[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a facsimile transceiver, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a facsimile transceiver showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof, shown with the tray for transmitting paper in an open position.

The broken line showing of the paper guide in FIG. 8 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

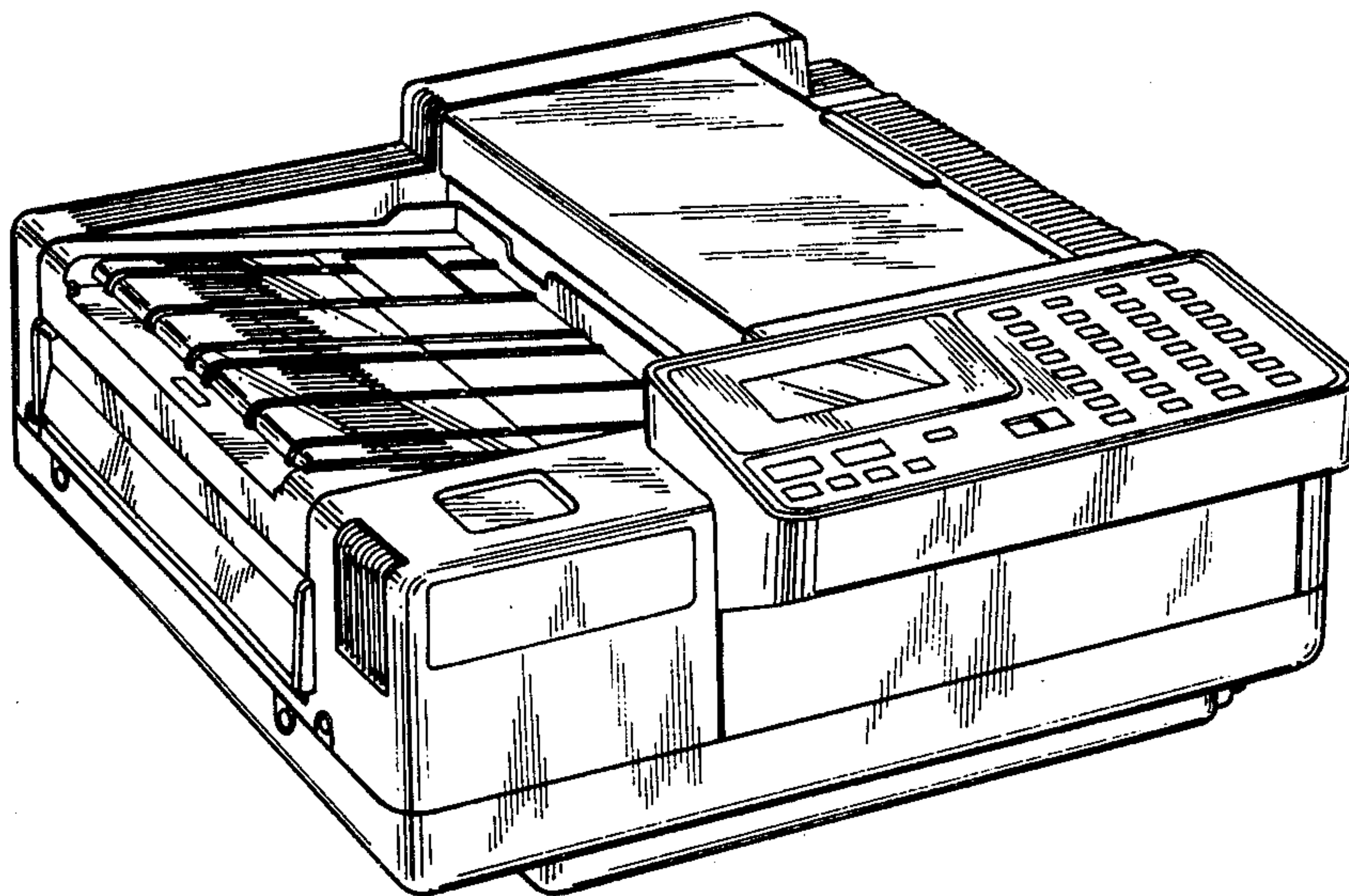

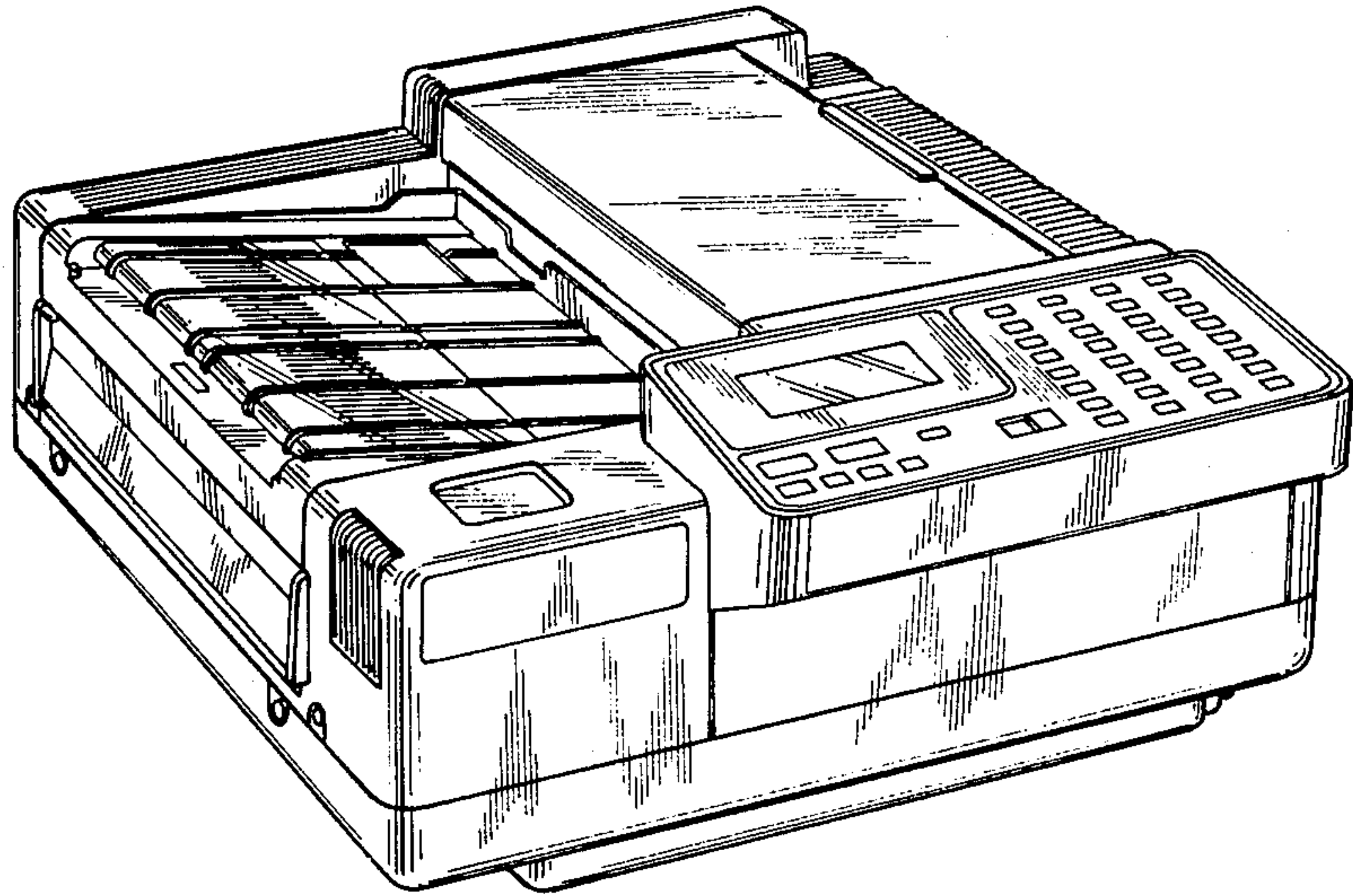

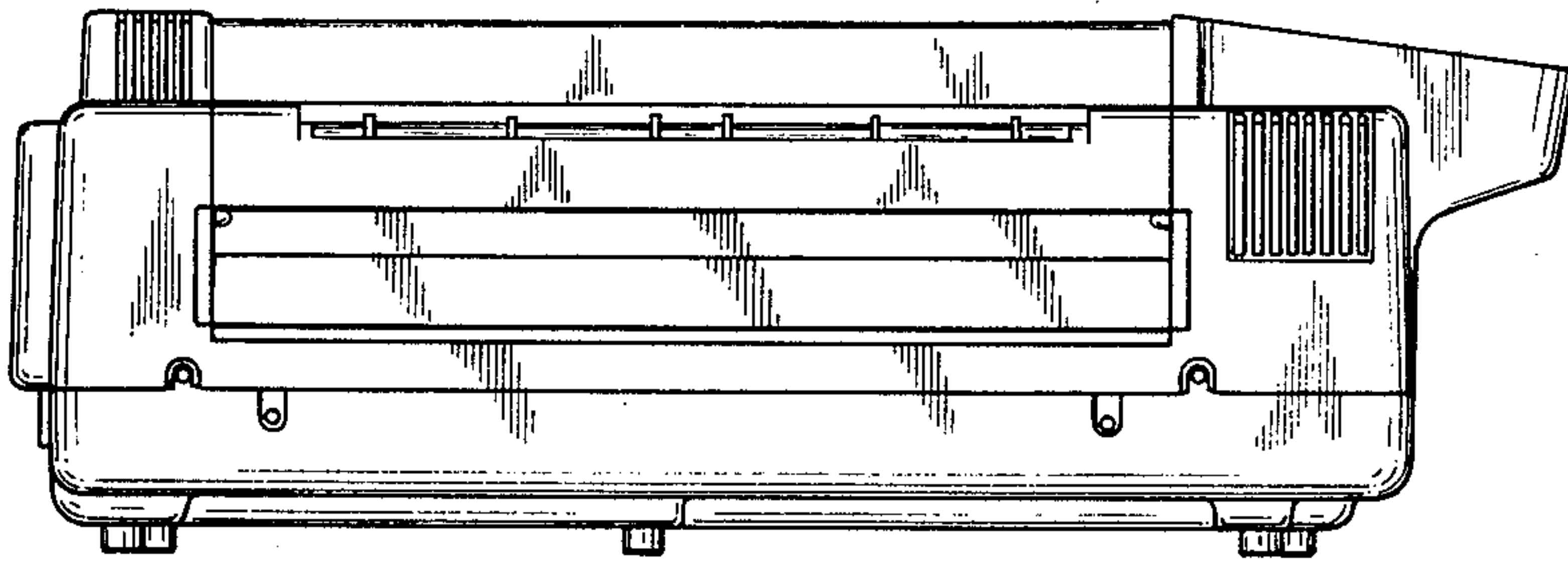

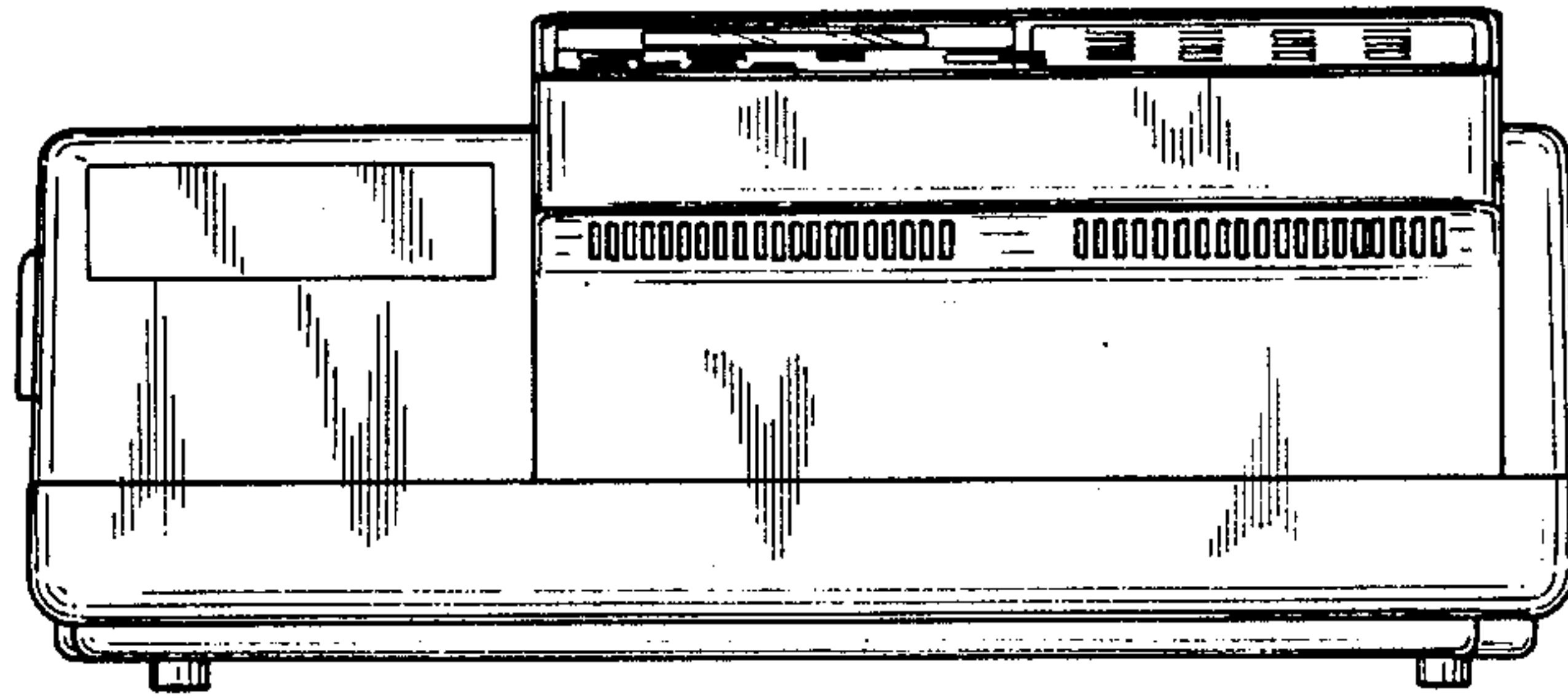

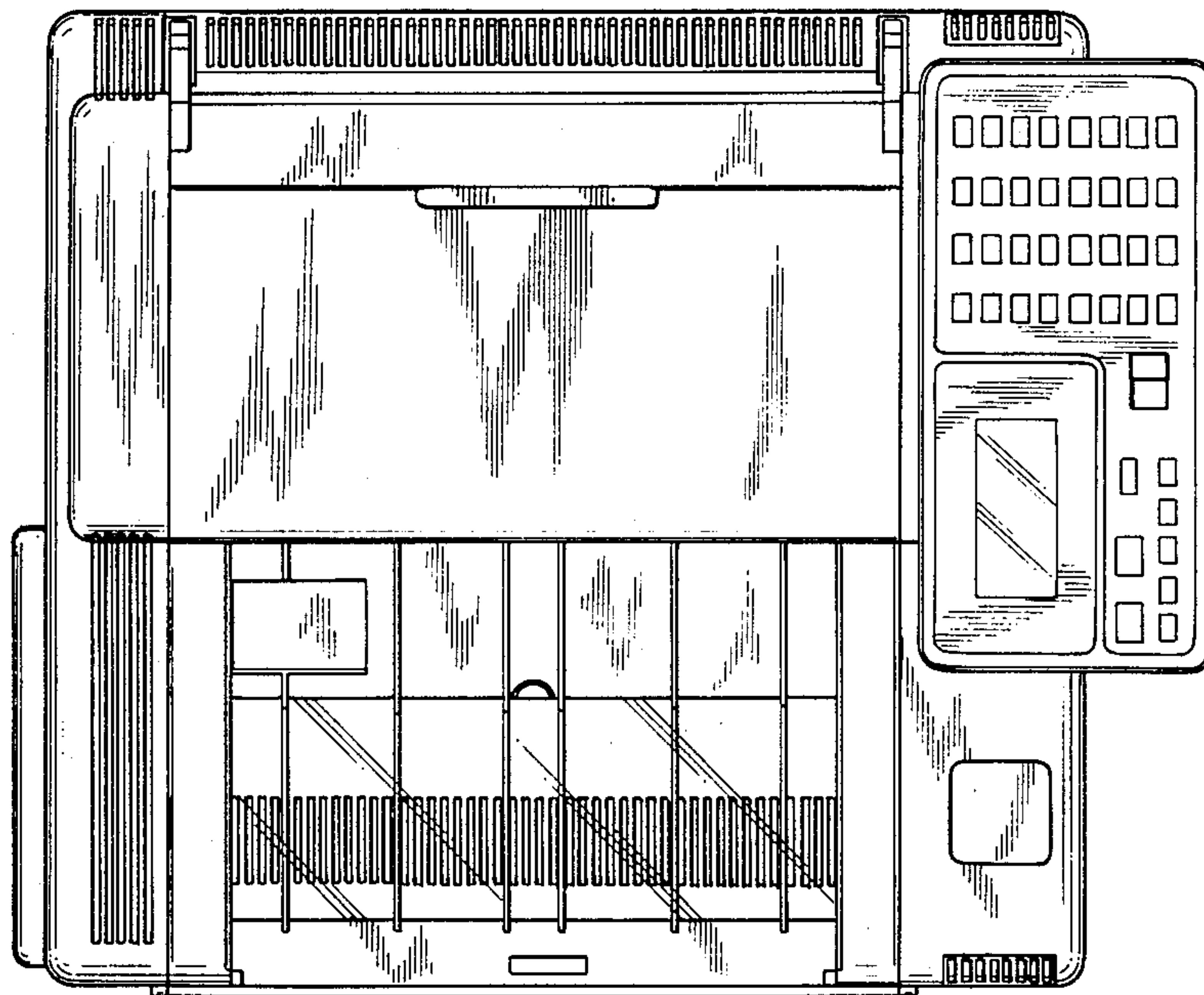

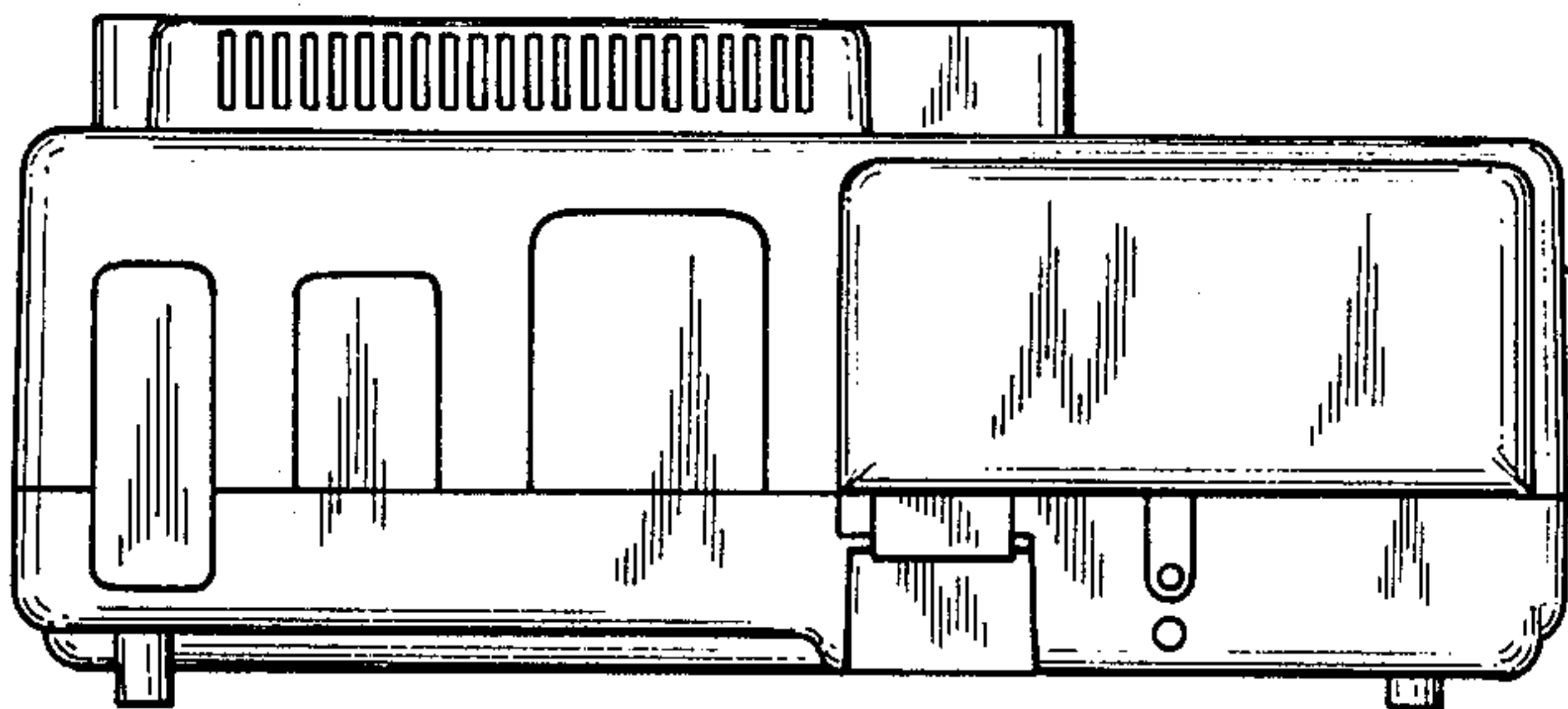

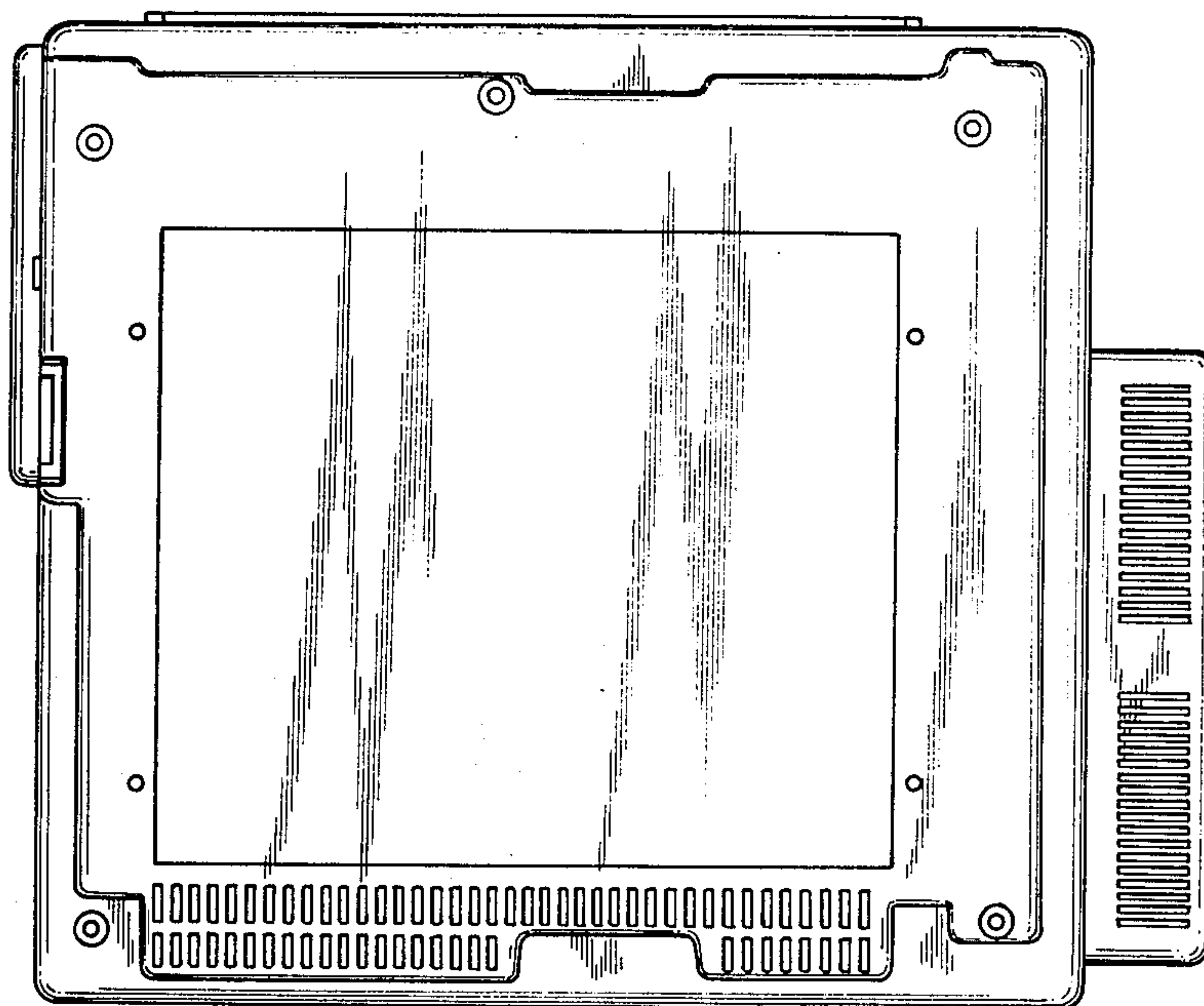

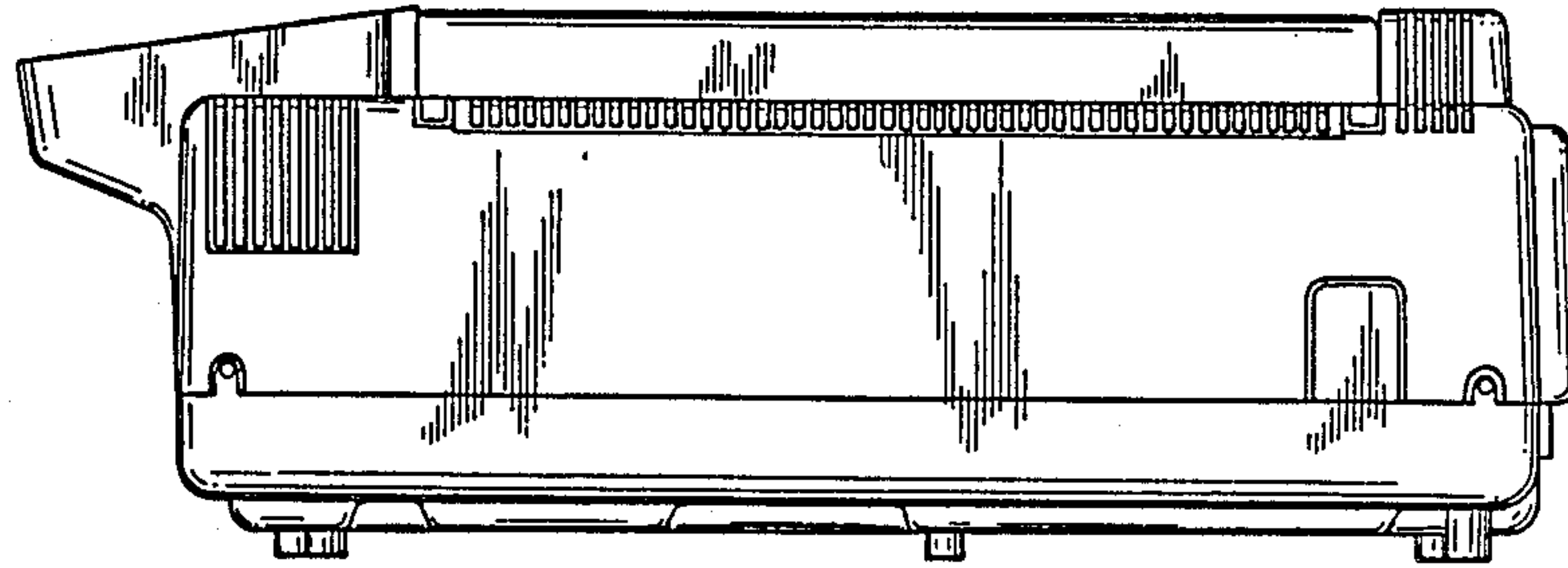
