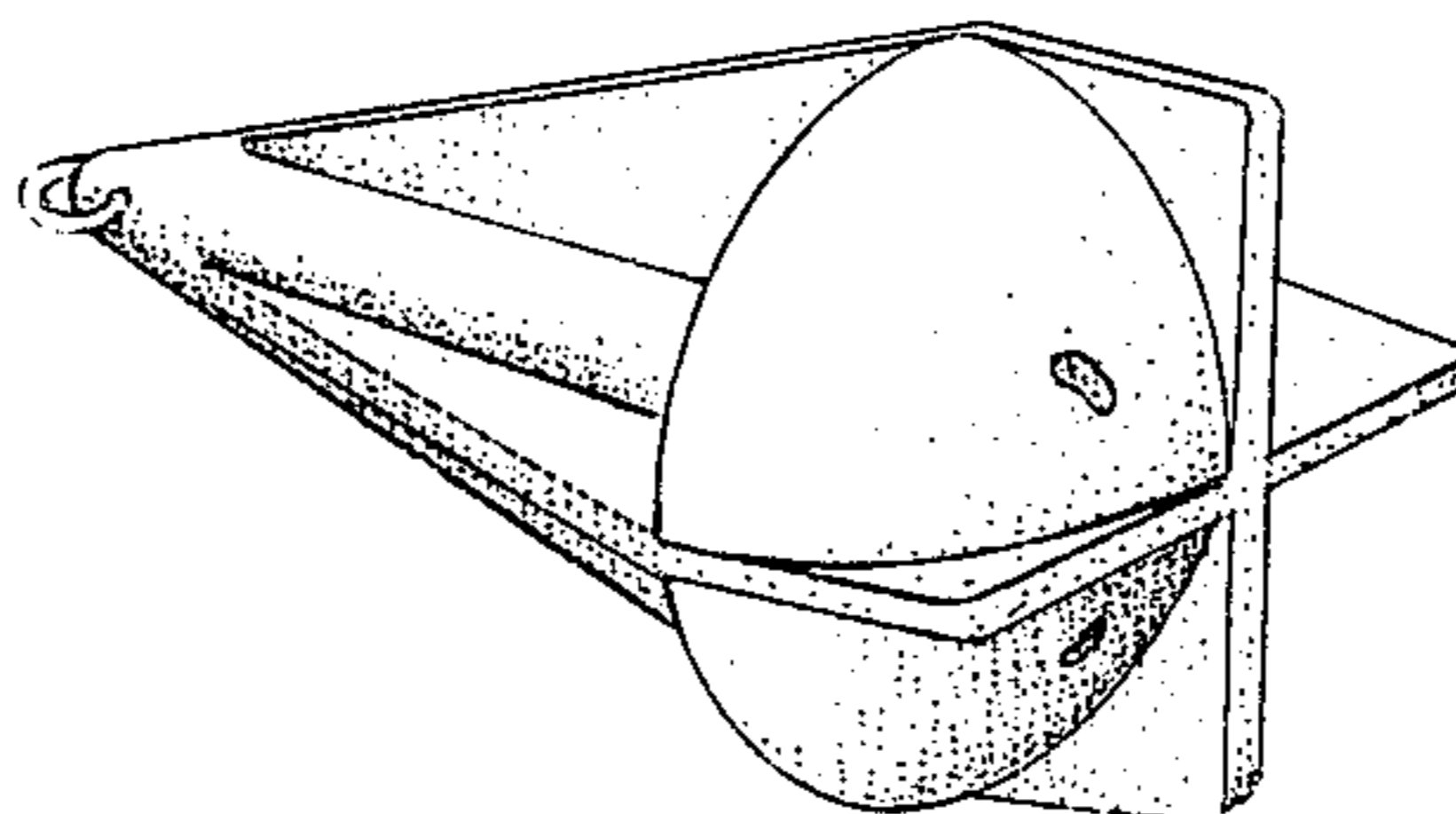
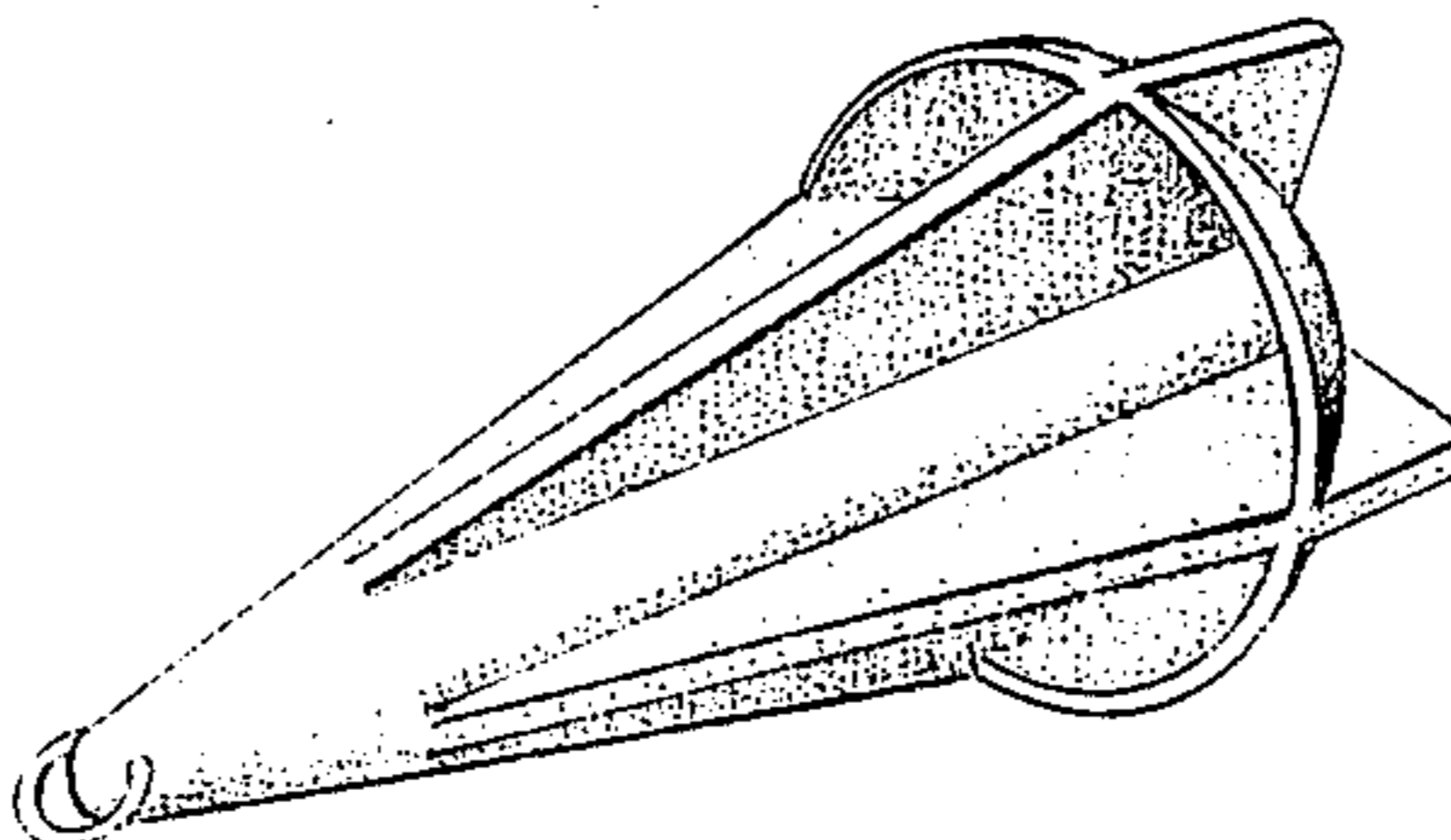

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an anchor showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken along line A—A in FIG. 1.
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view thereof.



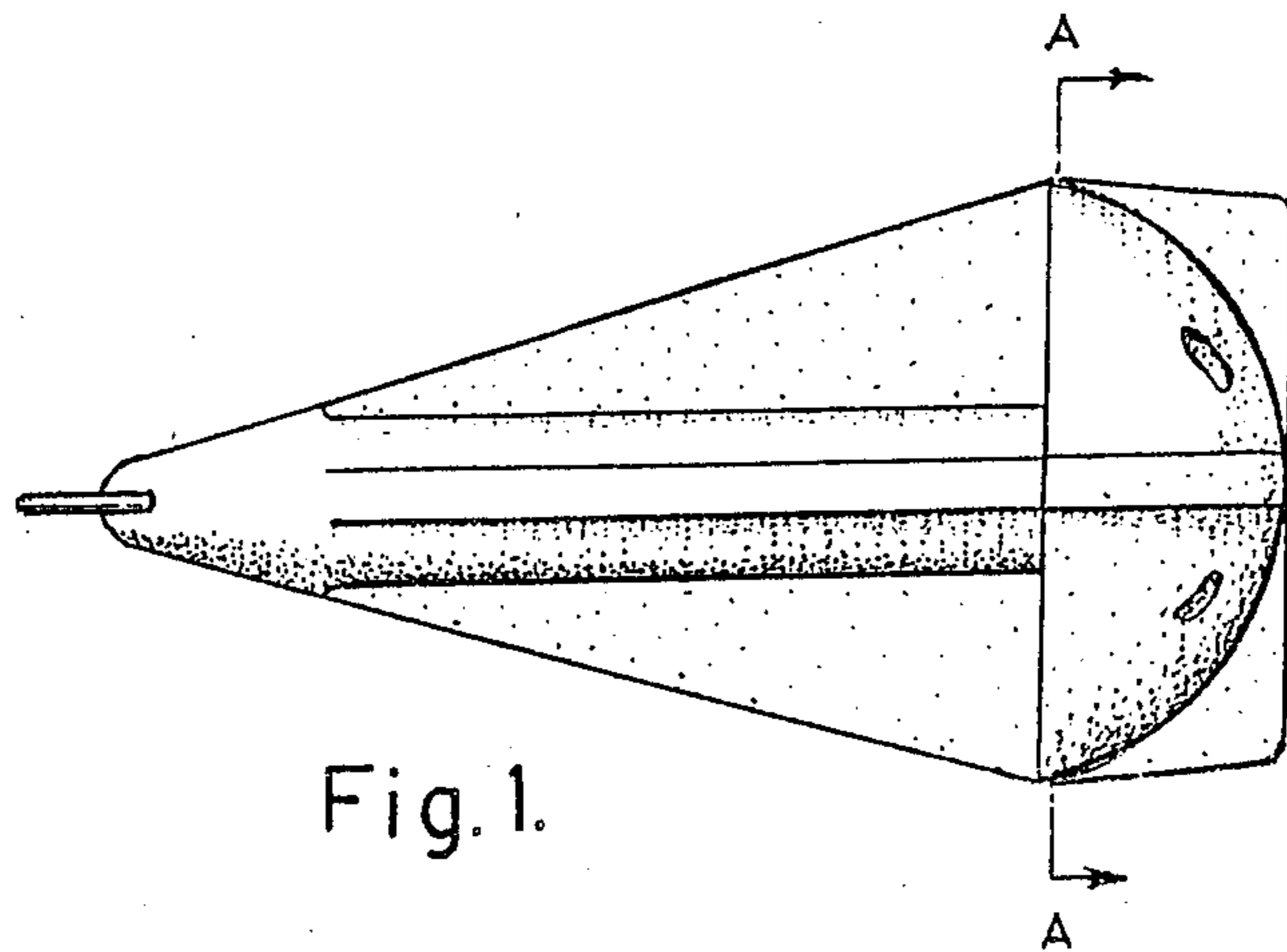

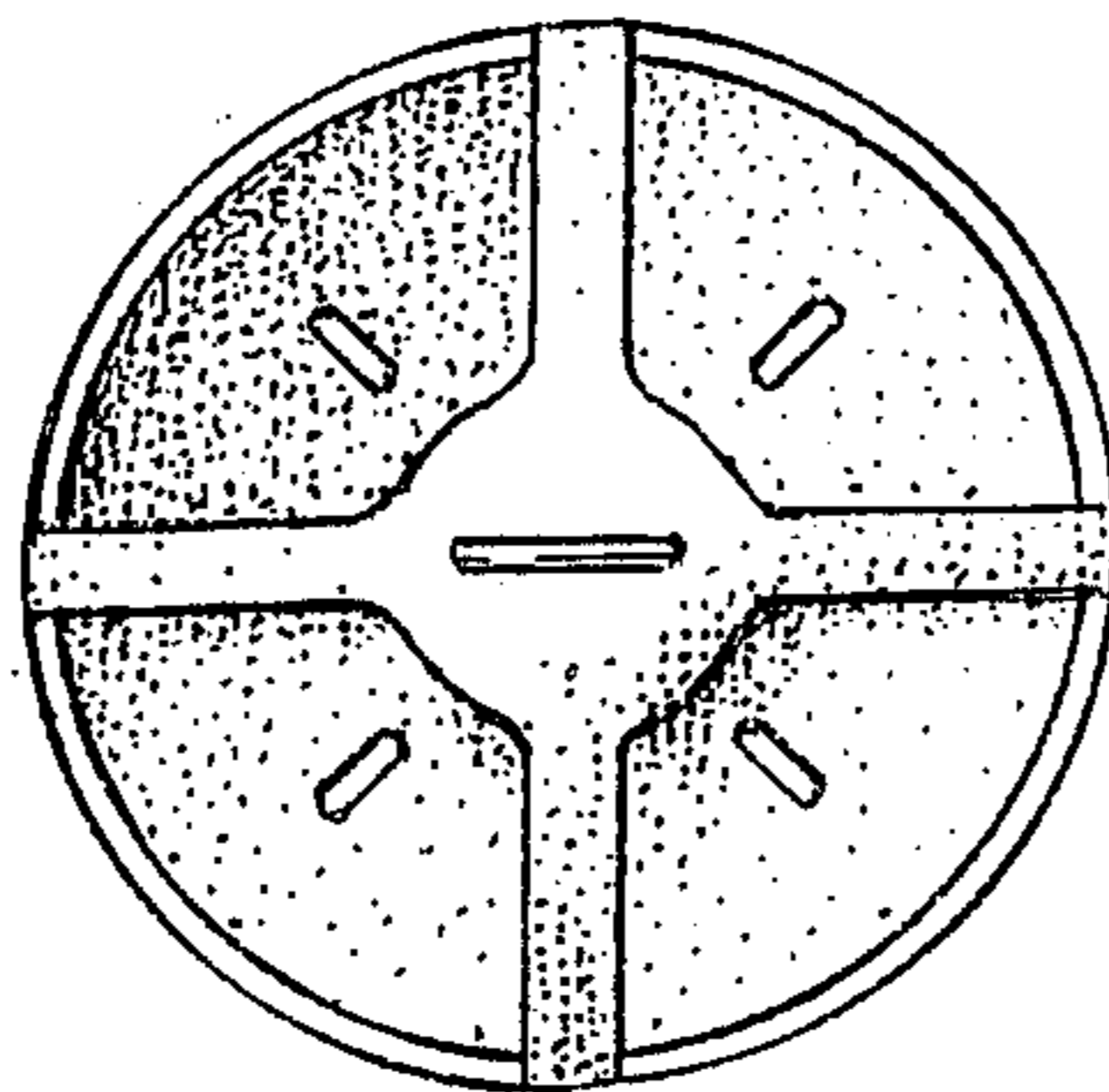

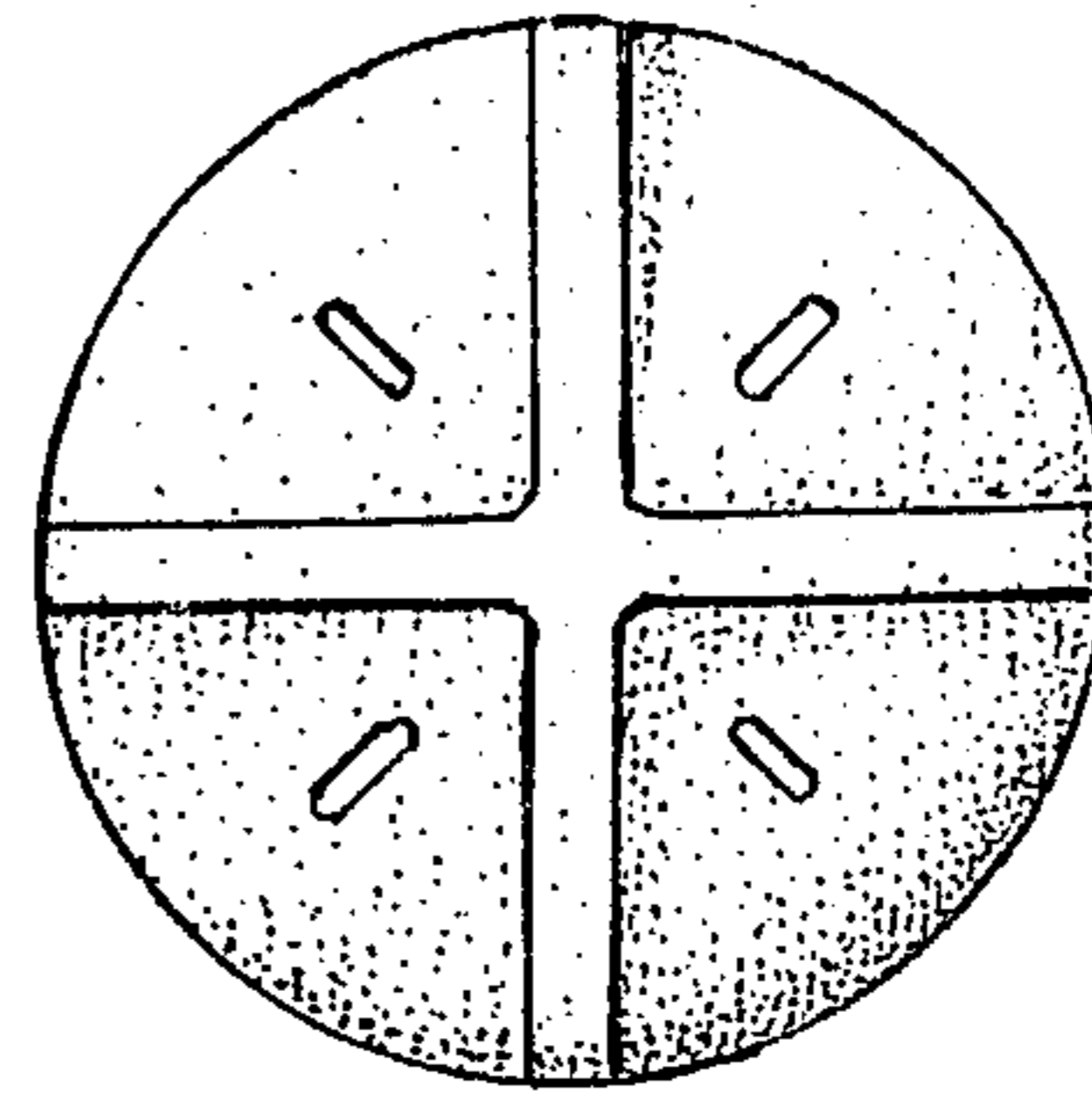

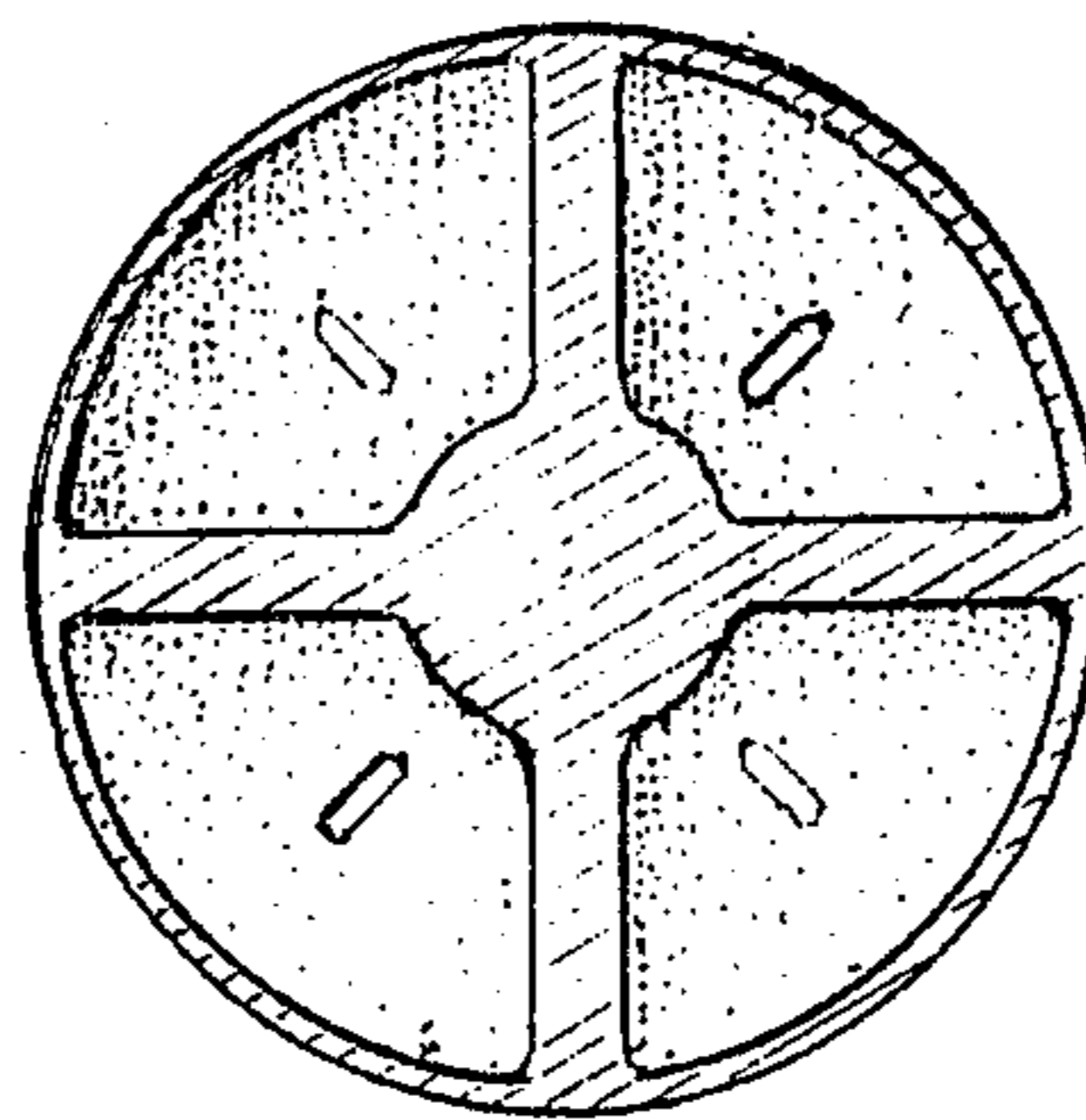

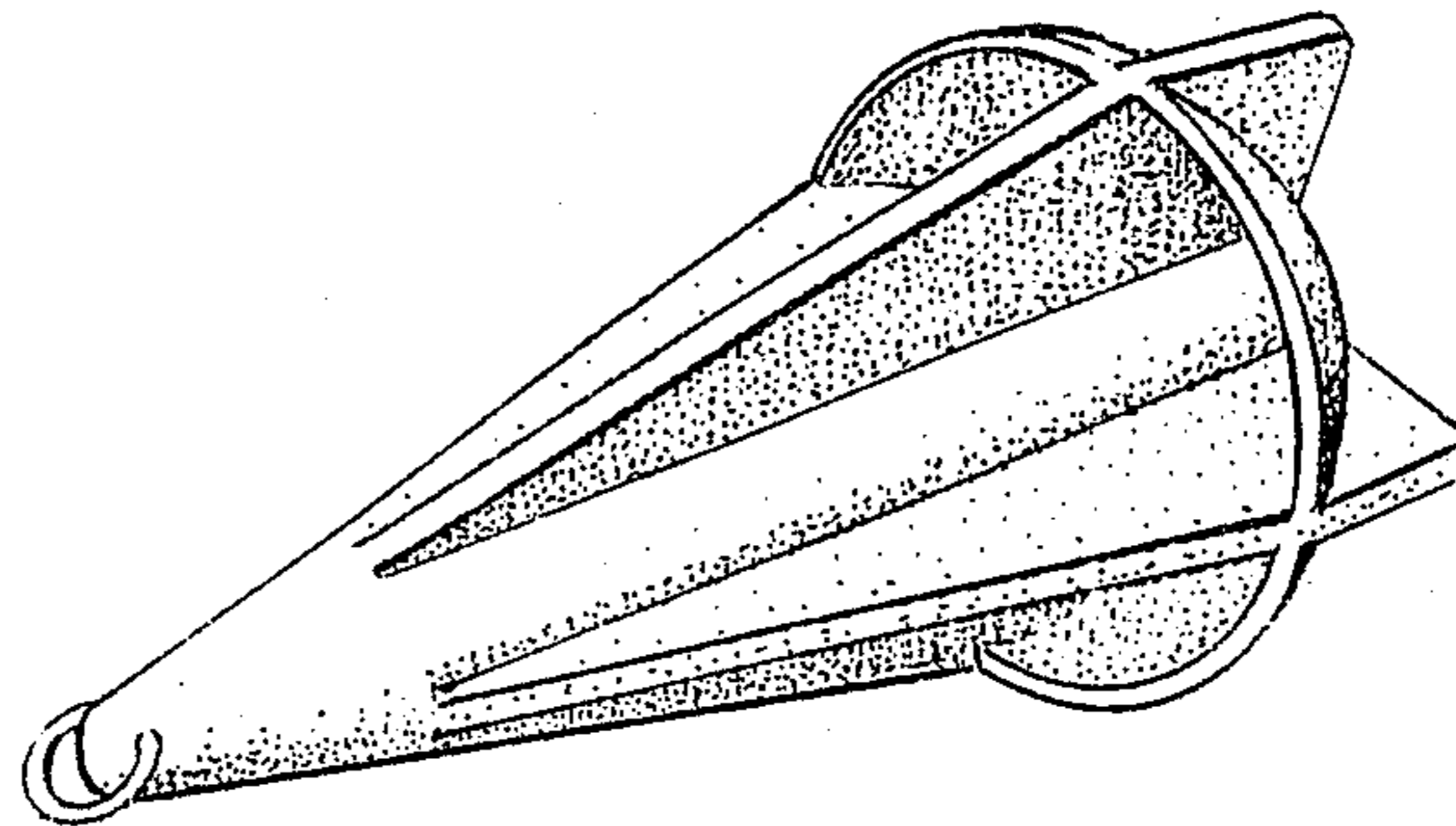

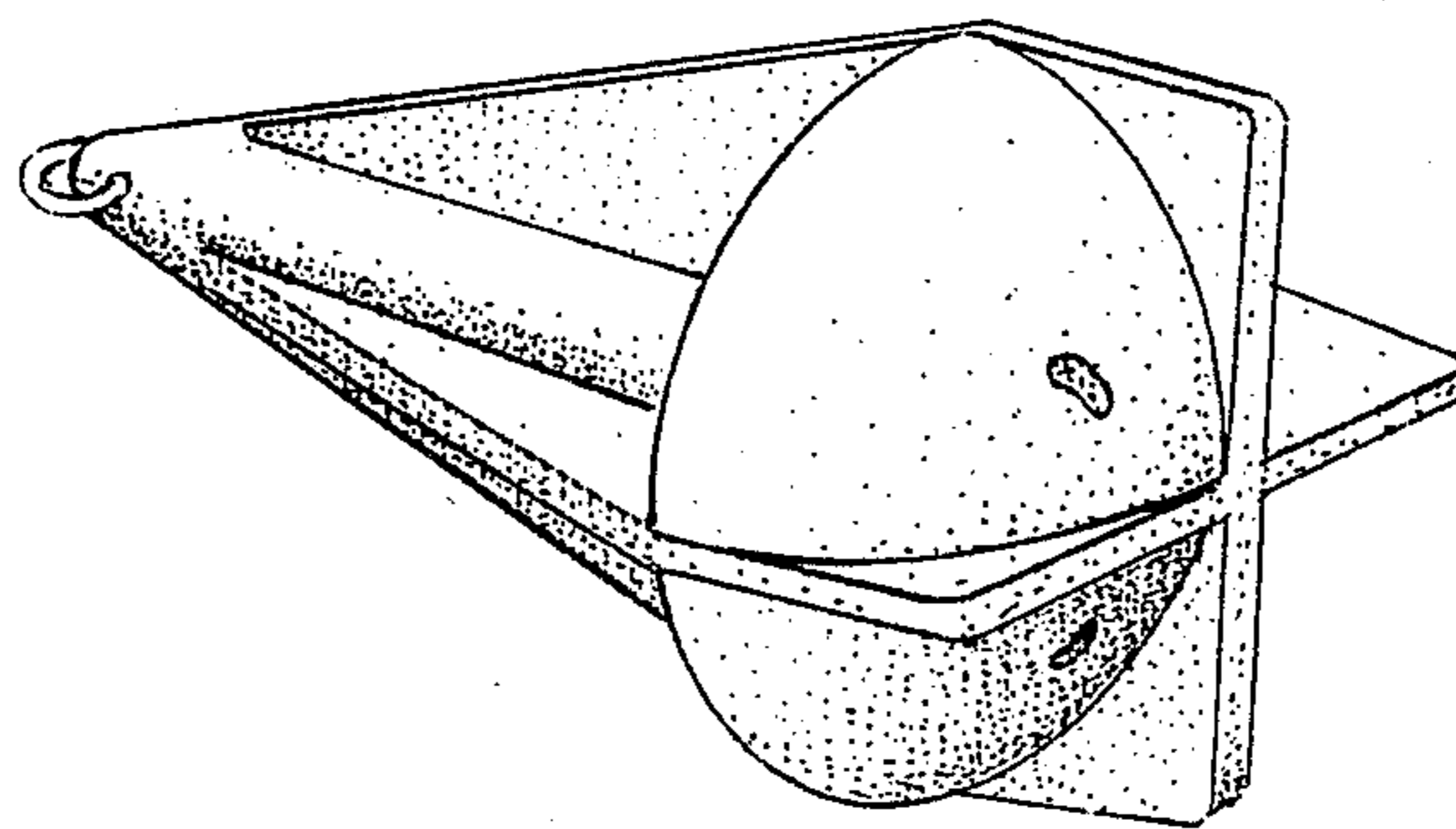
