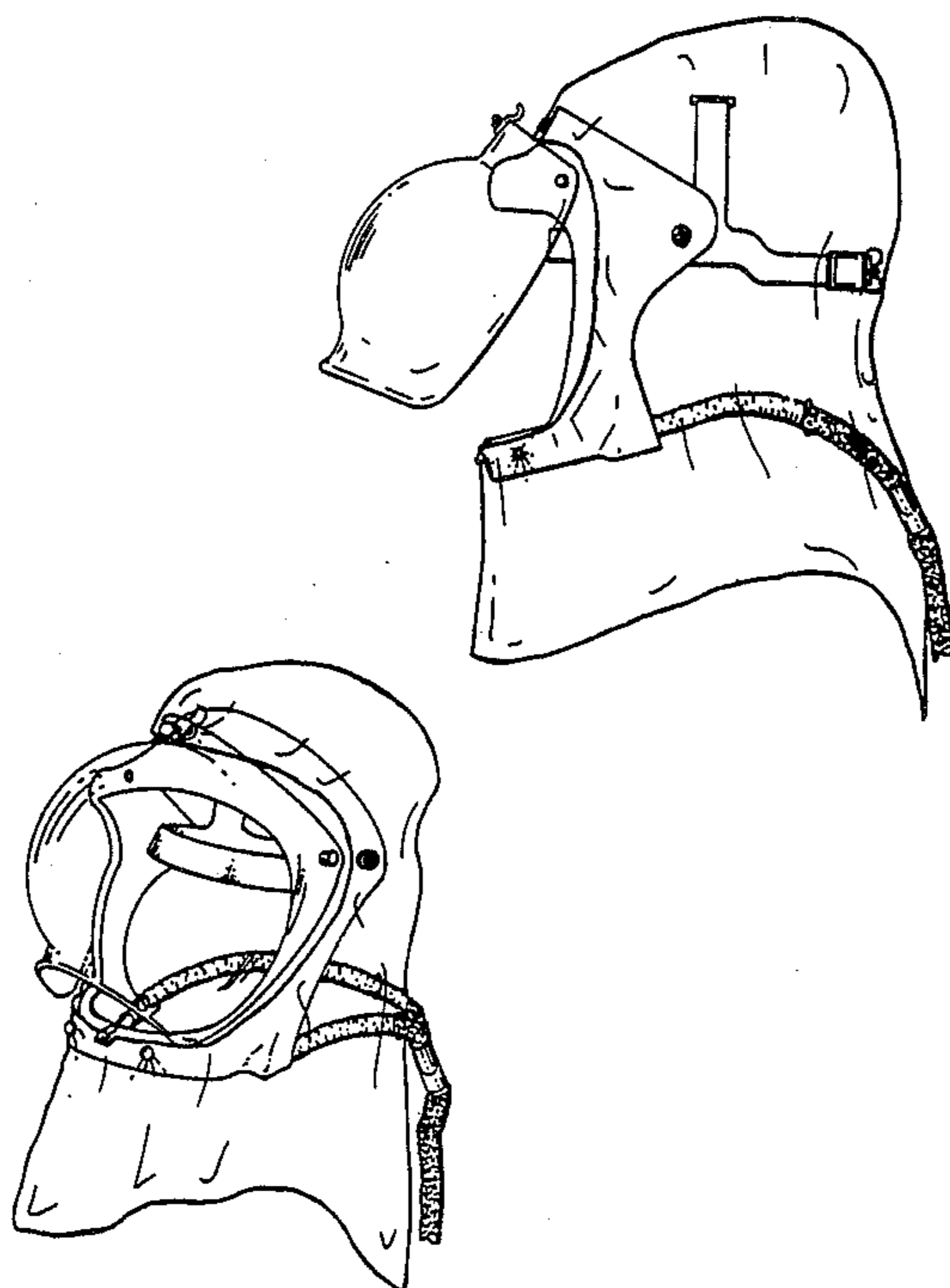

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a clean room safety hood showing our new design, the hose shown broken away for convenience of illustration; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 6 is a top plan view.



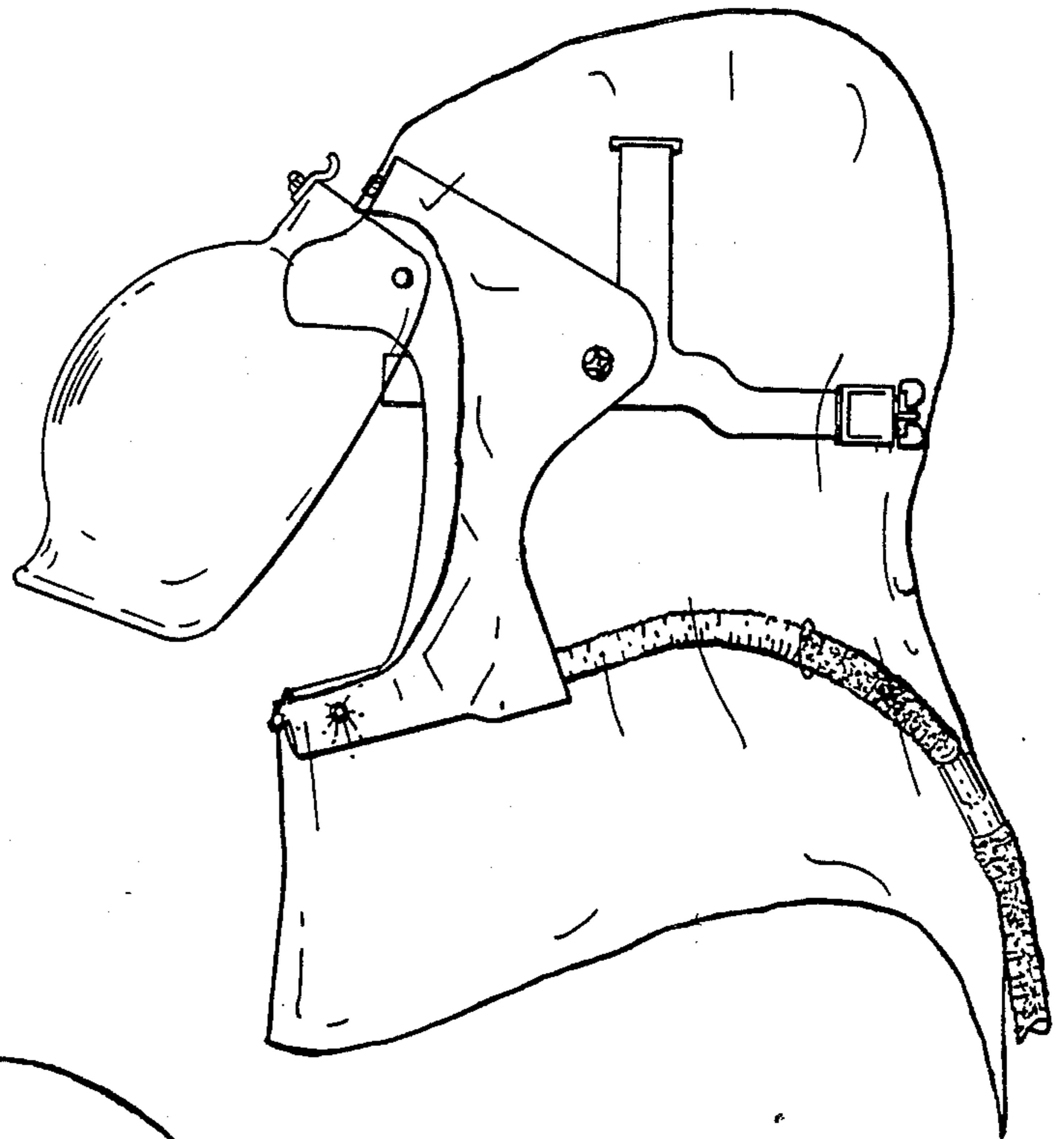

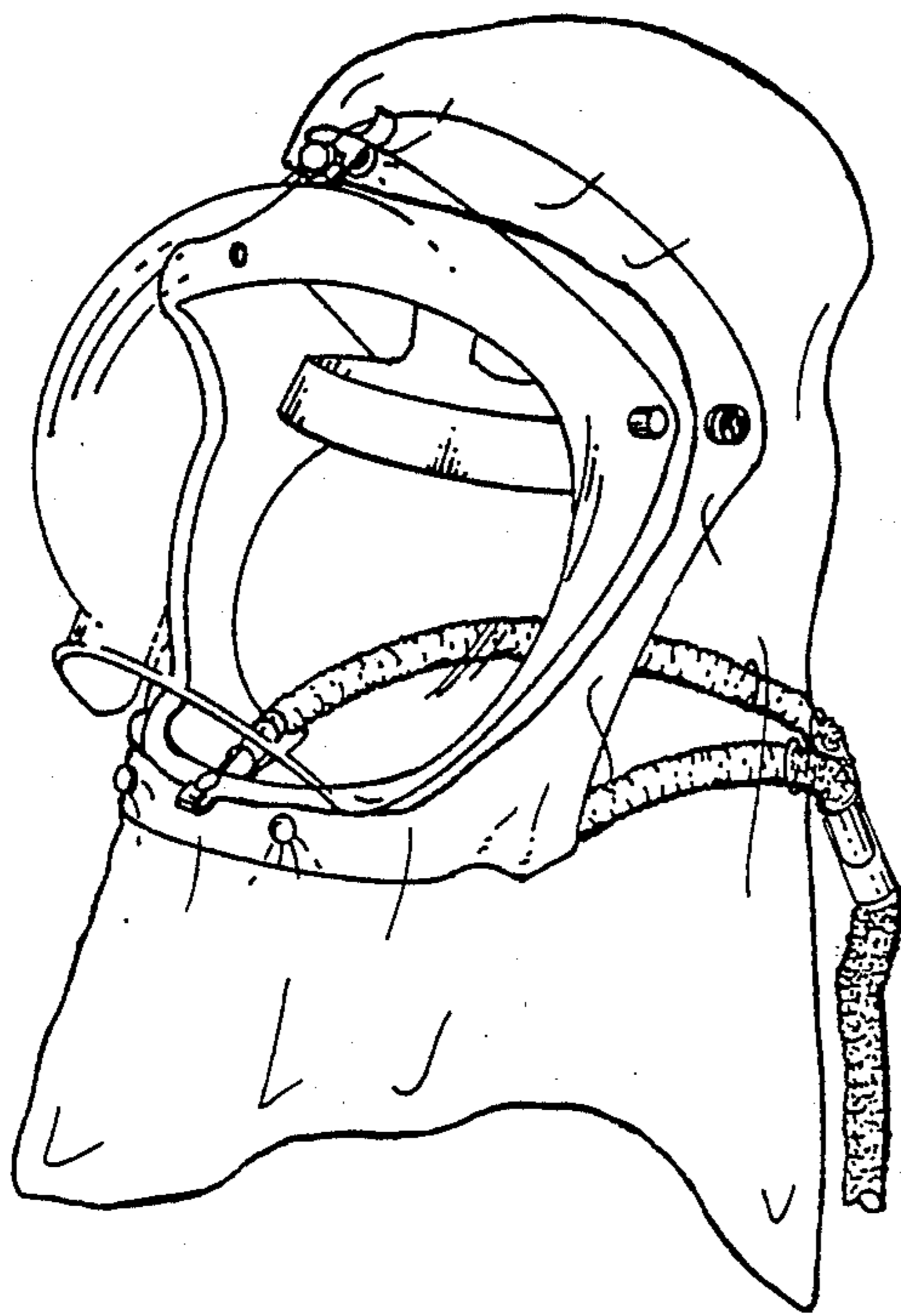

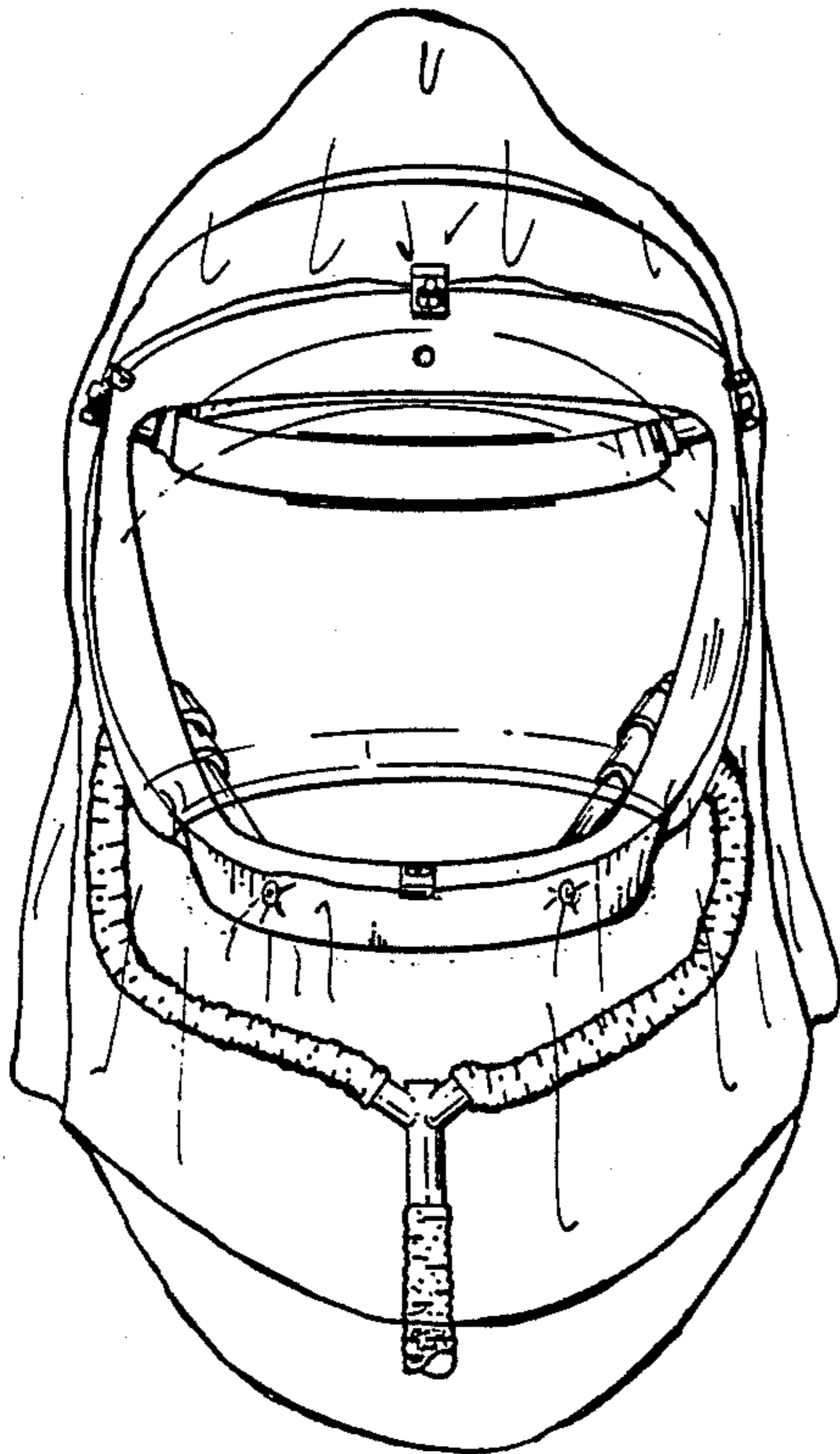

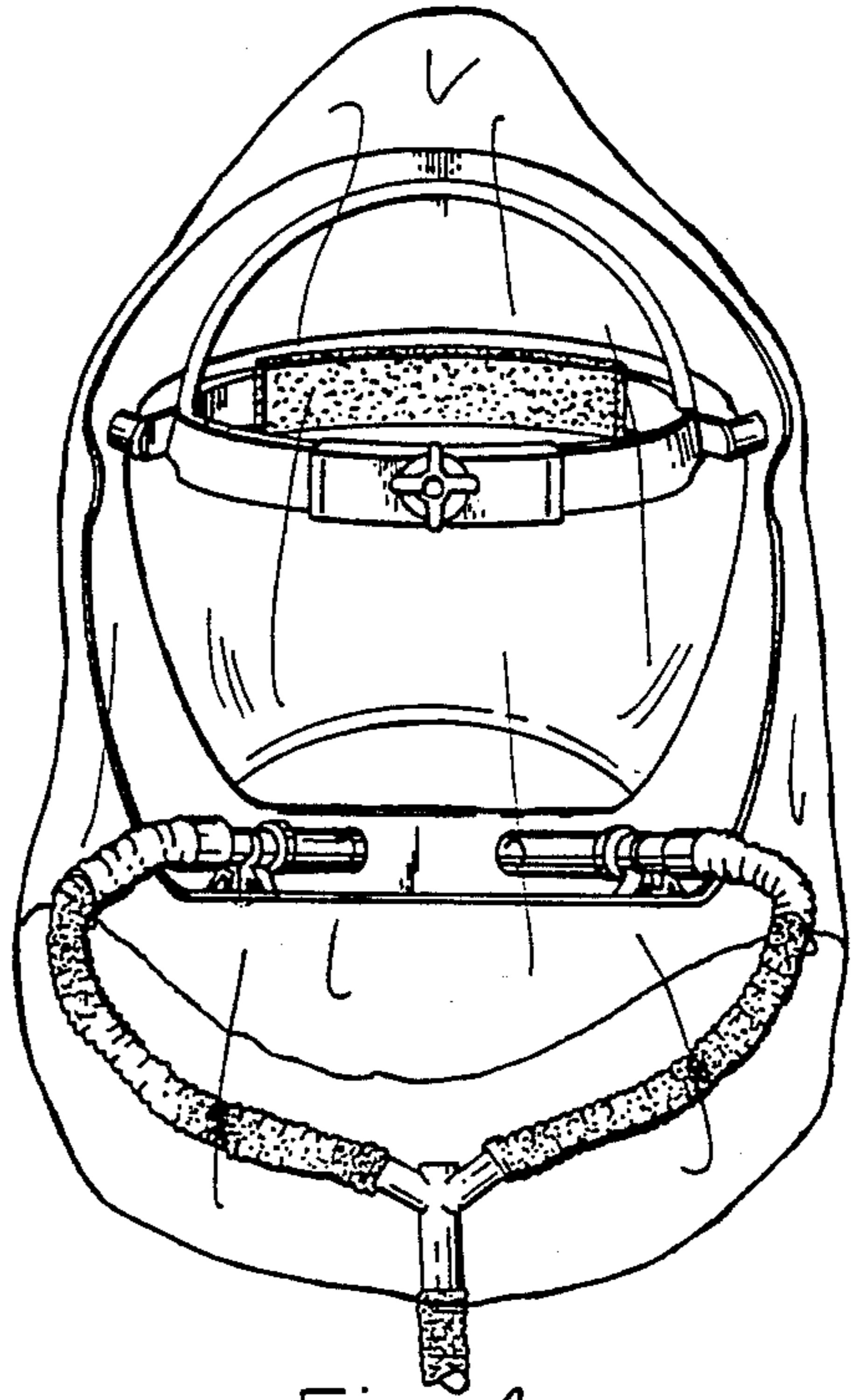

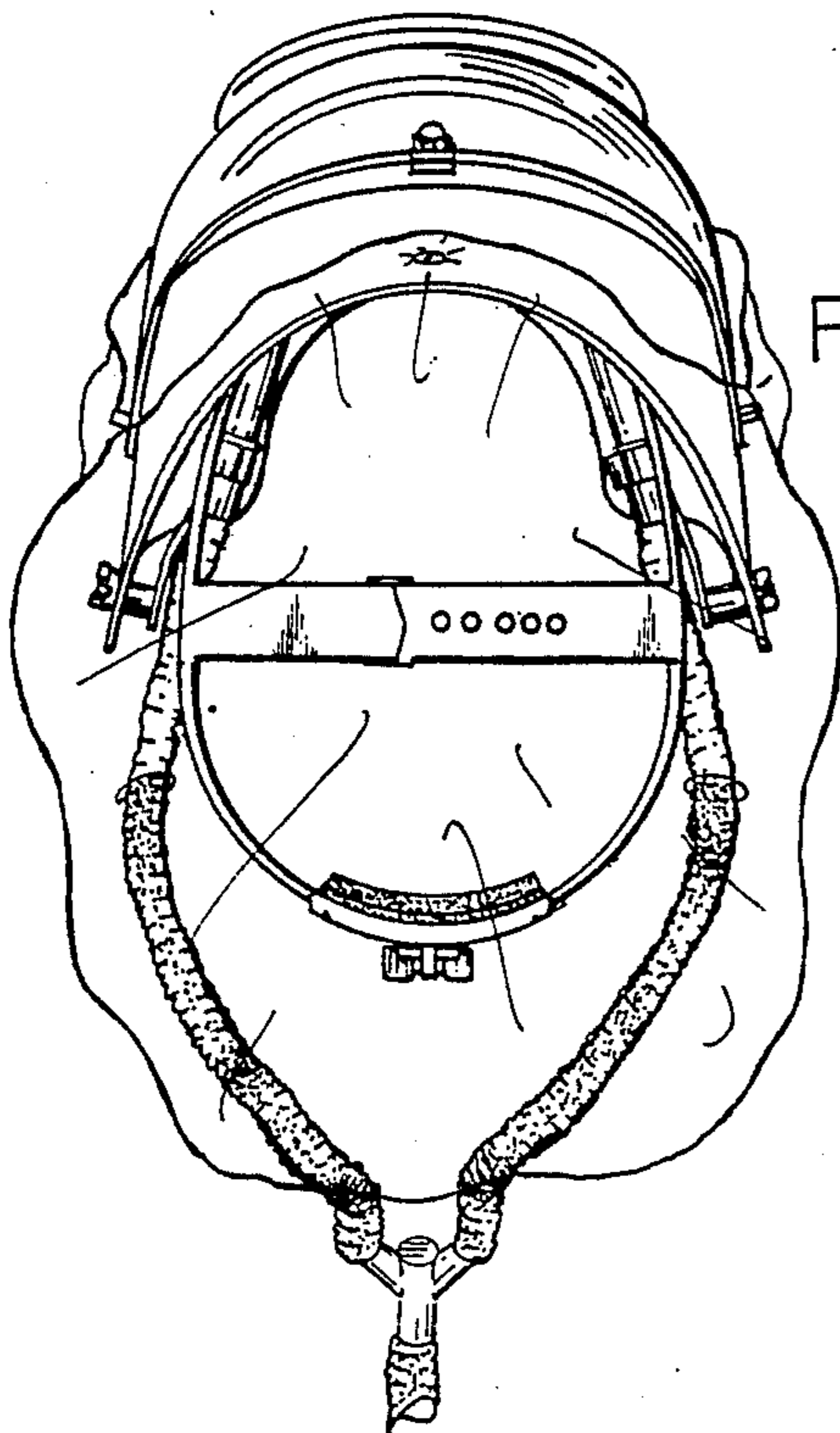

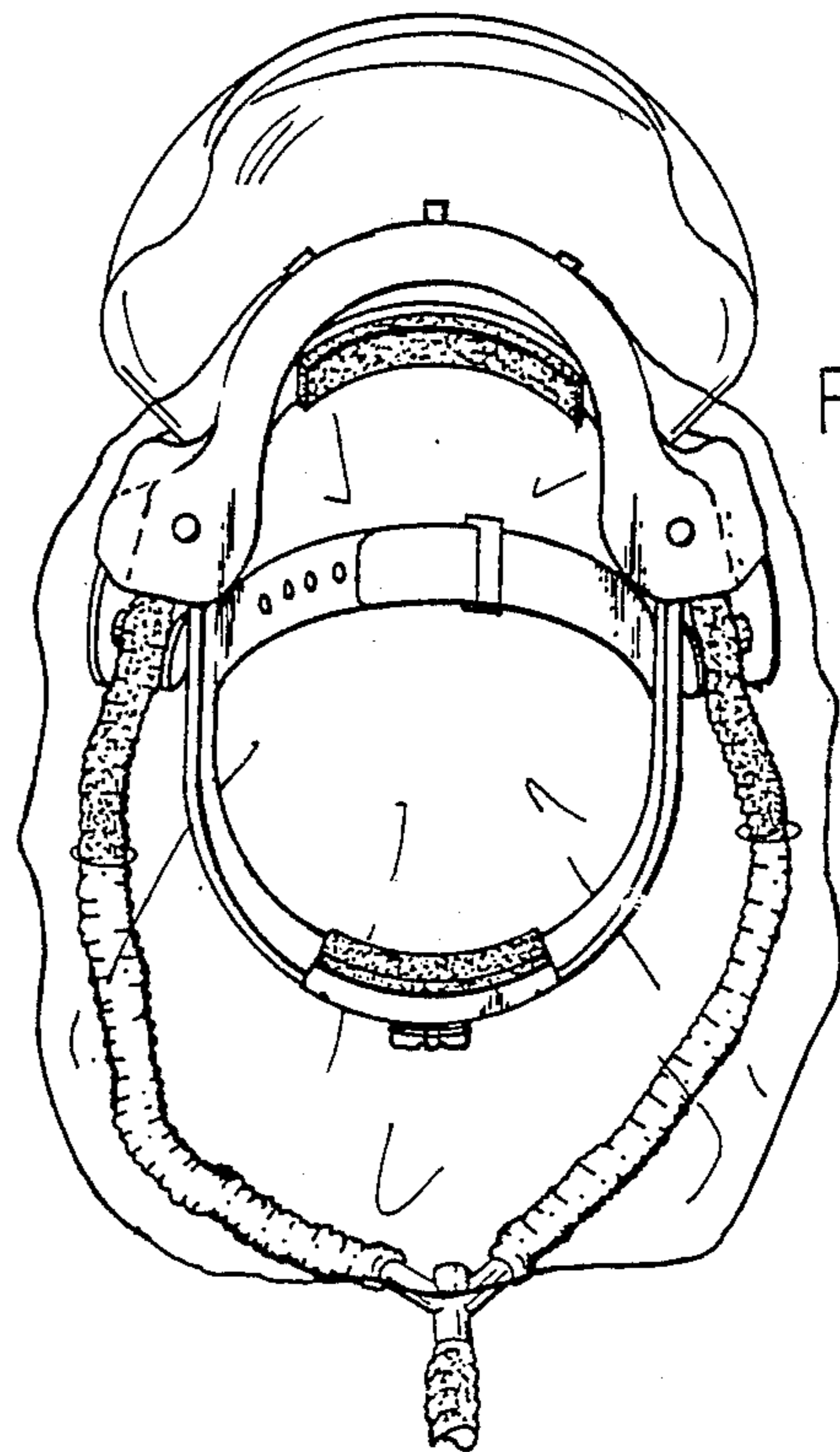
