[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined wrapper holder and counter for coins, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined wrapper holder and counter for coins showing new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of the top portion thereof.
