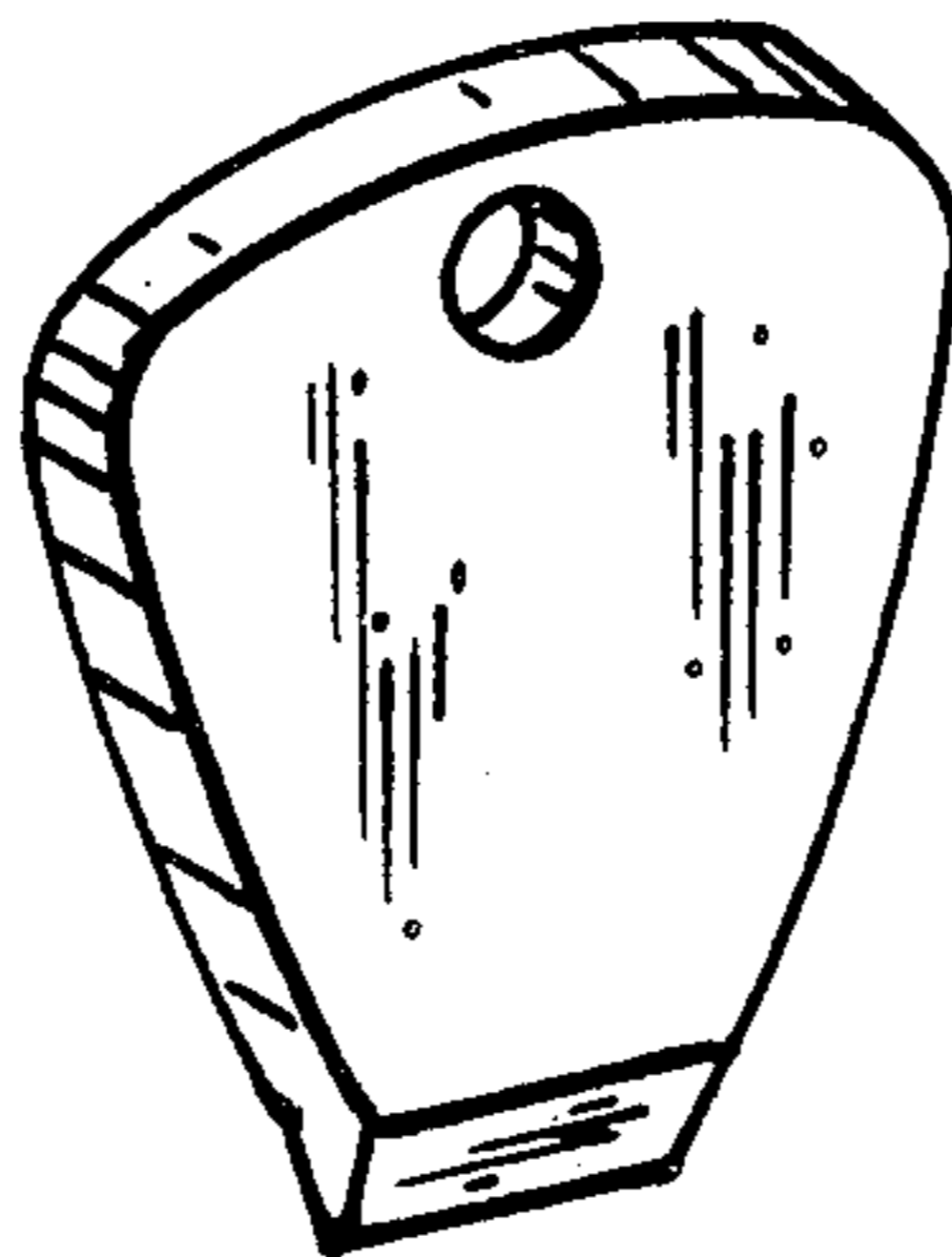

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lottery ticket scraper or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lottery ticket scraper or the like, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom end elevational view thereof.



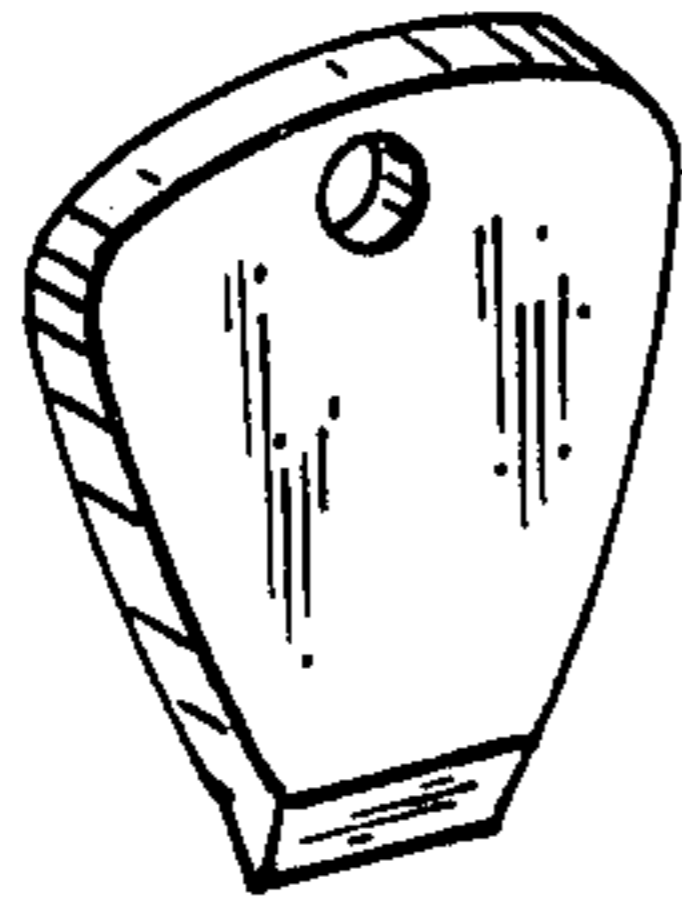

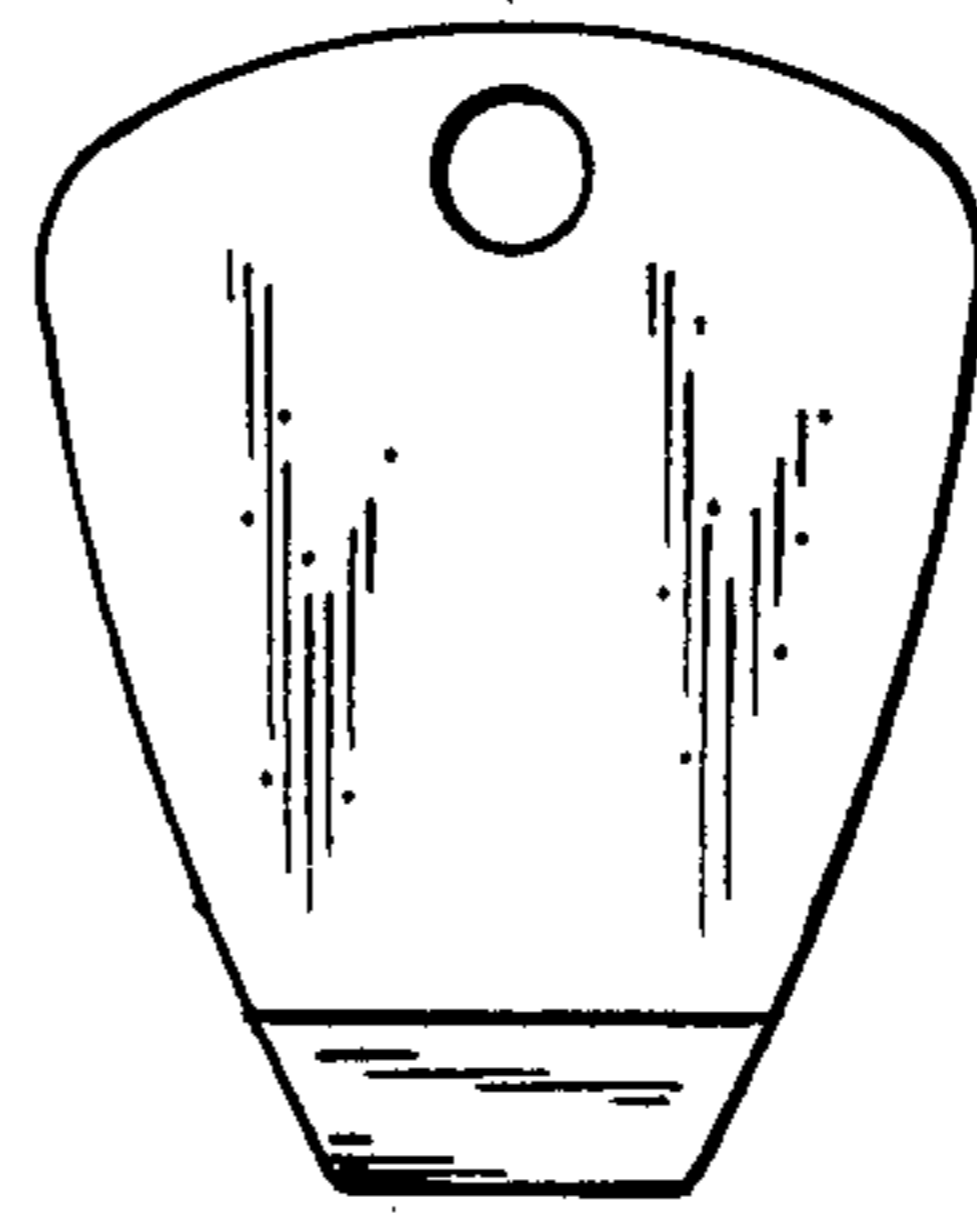

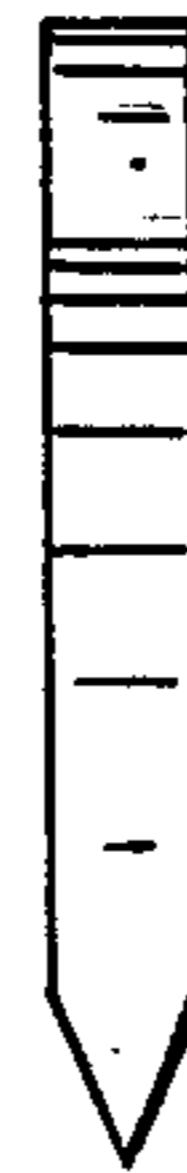

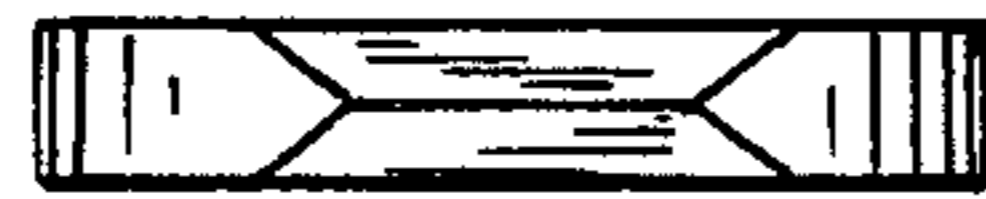
