FIG. 4 is a plan view from below.

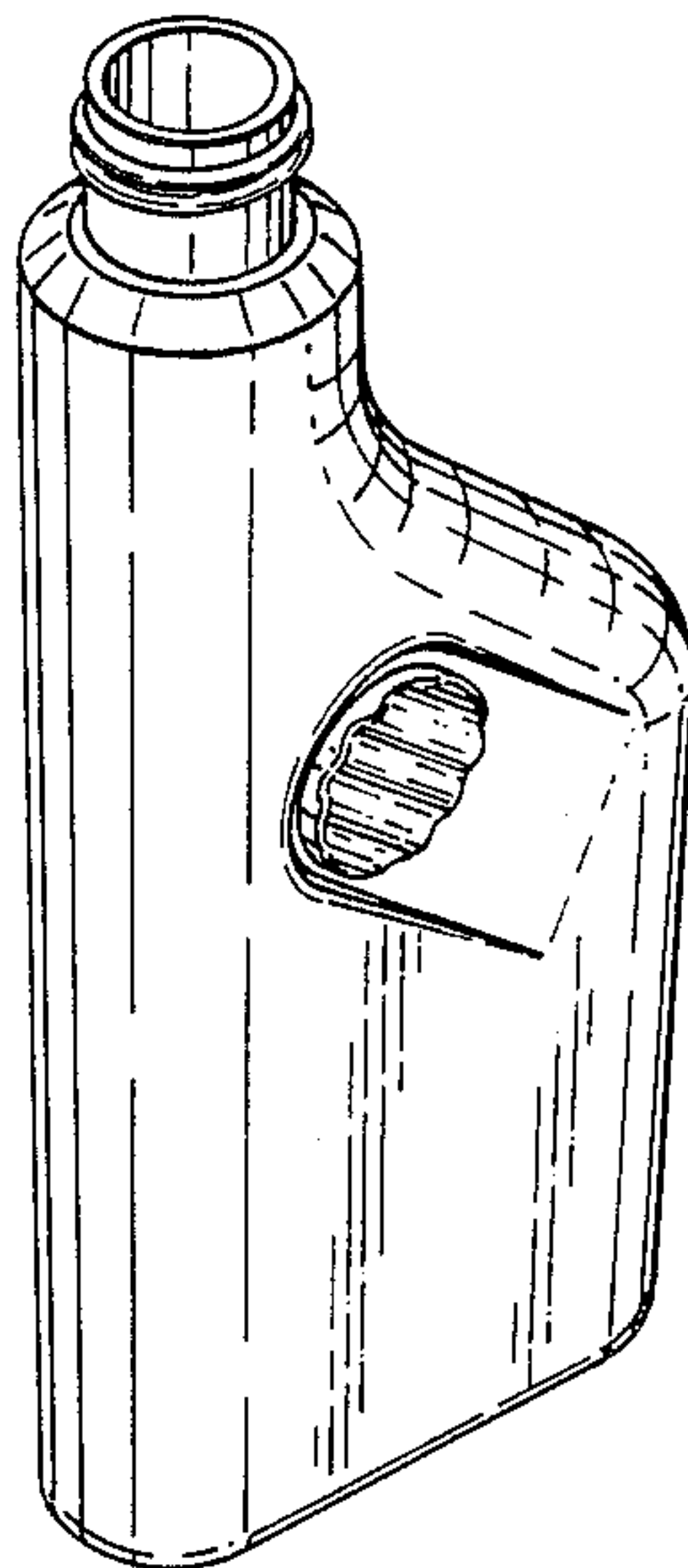

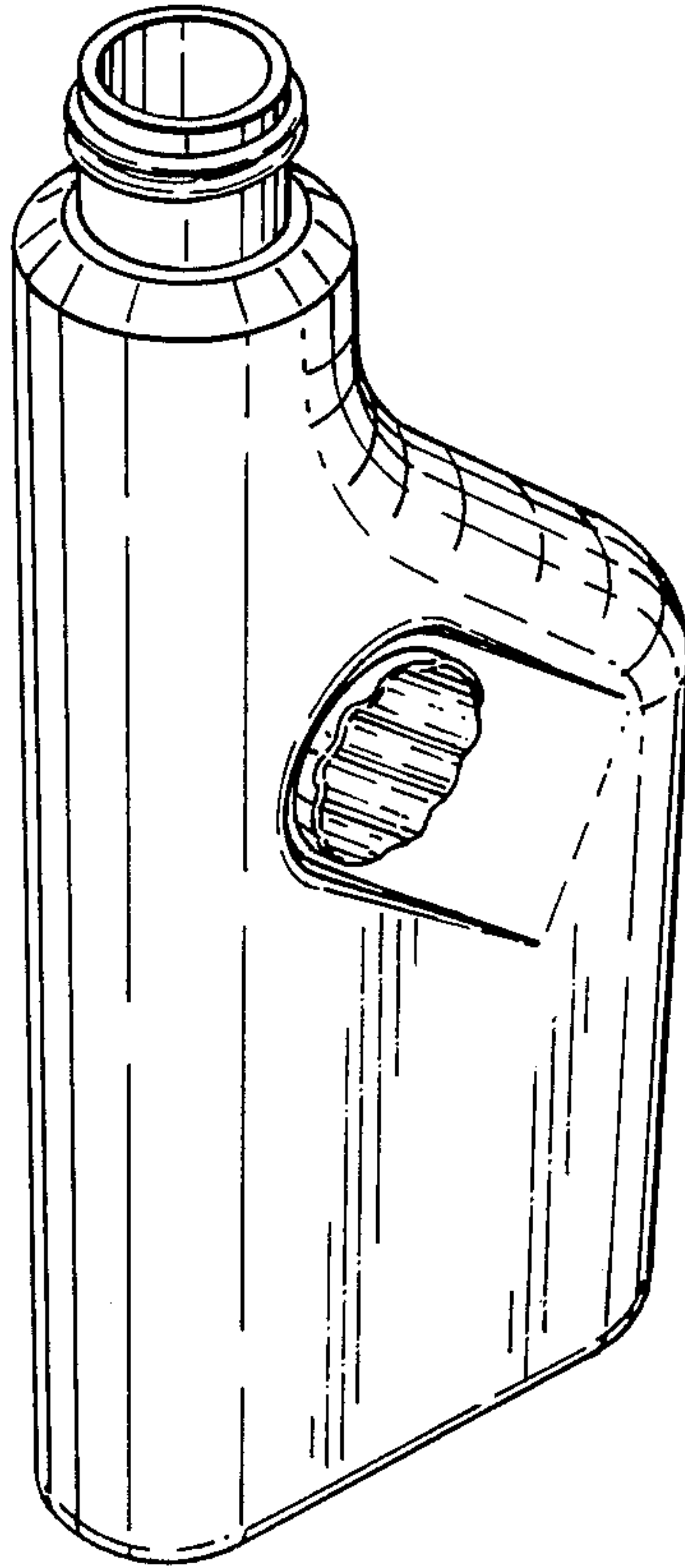

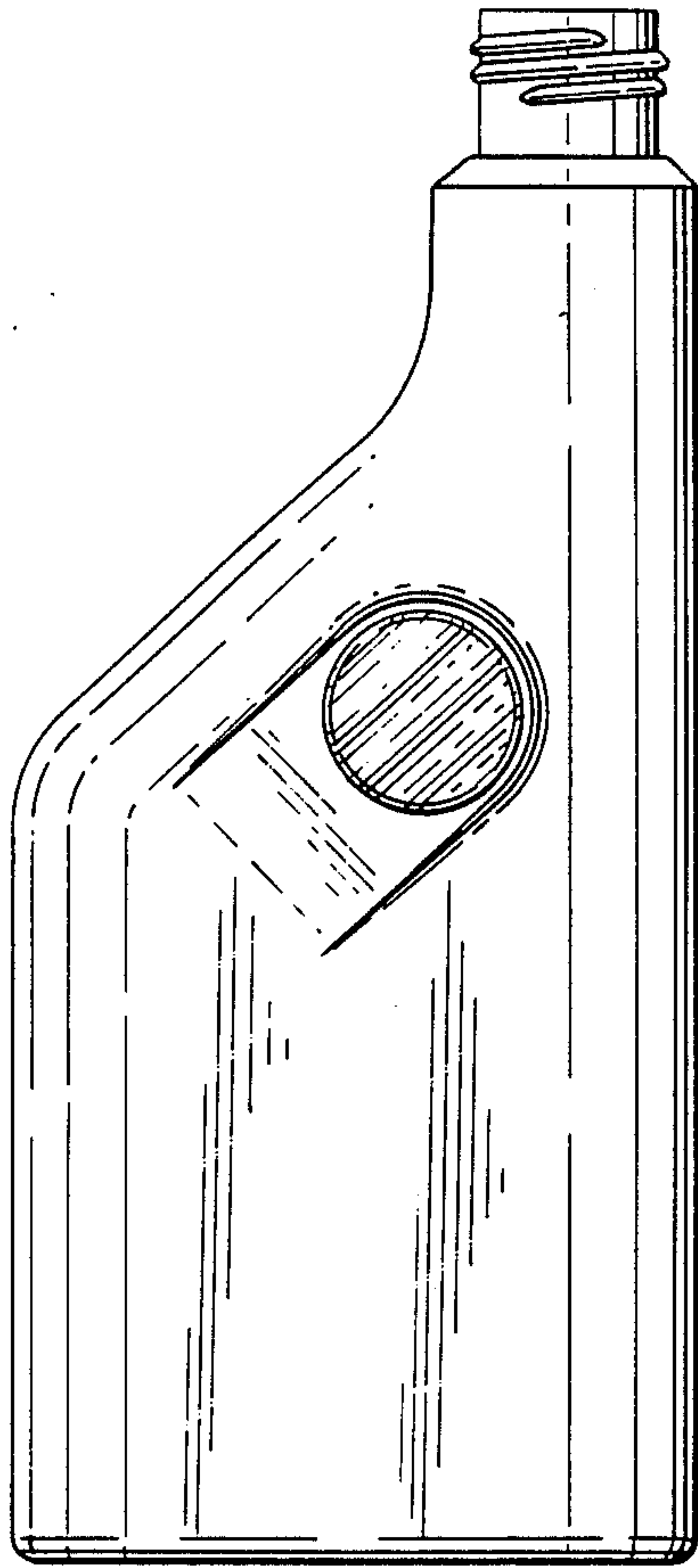

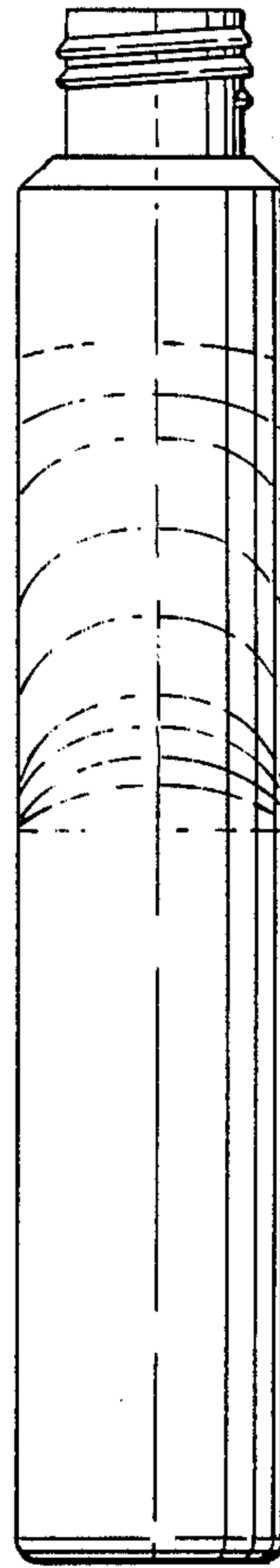
