DESCRIPTION

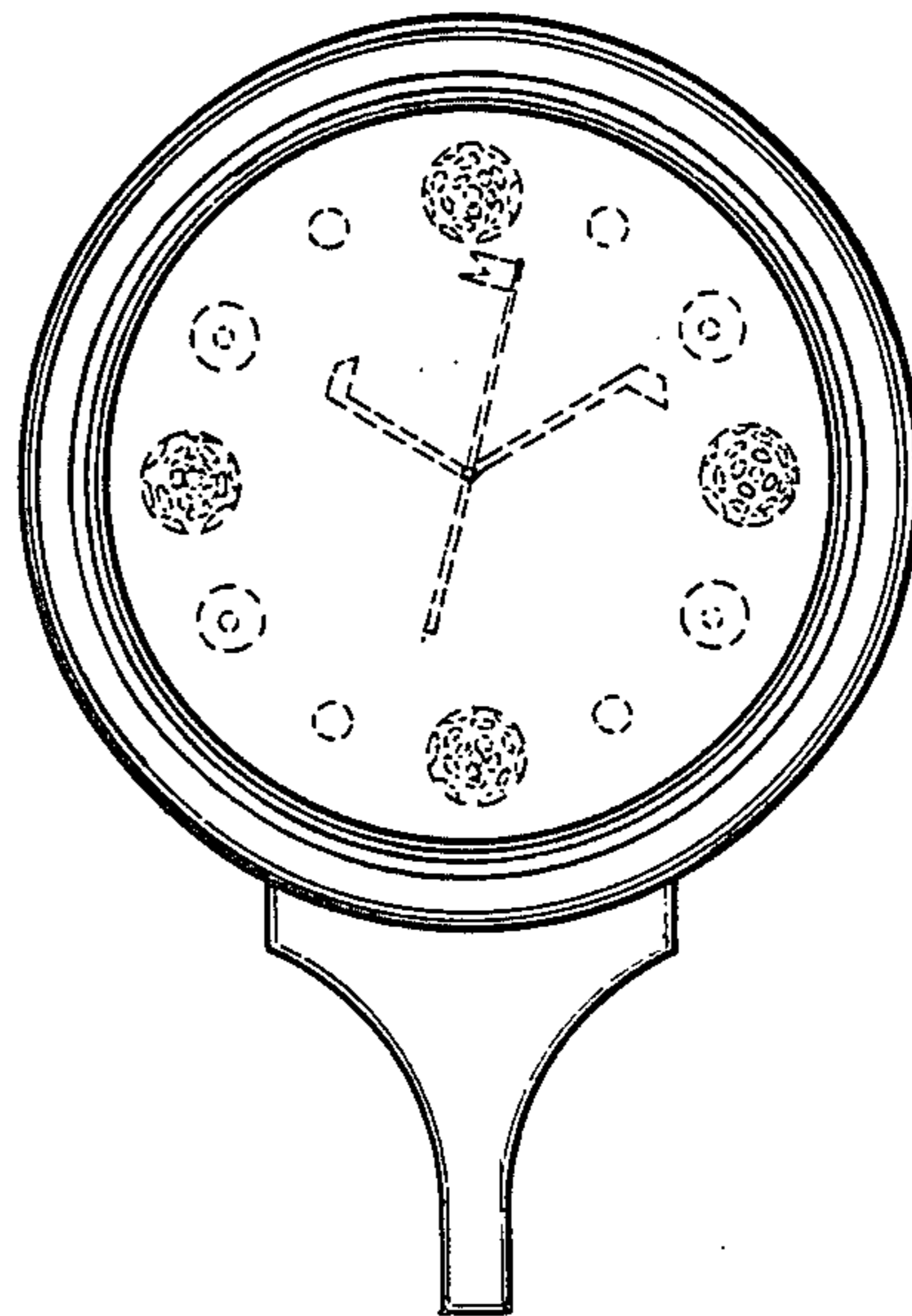
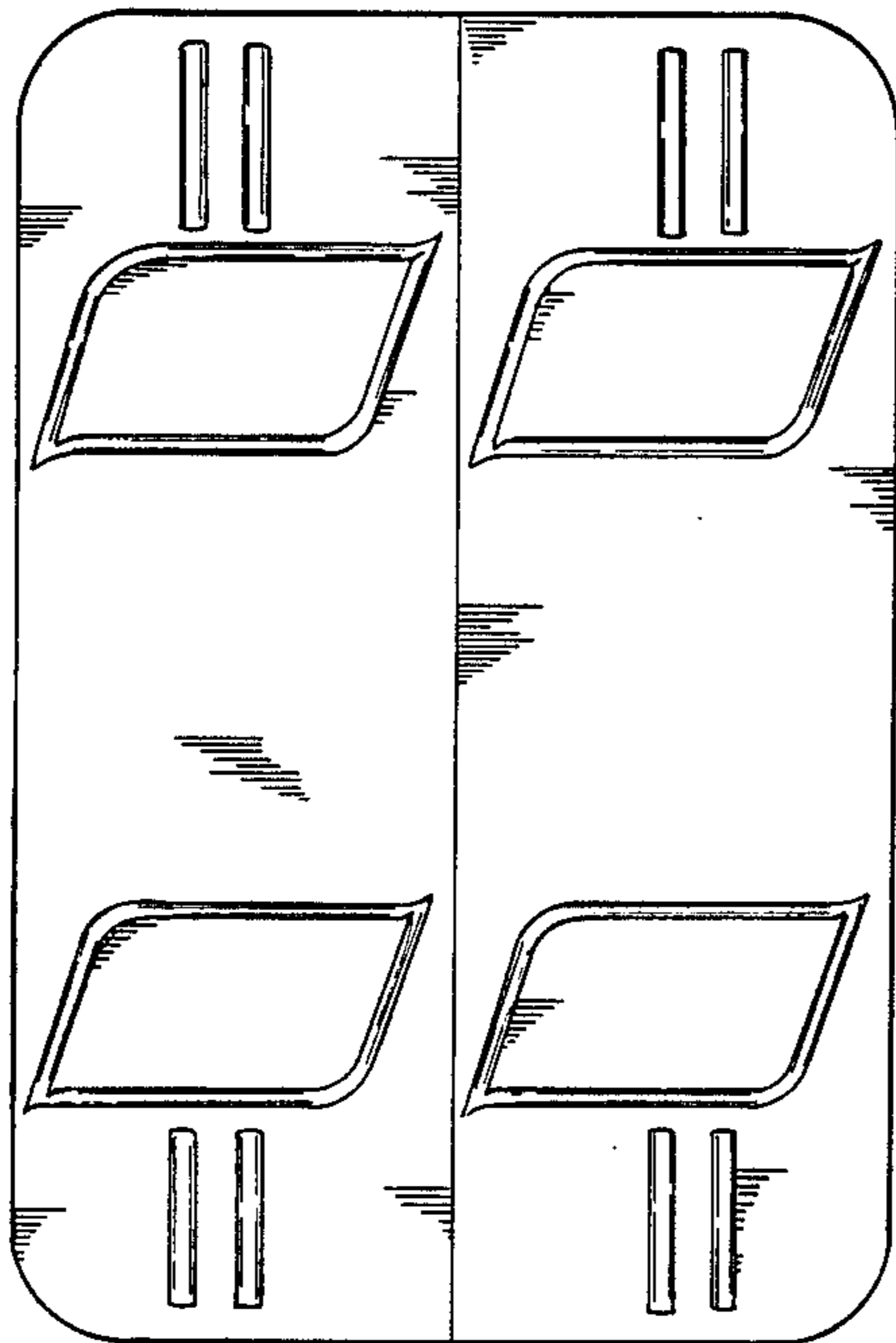
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a golf clock frame showing my new design, the broken line showing of a face and hands is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



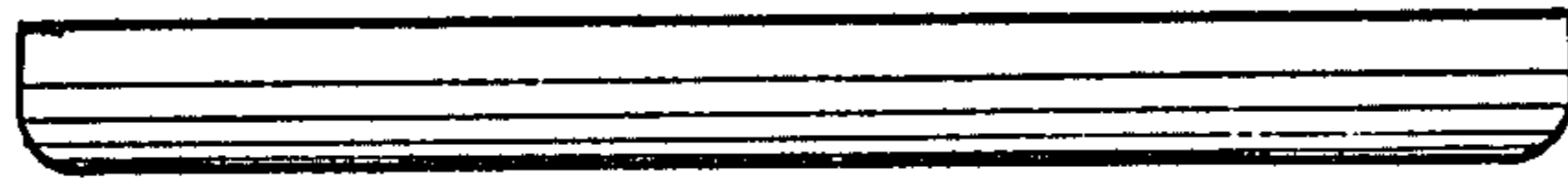

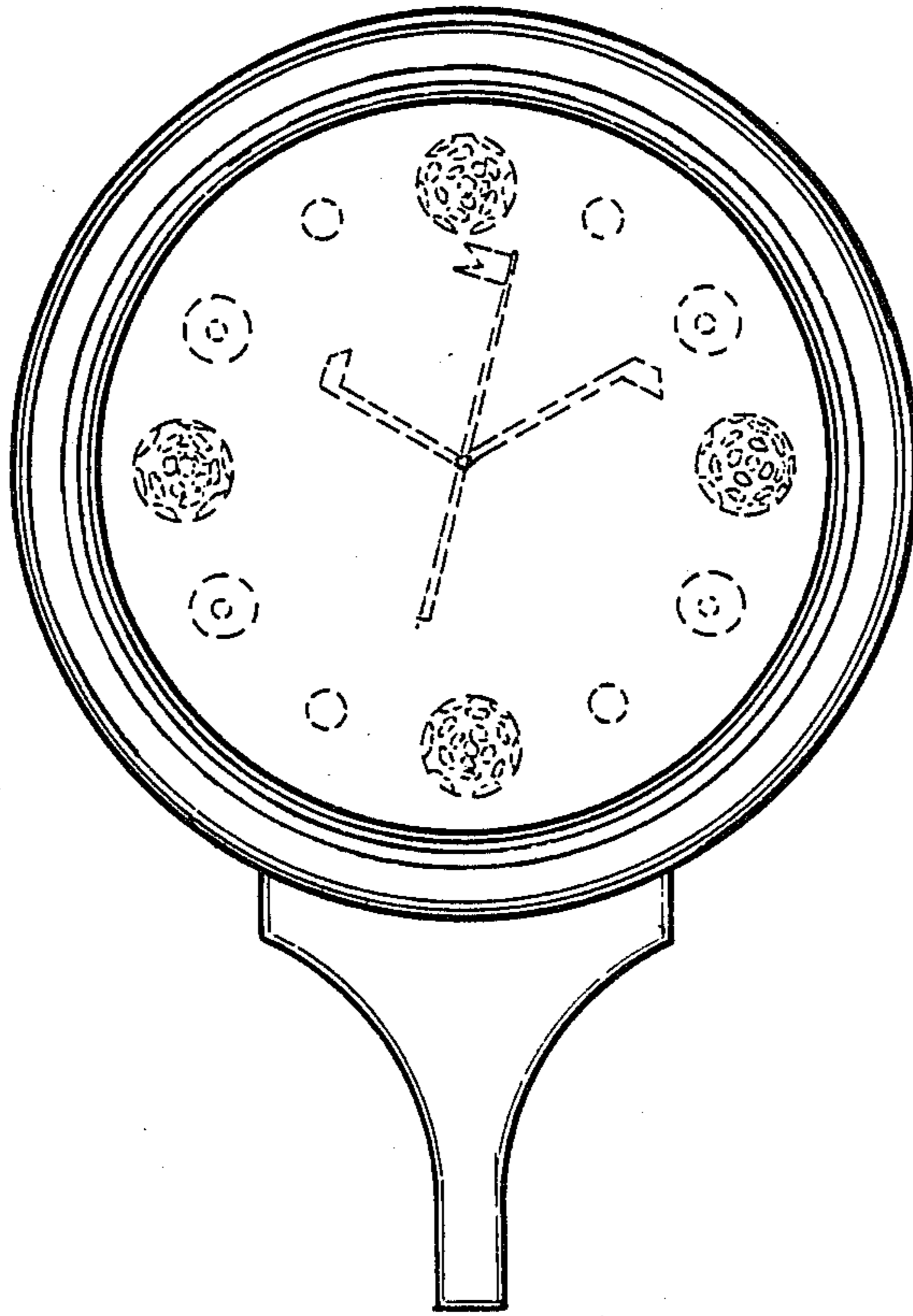

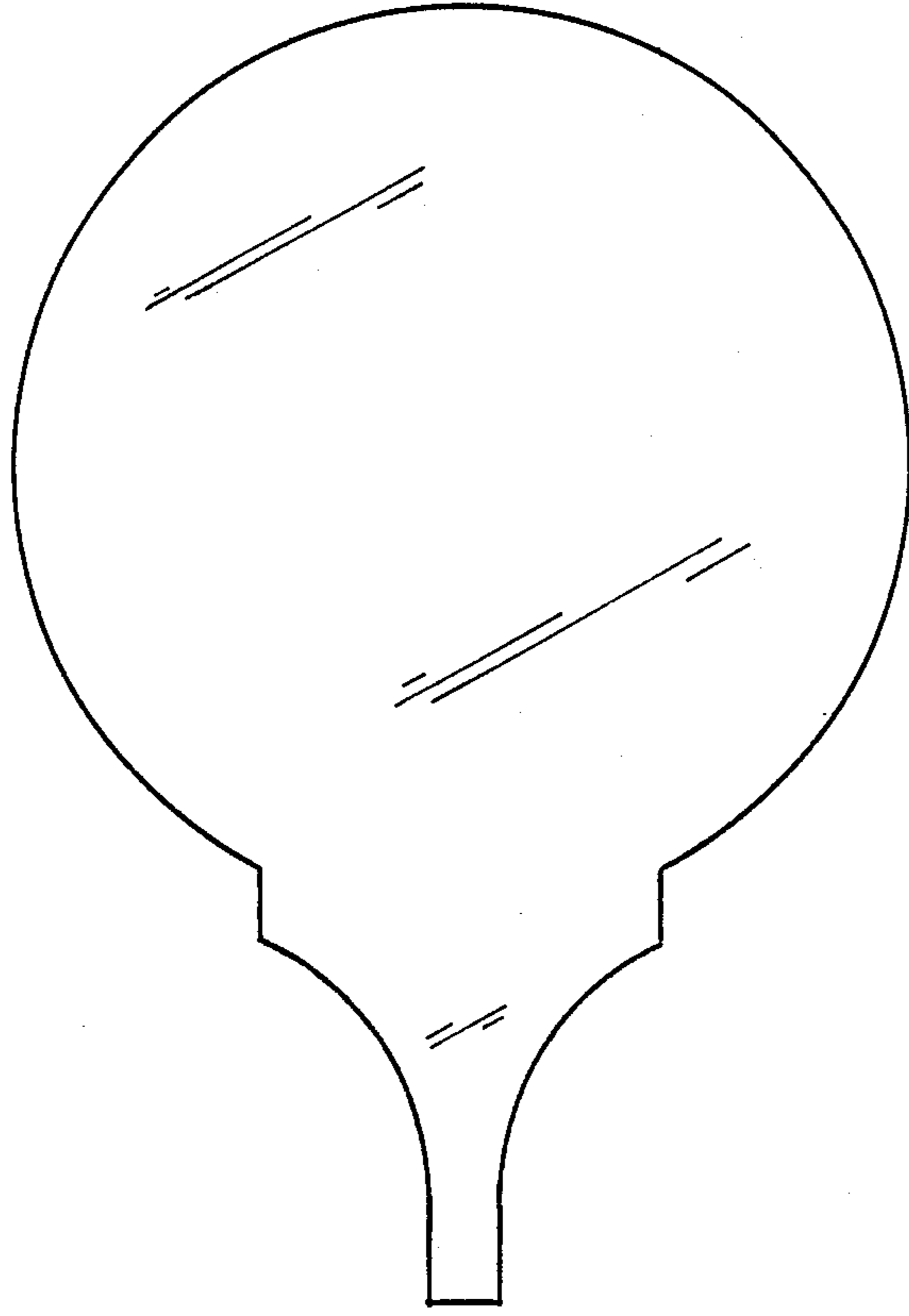
