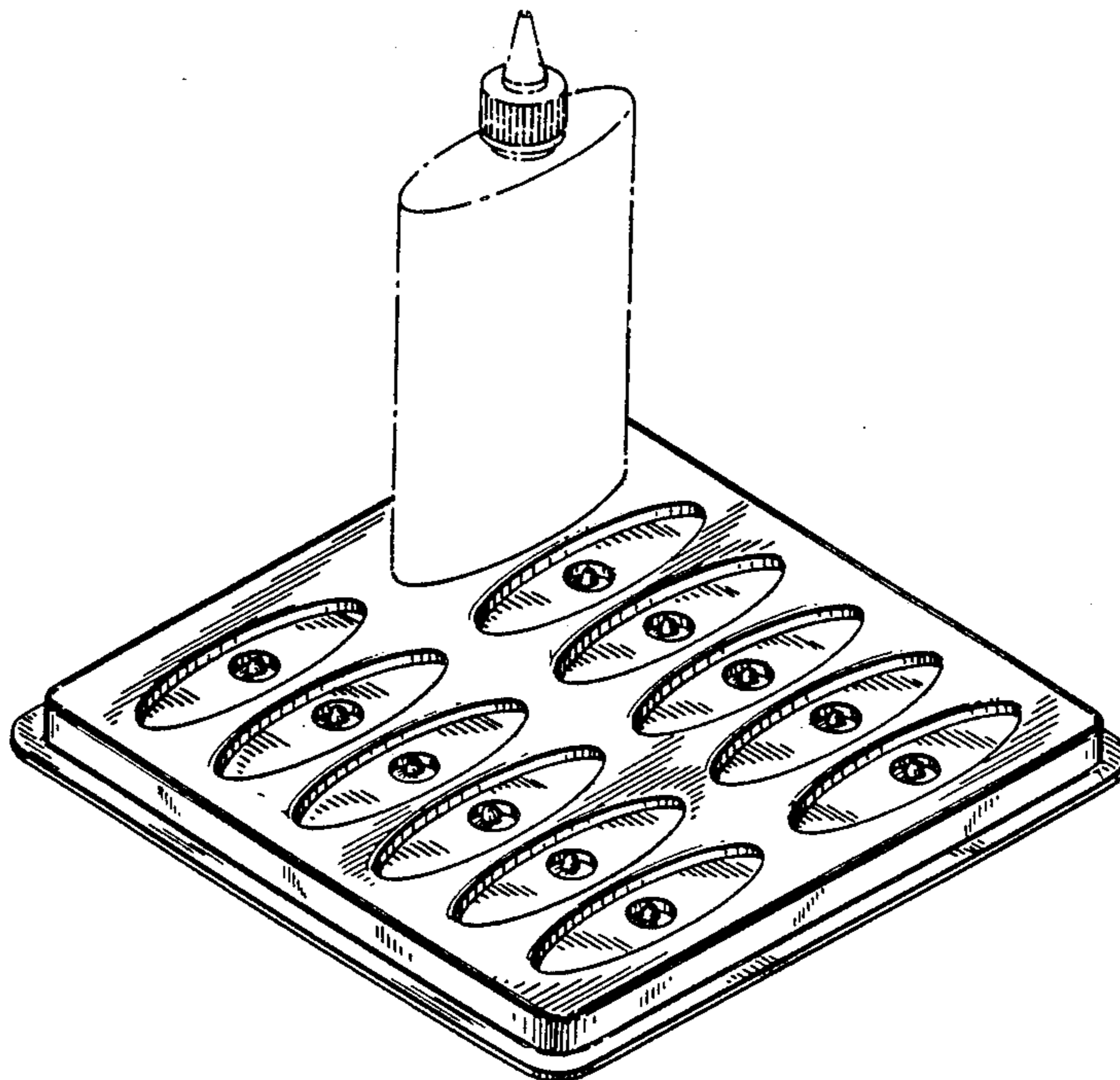

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stackable packaging unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a stackable packaging unit showing my new design, the container shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical and the fragmented container shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof, the front being identical and the fragmented container shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a fragmentary enlarged sectional view of FIG. 4 taken in the direction of arrows 5—5. FIG. 6 is a fragmentary enlarged sectional view of FIG. 4 taken in the direction of arrows 6—6.



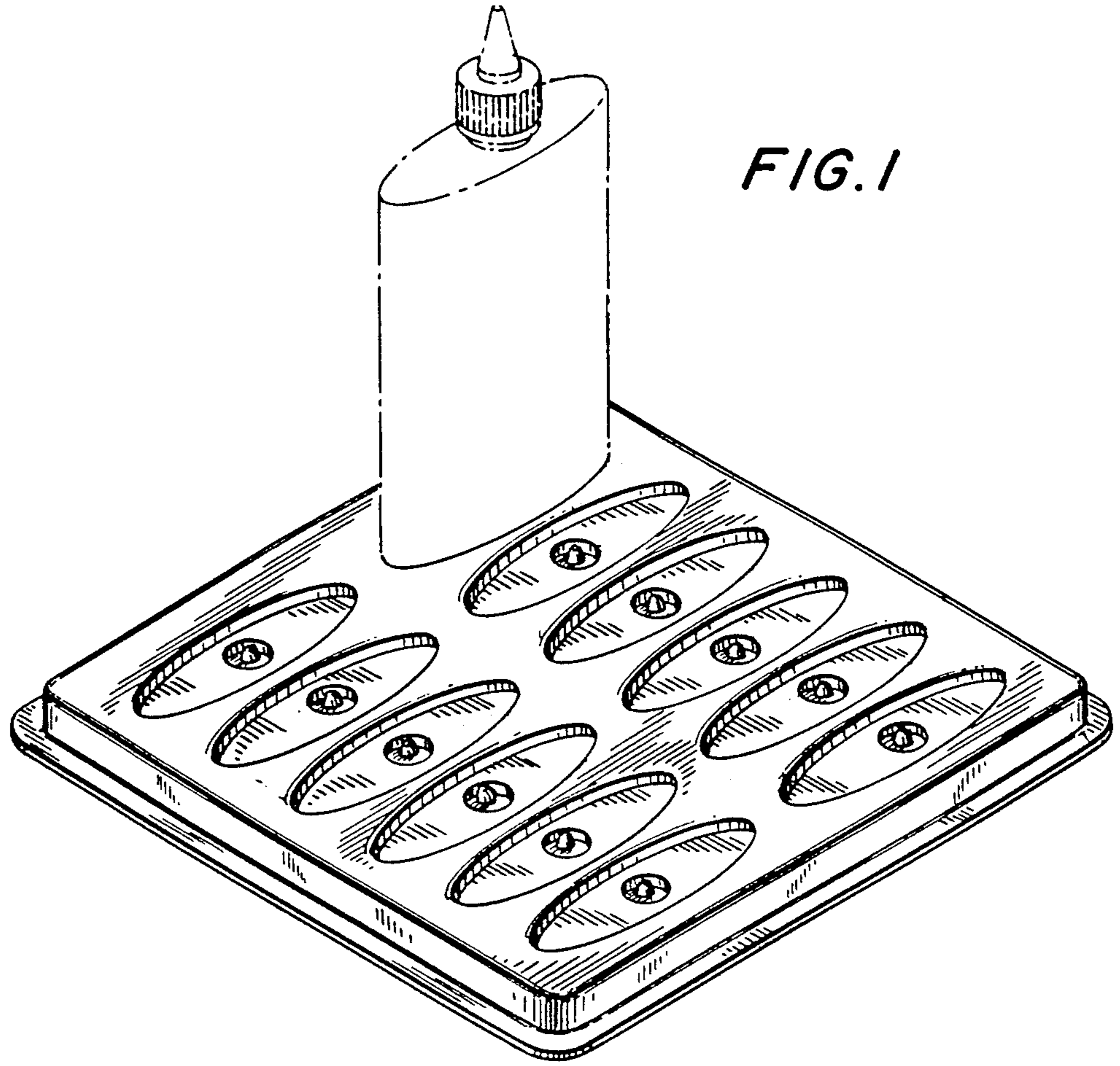

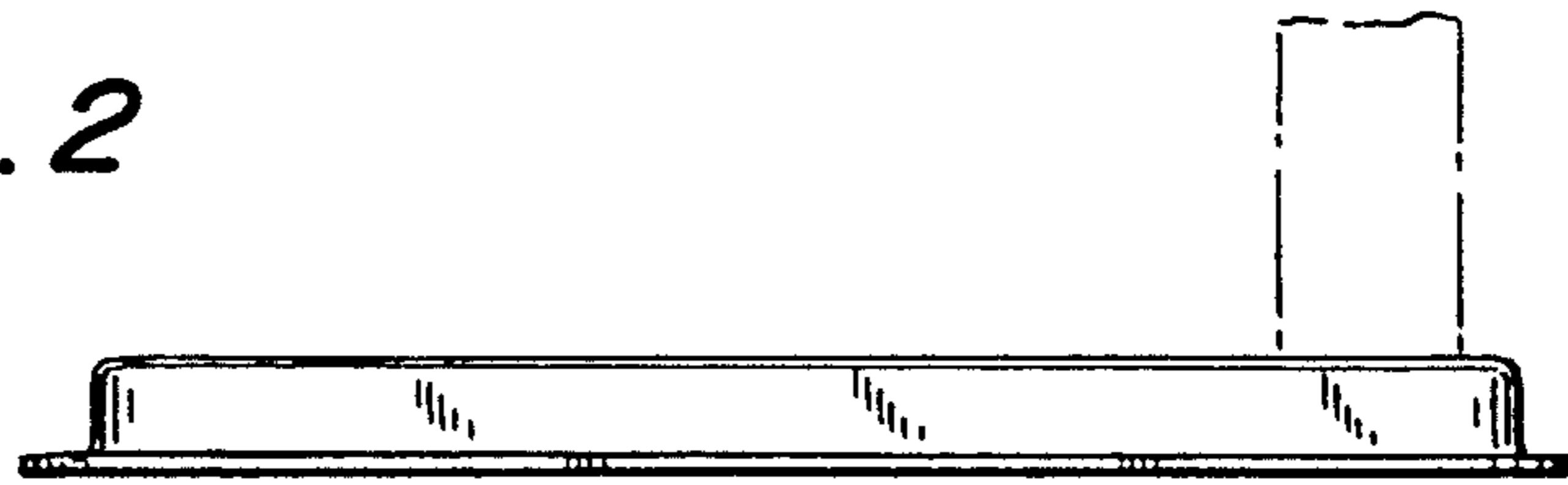

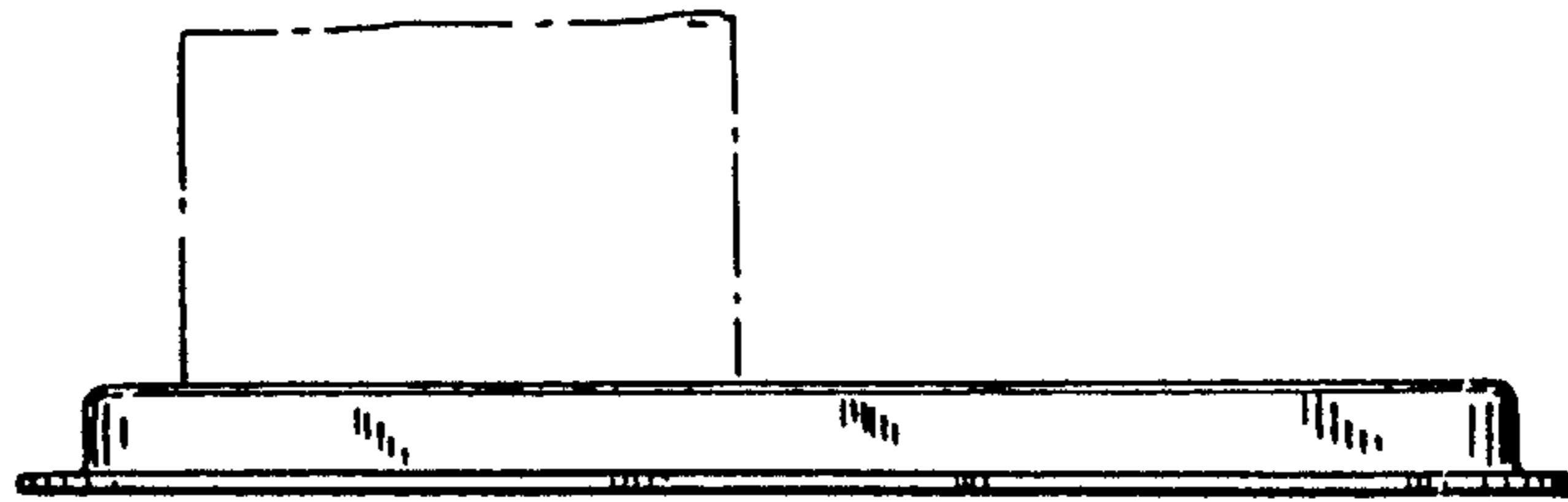

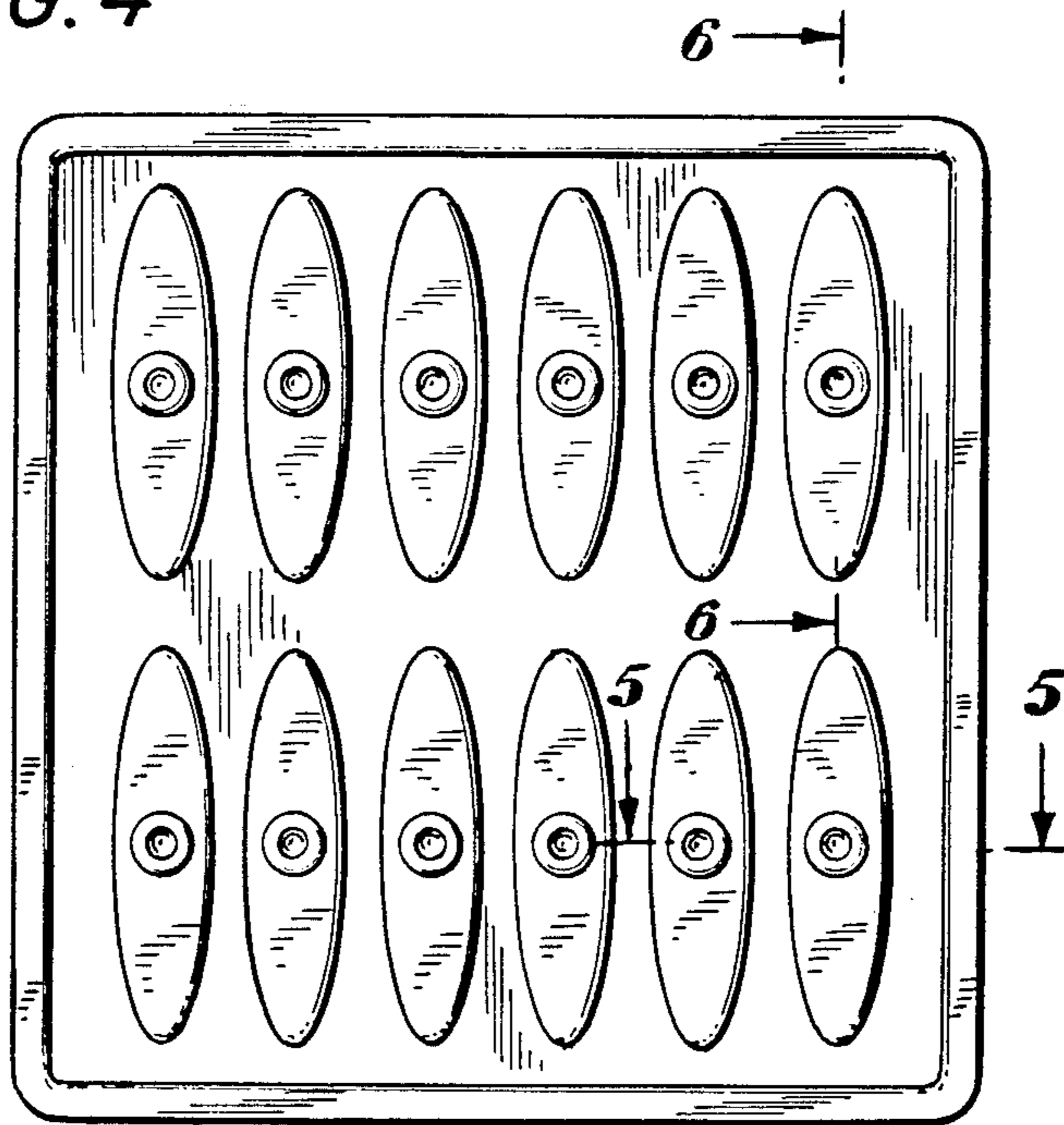

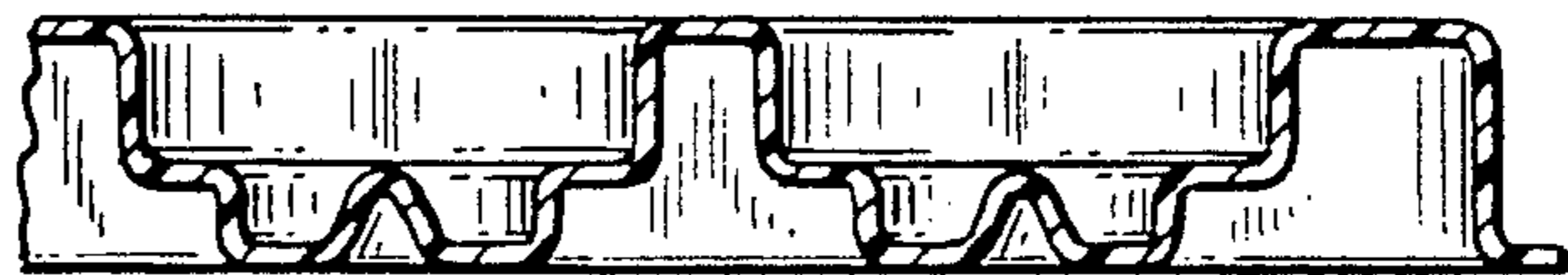
