FIG. 2 is a right side view illustrating the design which is repeated around the outside of the ring and is the subject of this design patent. The design is uniform around the ring.

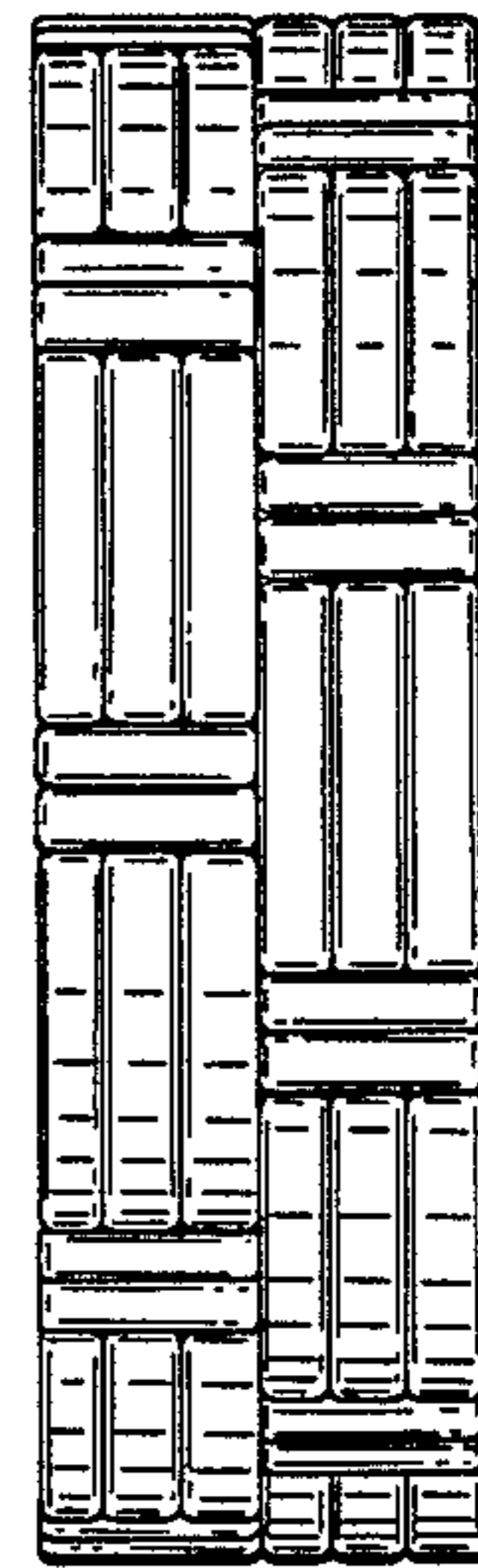
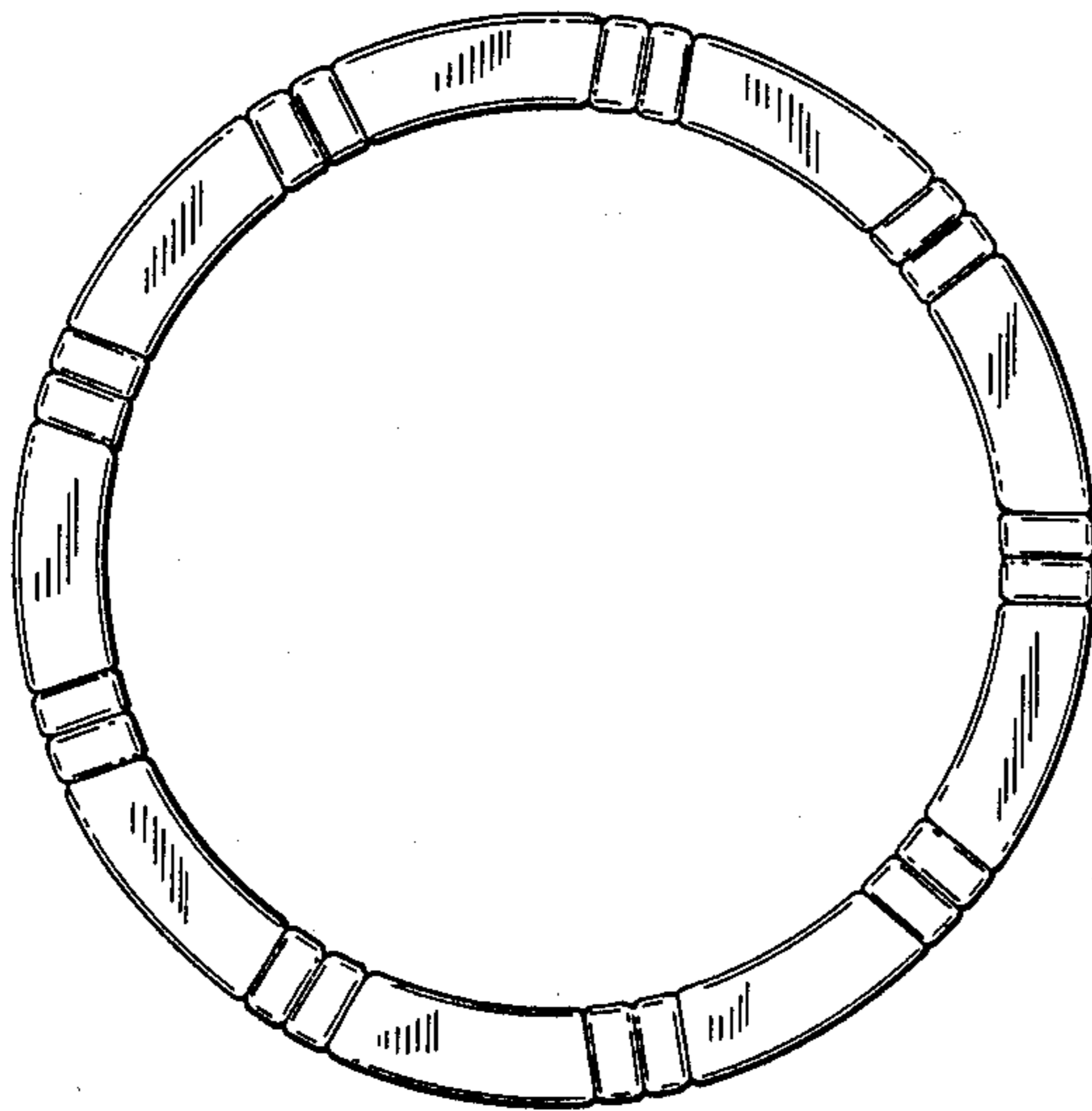

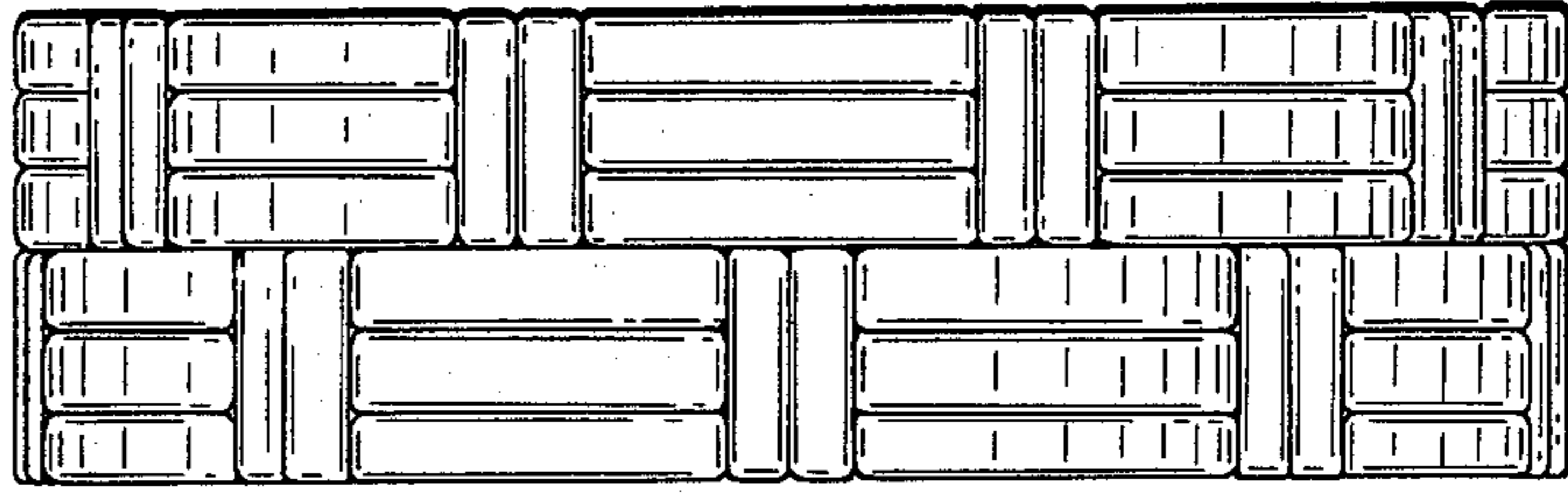
