The ornamental design for a strip of interconnected bibs, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a strip of interconnected bibs showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image.

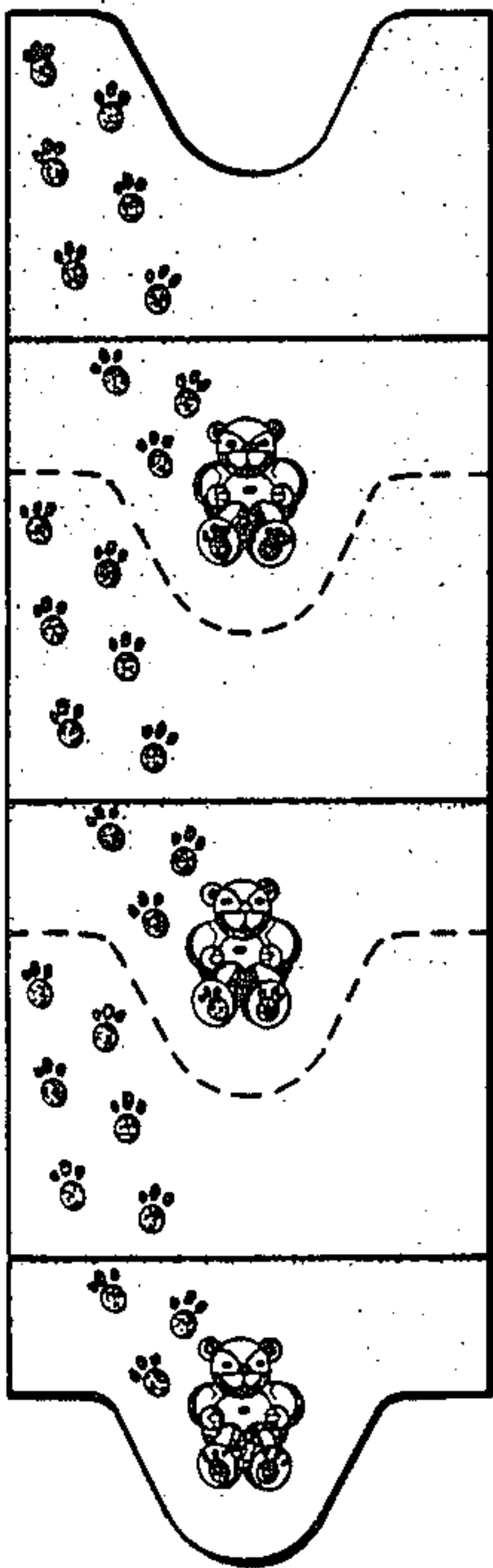

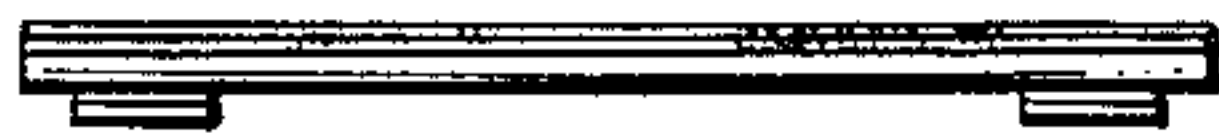
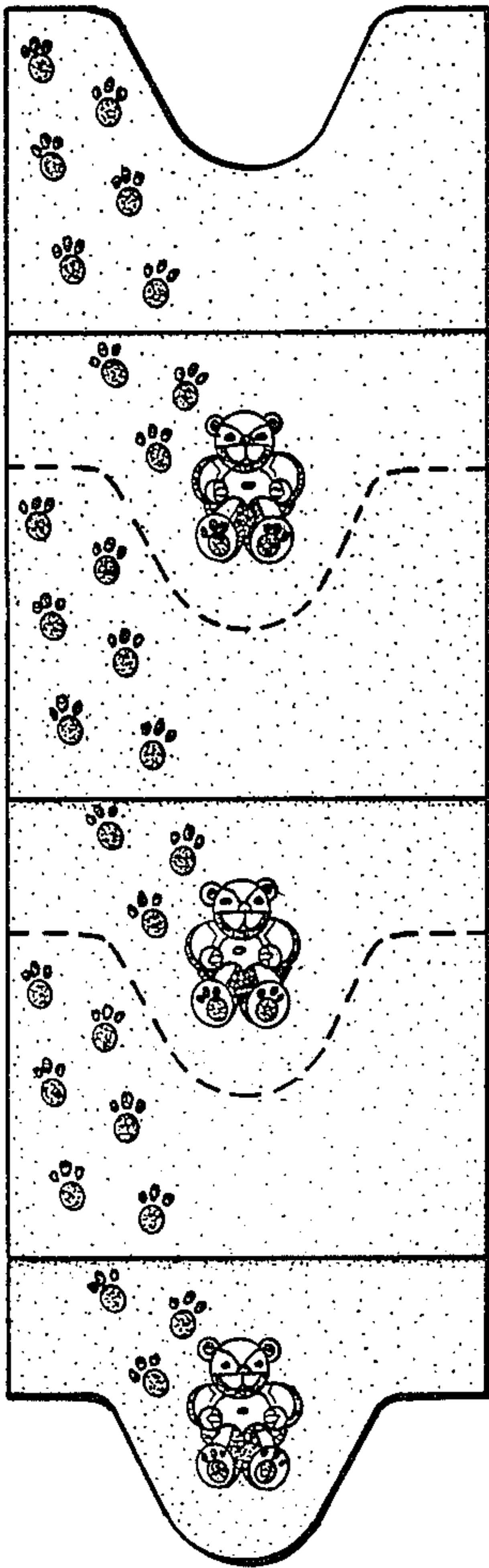

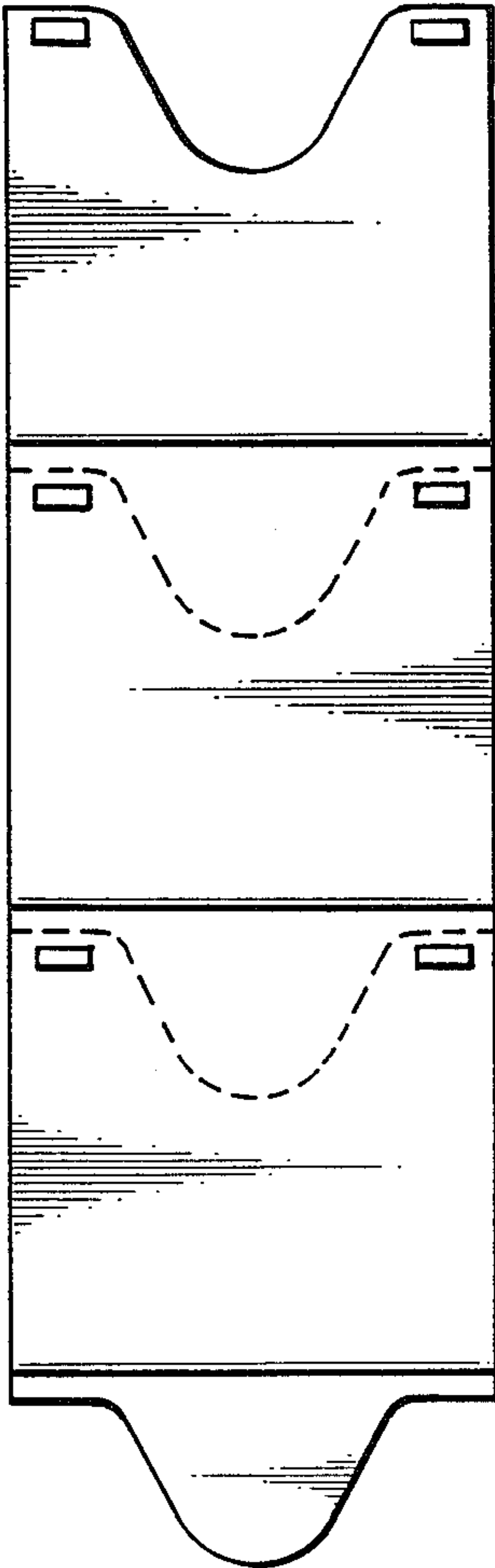
