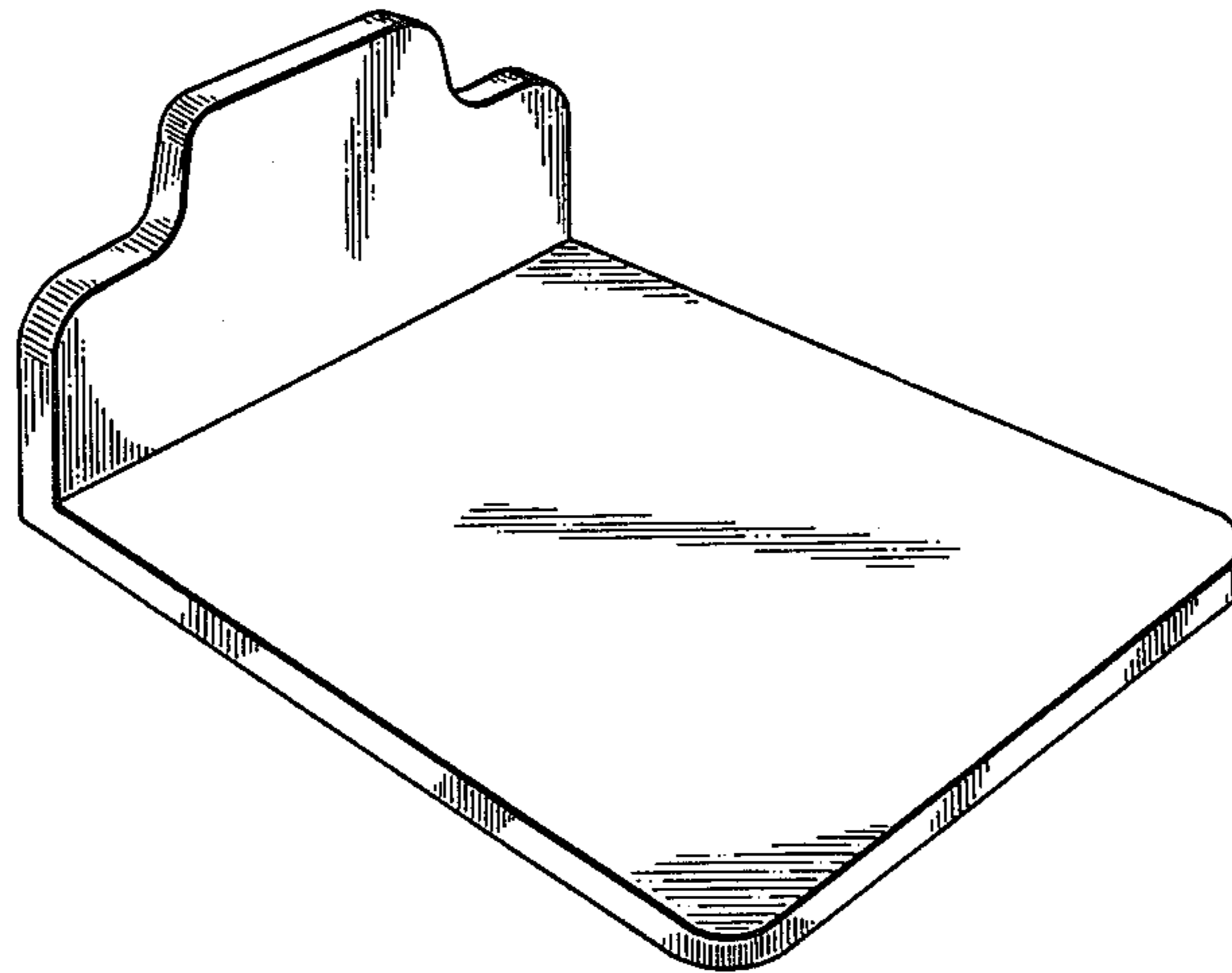

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a cutting board showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, it being understood that the right side elevational view is a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



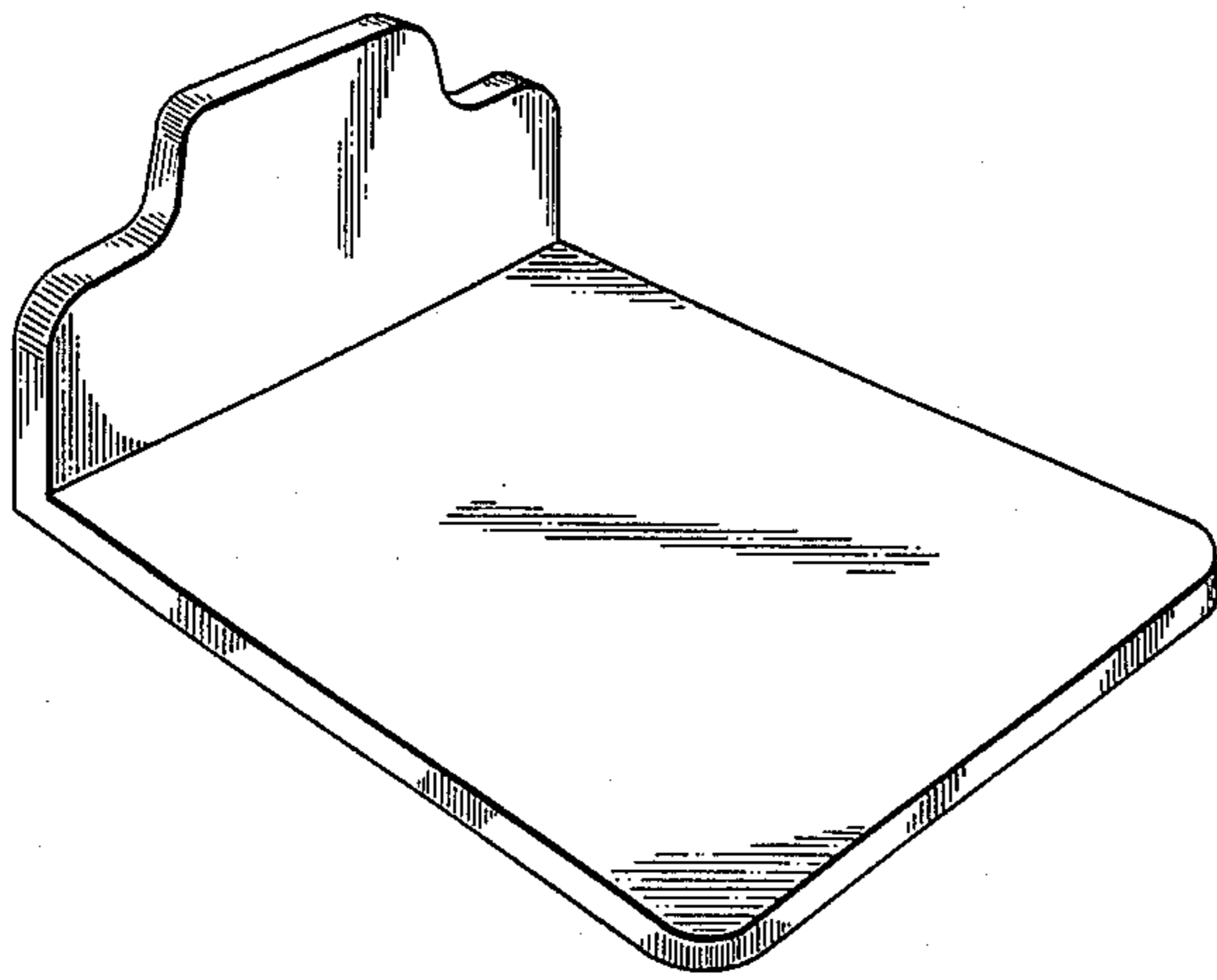

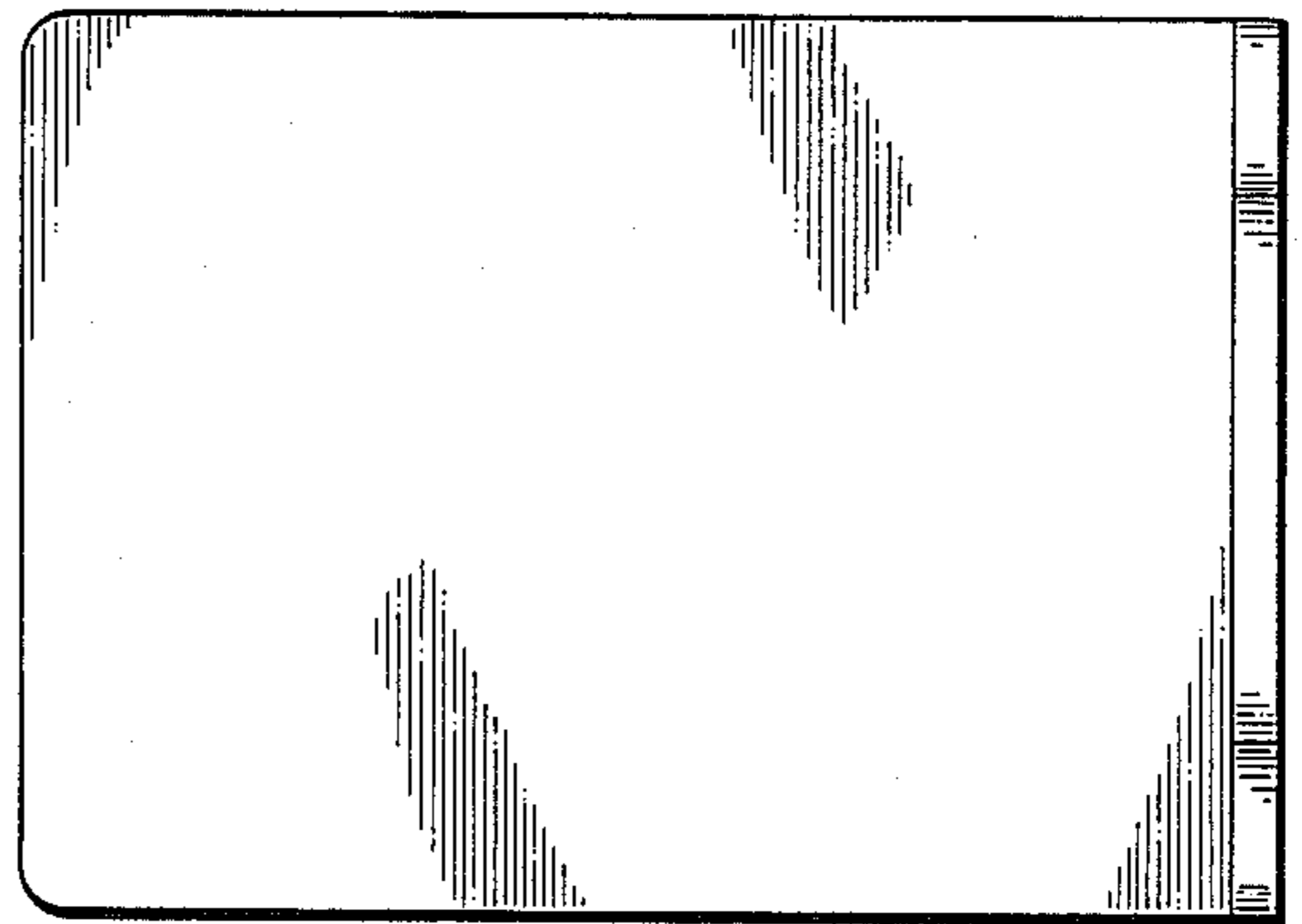

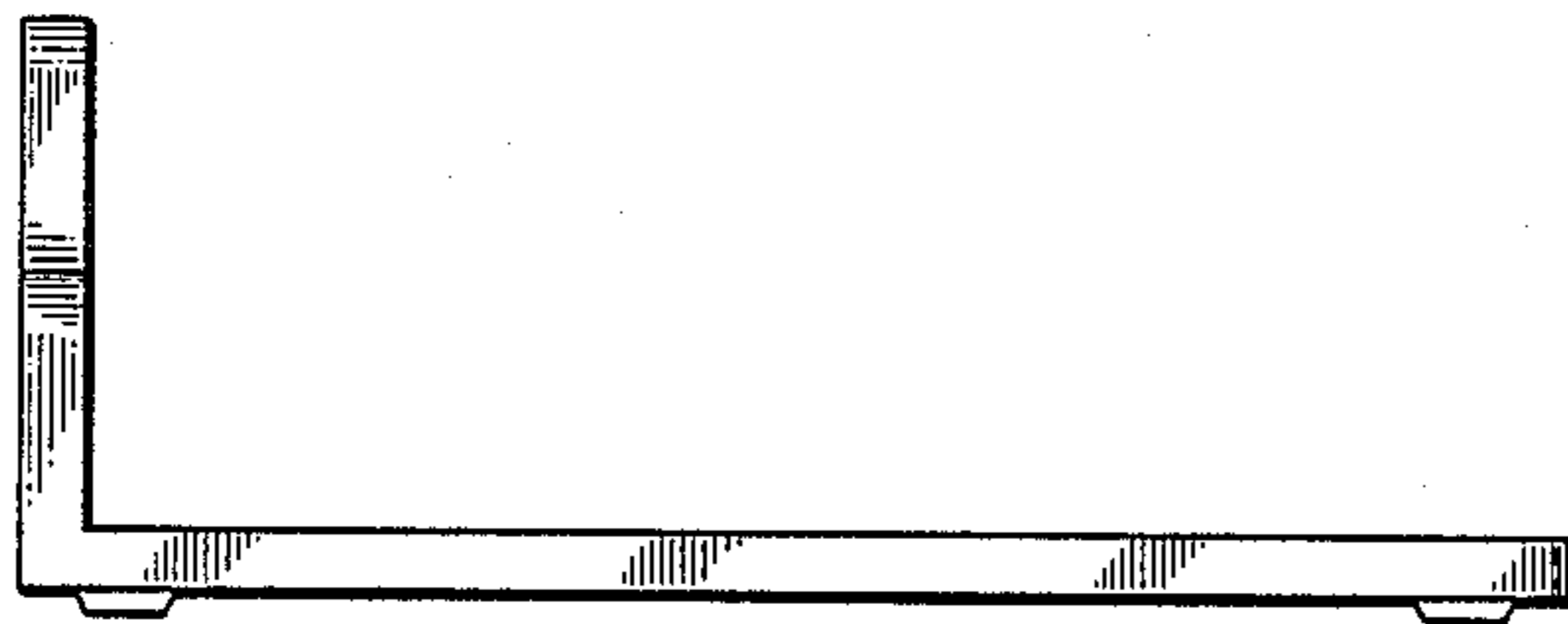

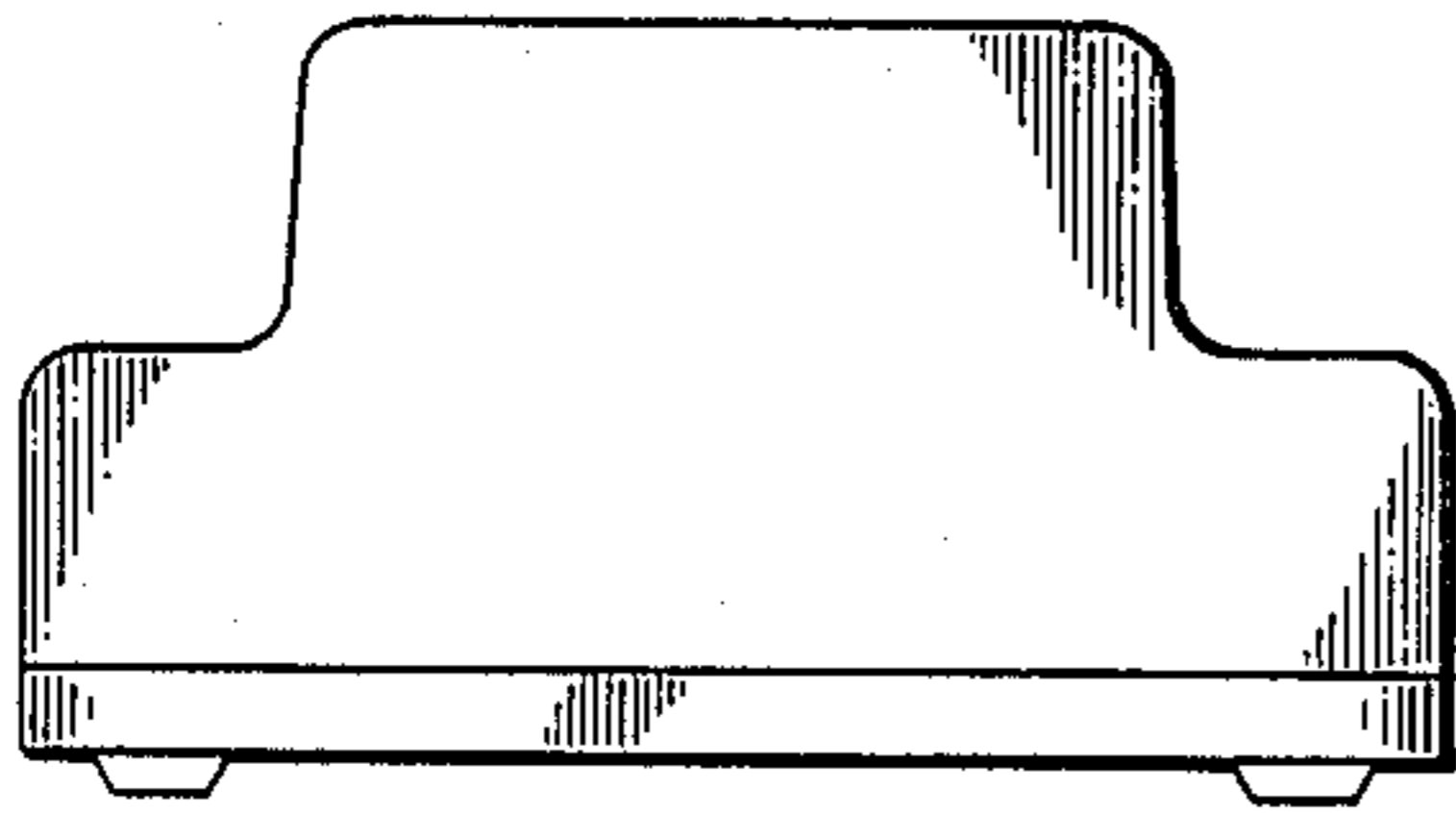

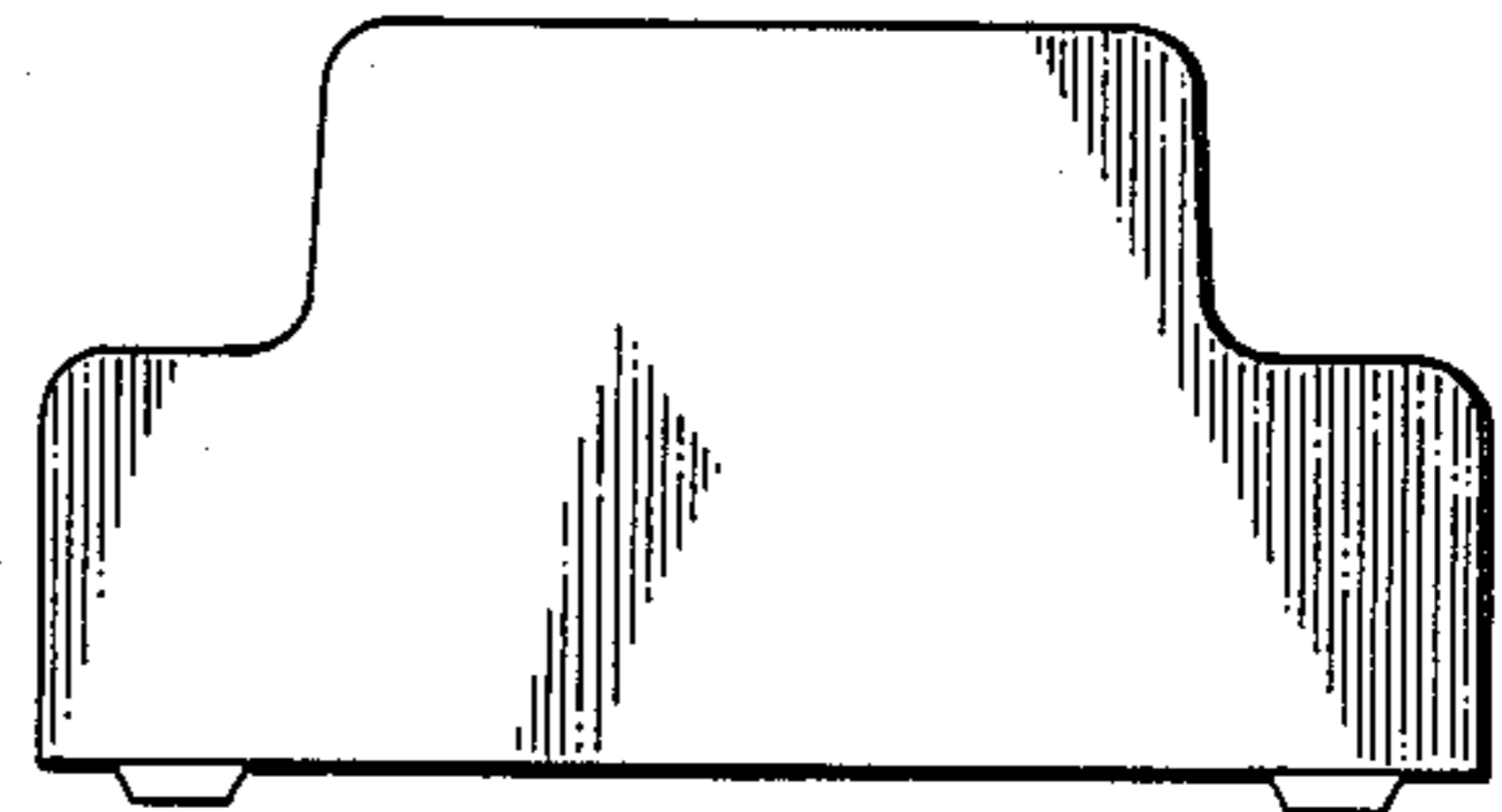

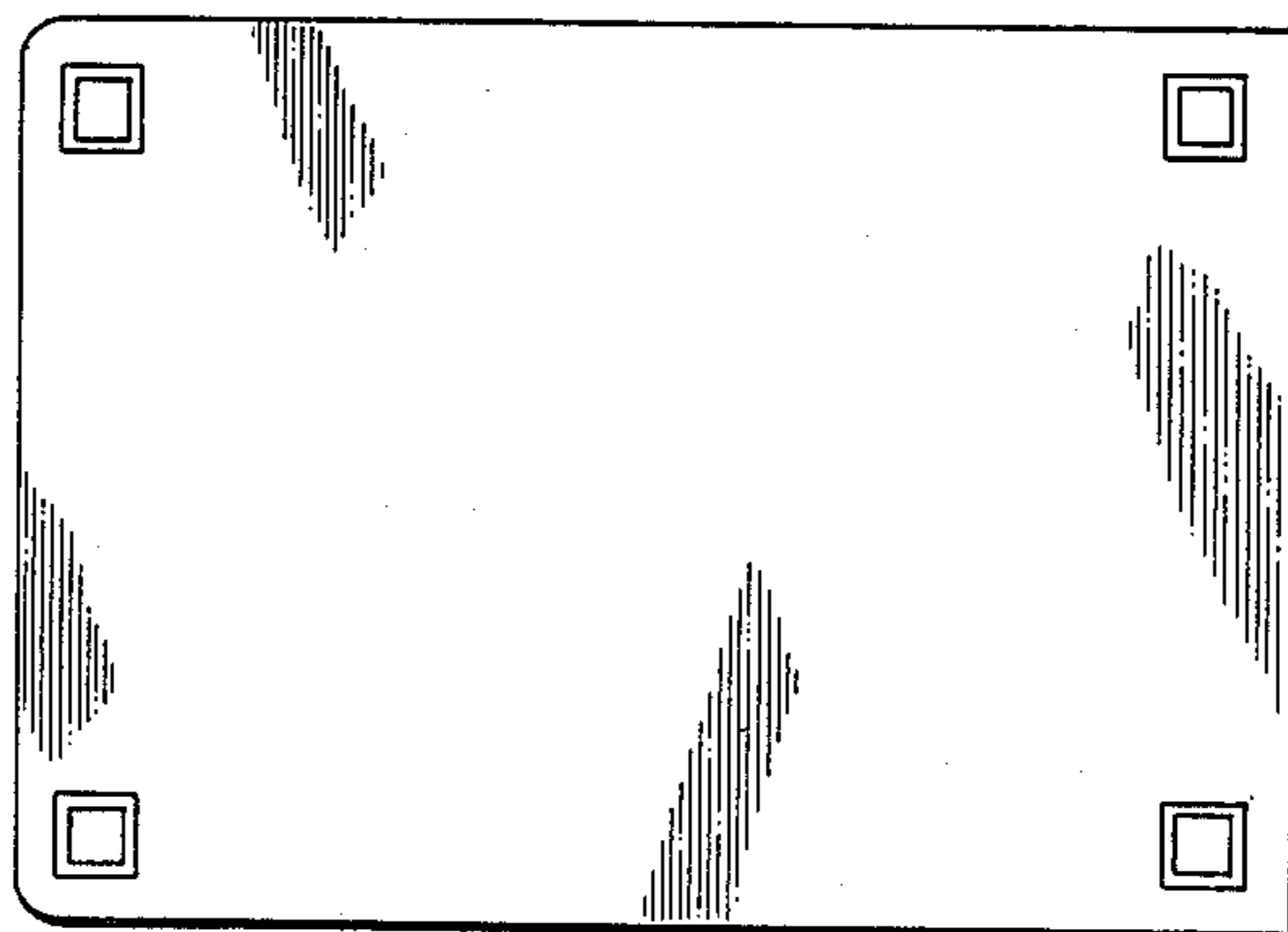
