FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined cabinet door and hinge unit showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1.

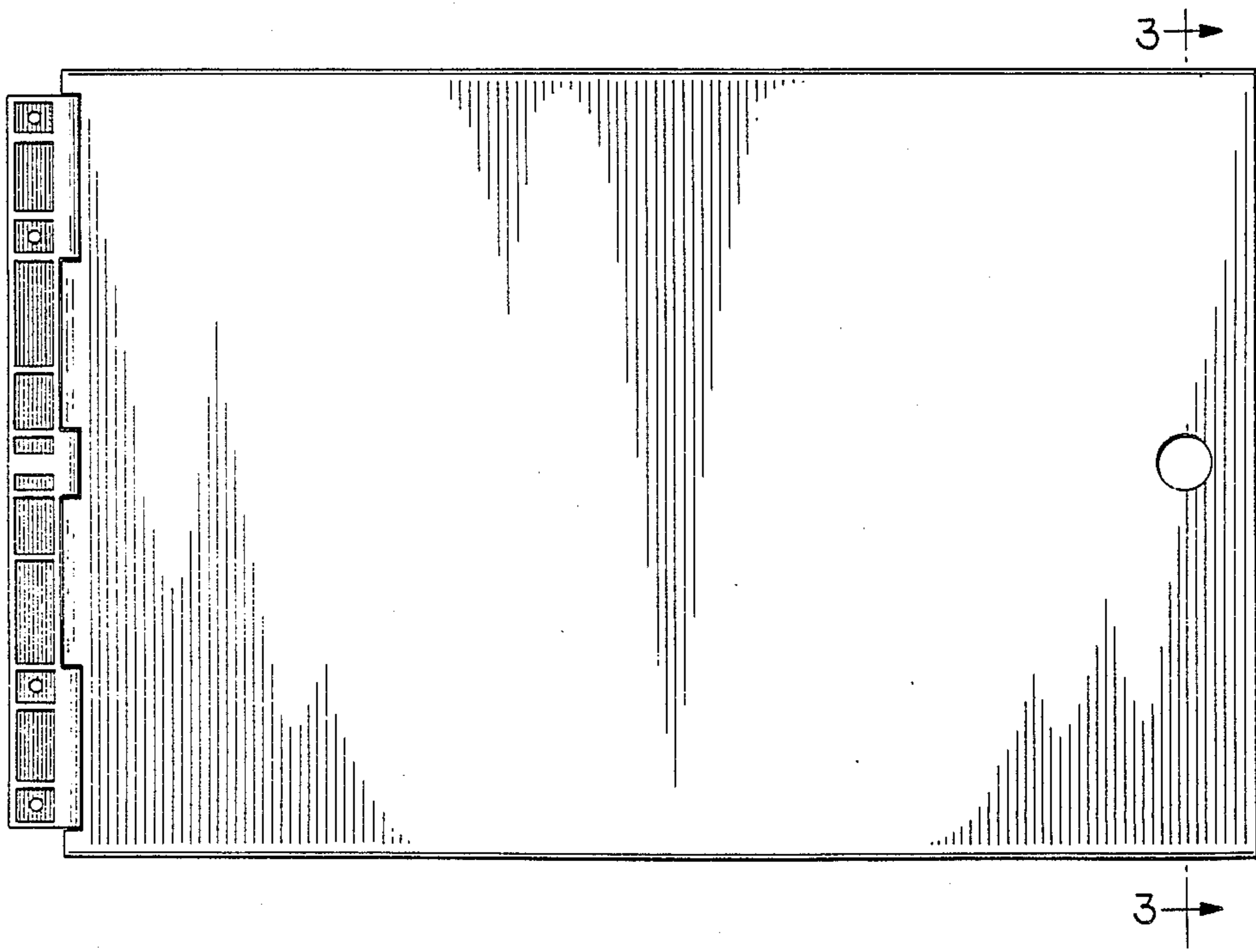

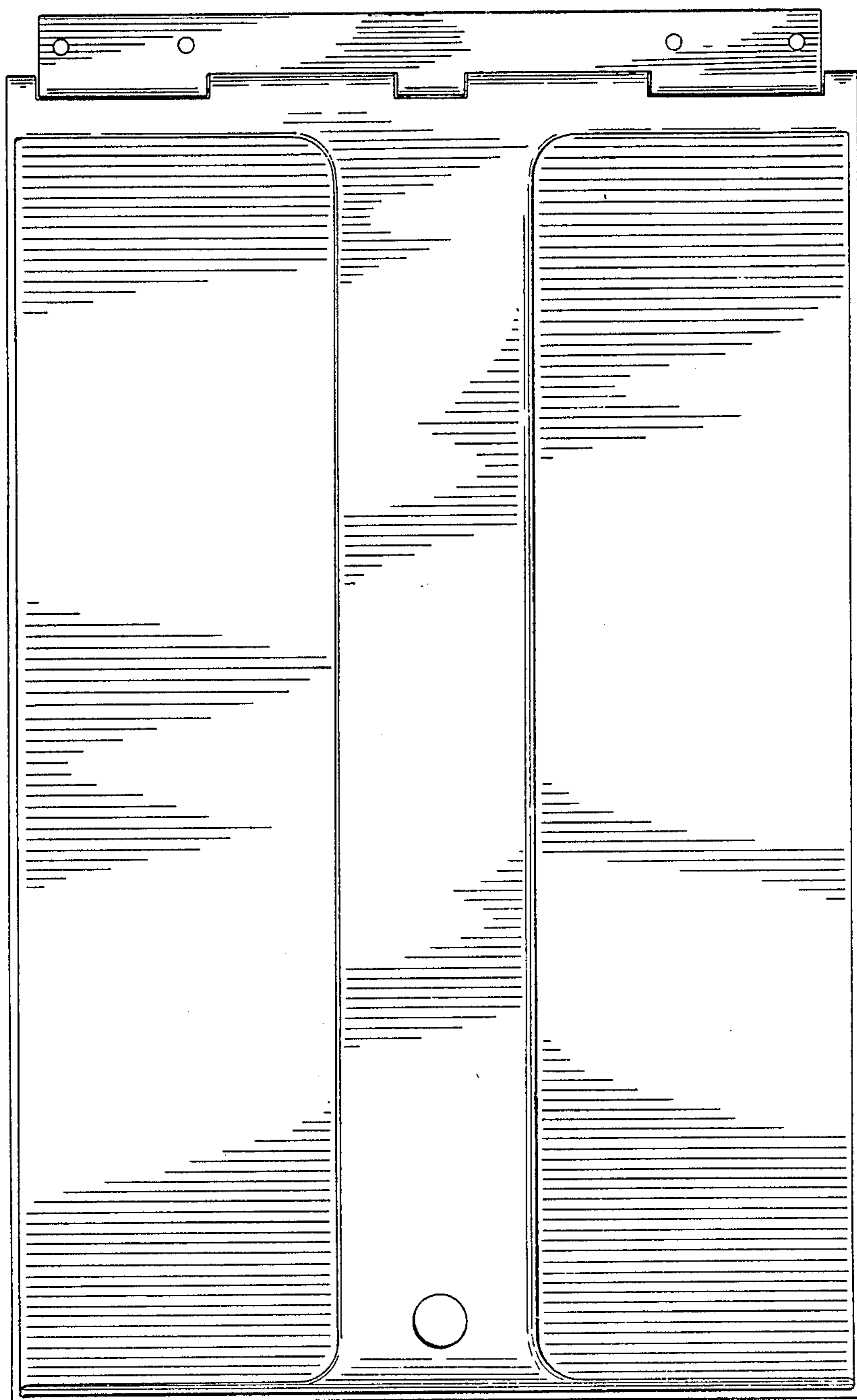

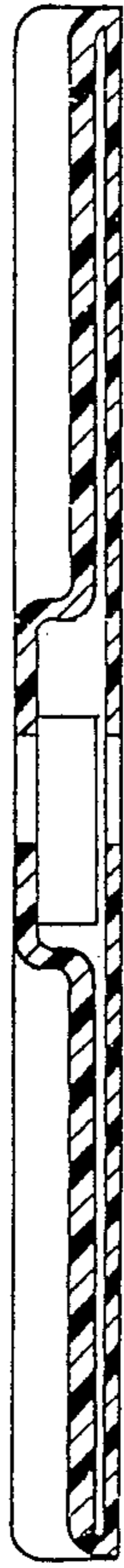
