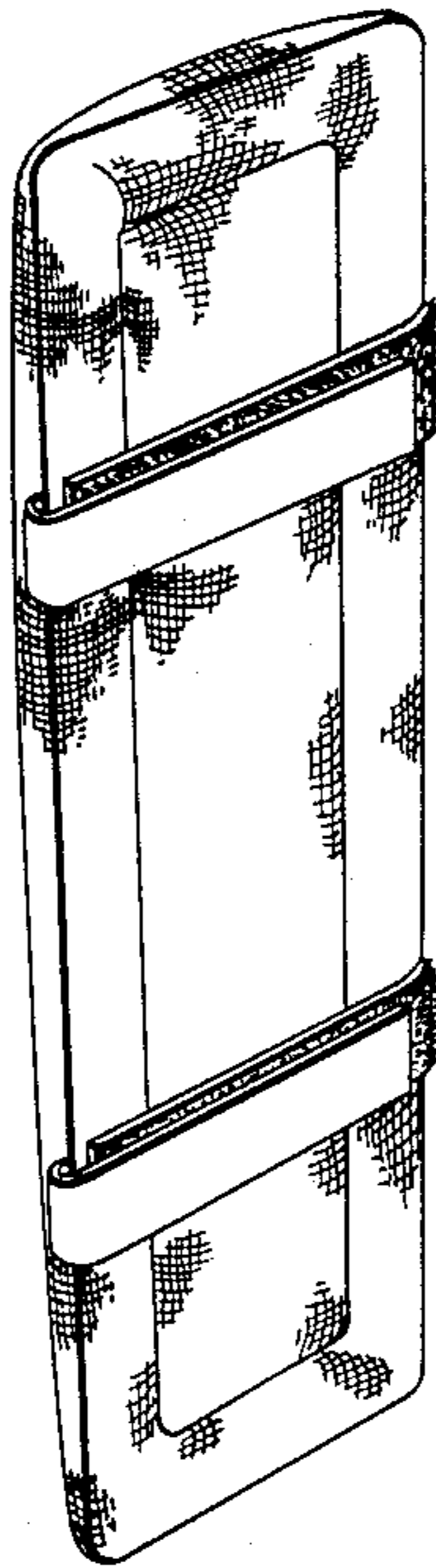
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a protective pad for

- FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



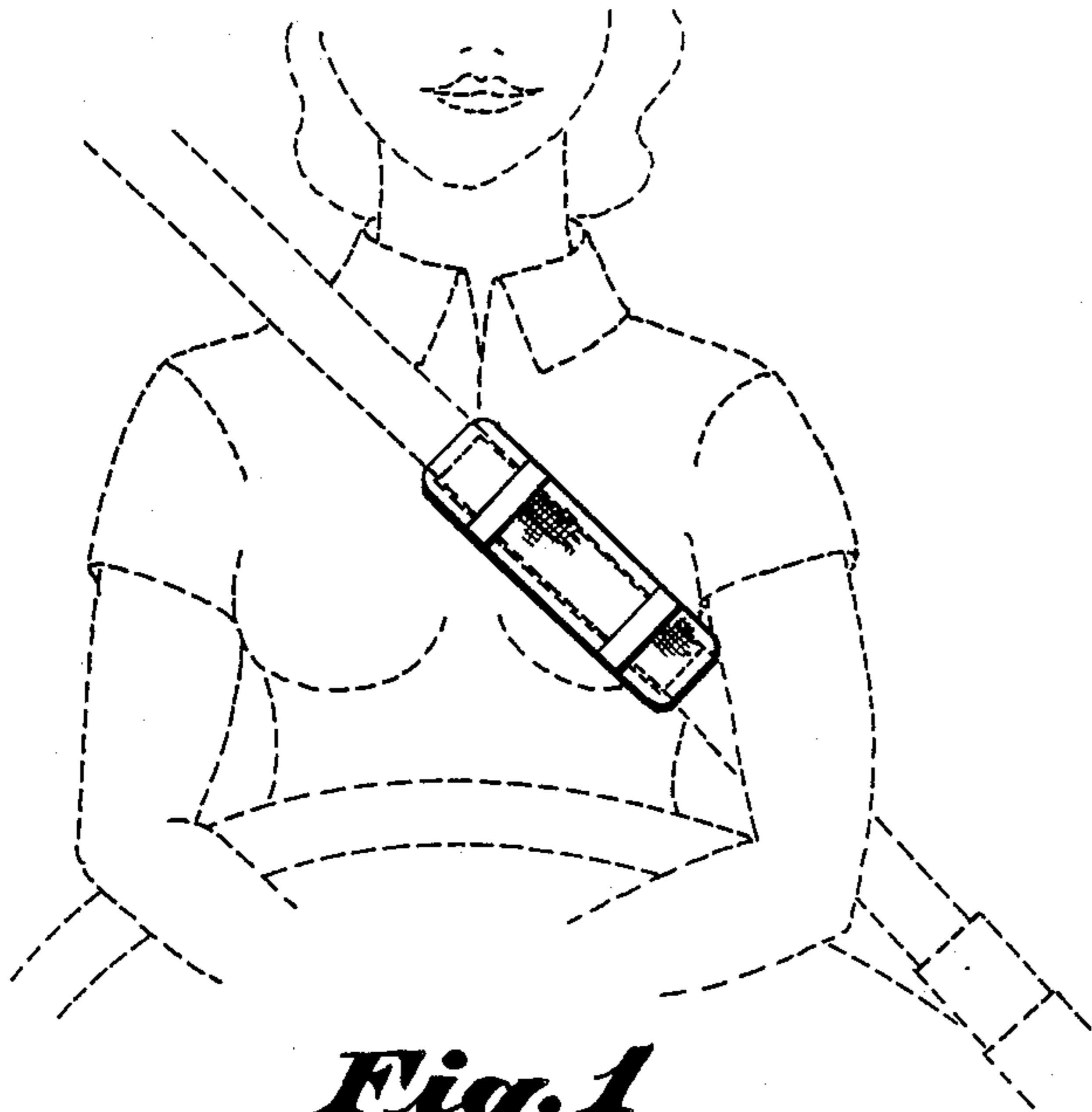

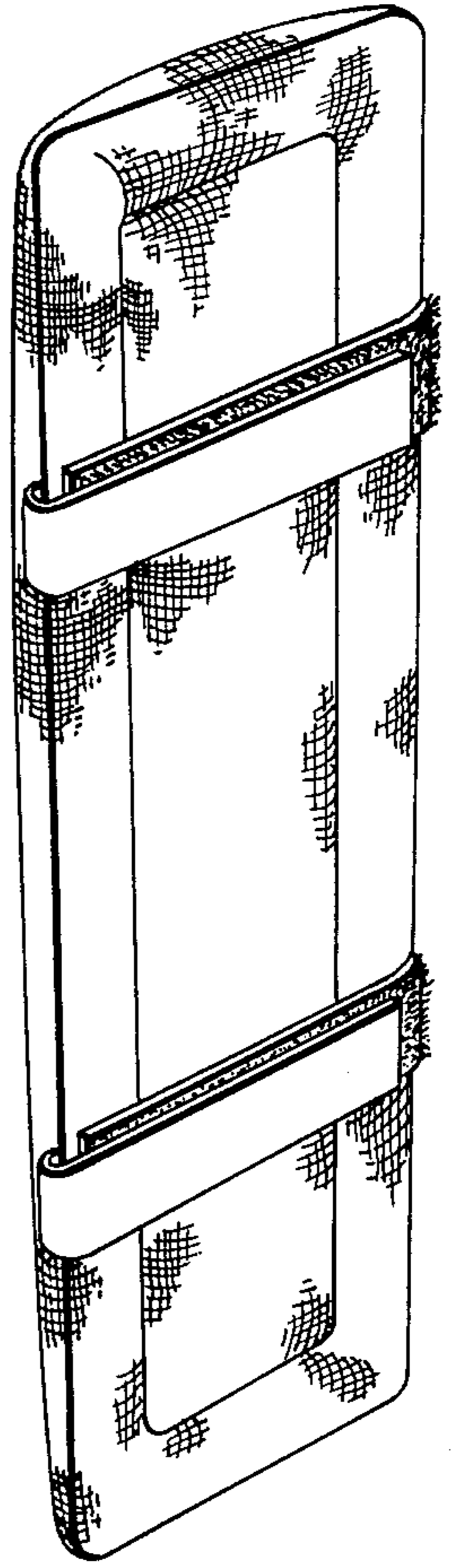

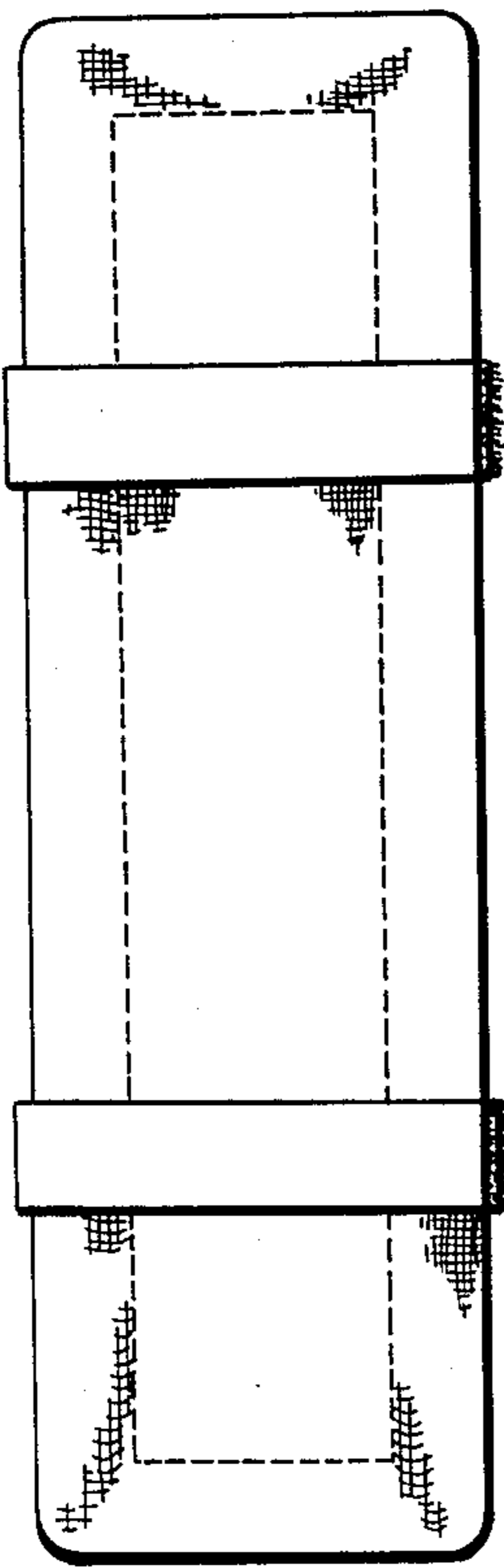

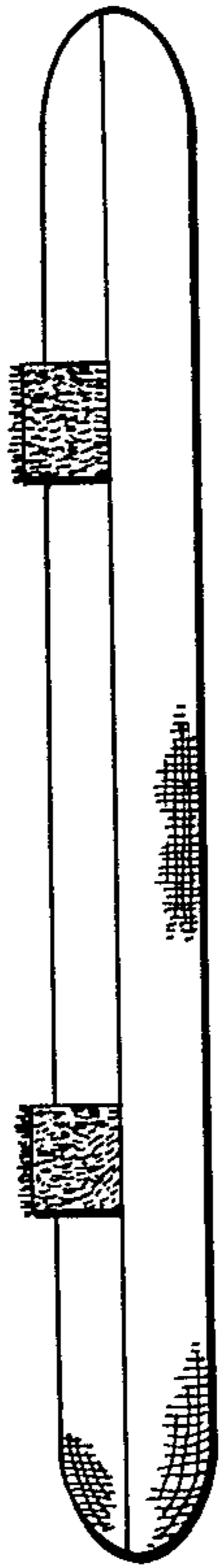

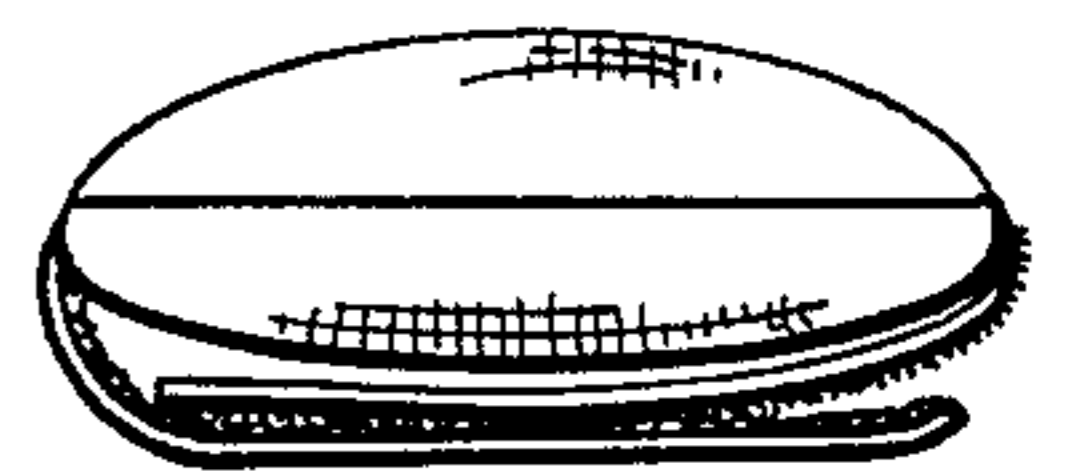
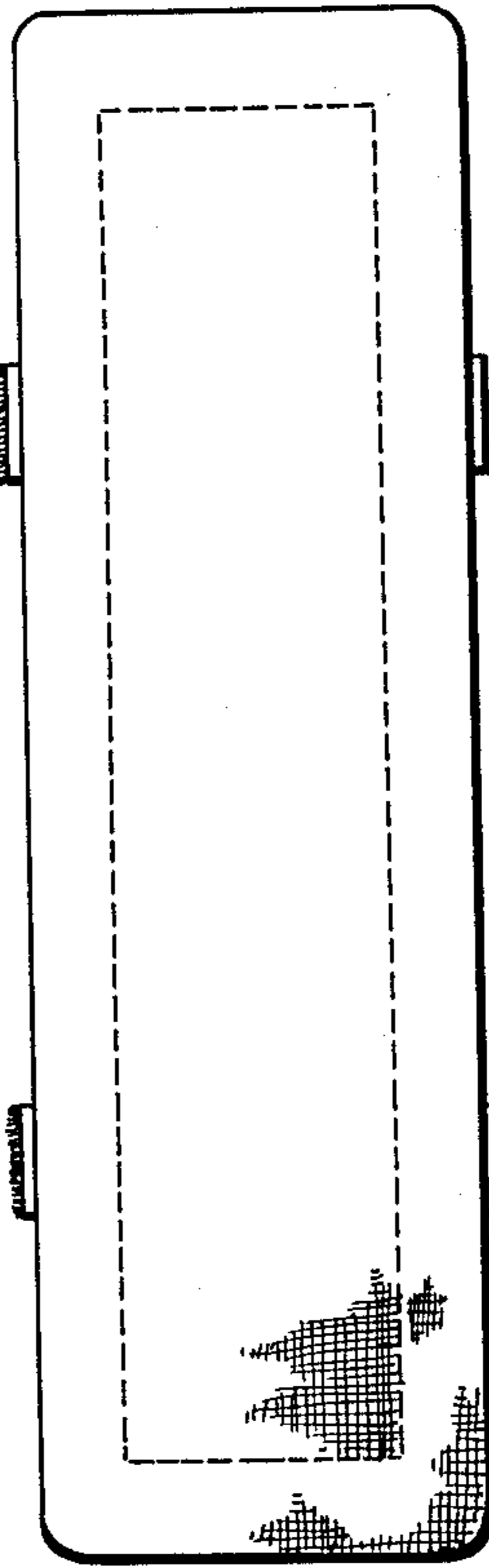
