showing my new design, a tray of the food serving cart
being removed for clarity of illustration;
FIG. 2 is a vertical sectional view thereof; and

line 3—3 of FIG. 2.

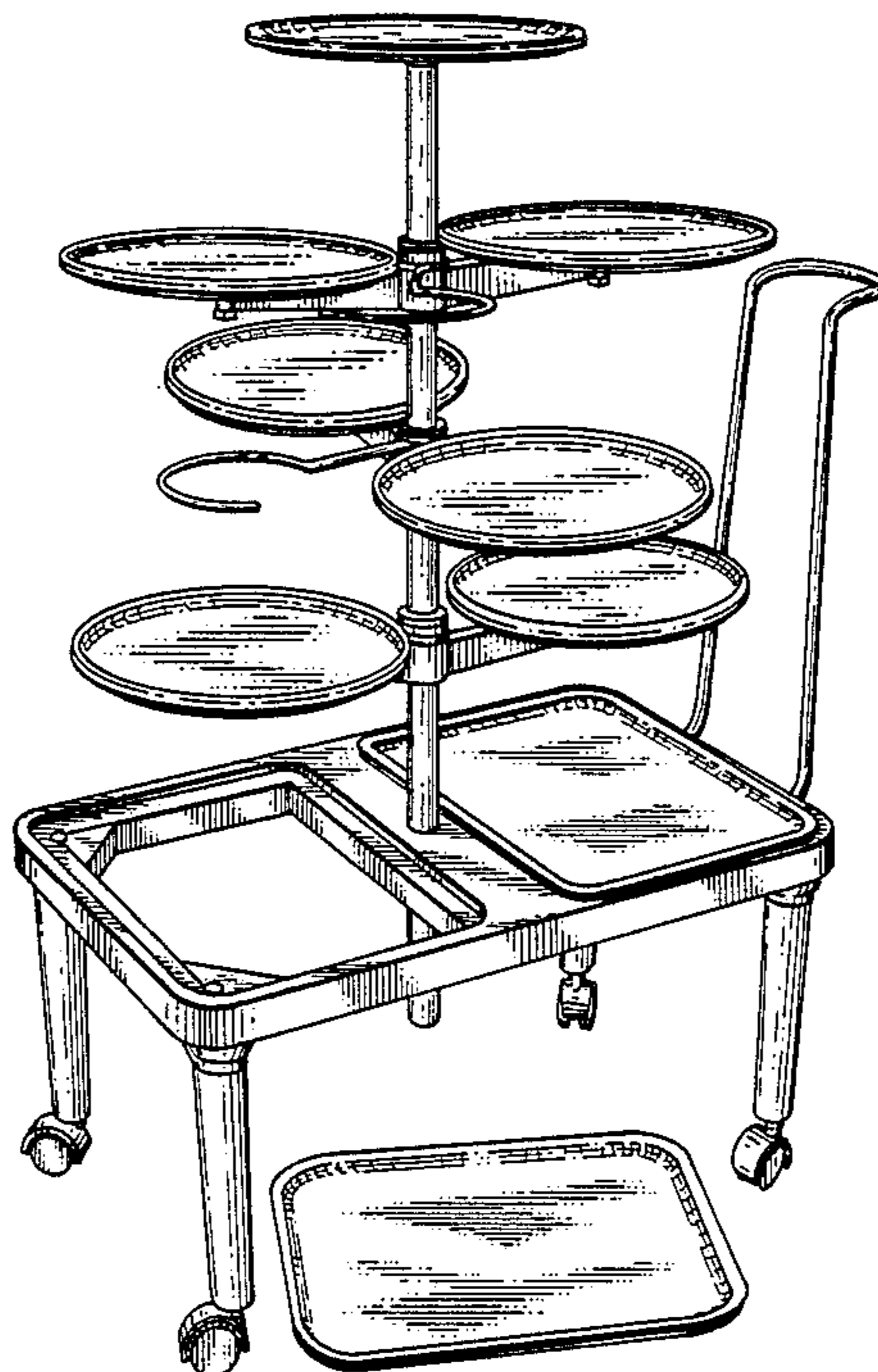

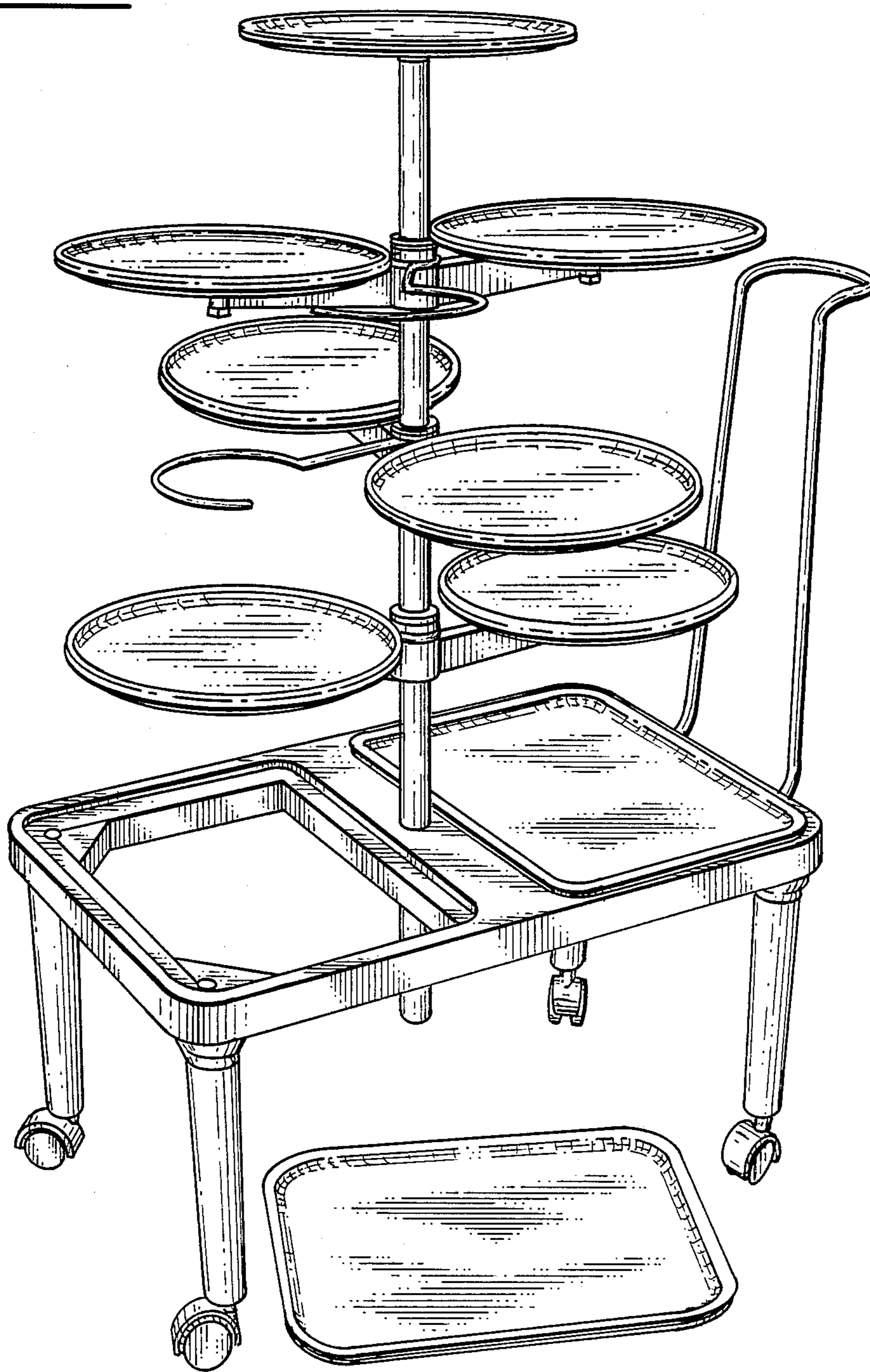

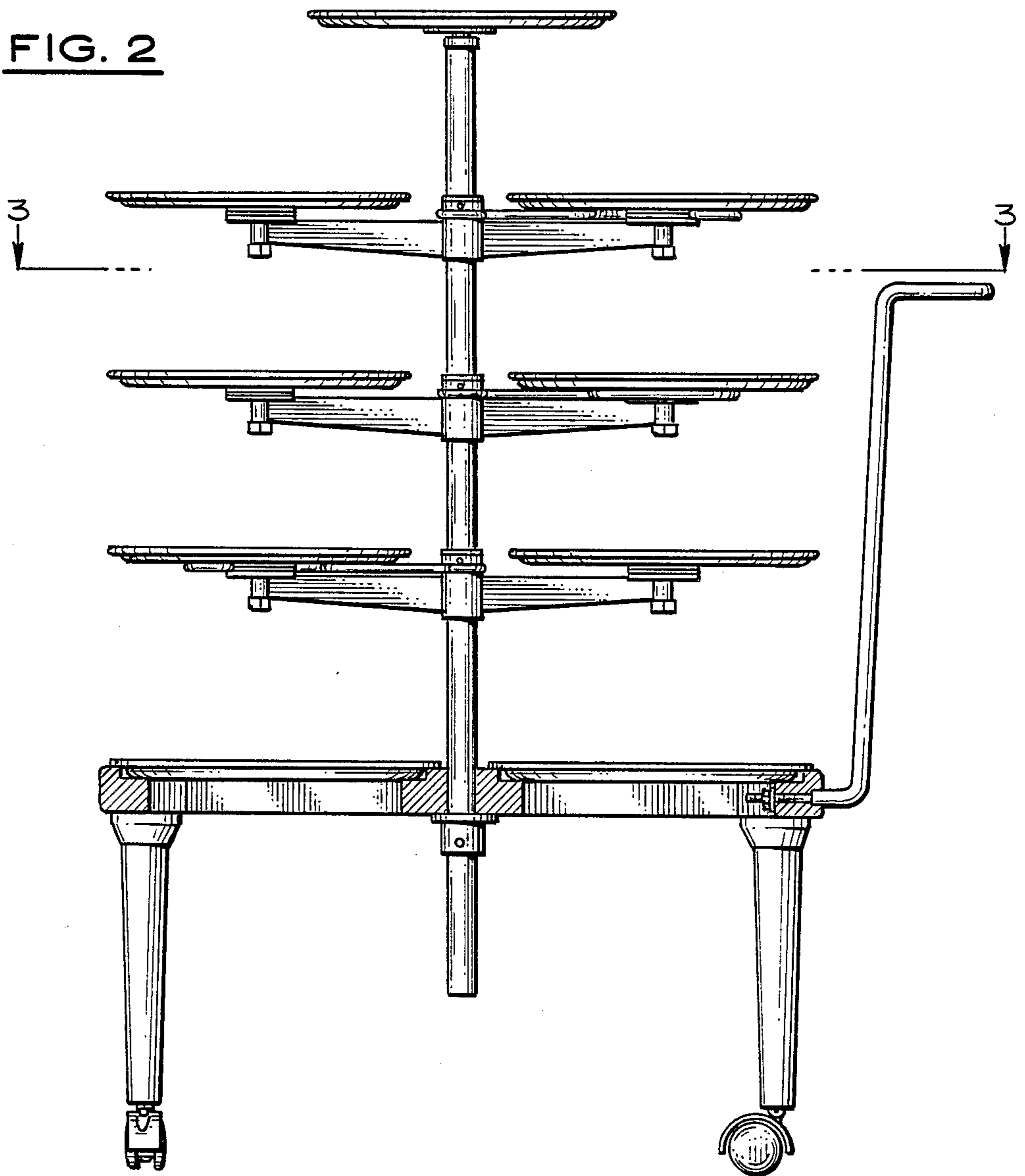
