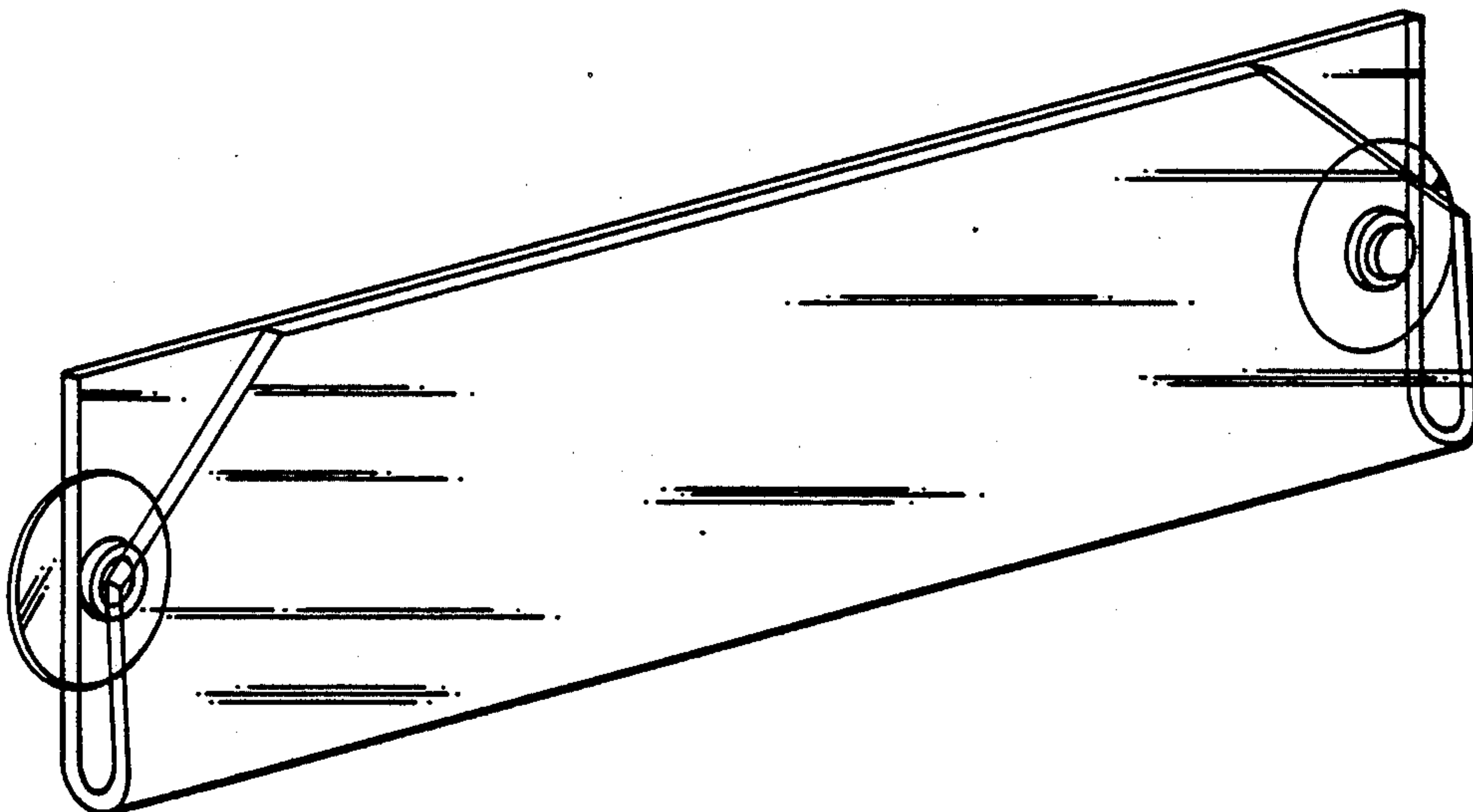

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a card holder for window display showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is an end elevation view thereof, the opposite end being substantially a mirror image of that shown.



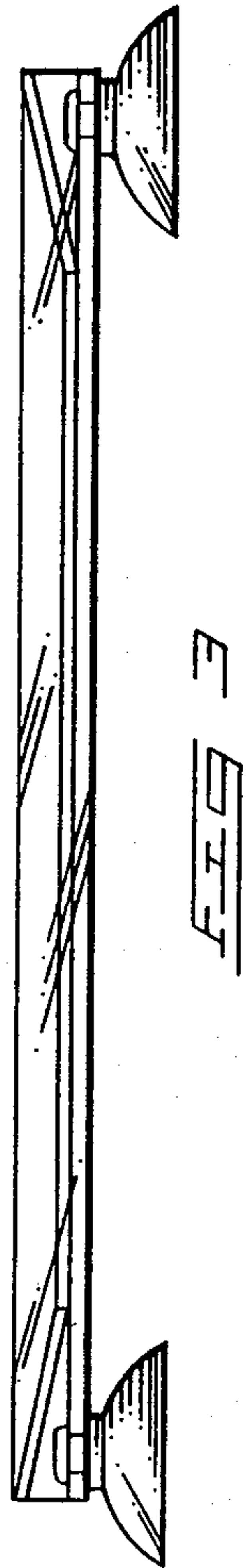
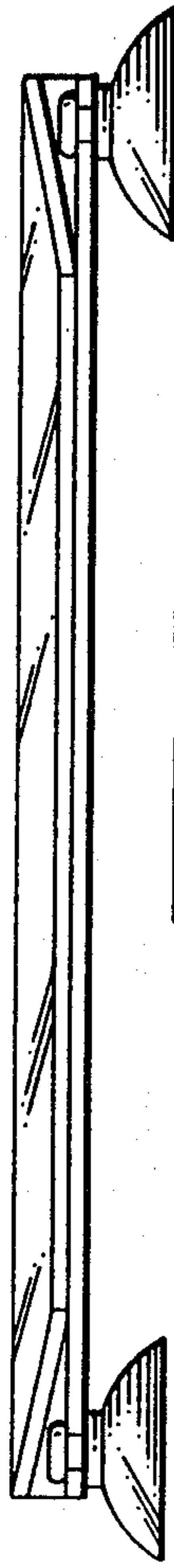
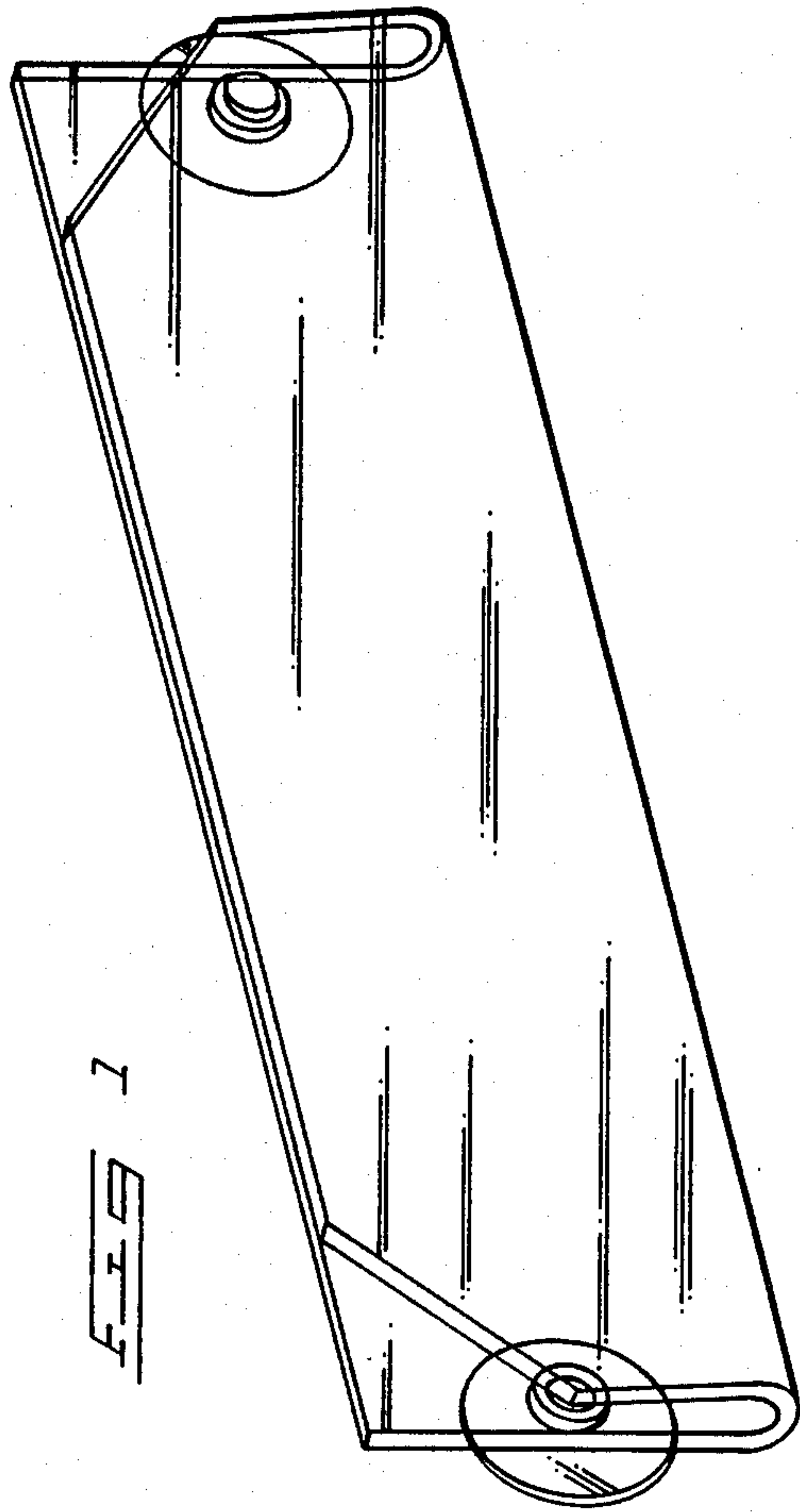

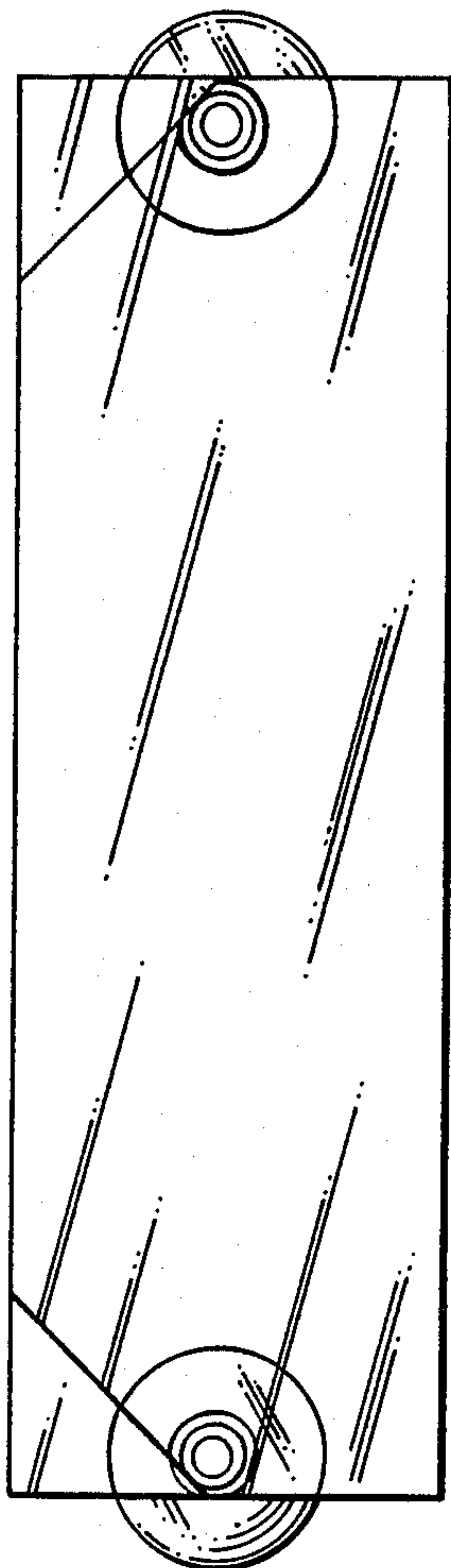

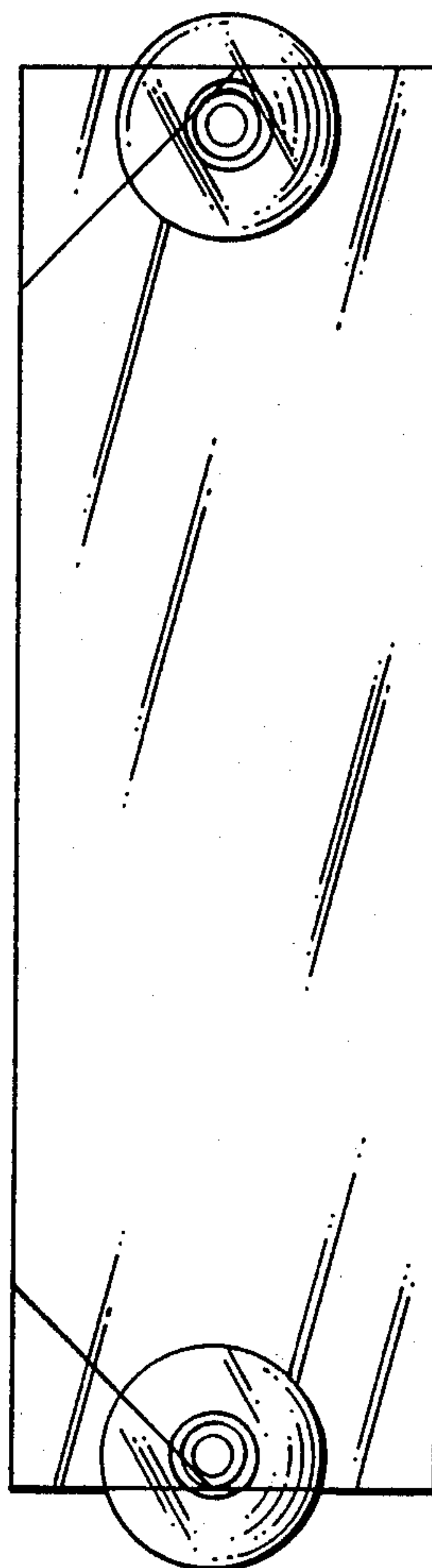
