[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cycle pedal, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the cycle pedal showing my new design, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the cycle pedal, the rear view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side of the cycle pedal, the other side being identical thereto; and
 FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along the line IV—IV of FIG. 1, the remaining exposed surfaces being plain and unornamented.
