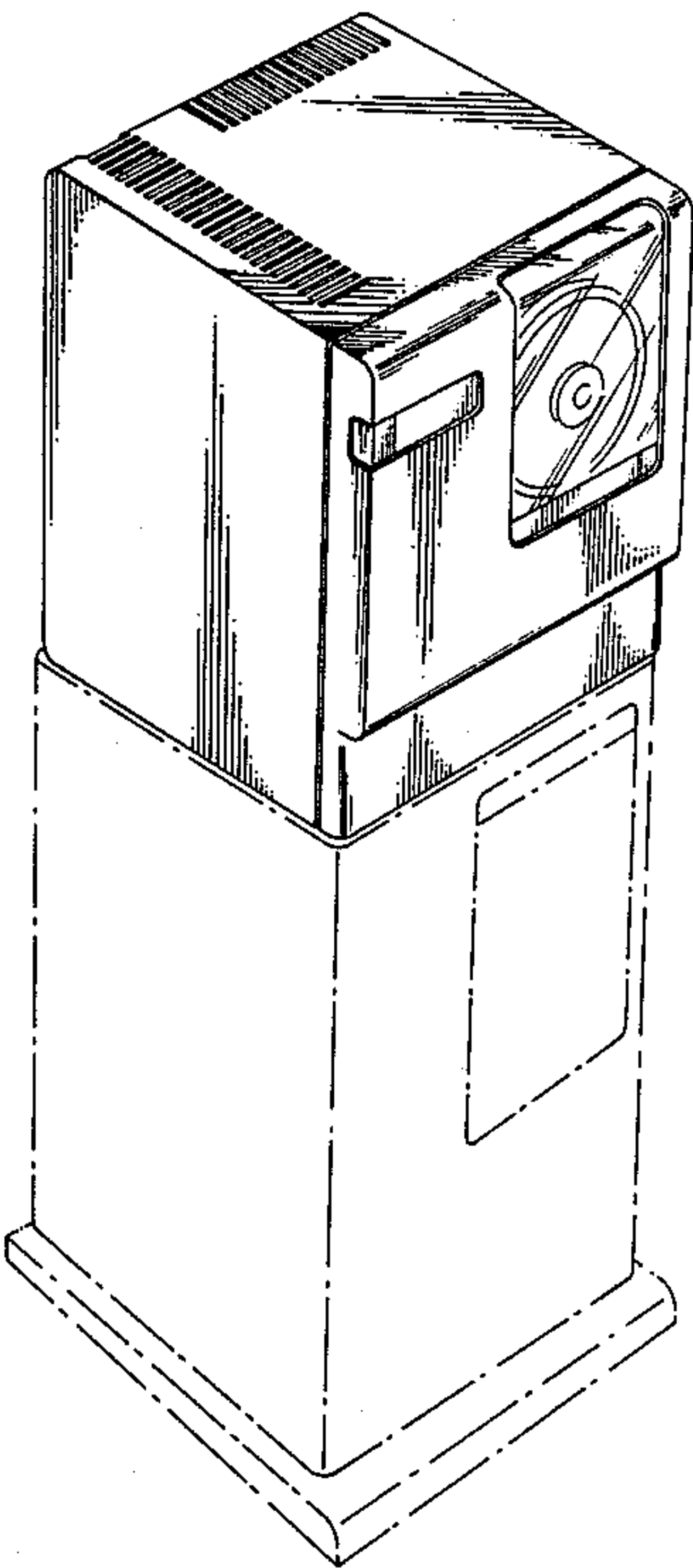

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of the free standing tape drive cabinet showing our new design, the stand being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale.



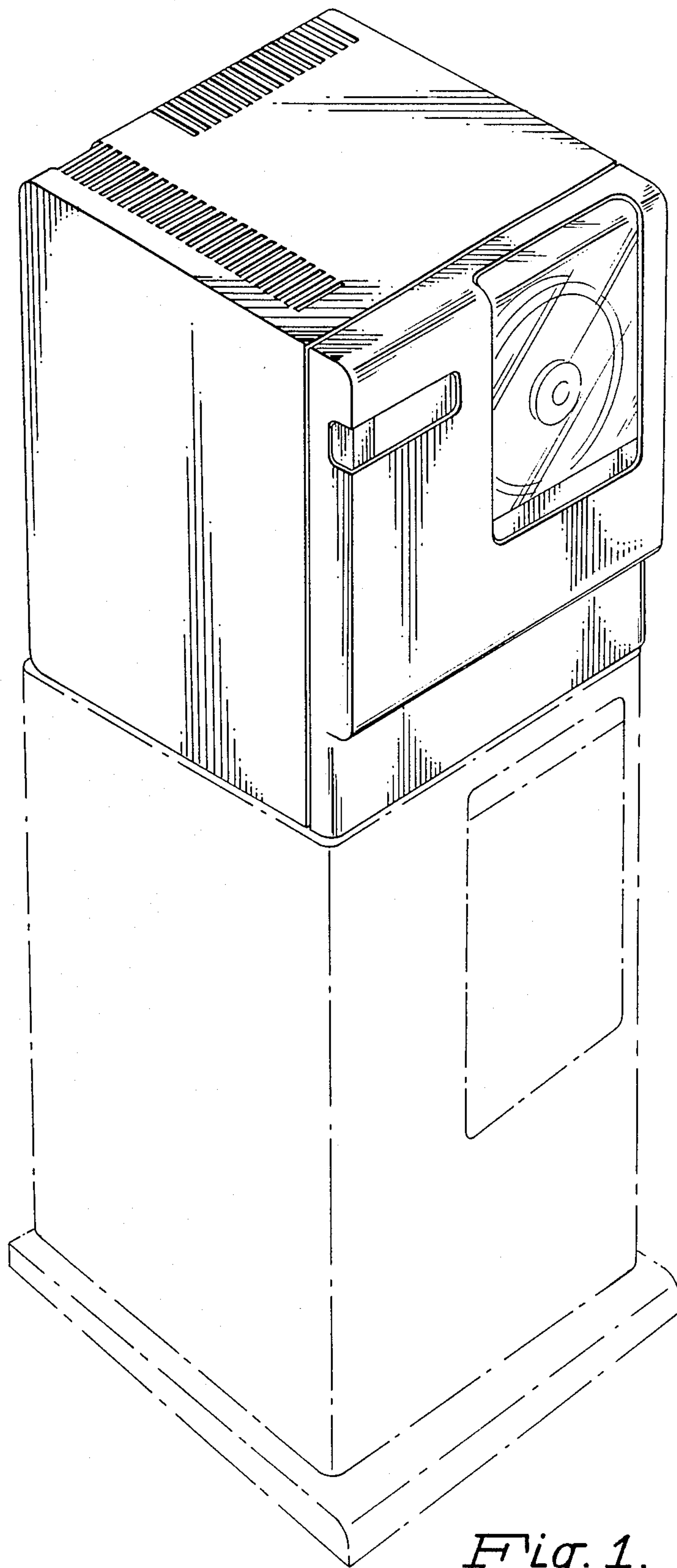

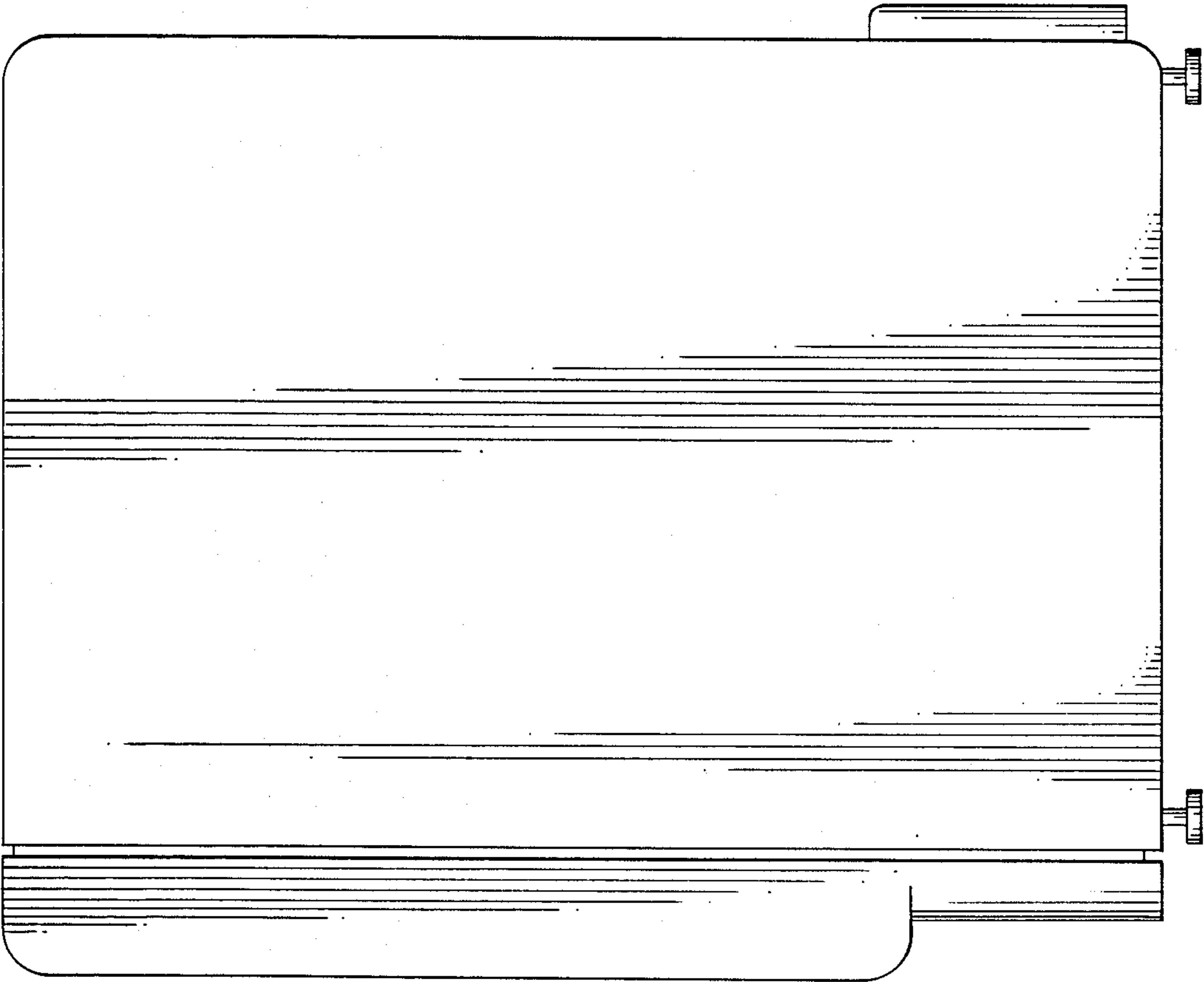

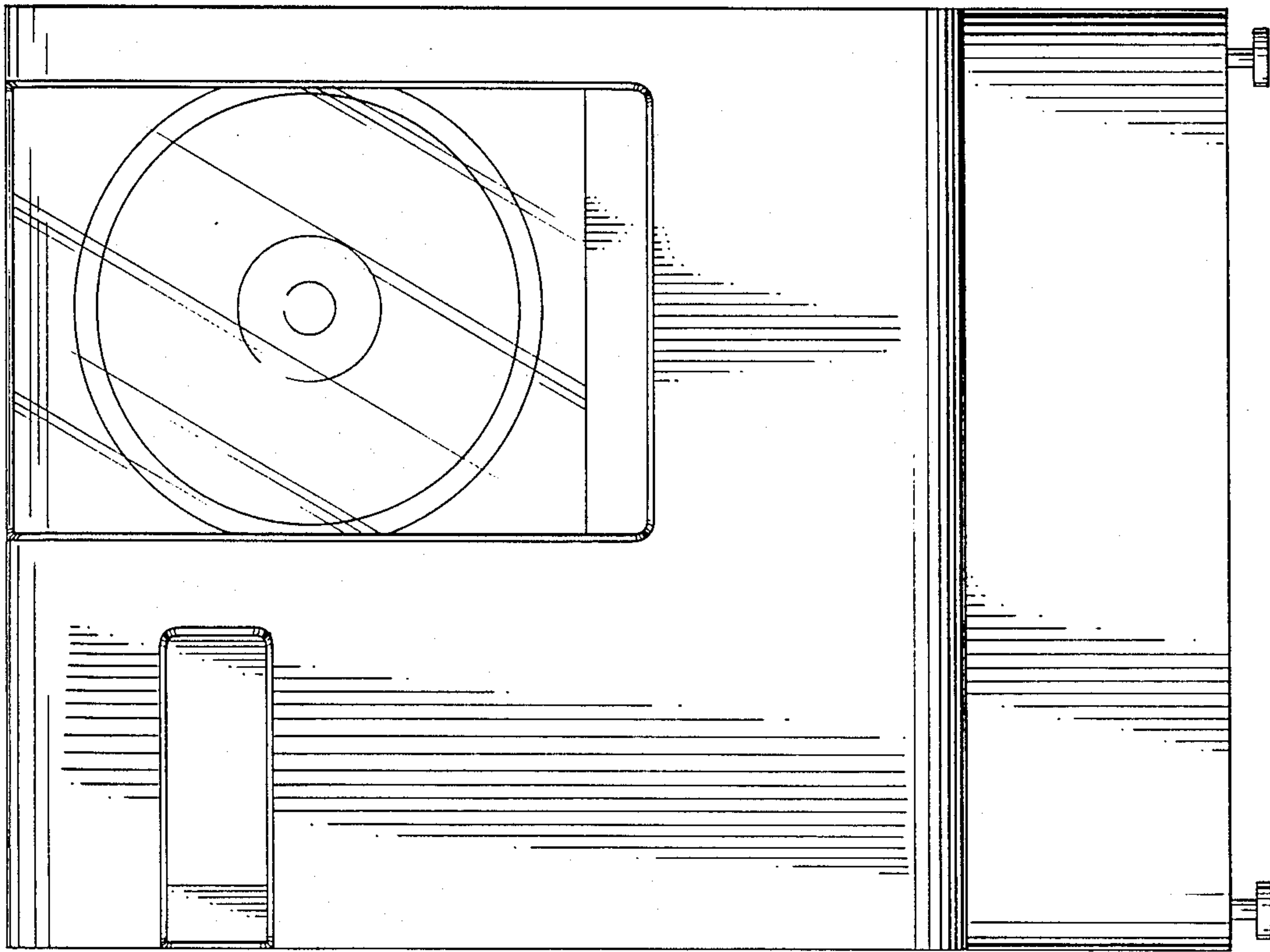

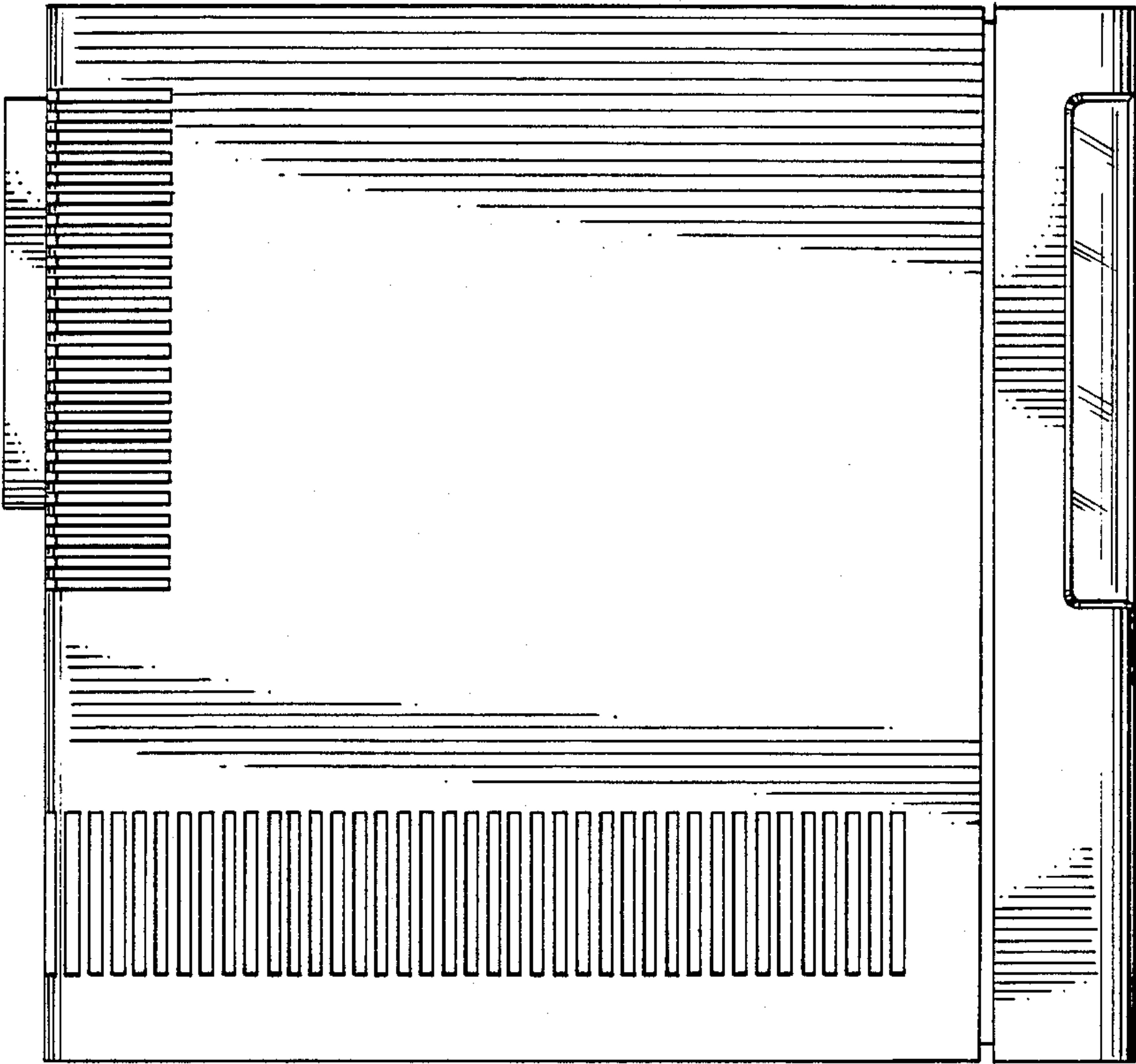

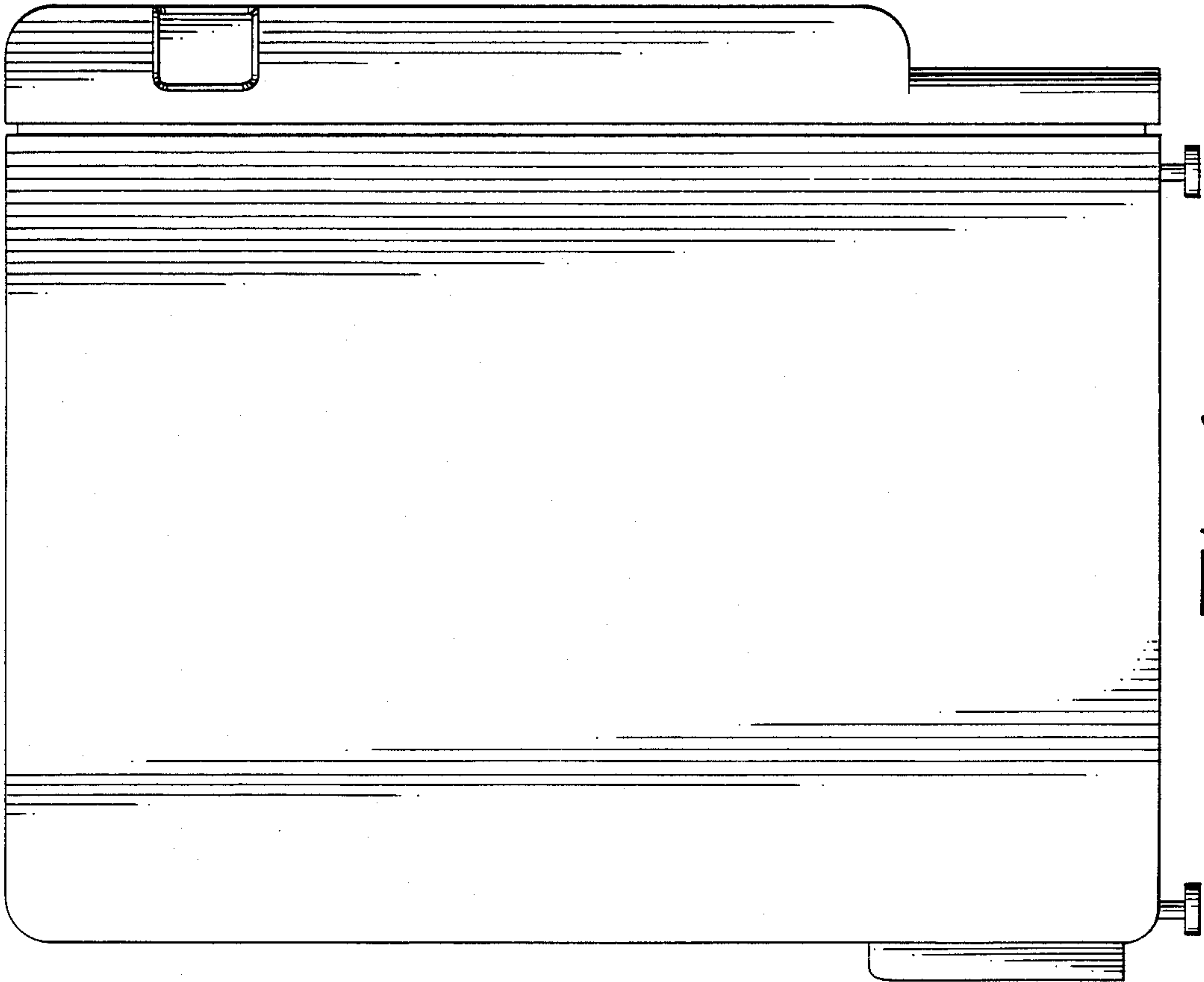

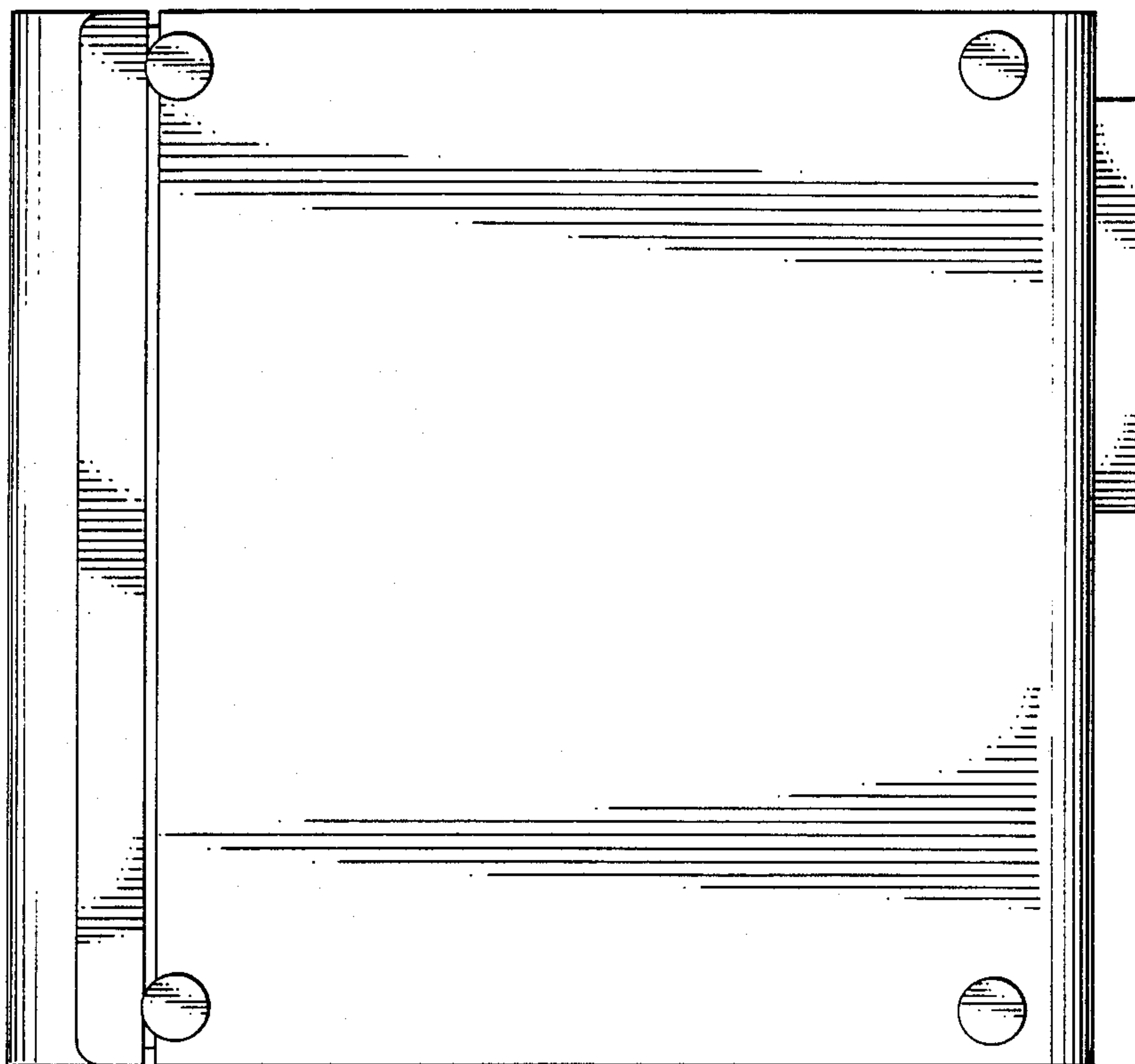

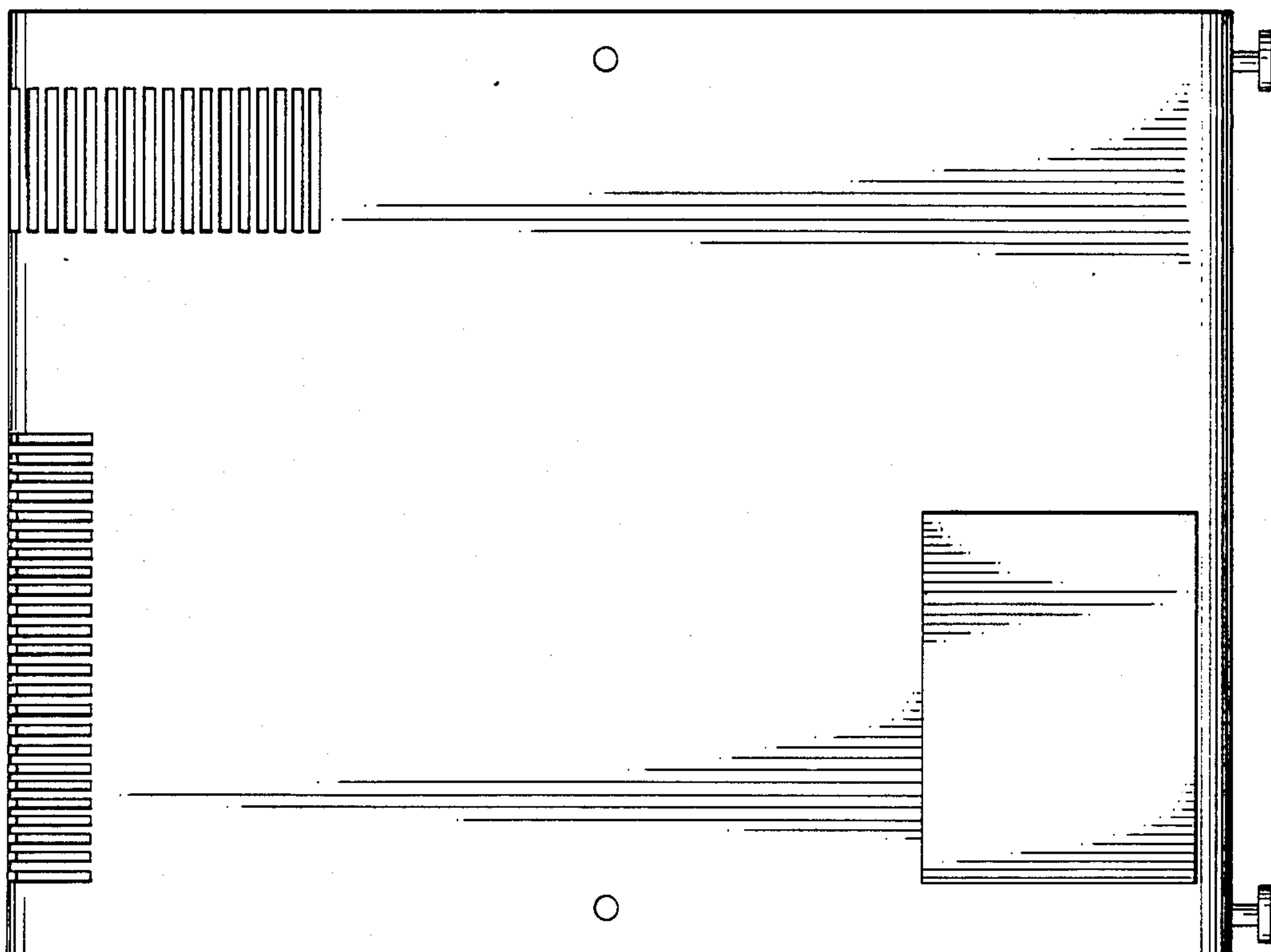
