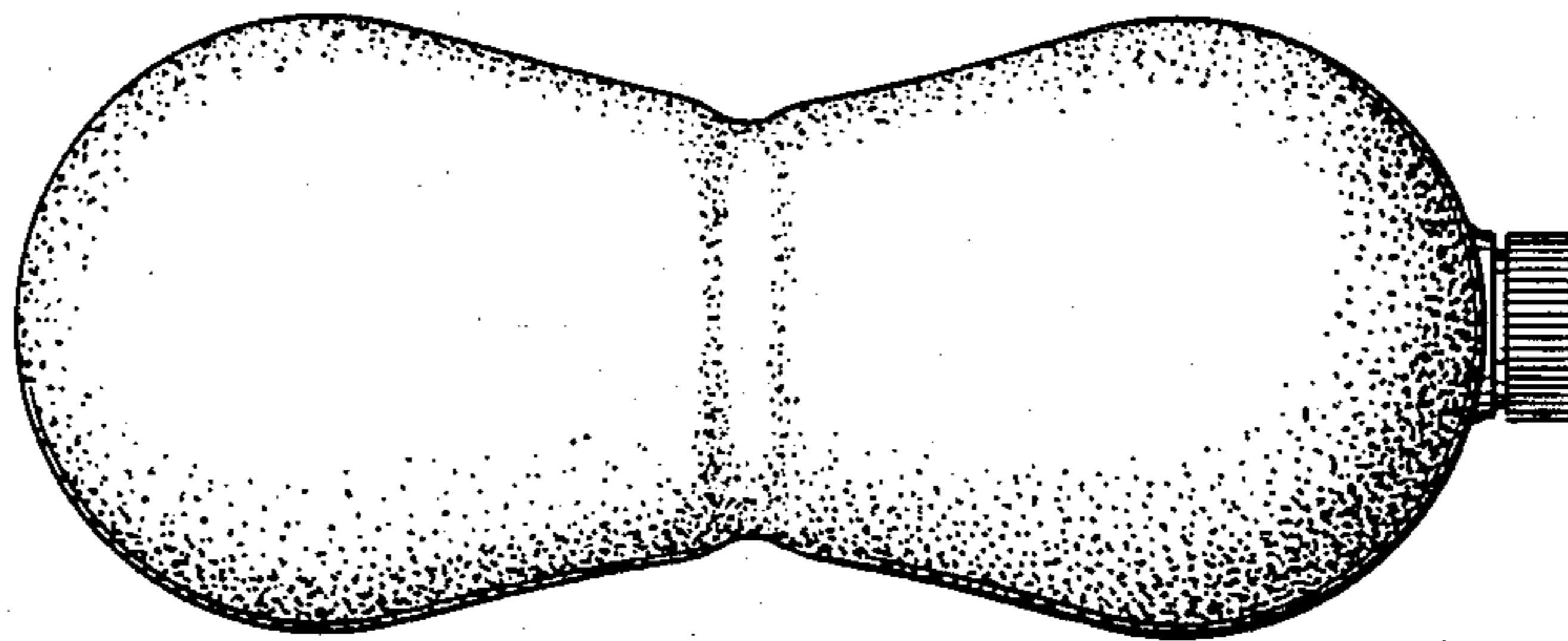

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a therapeutic traction pillow, showing my new design, the rear view being identical to that shown;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.



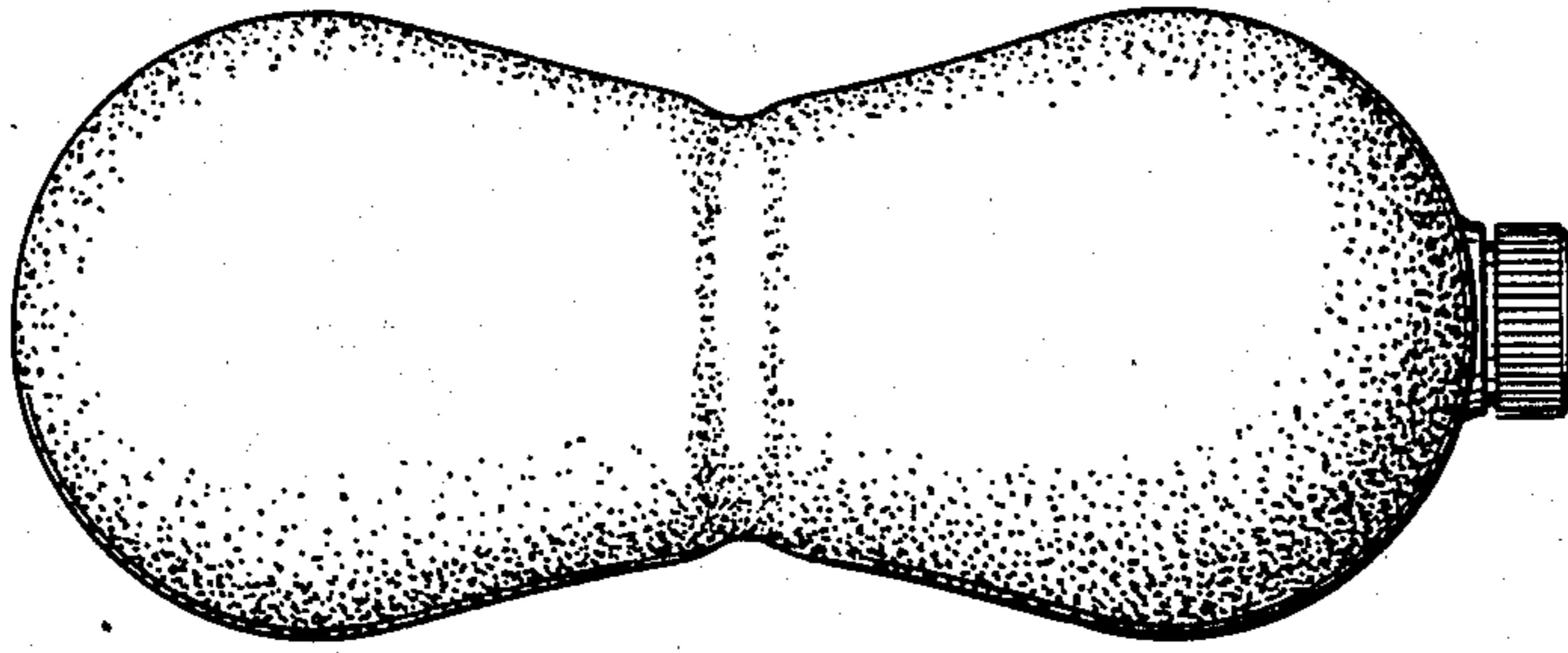

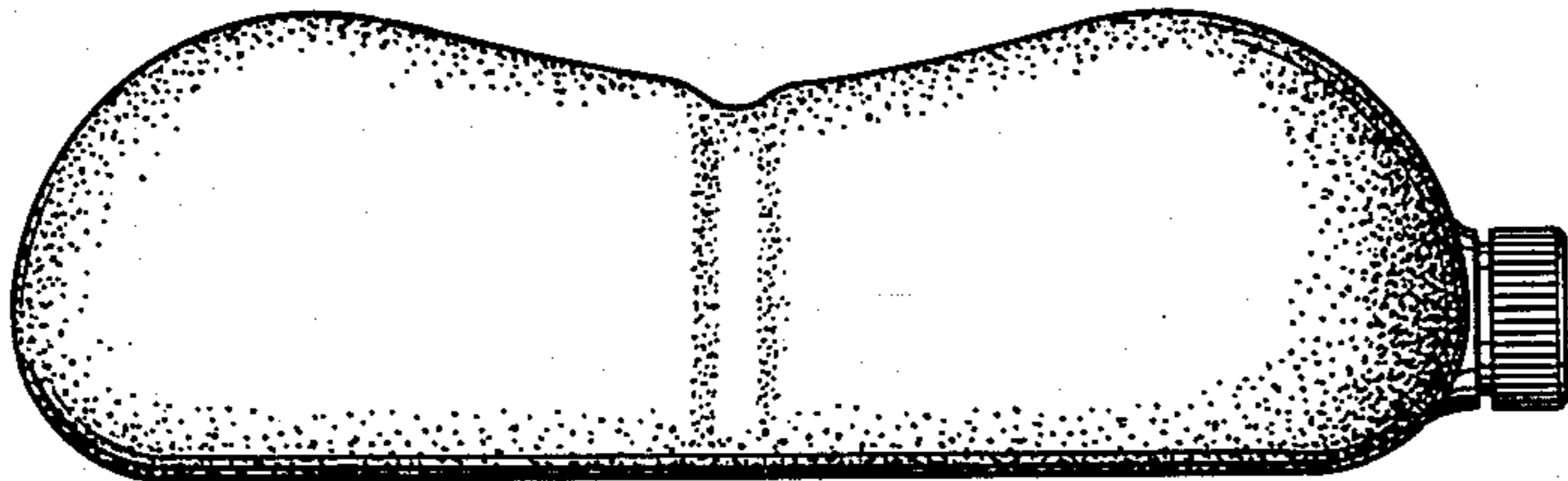

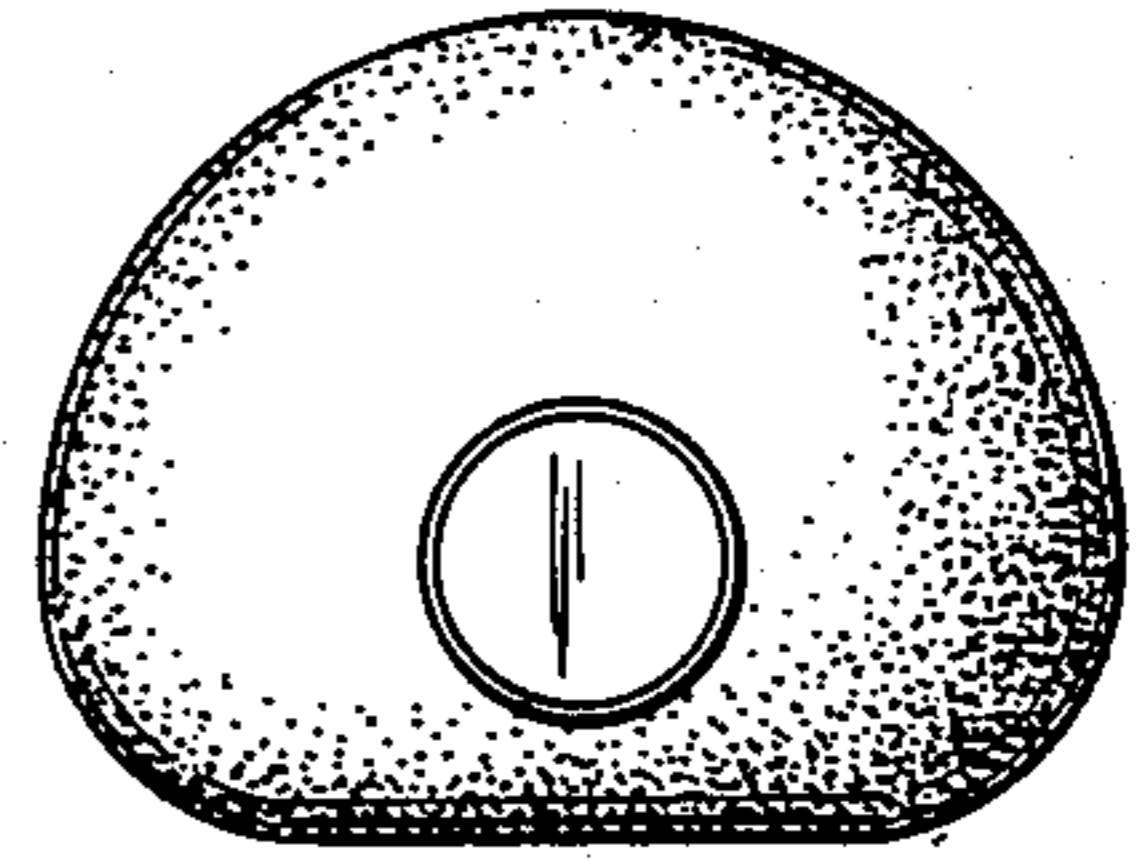

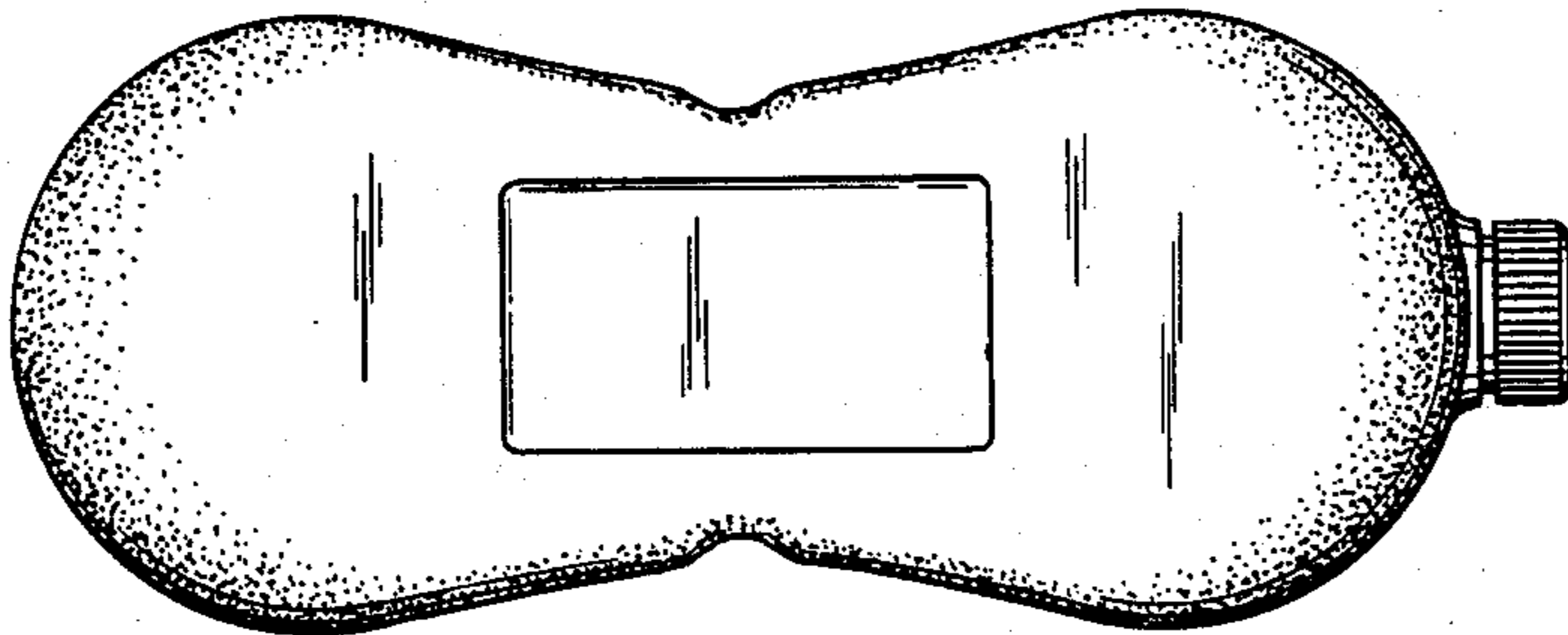

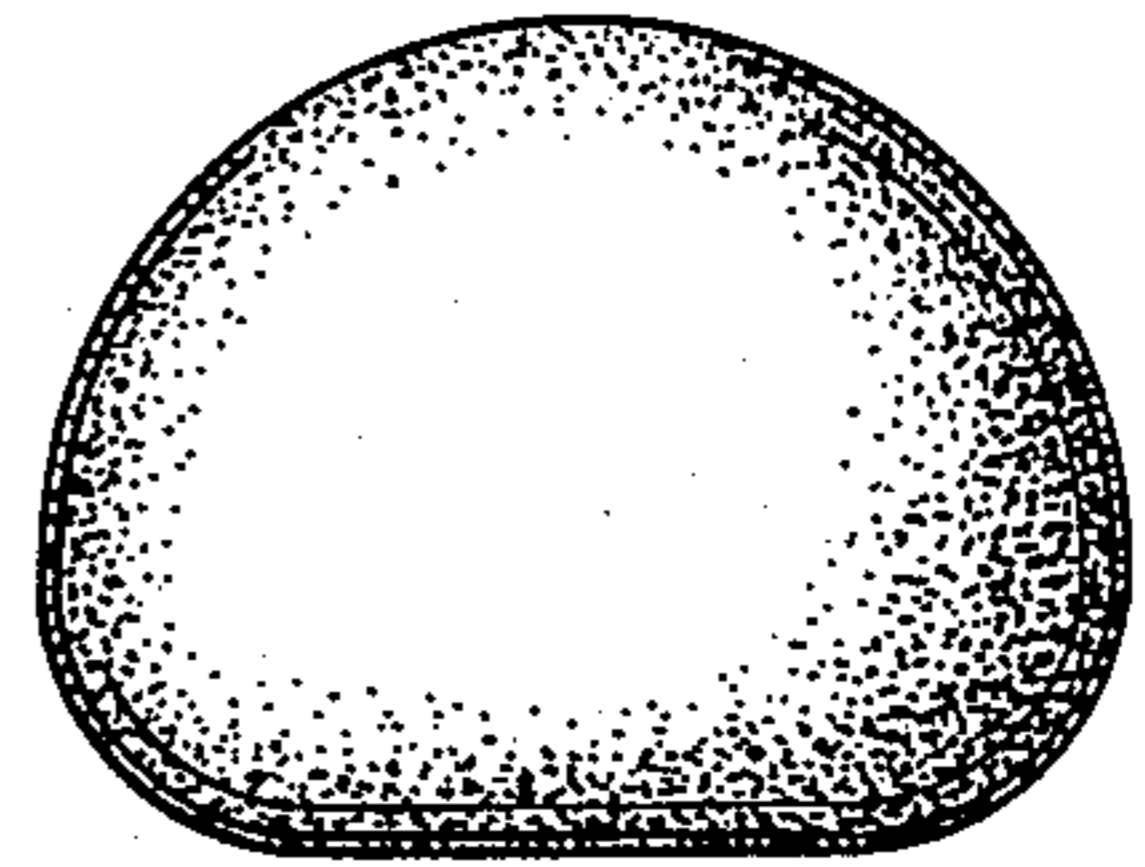
