The ornamental design for a lighted mirror, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, perspective view of my new design for a lighted mirror showing the mirror in a tilted orientation.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 2 taken along the lines 3—3.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2 taken along the lines 4—4.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2 taken along the lines 5—5.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2 taken along the lines 6—6.

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof in an alternate position; and

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7.



