The ornamental design for a shock absorber for motorcycle, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a shock absorber for motorcycle showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof along line 7—7 in FIG. 1.

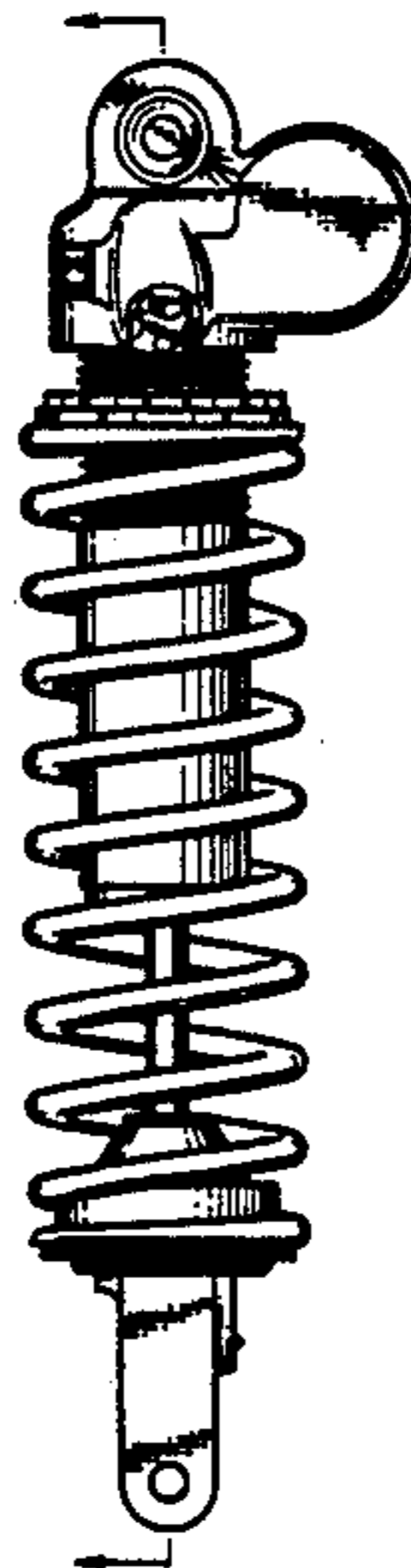

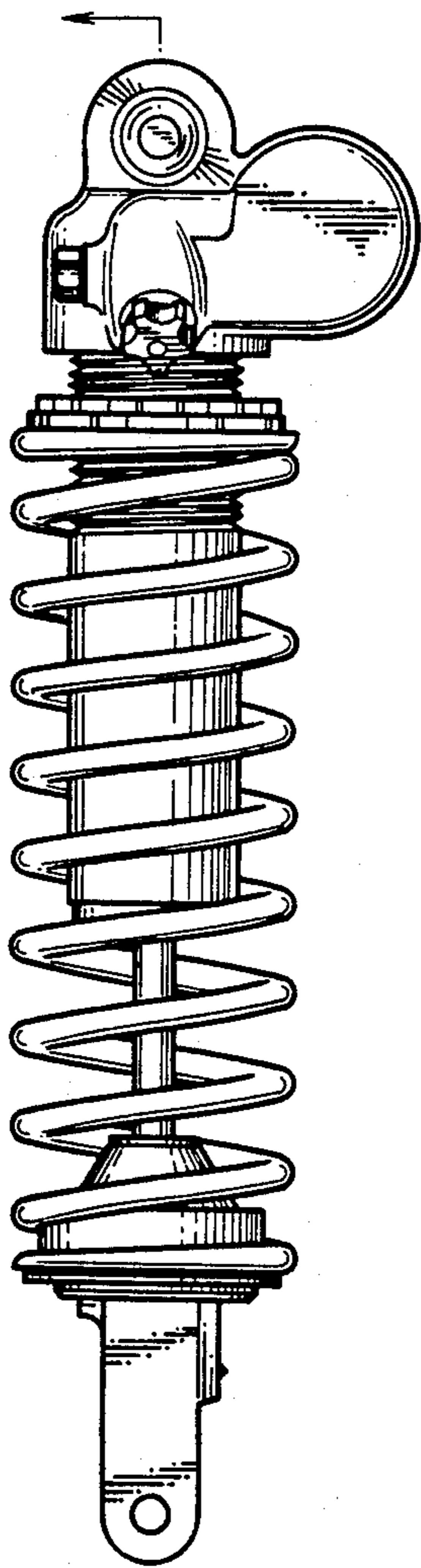

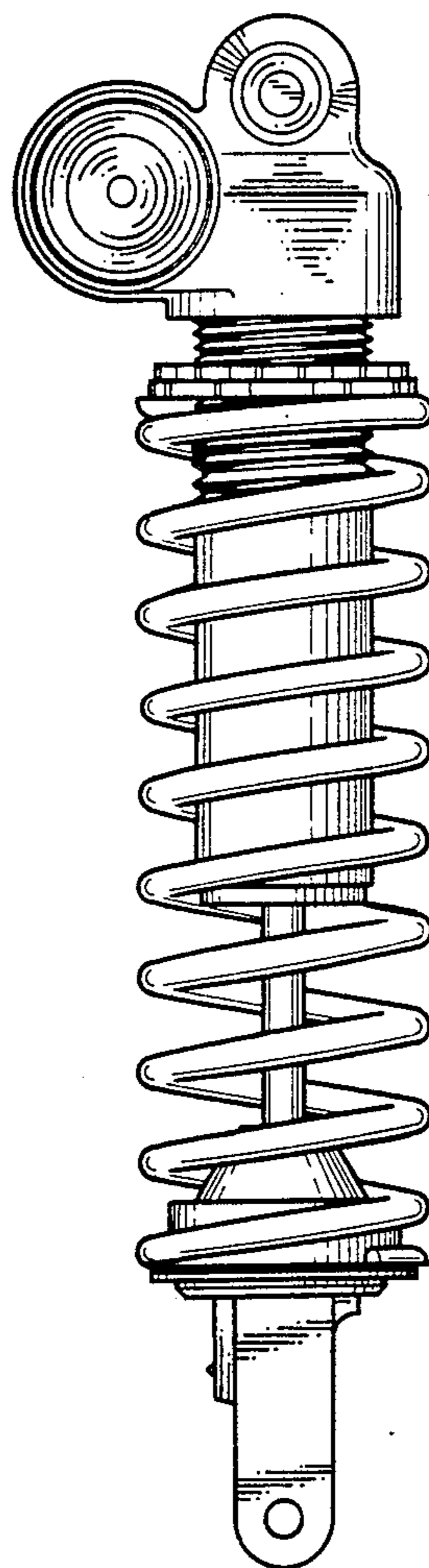

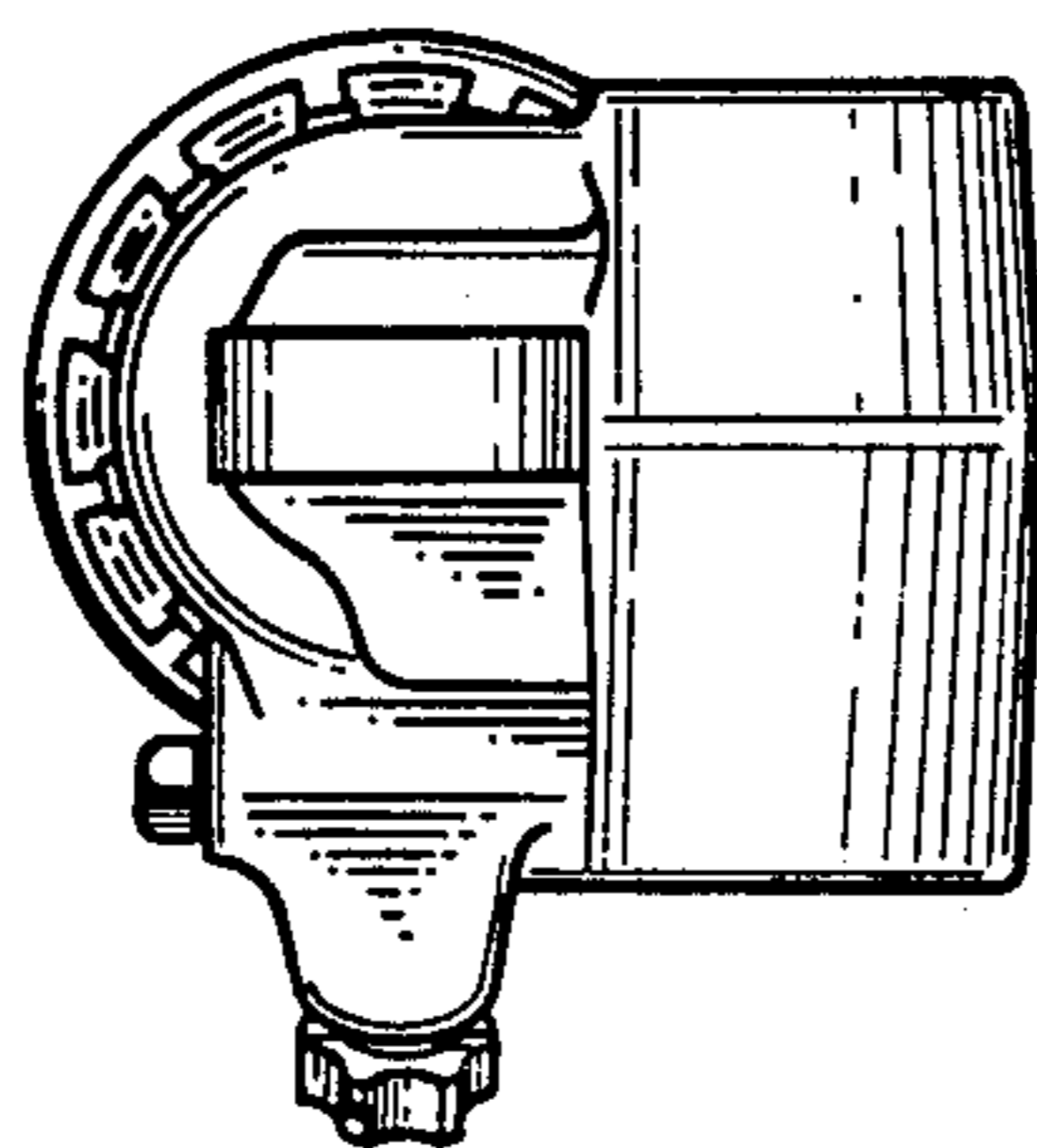

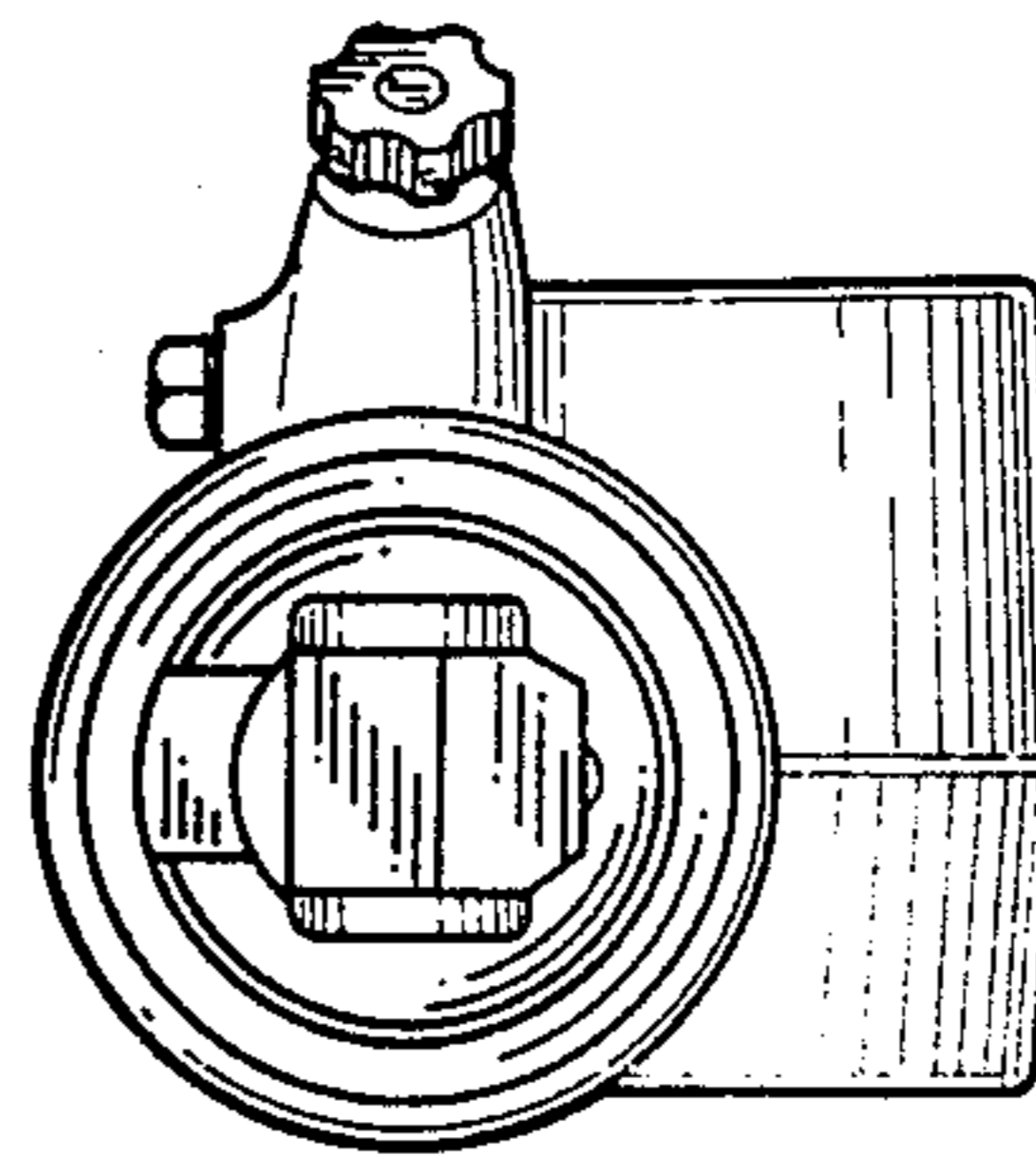

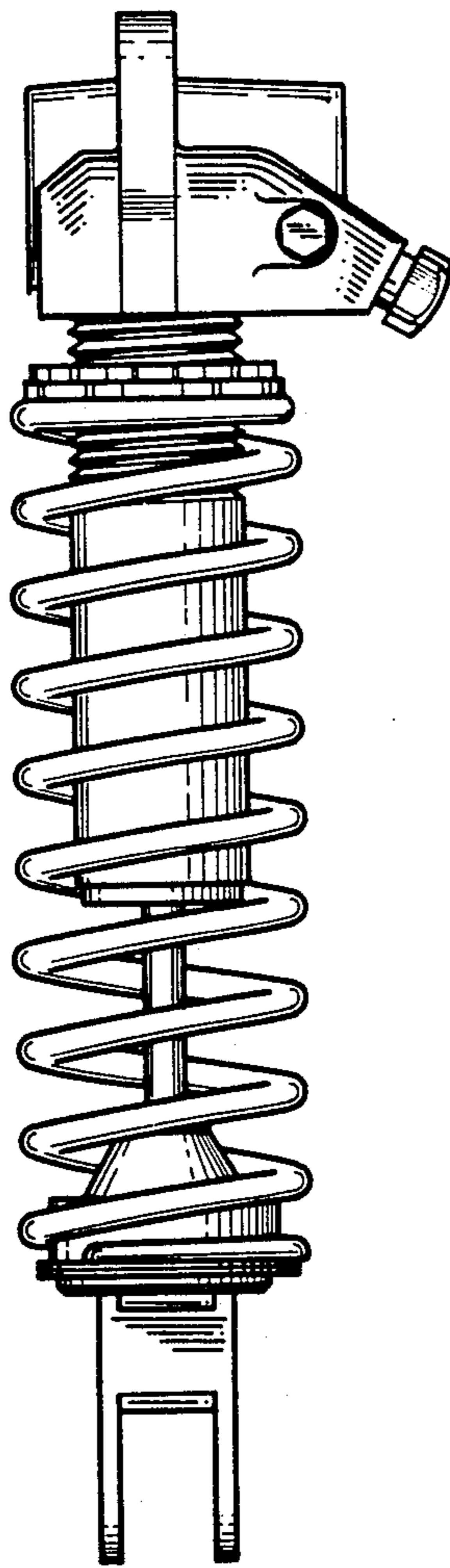

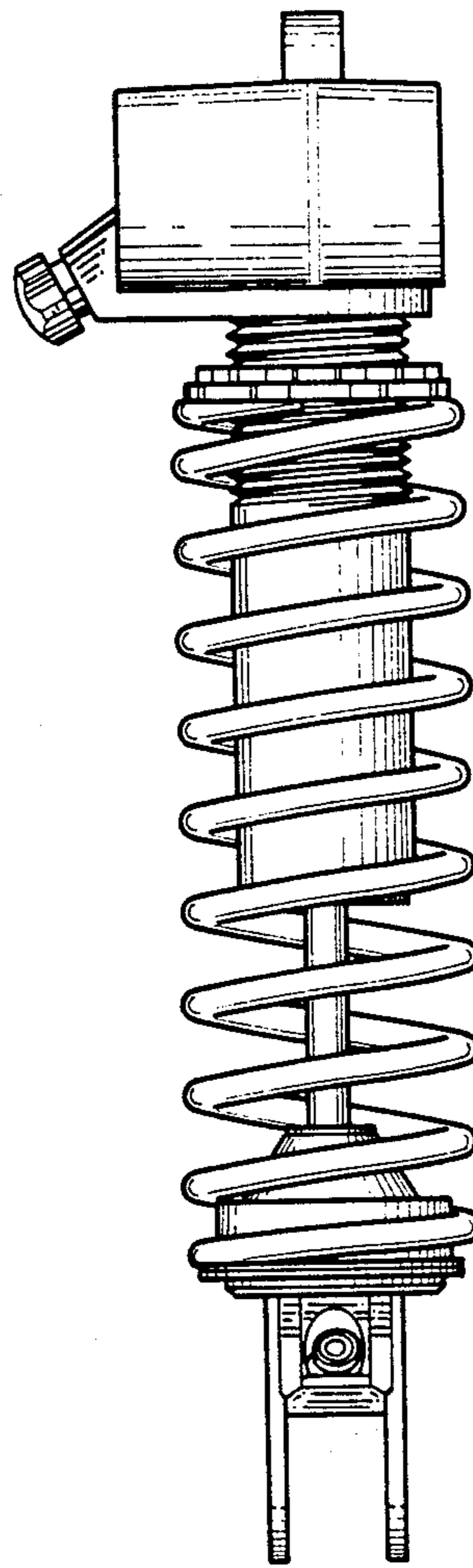
