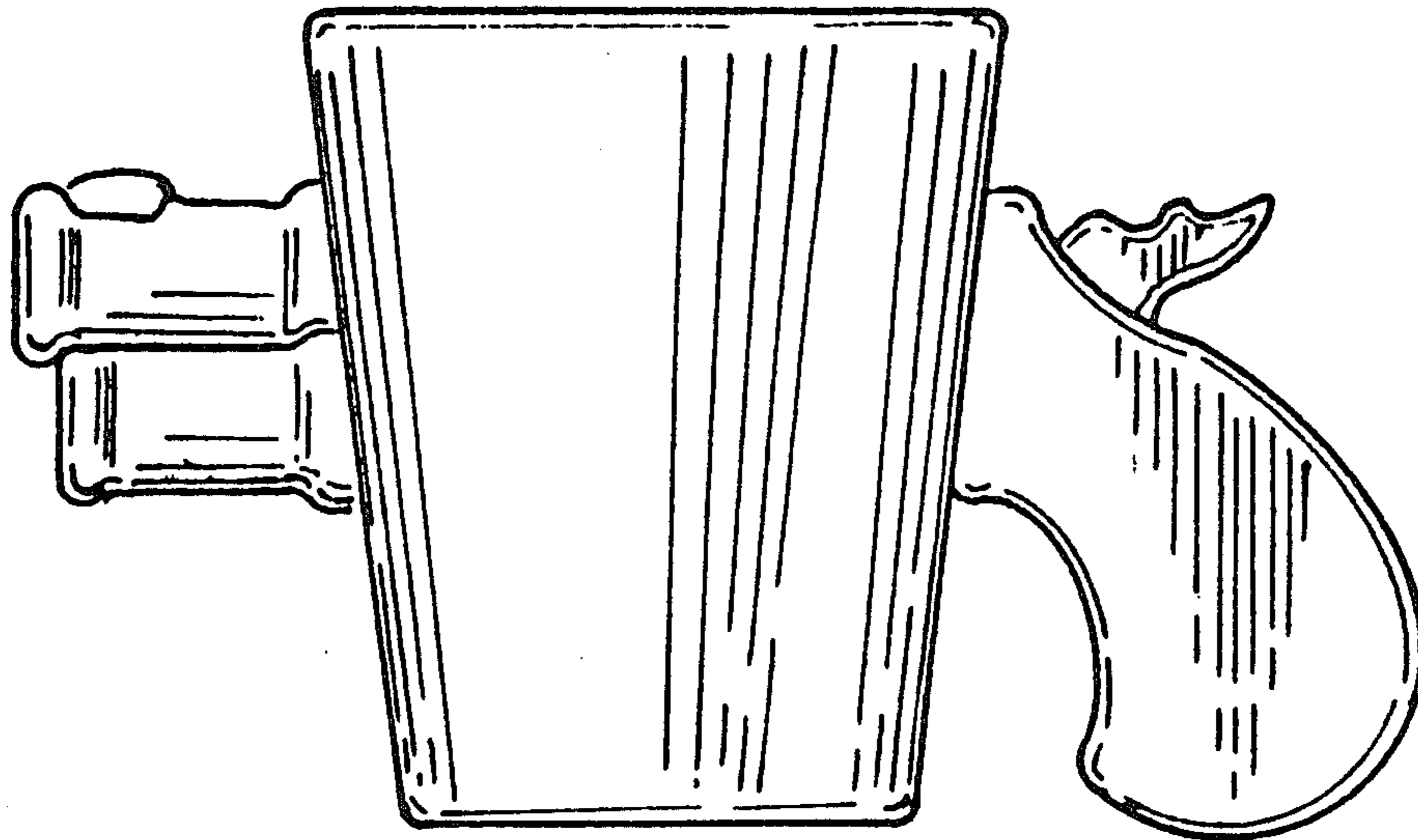

The ornamental design for a tumbler or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a tumbler or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view is a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.



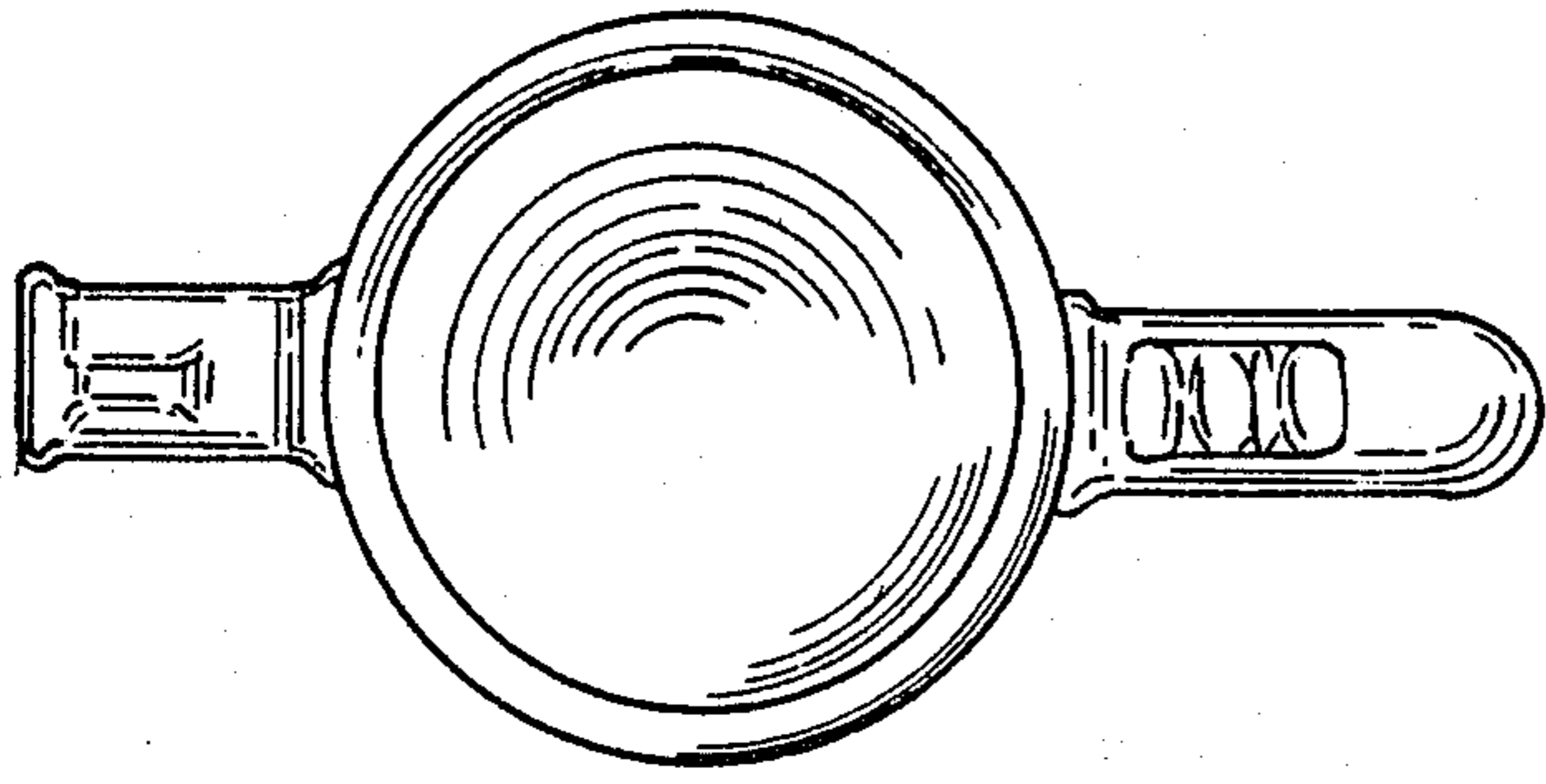

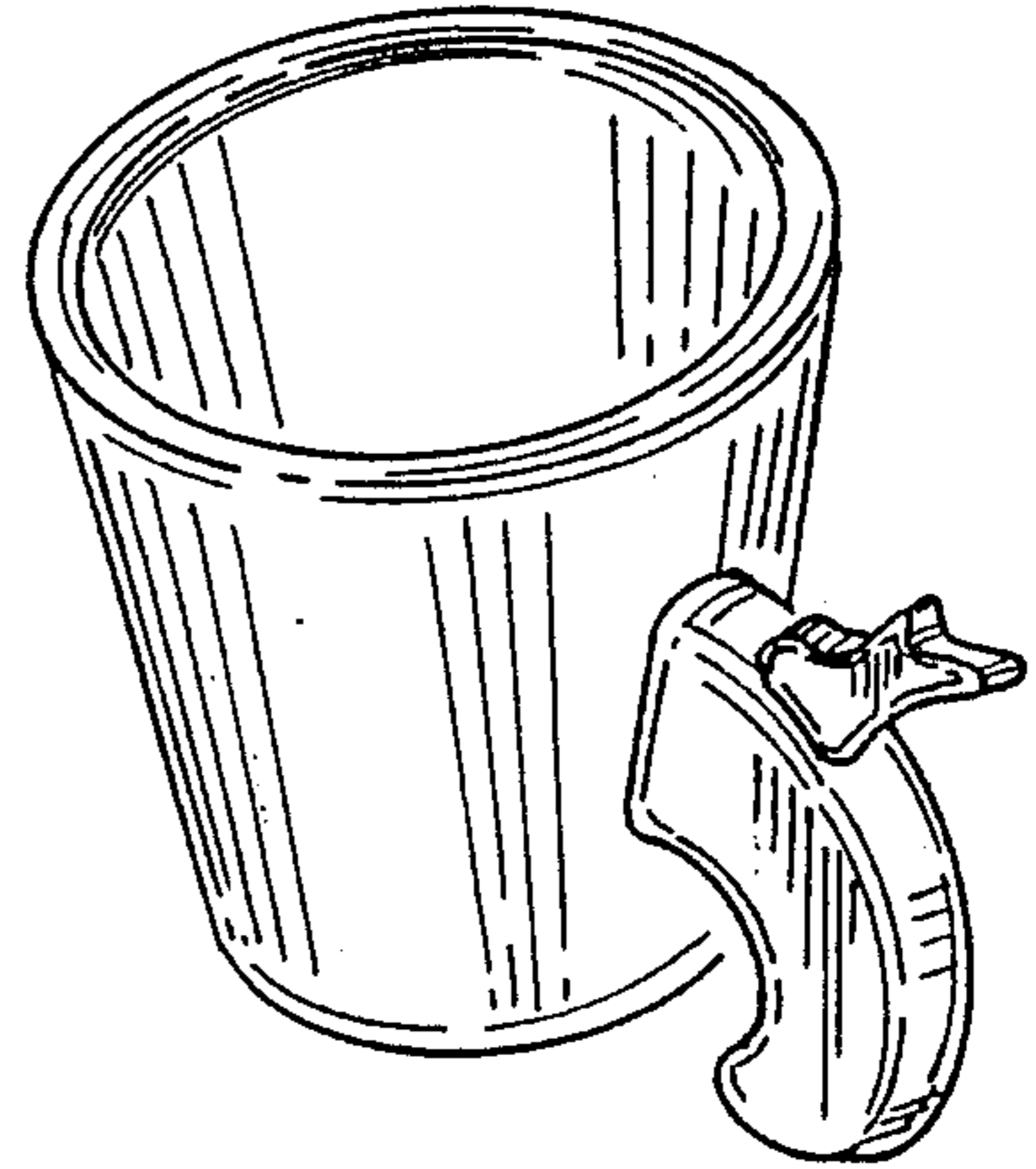

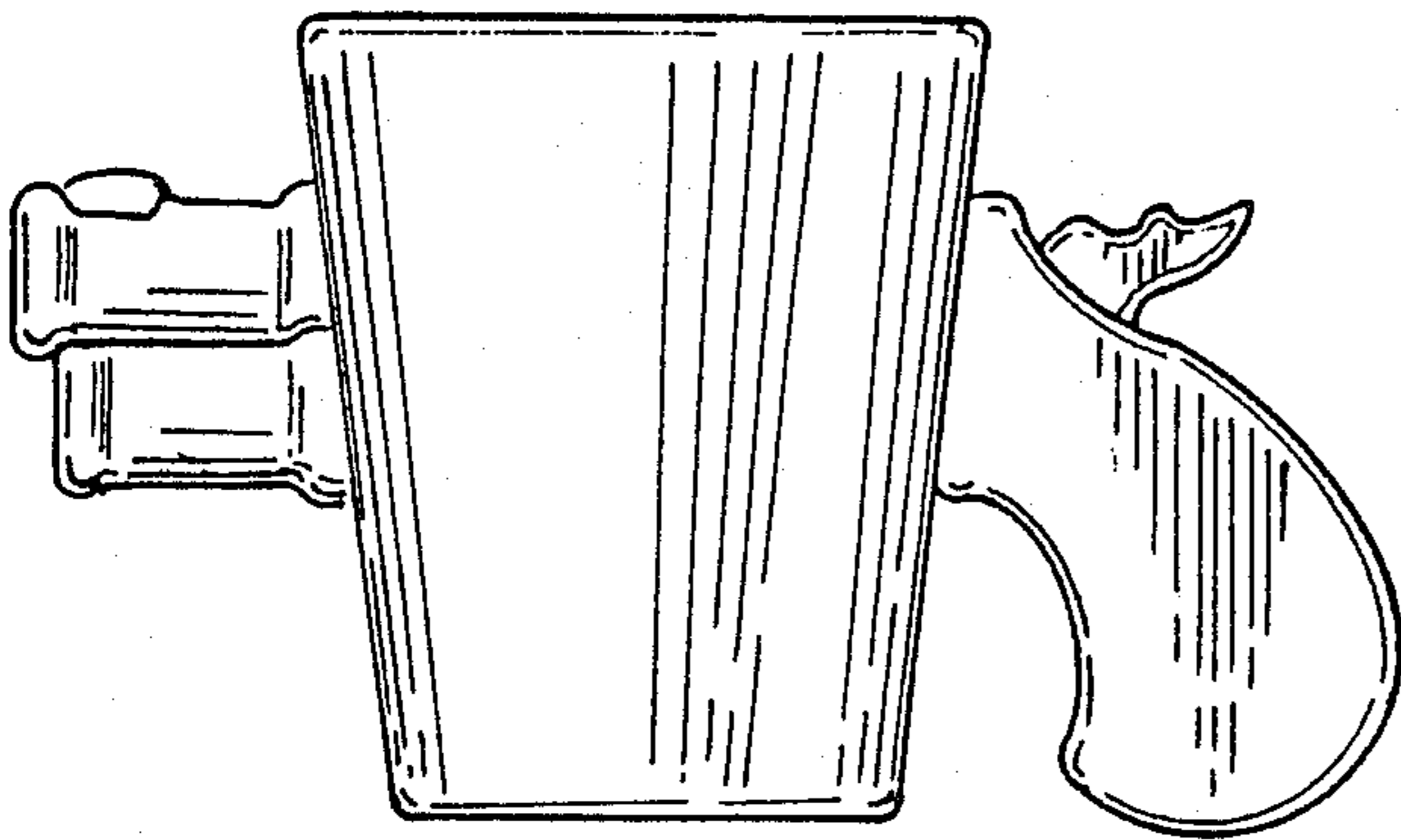

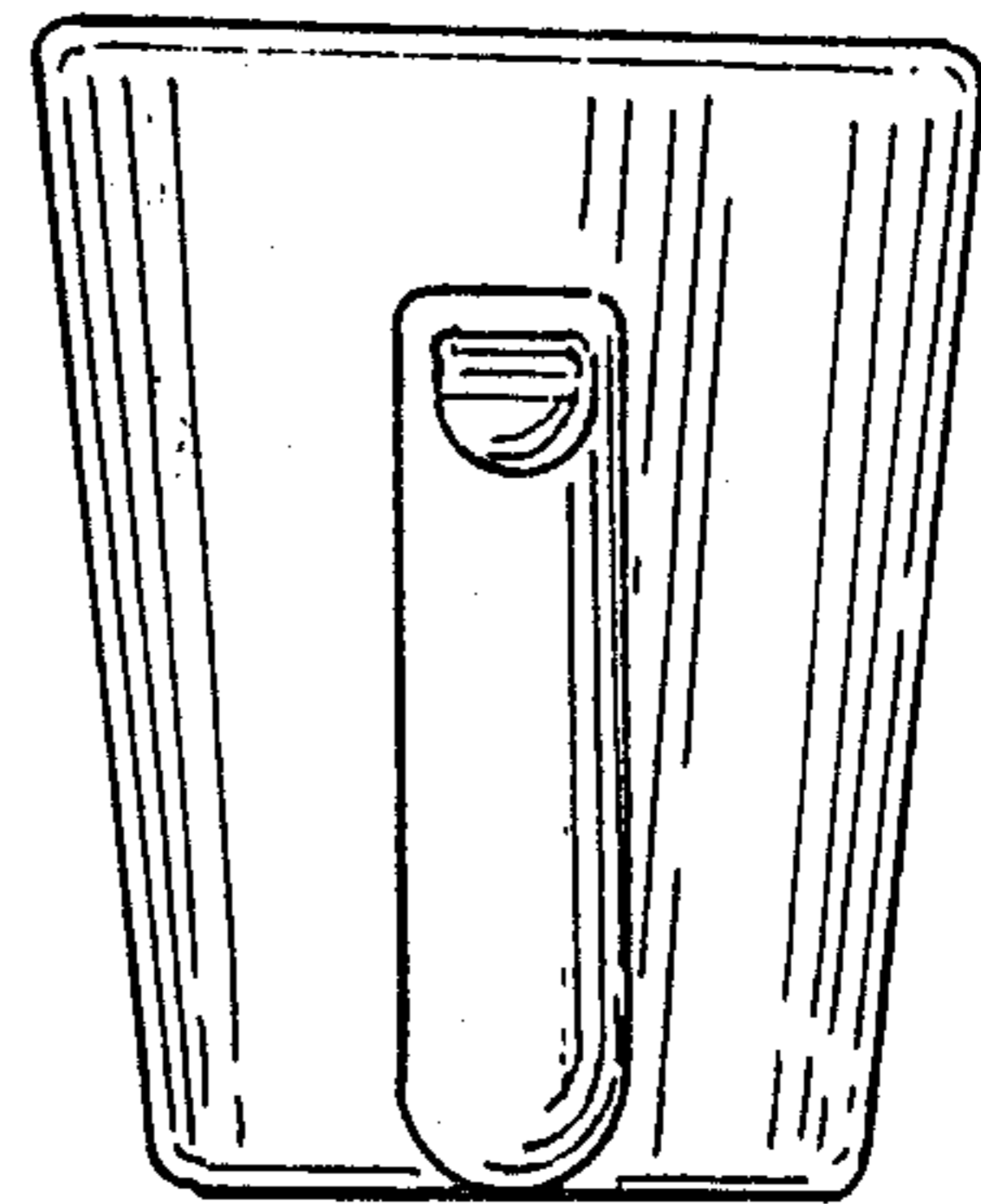

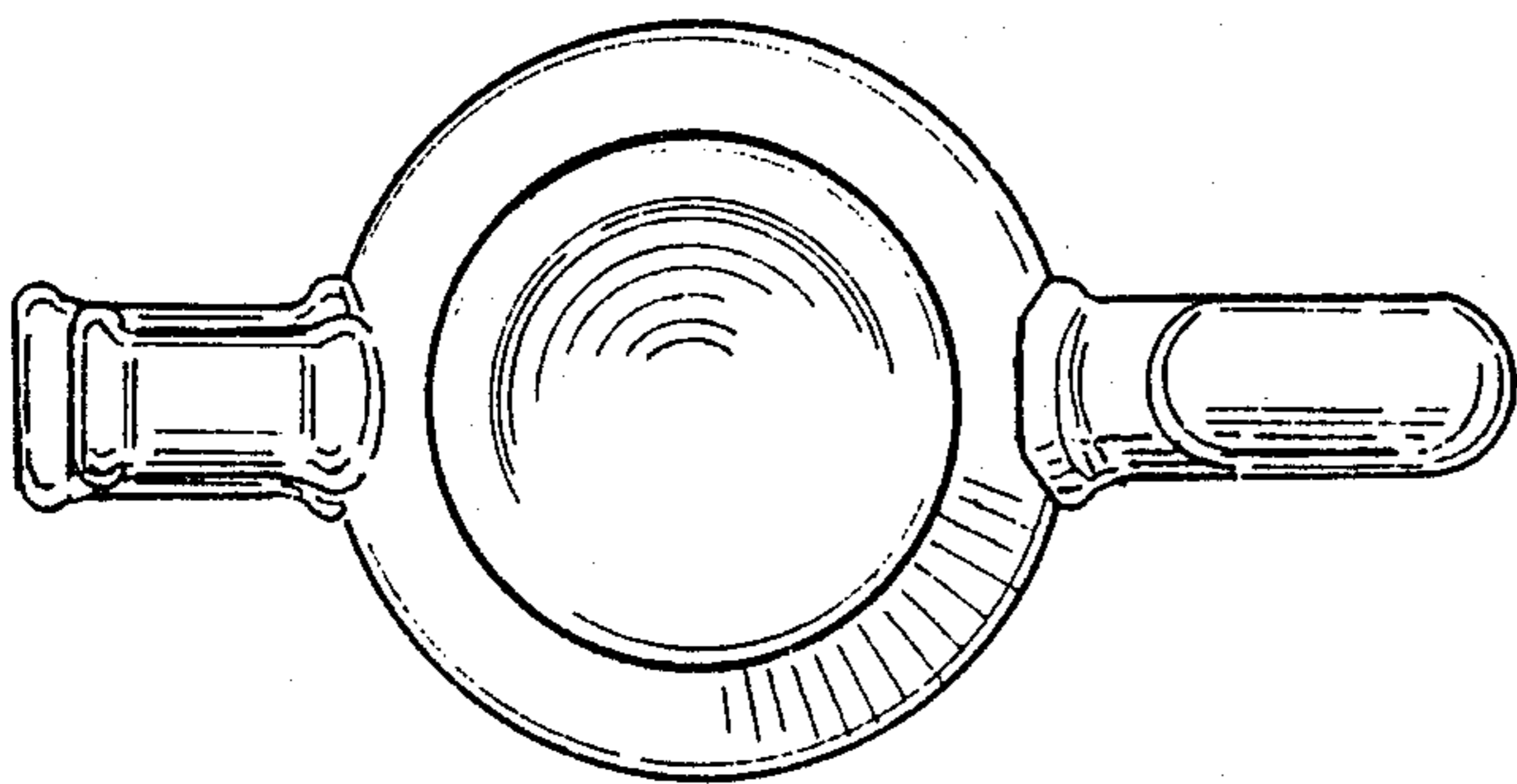

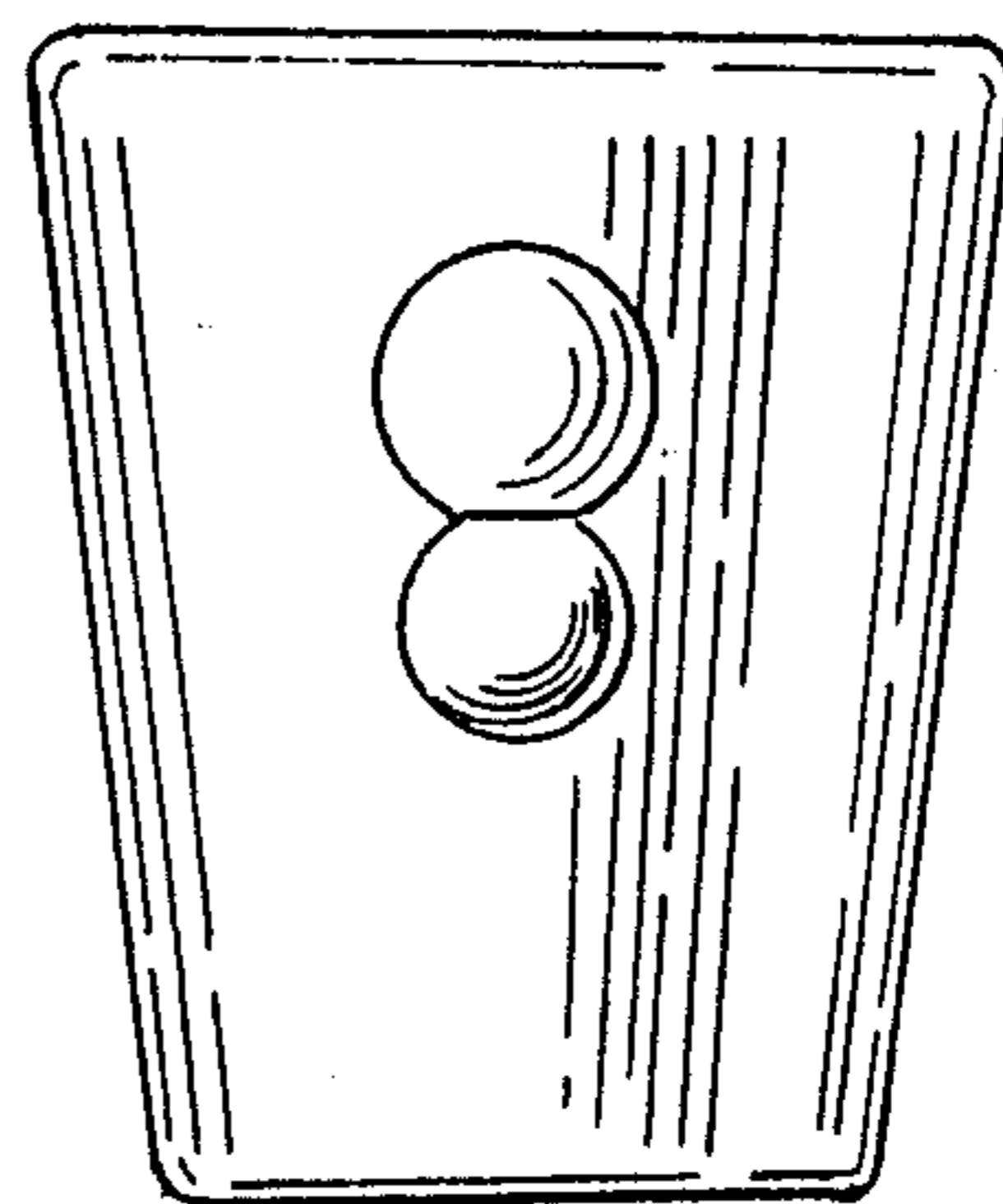
