DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a self supported
mirror showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 8;

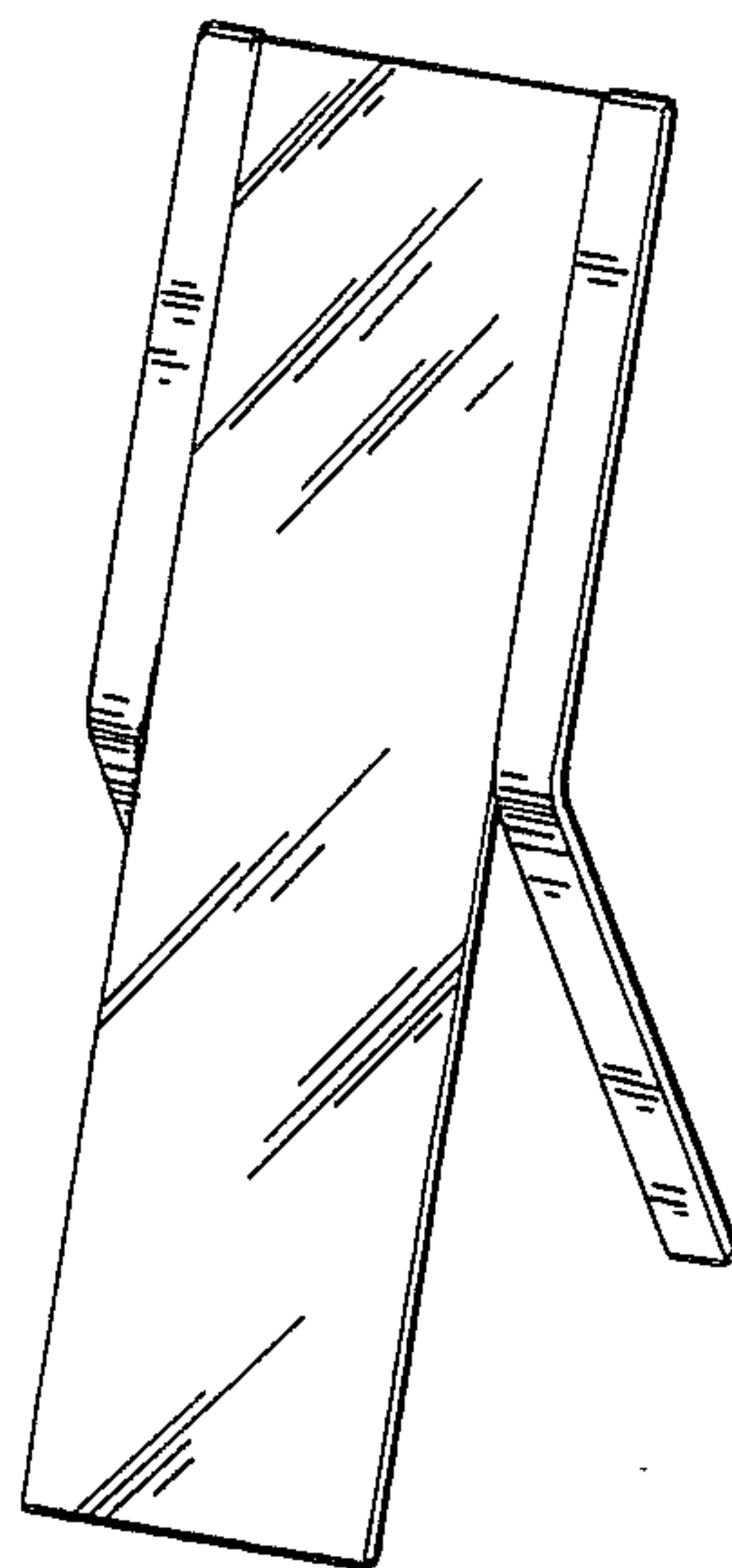
FIG. 10 is an enlarged front view of FIG. 8;

side being a mirror image.



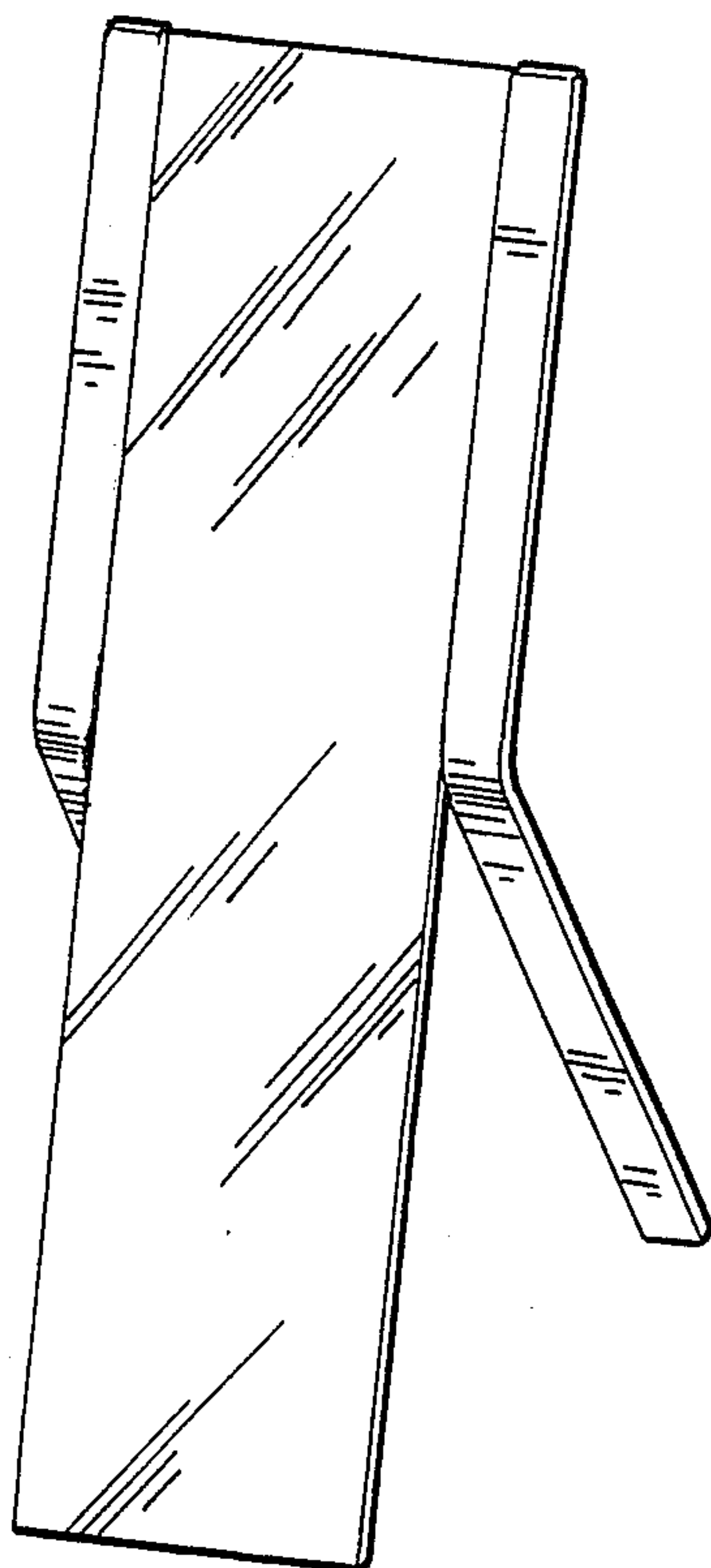

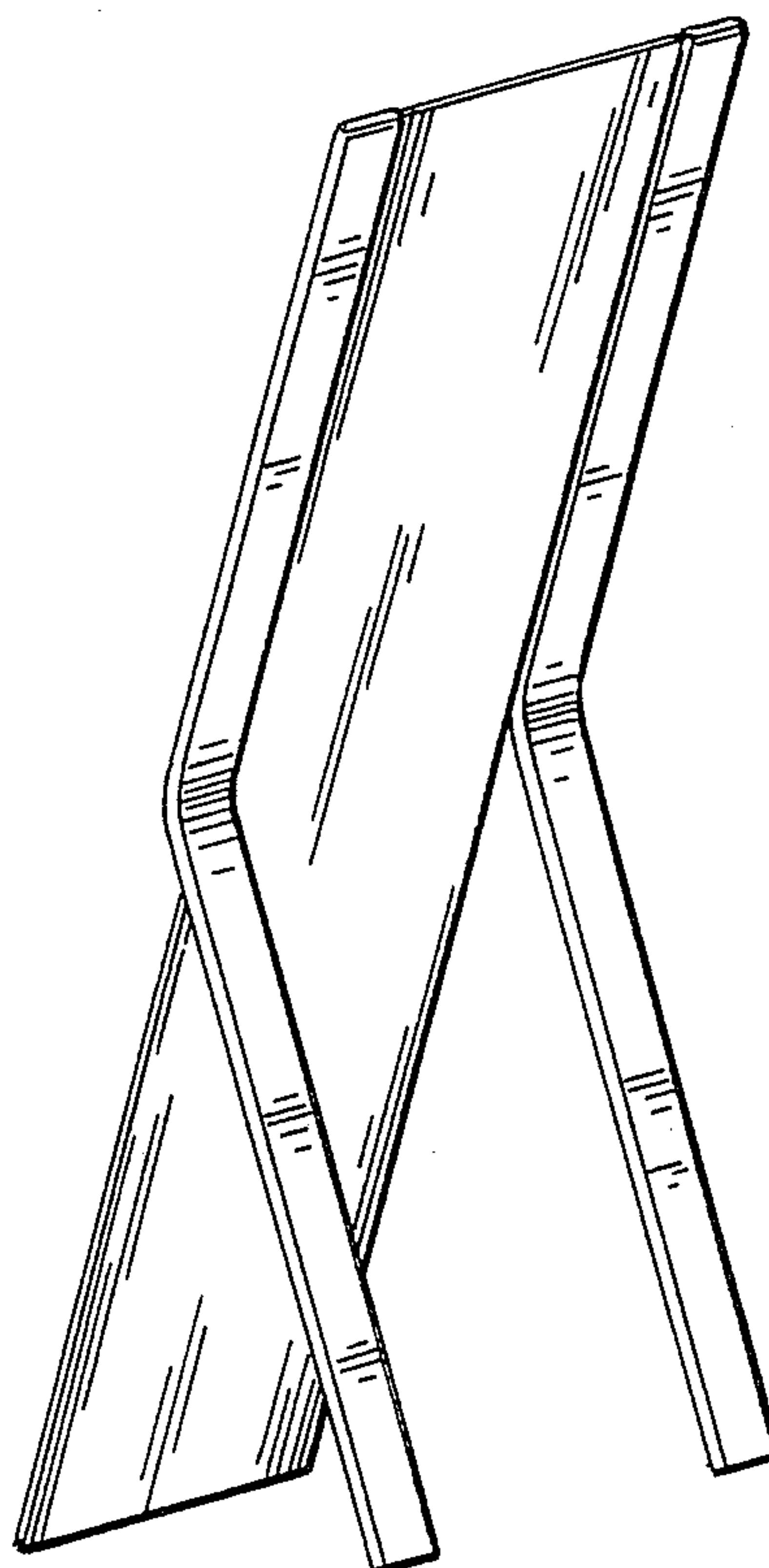

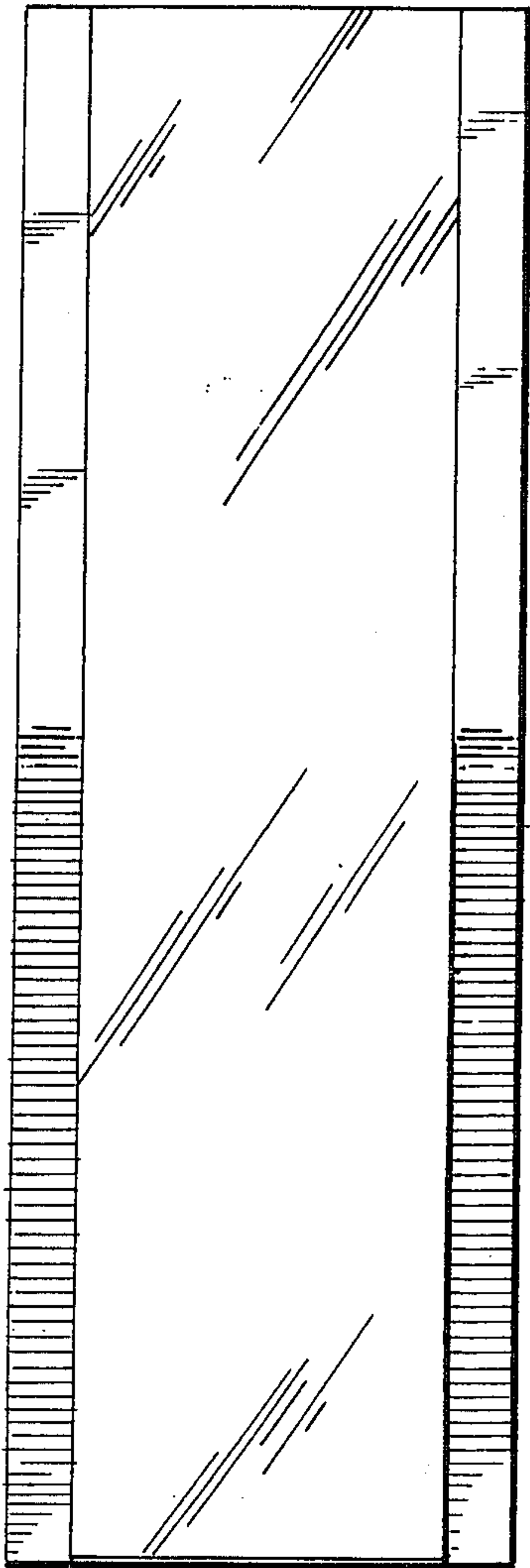

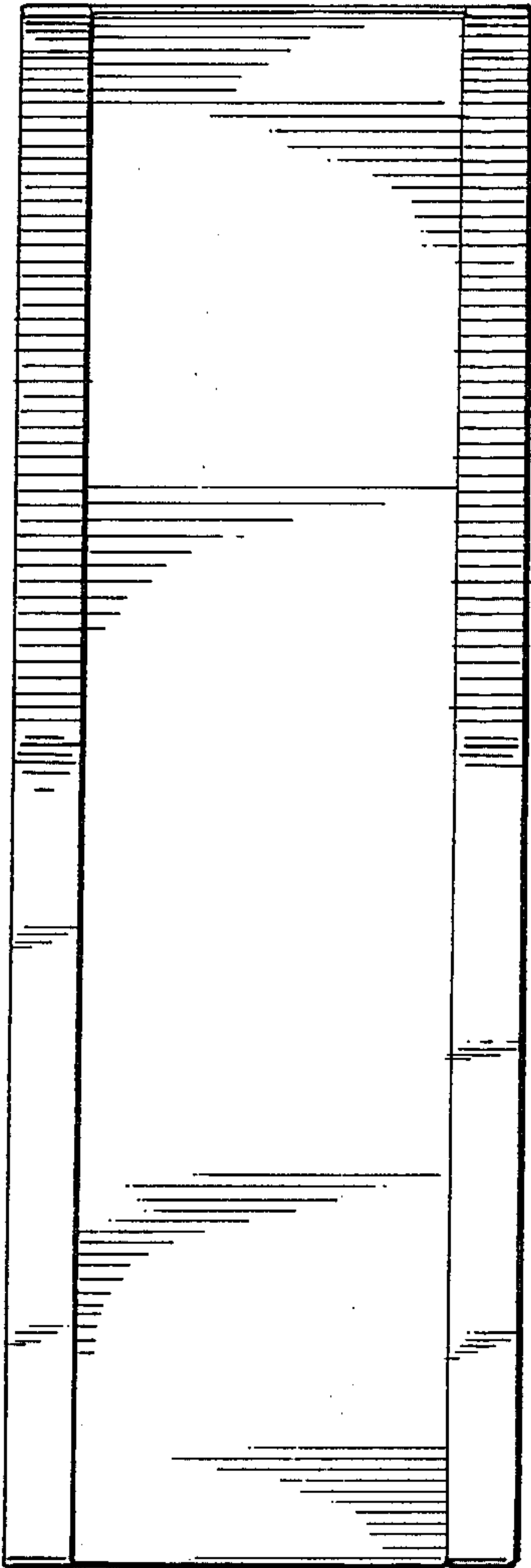

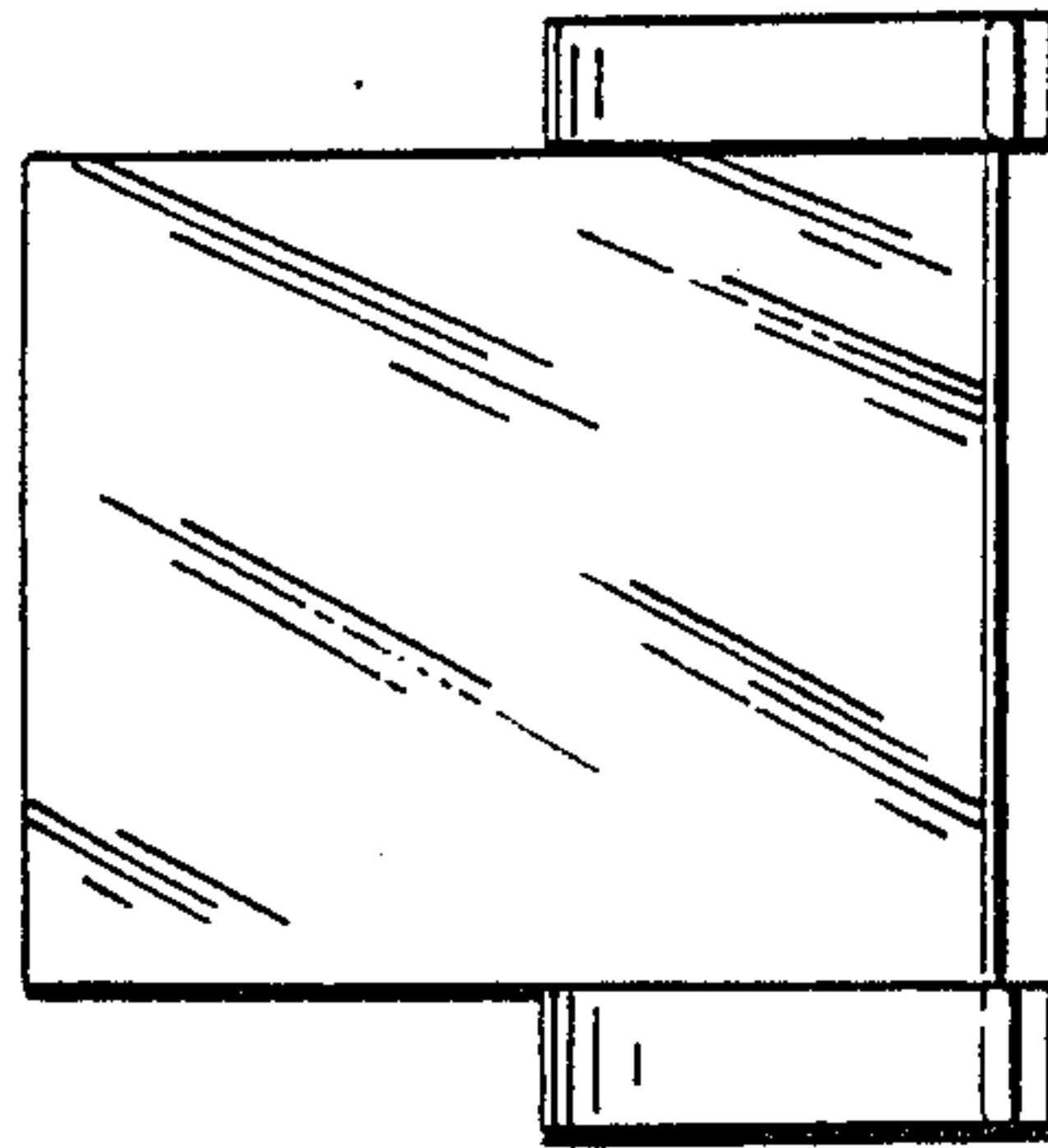

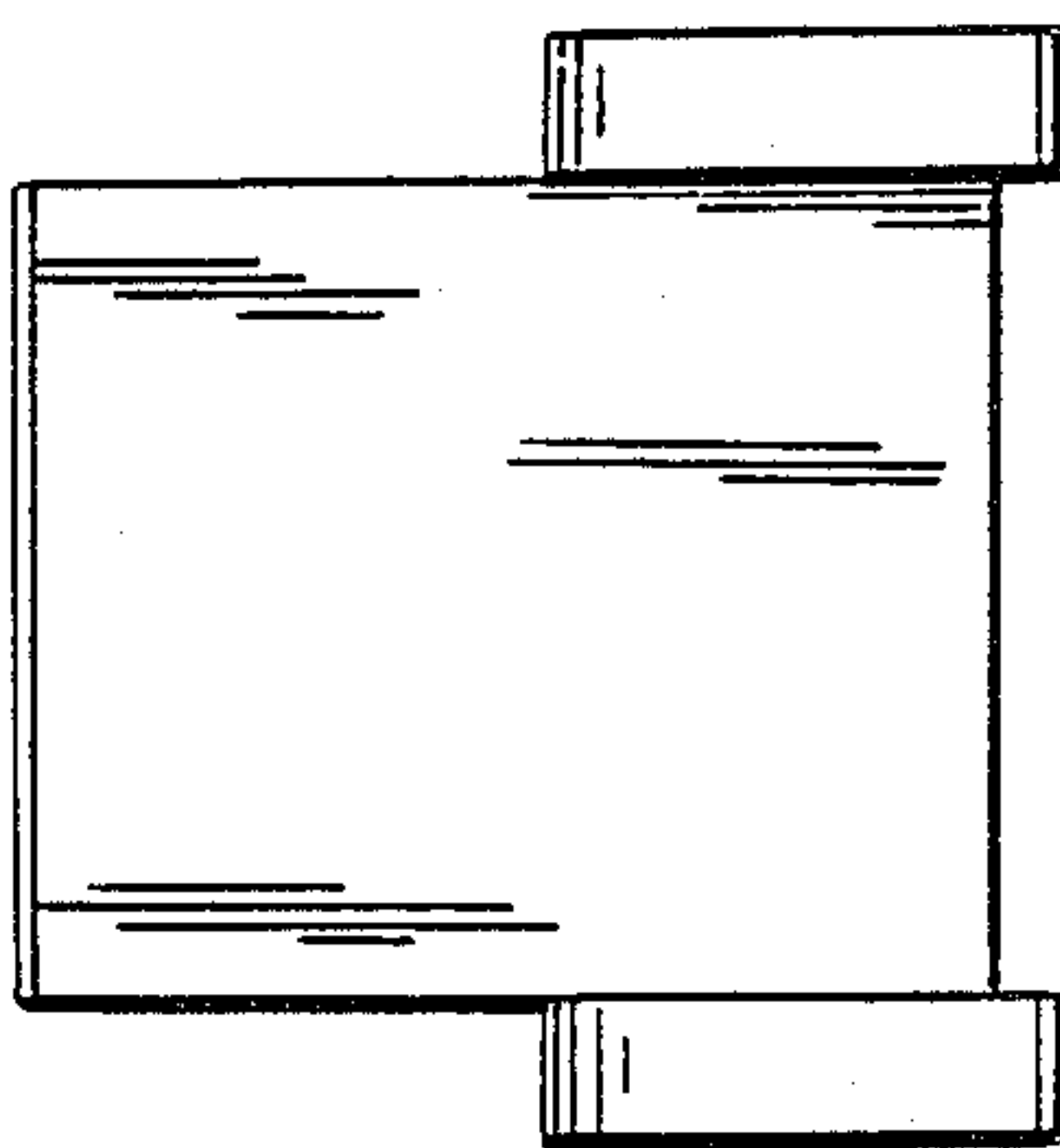
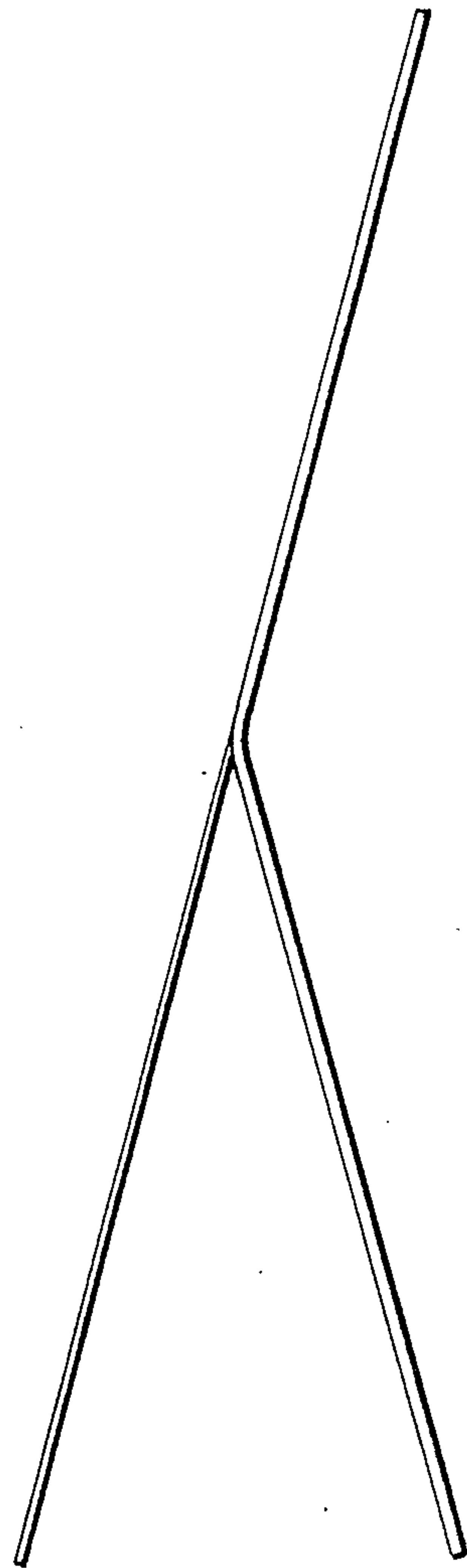

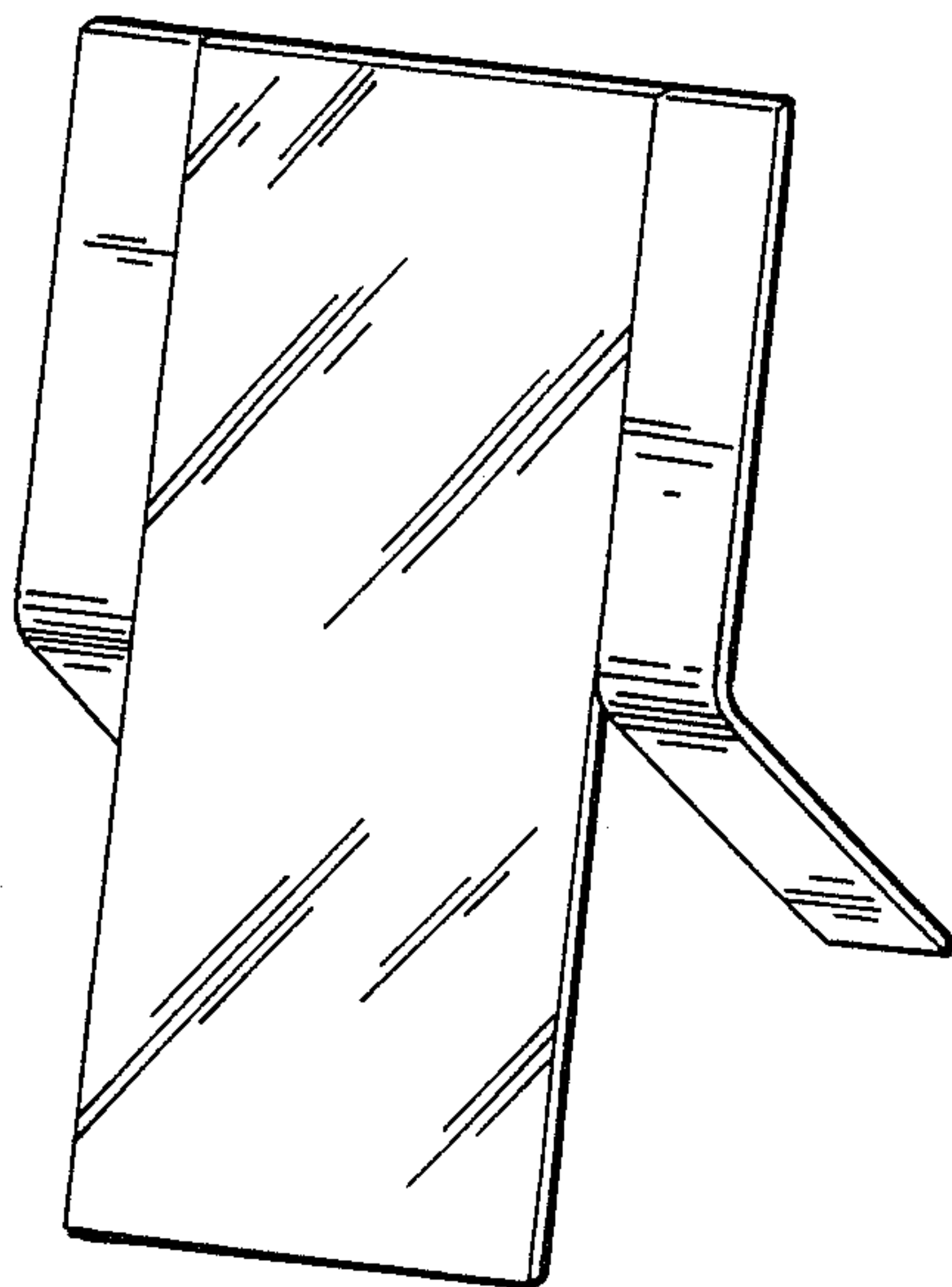

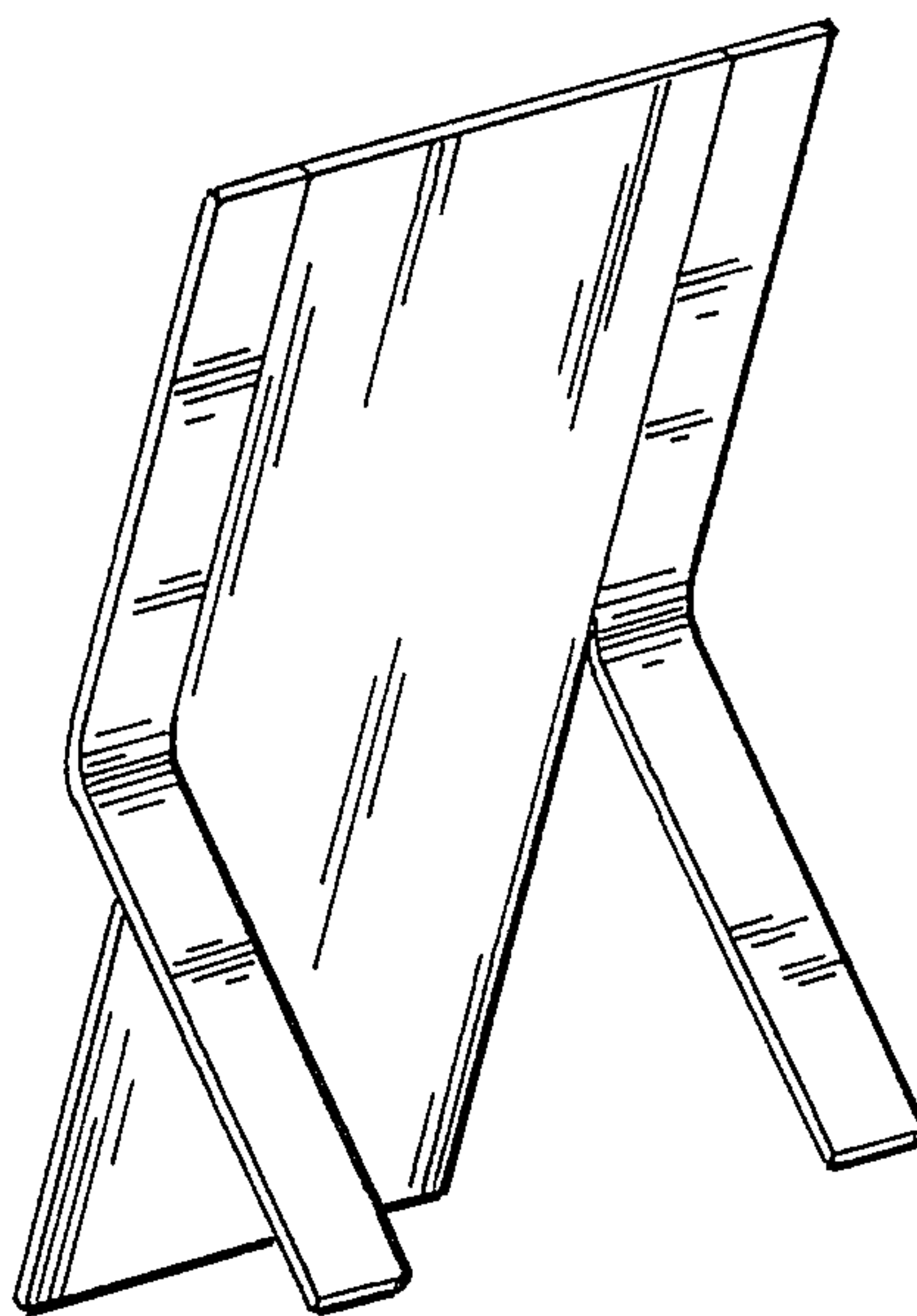

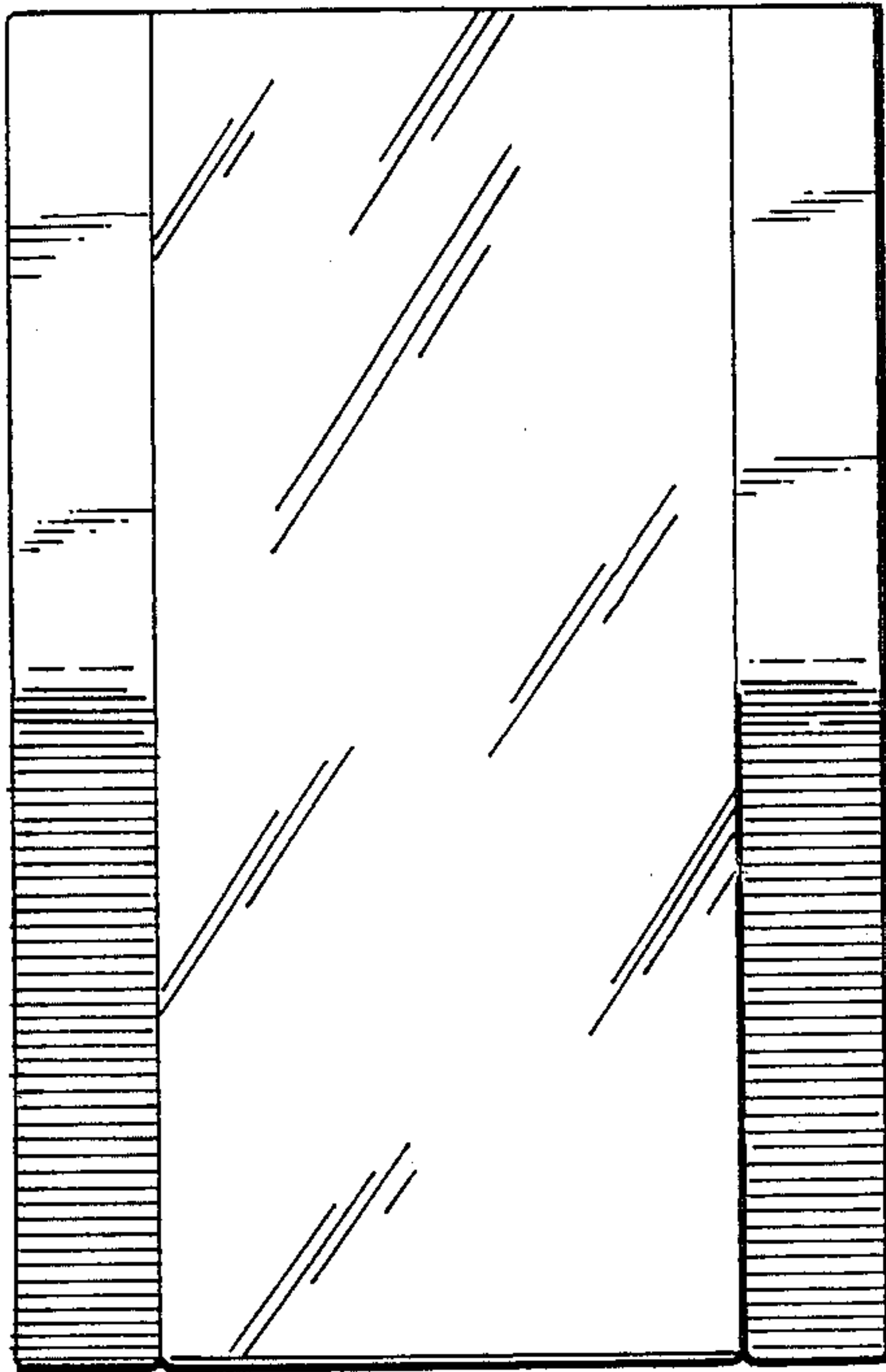

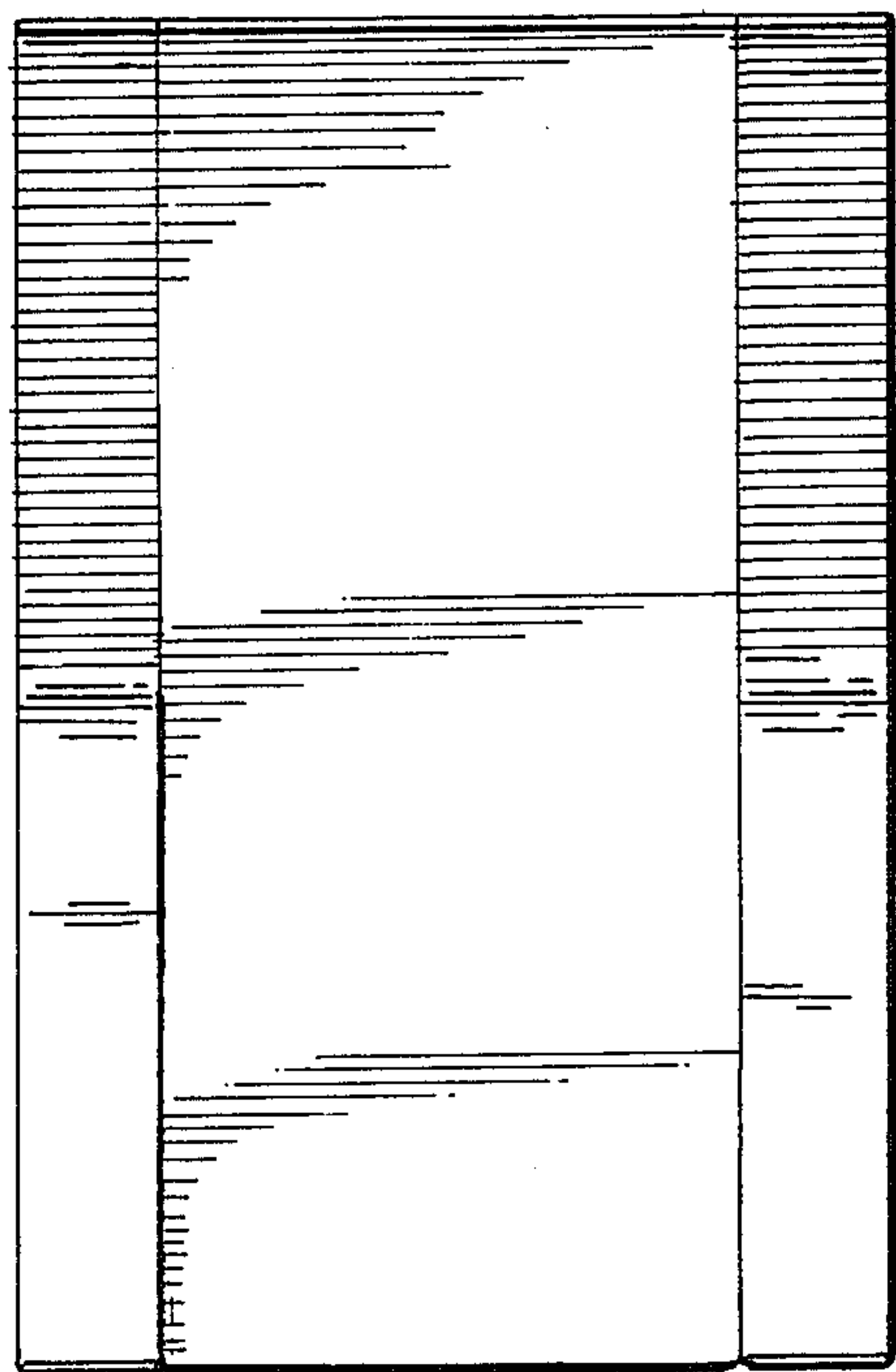

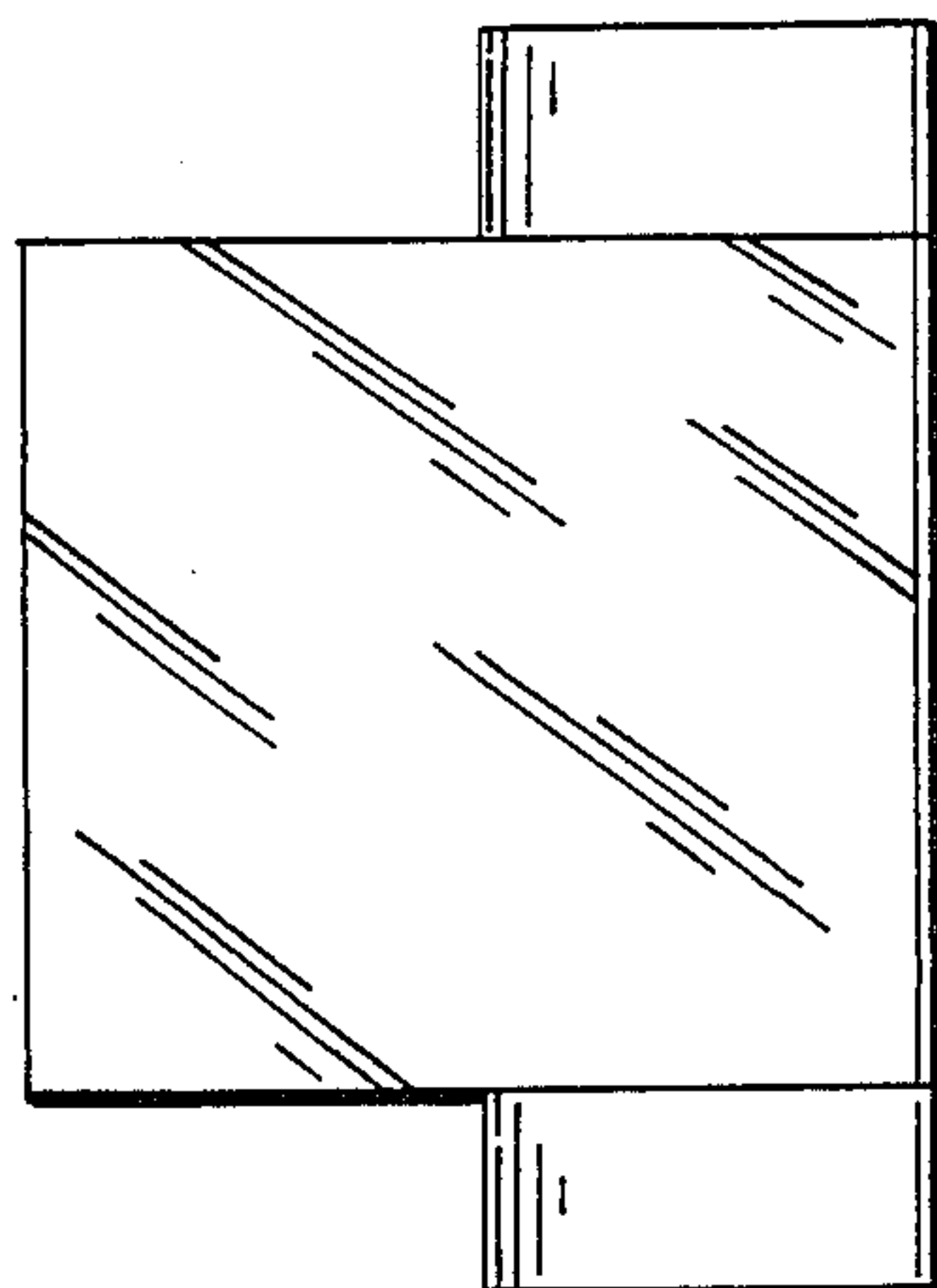

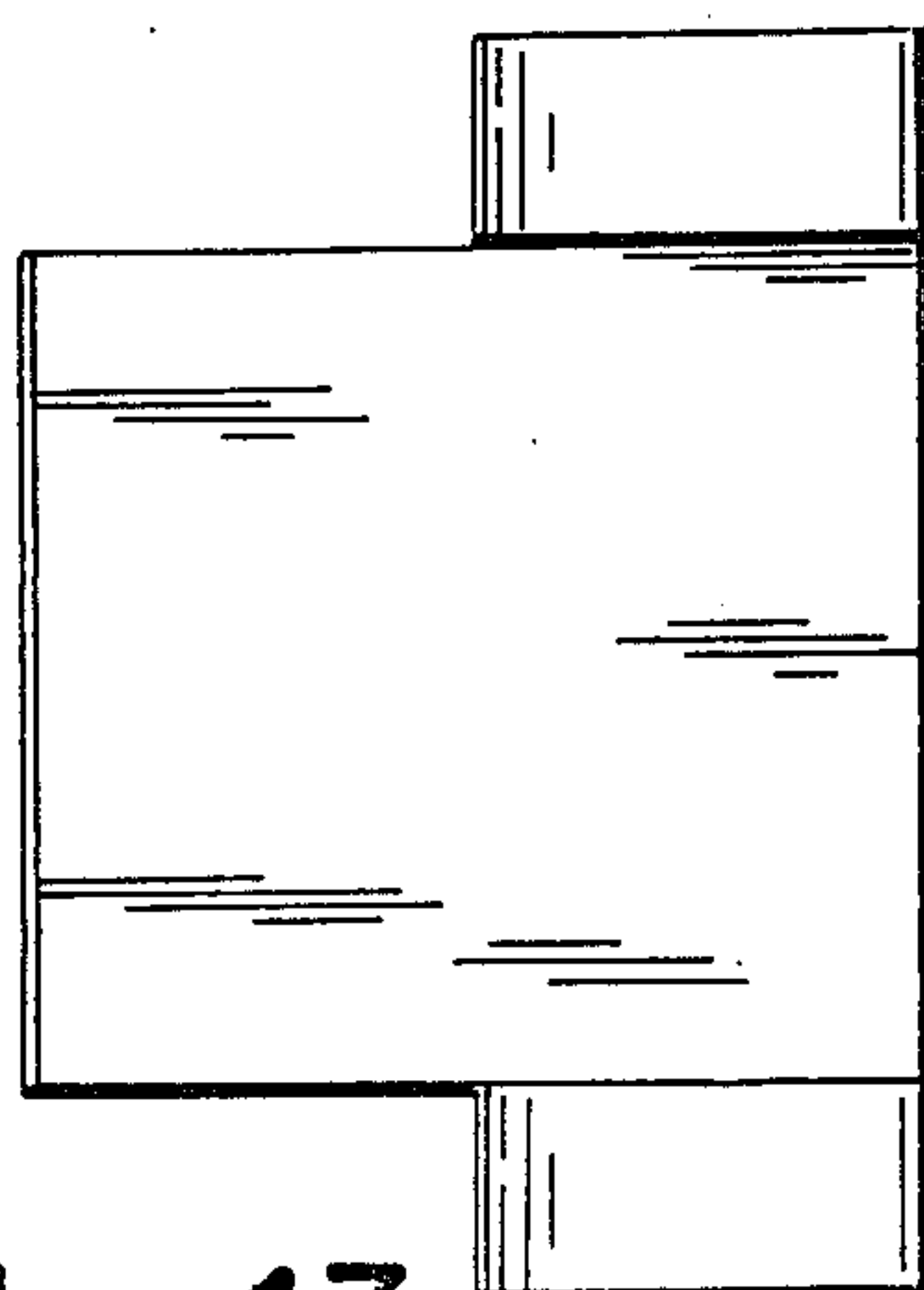
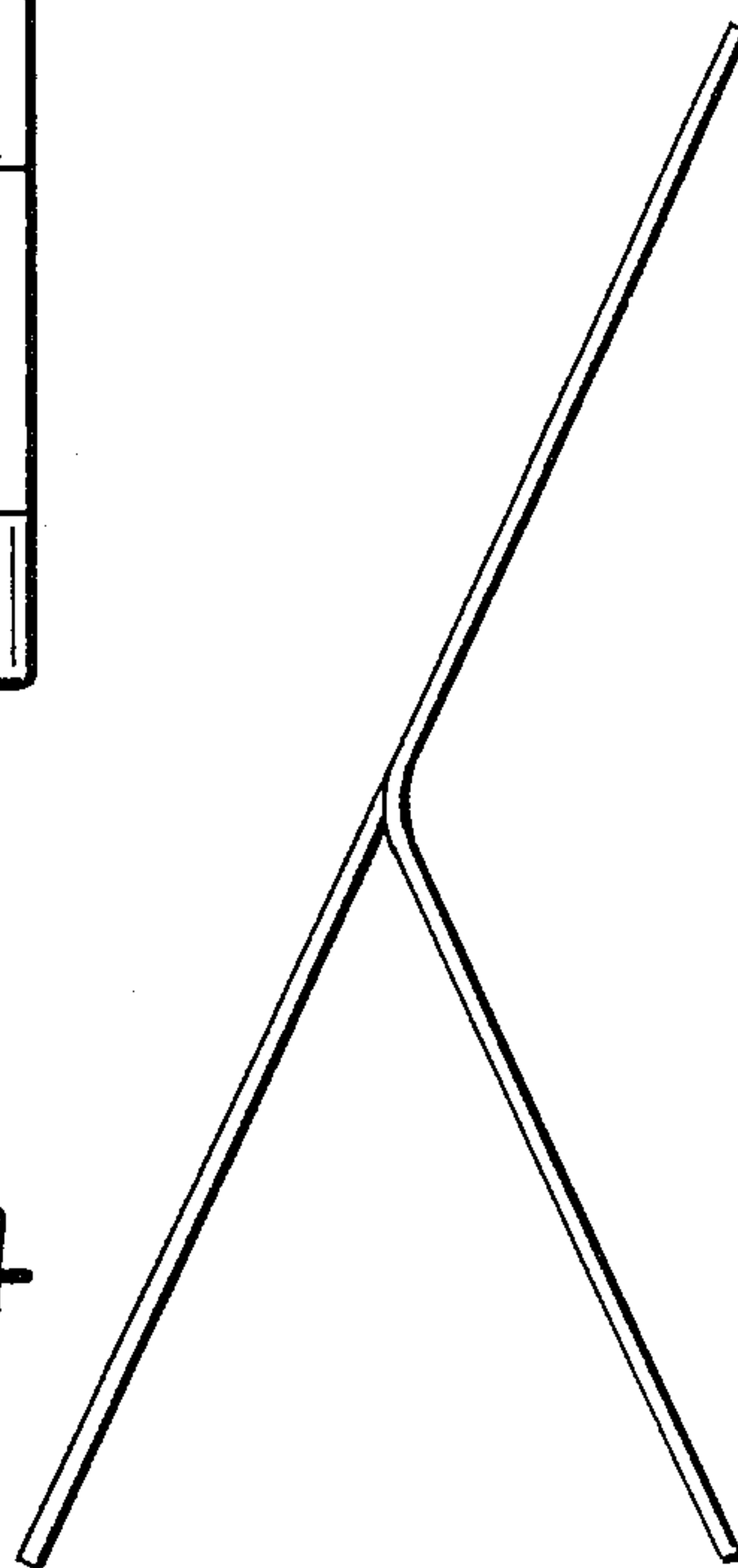
