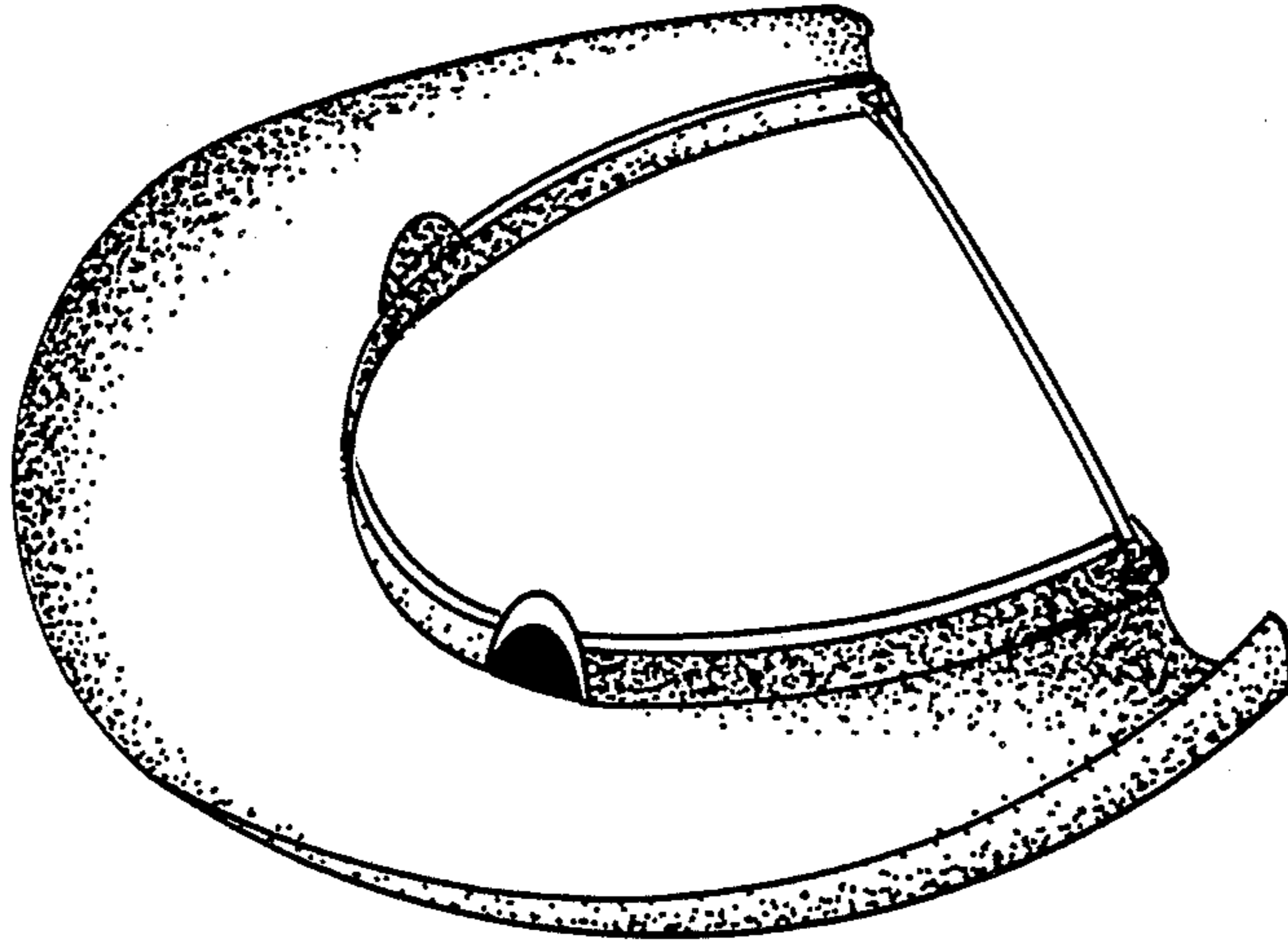

The ornamental design for a protective visor for use when bathing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a protective visor for use when bathing showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view as seen when worn, the right side being a mirror image thereof.



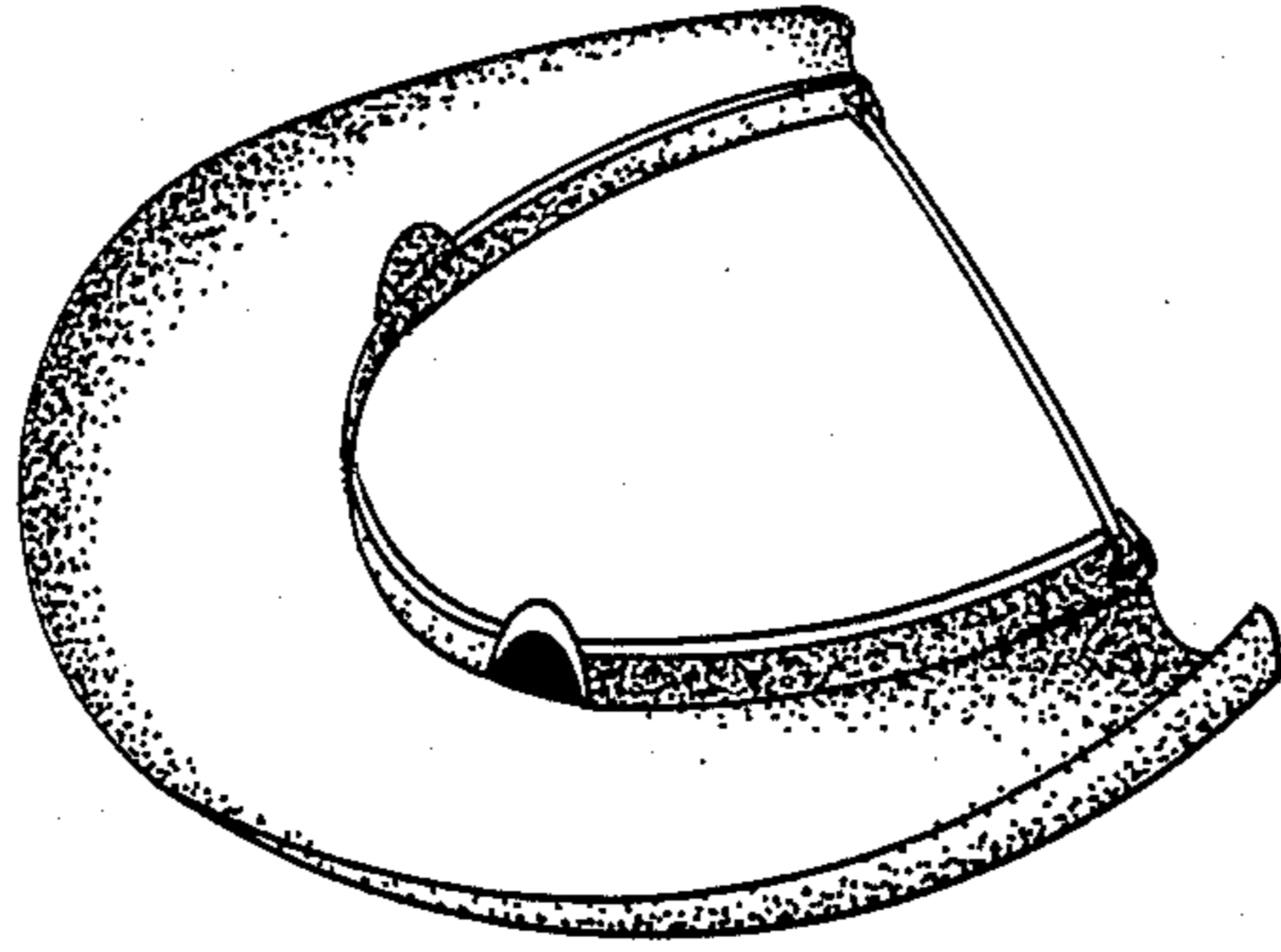

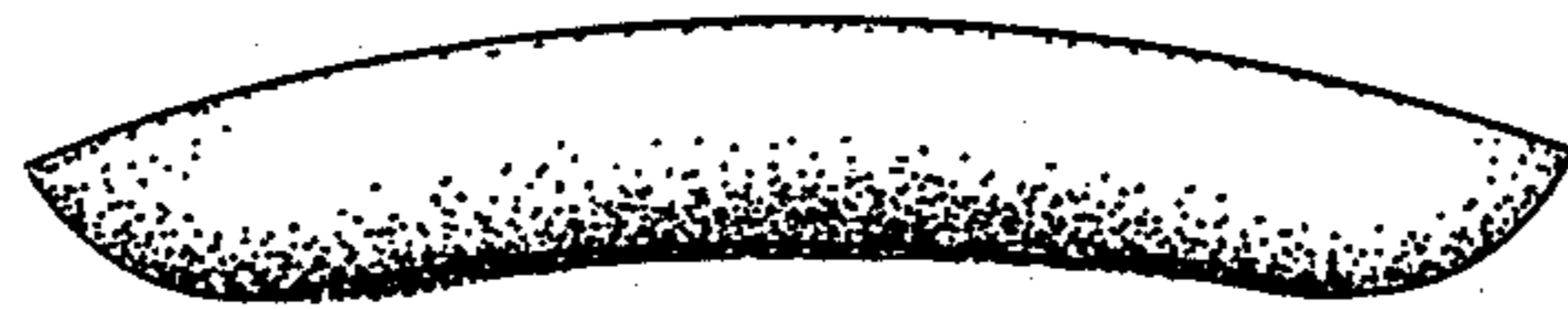

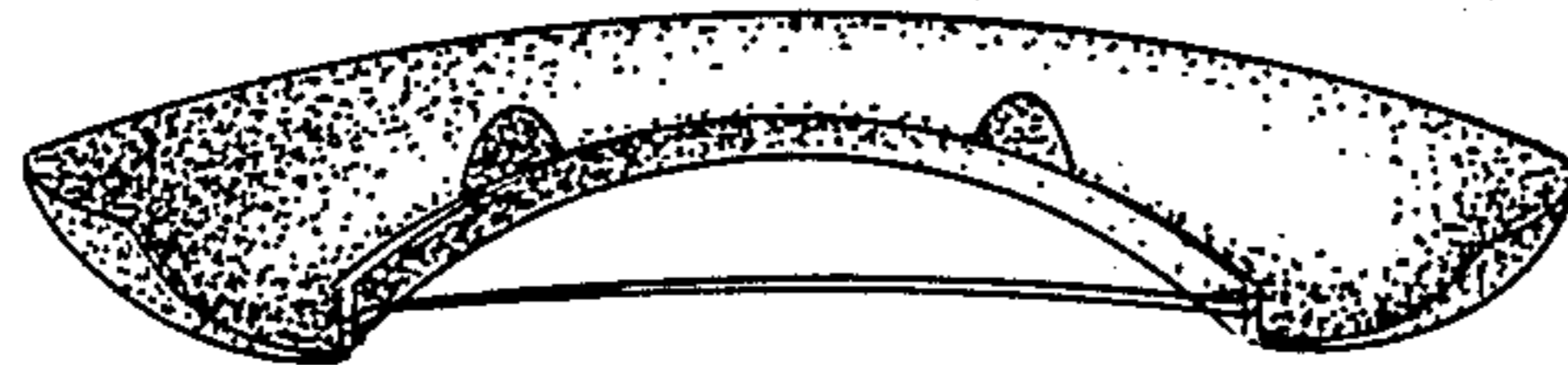

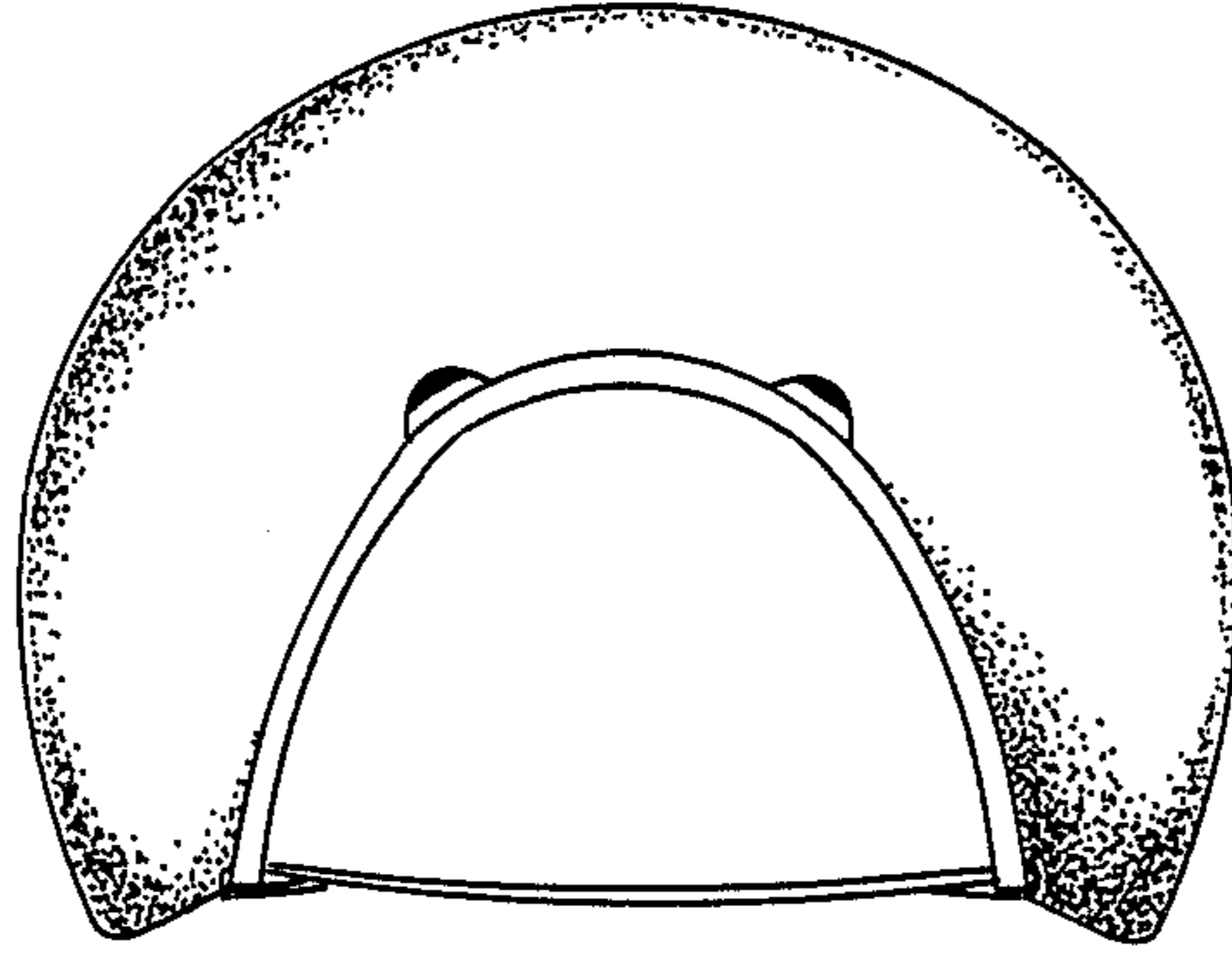

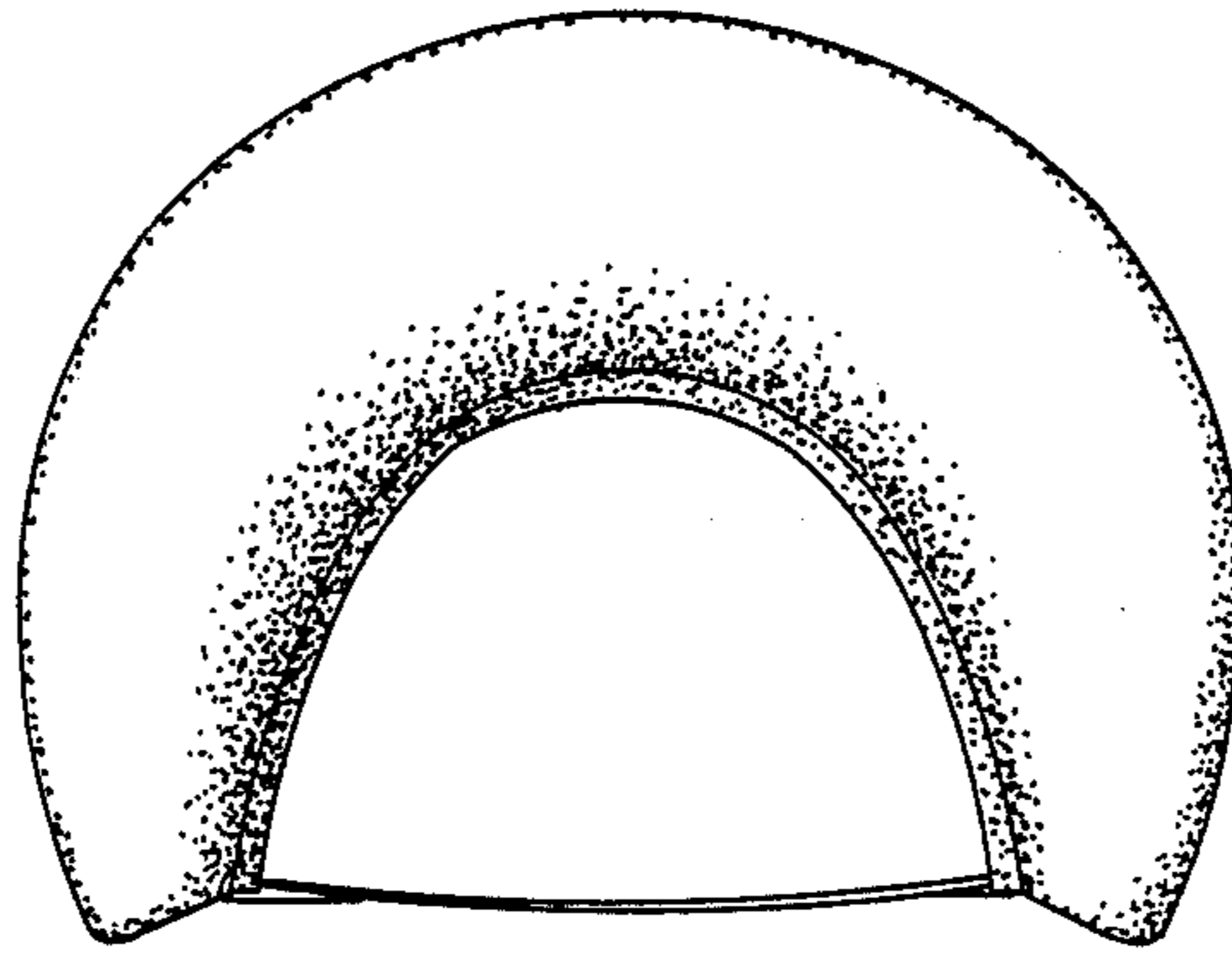
