The ornamental design for a handle for a mixer or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a handle for a mixer or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

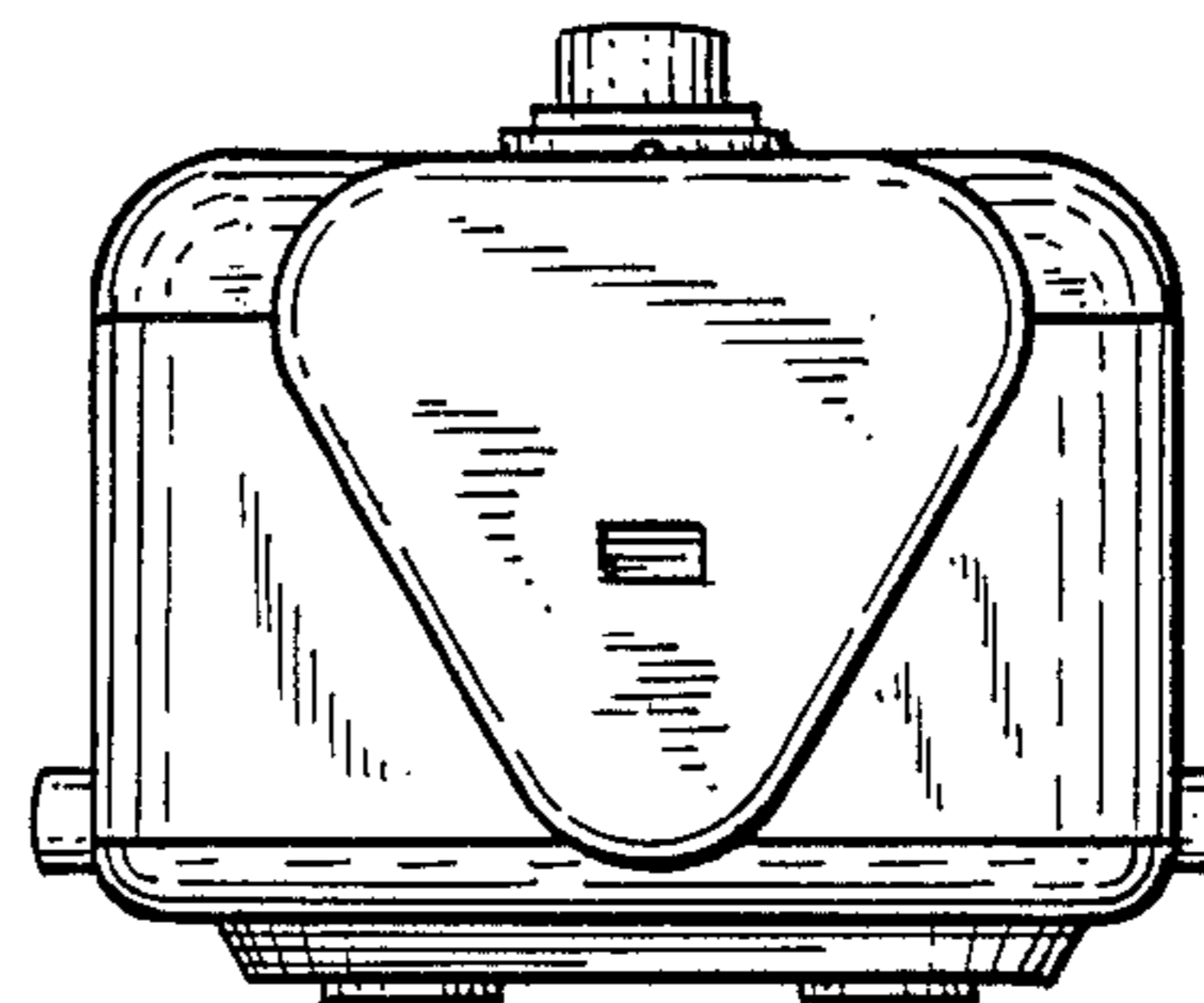
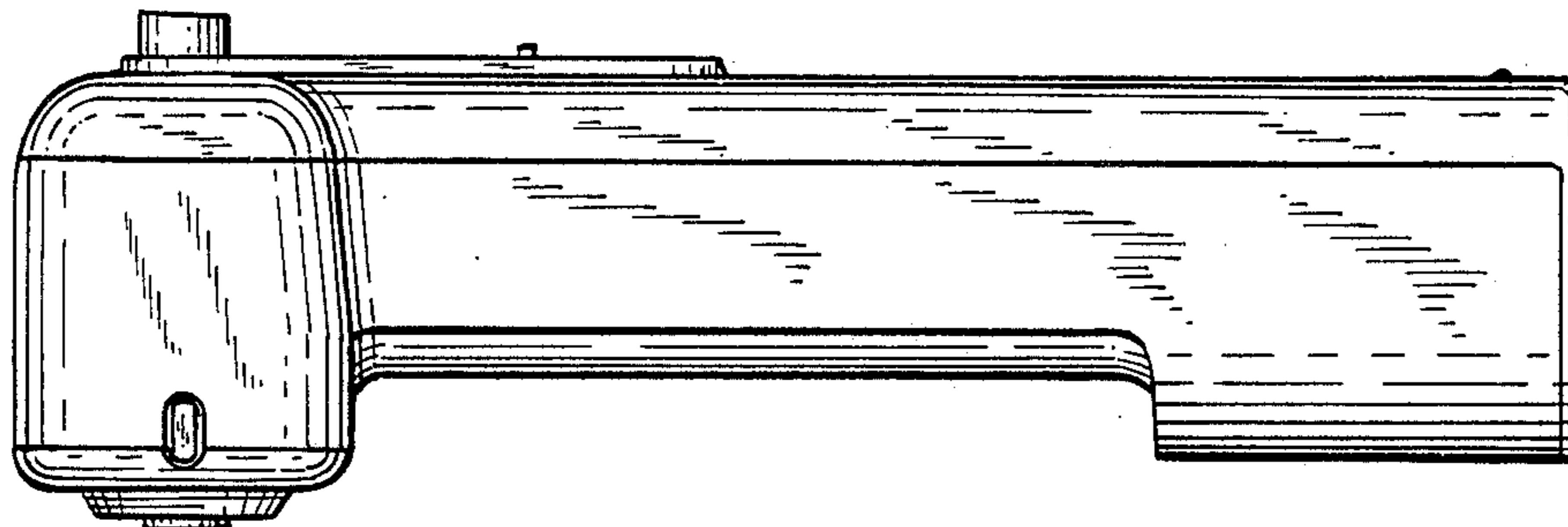

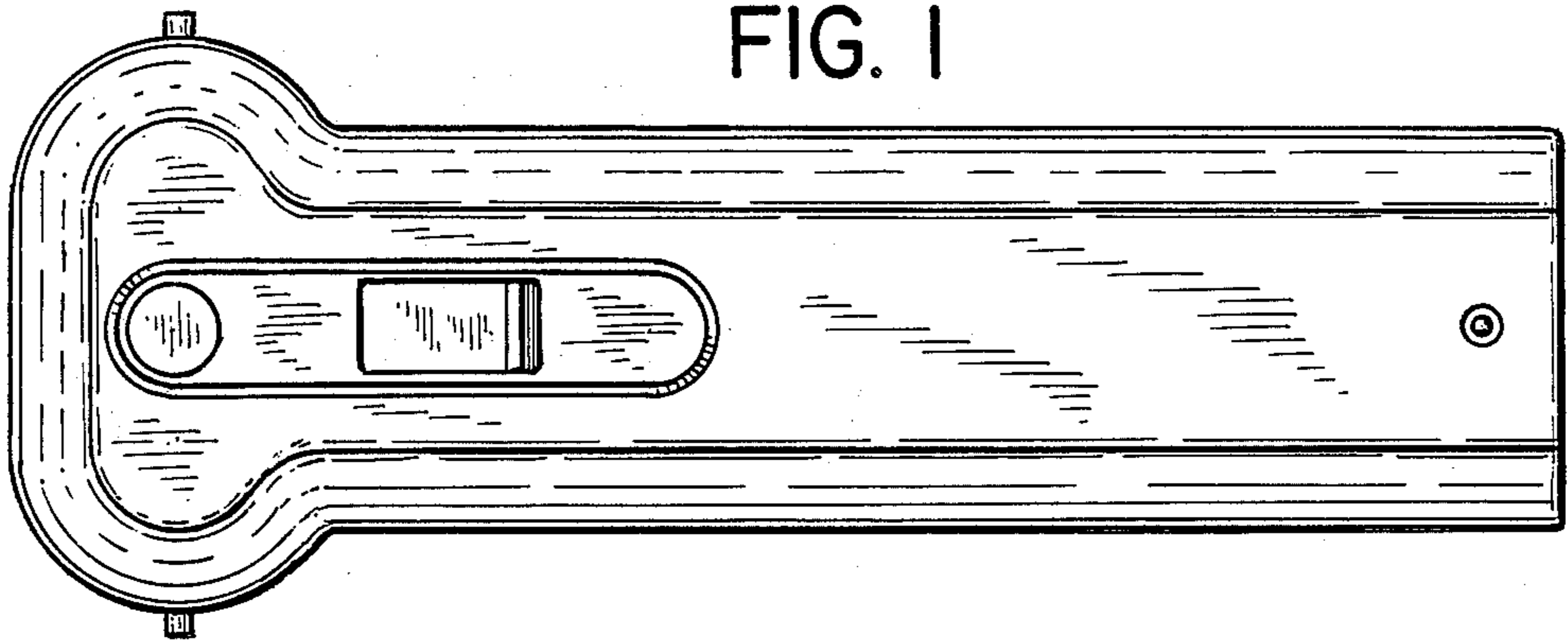

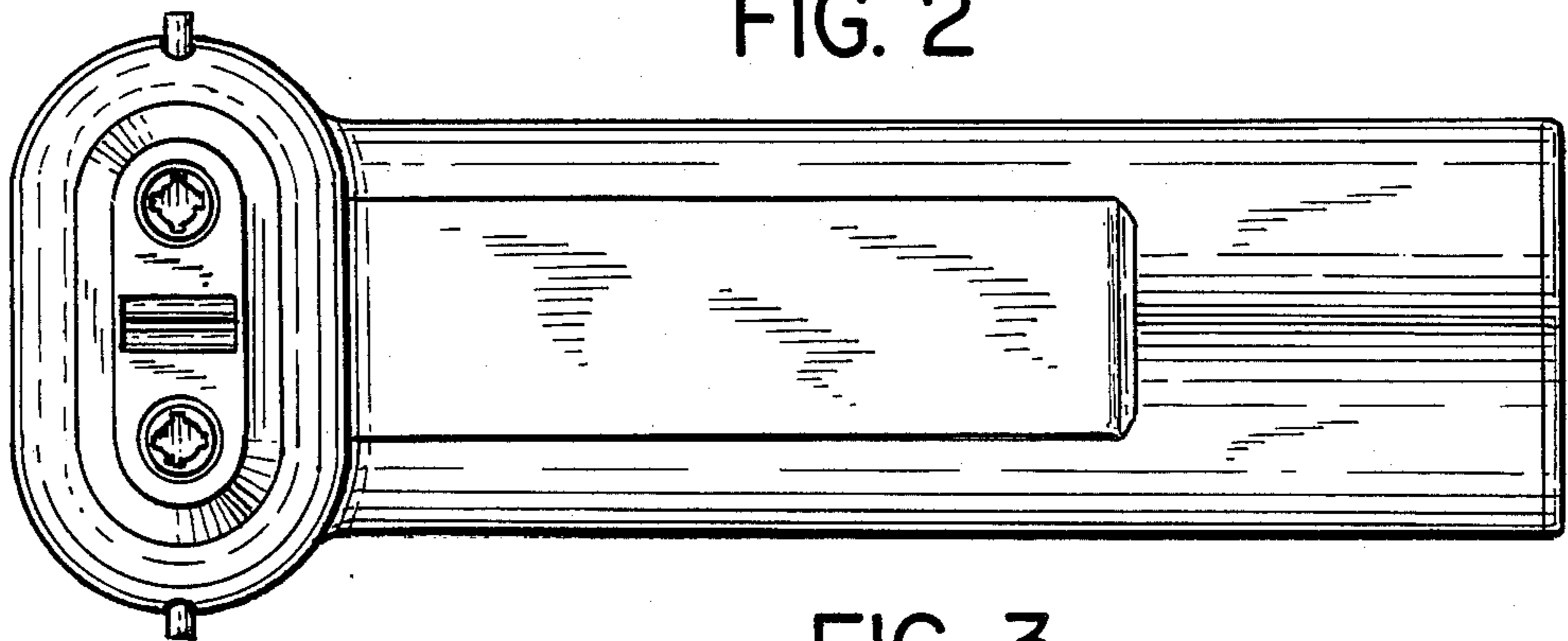

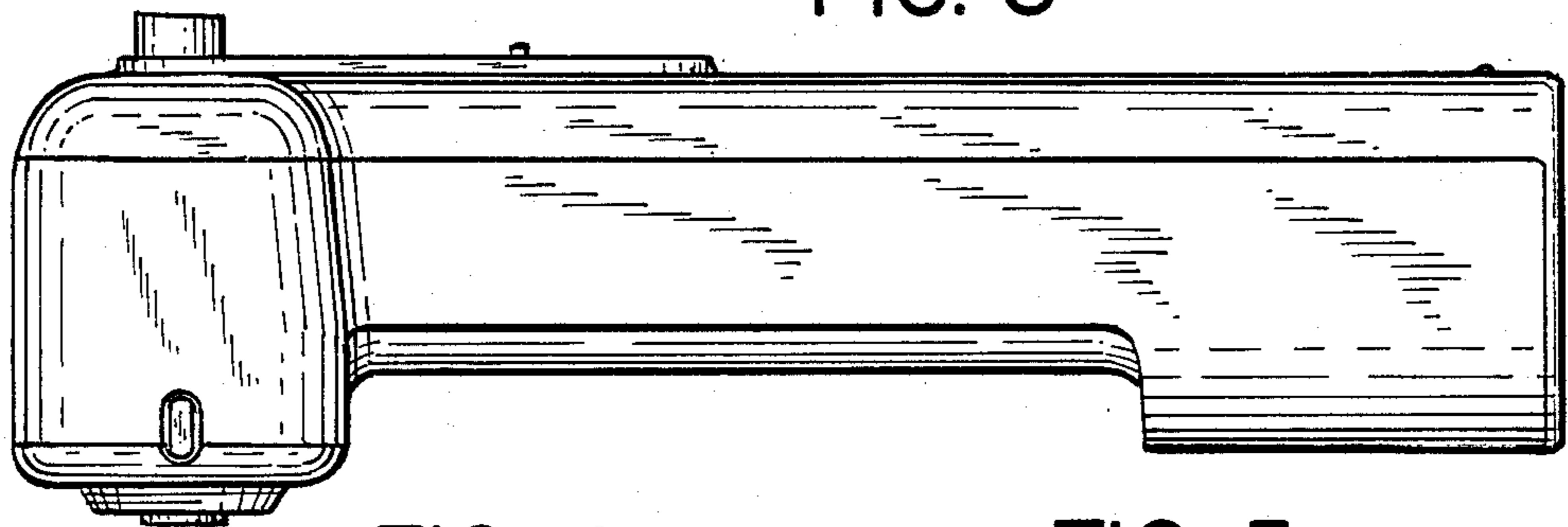

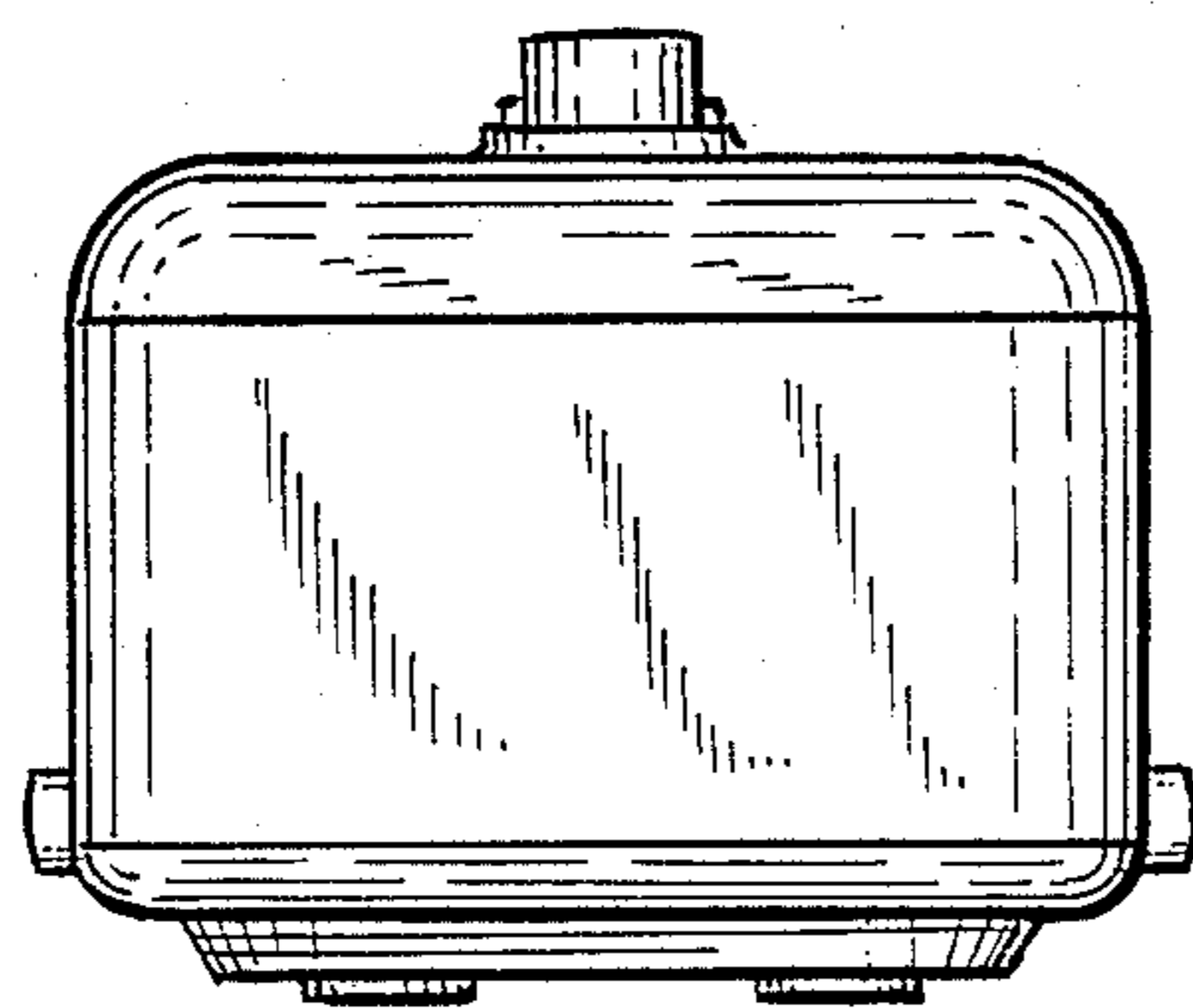
