The ornamental design for a wine decanter or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a wine decanter or the like showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

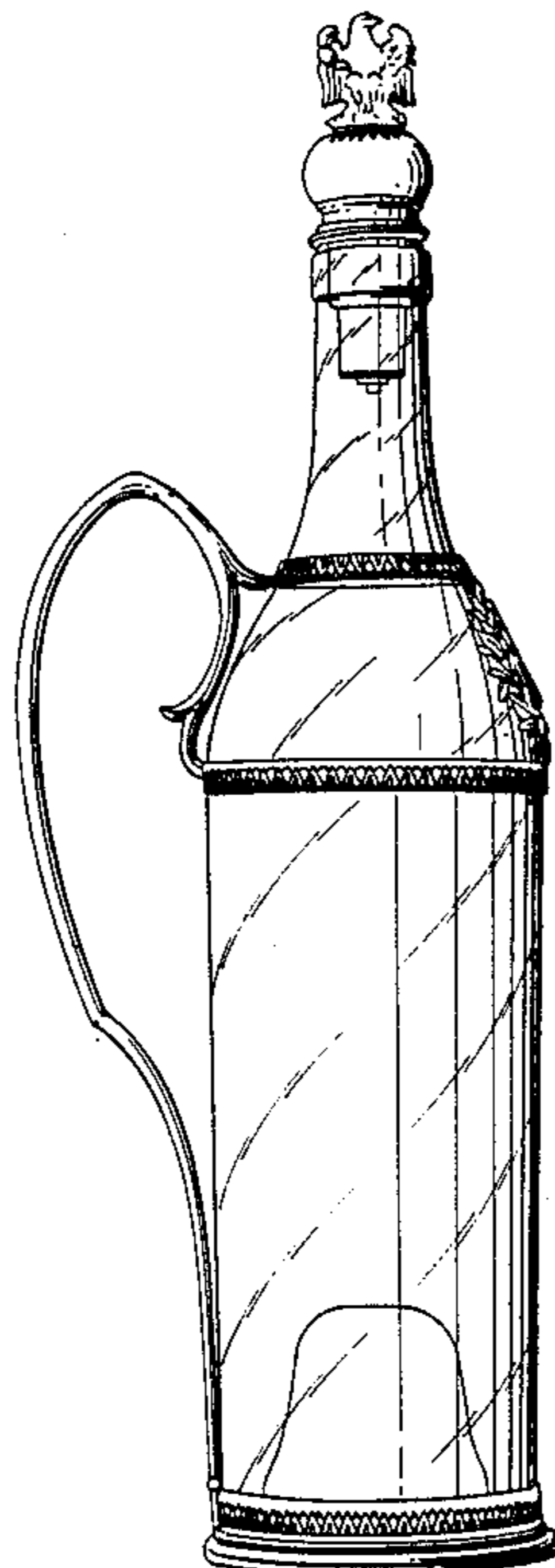

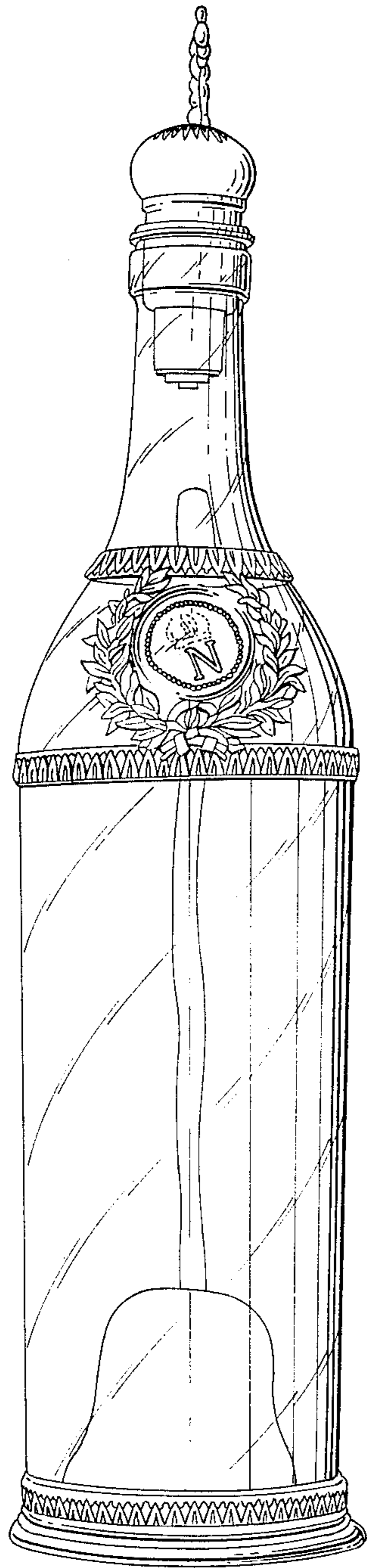

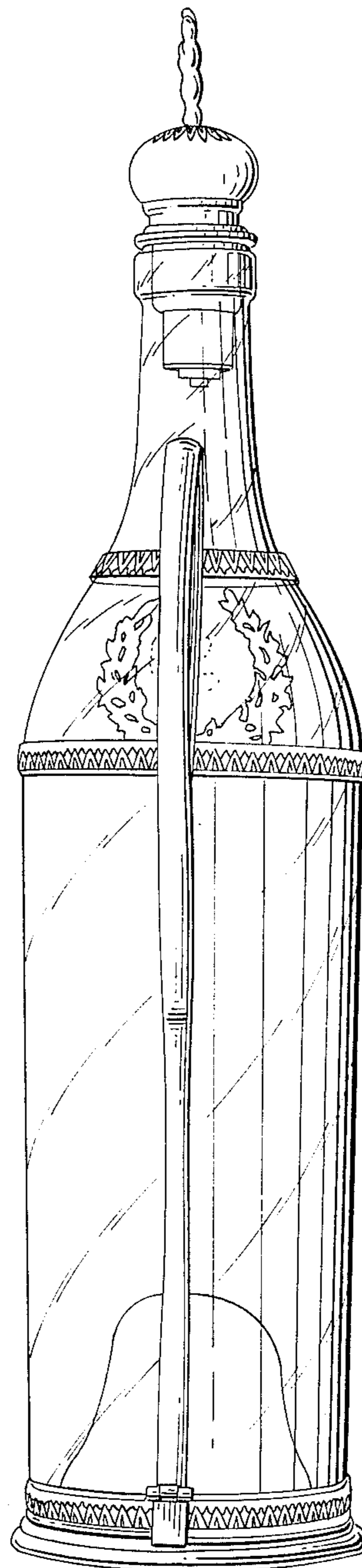

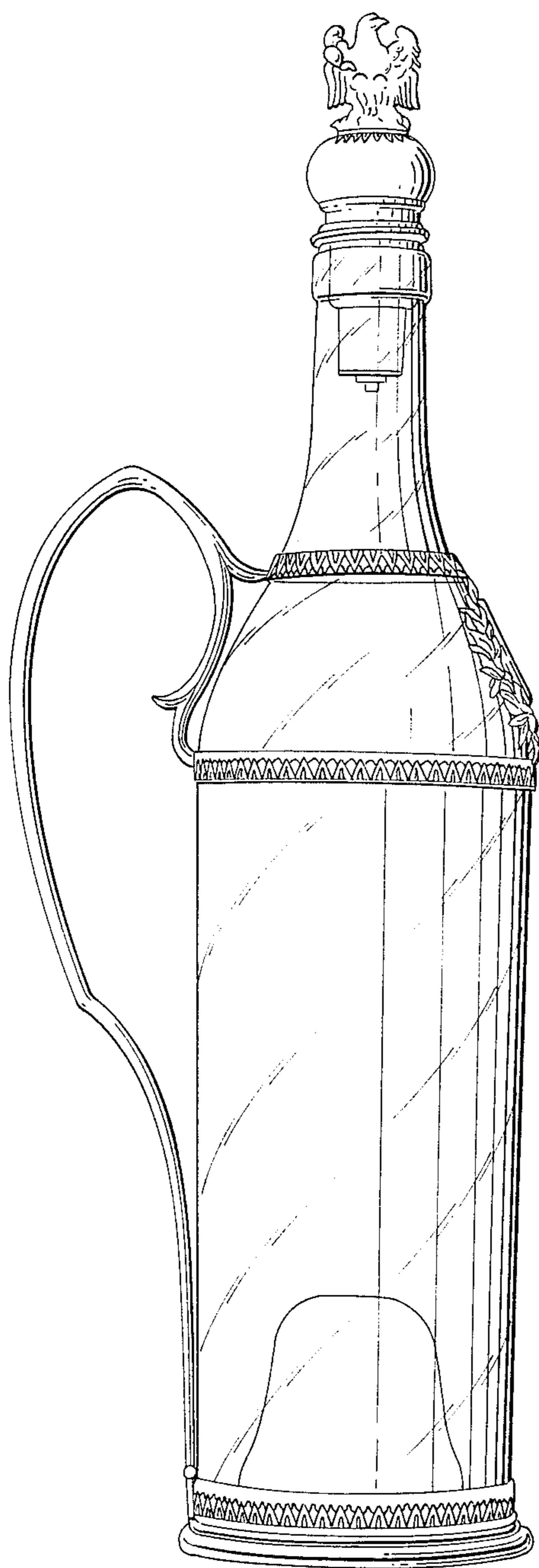

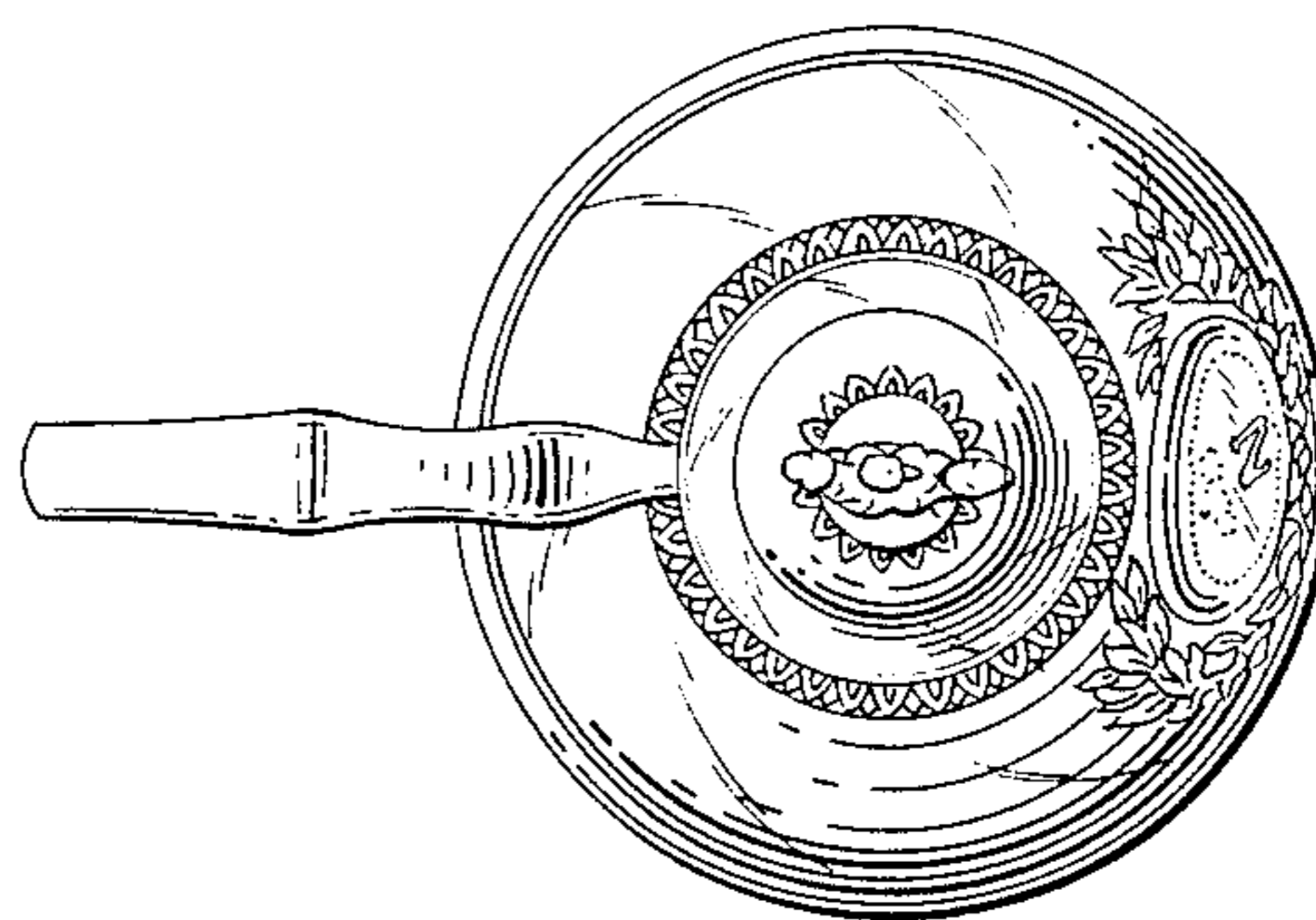
