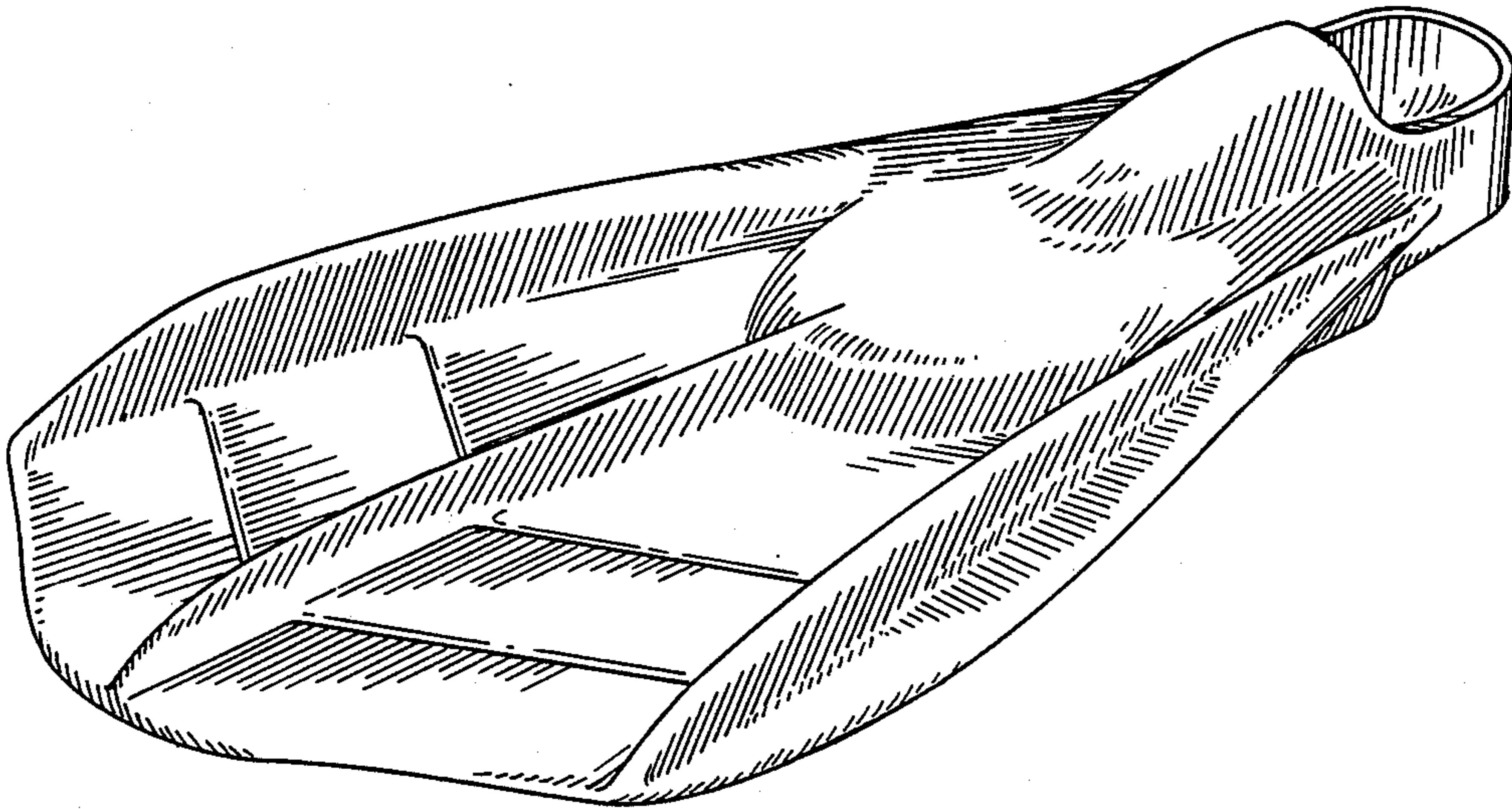
DESCRIPTION

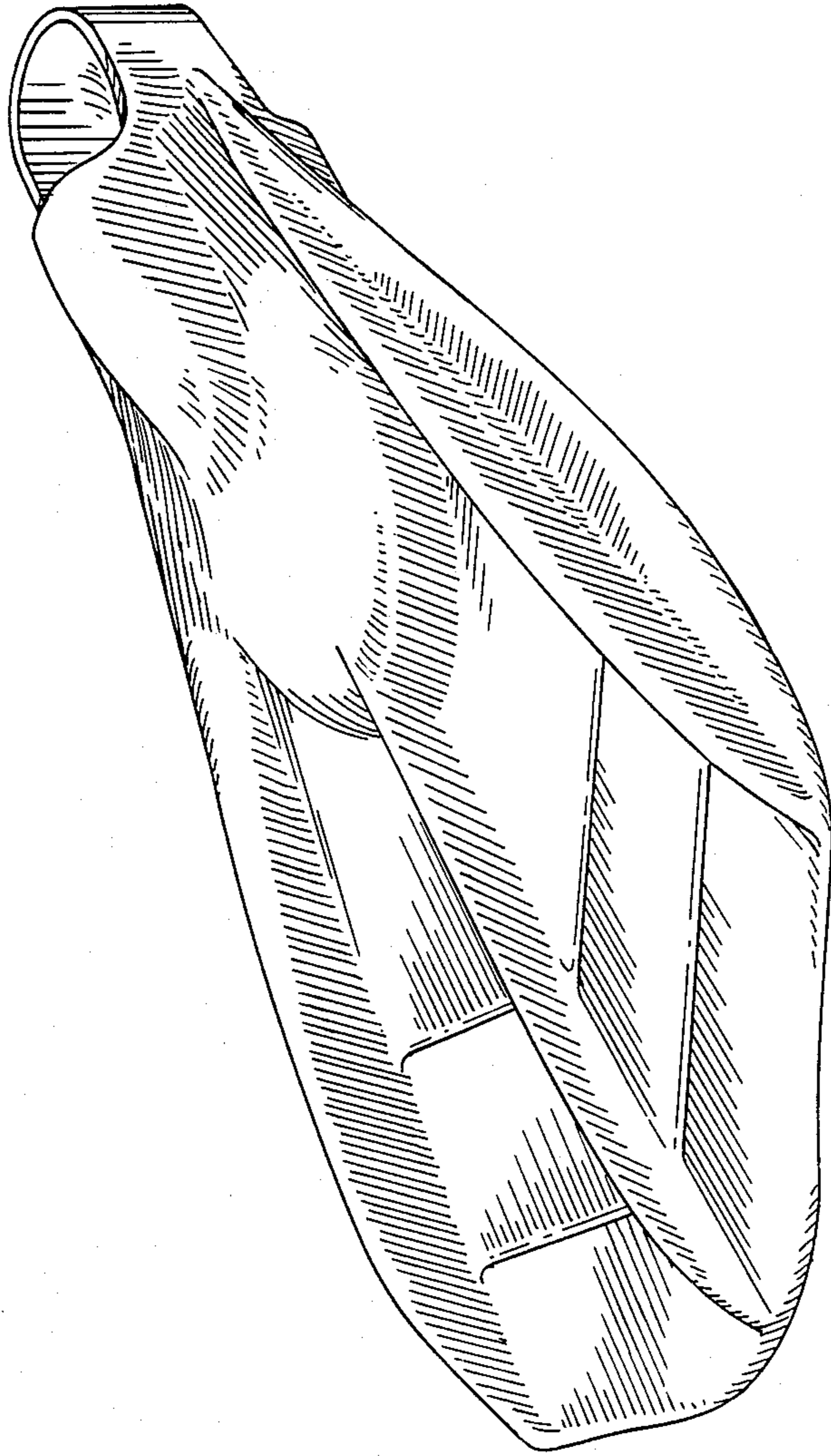

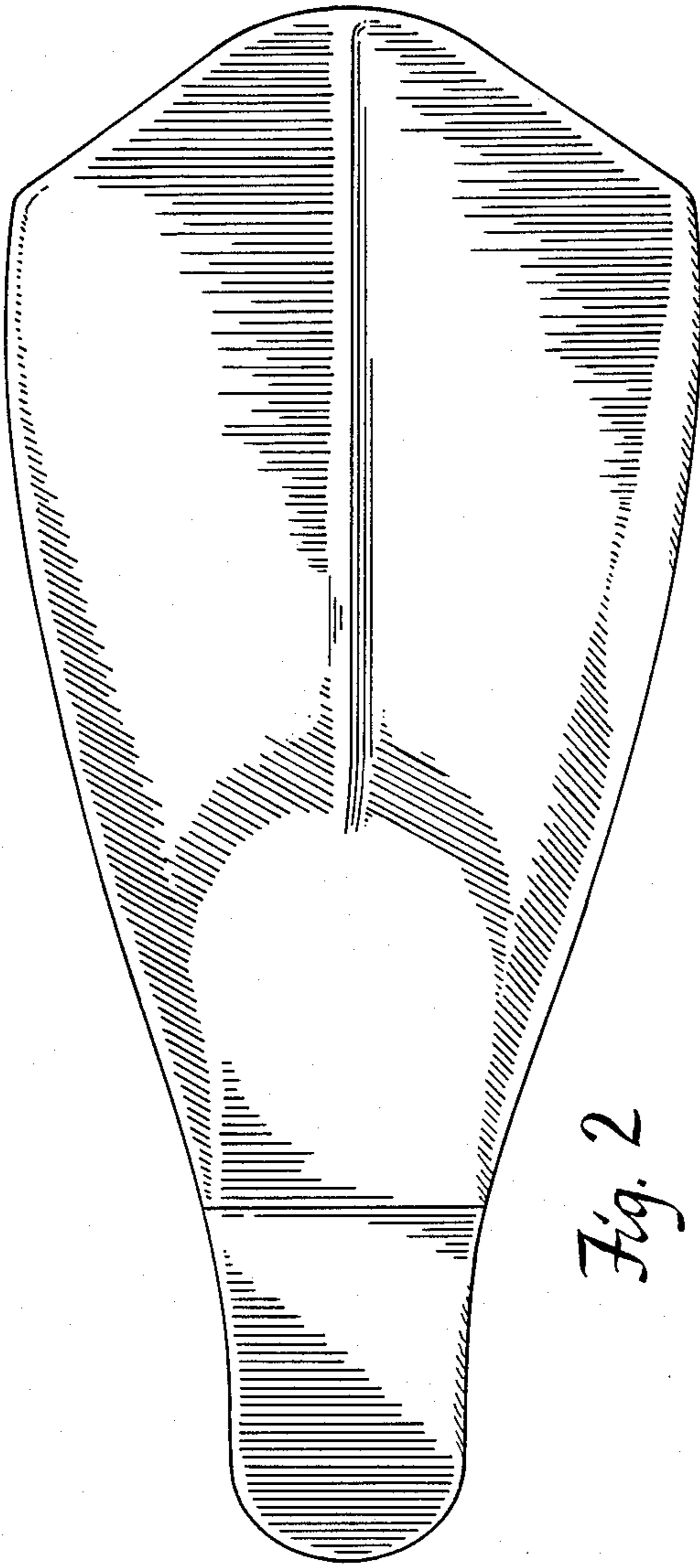

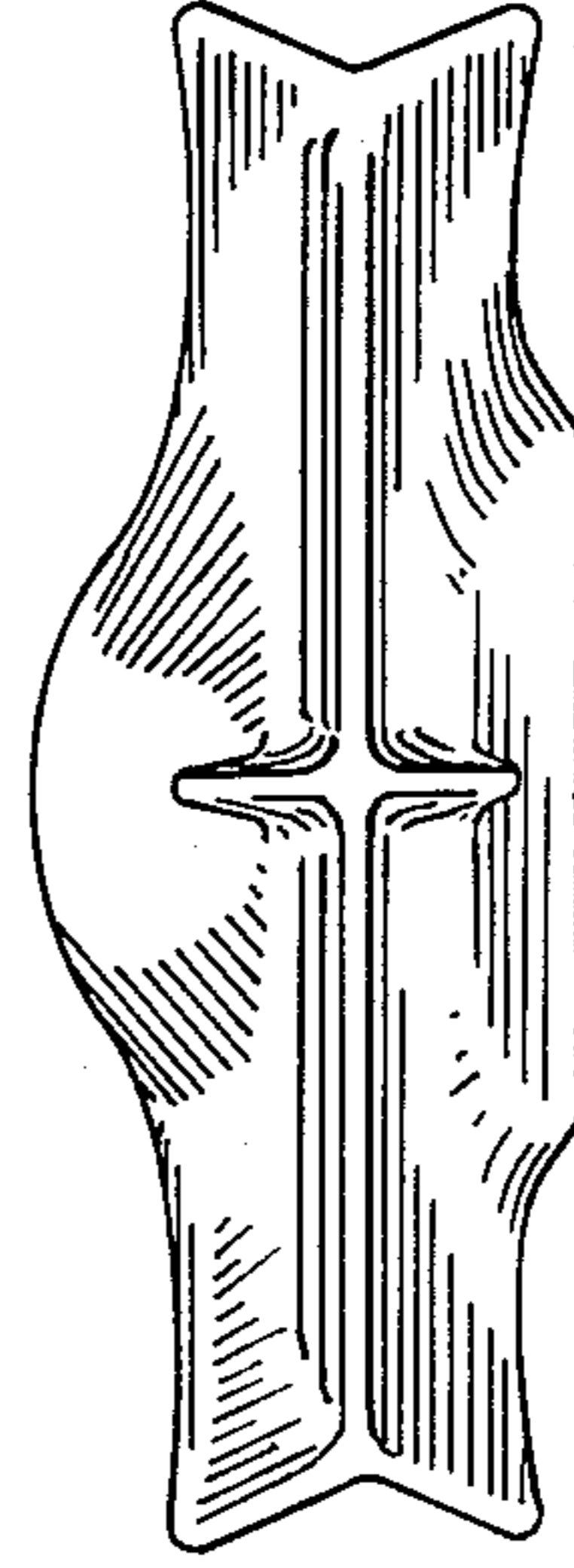

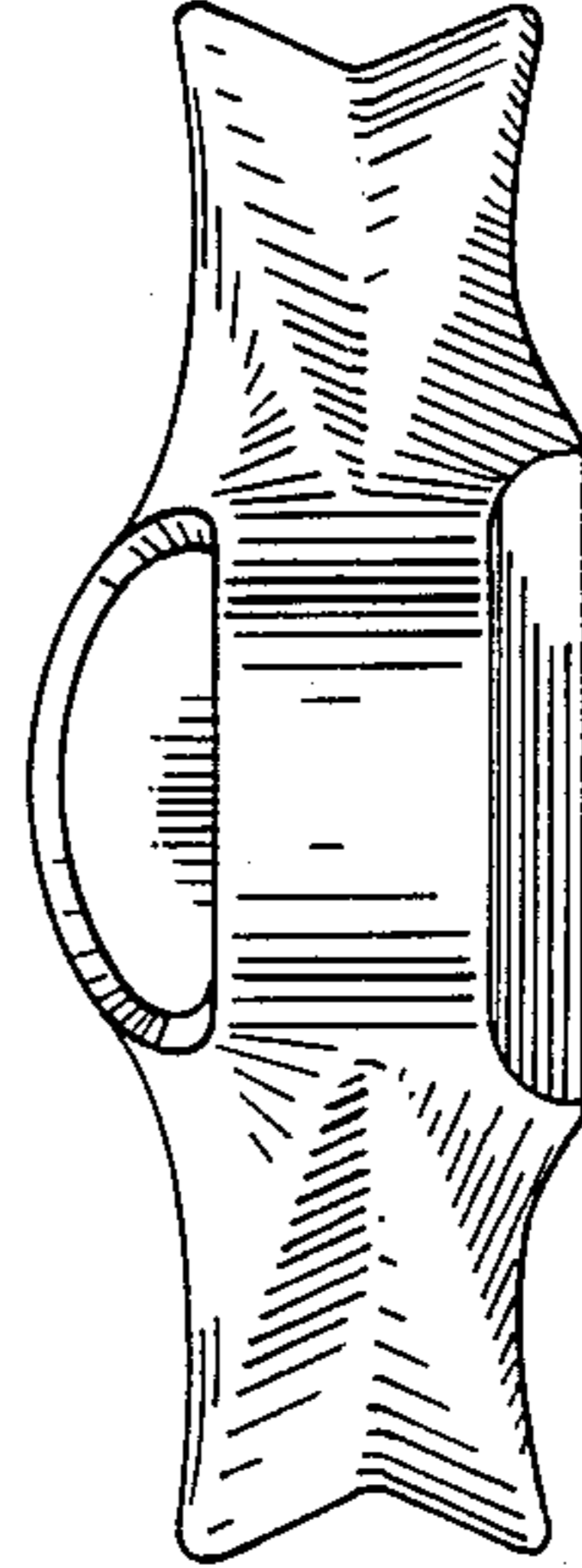

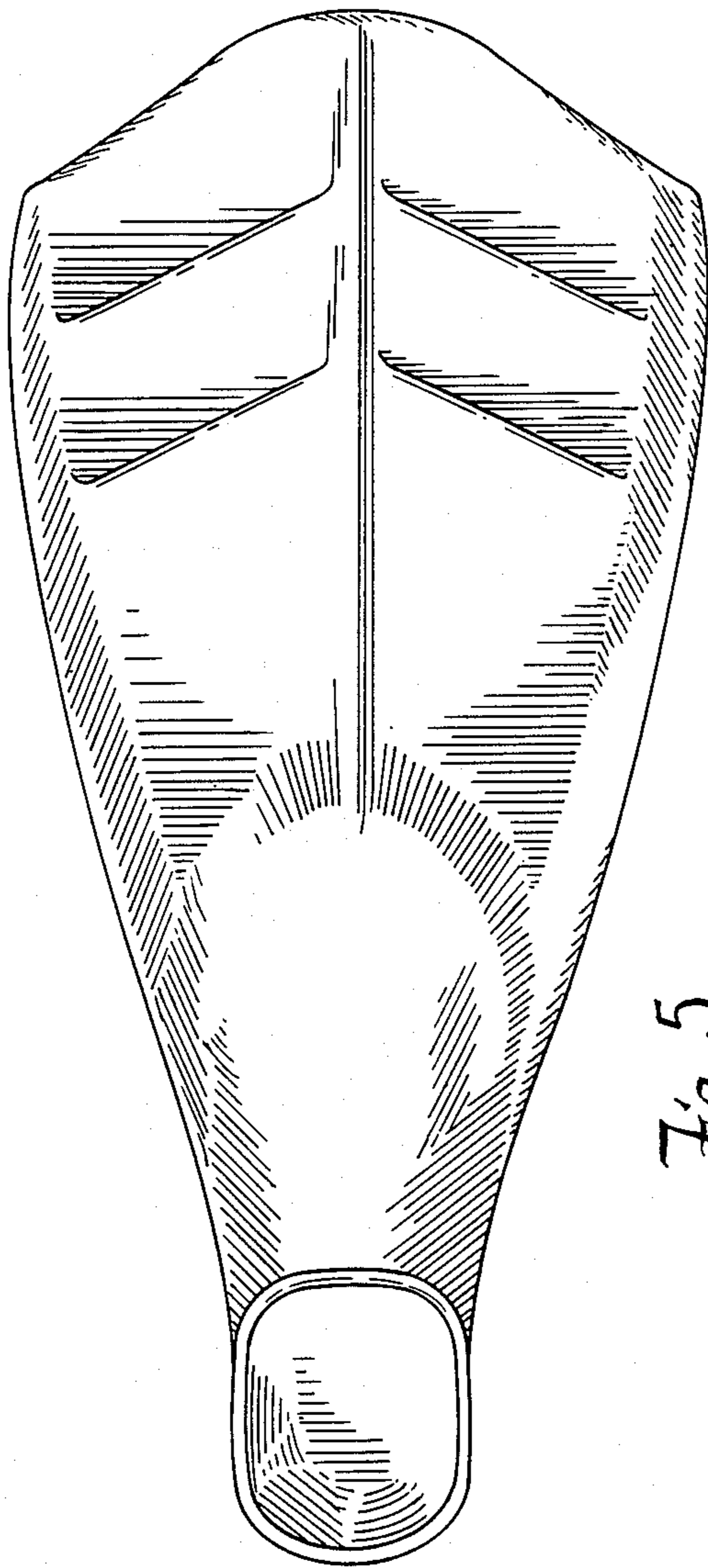

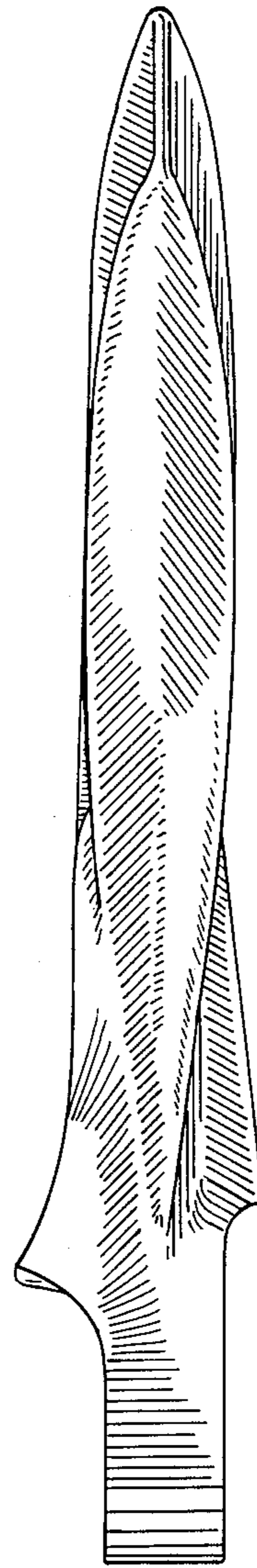
