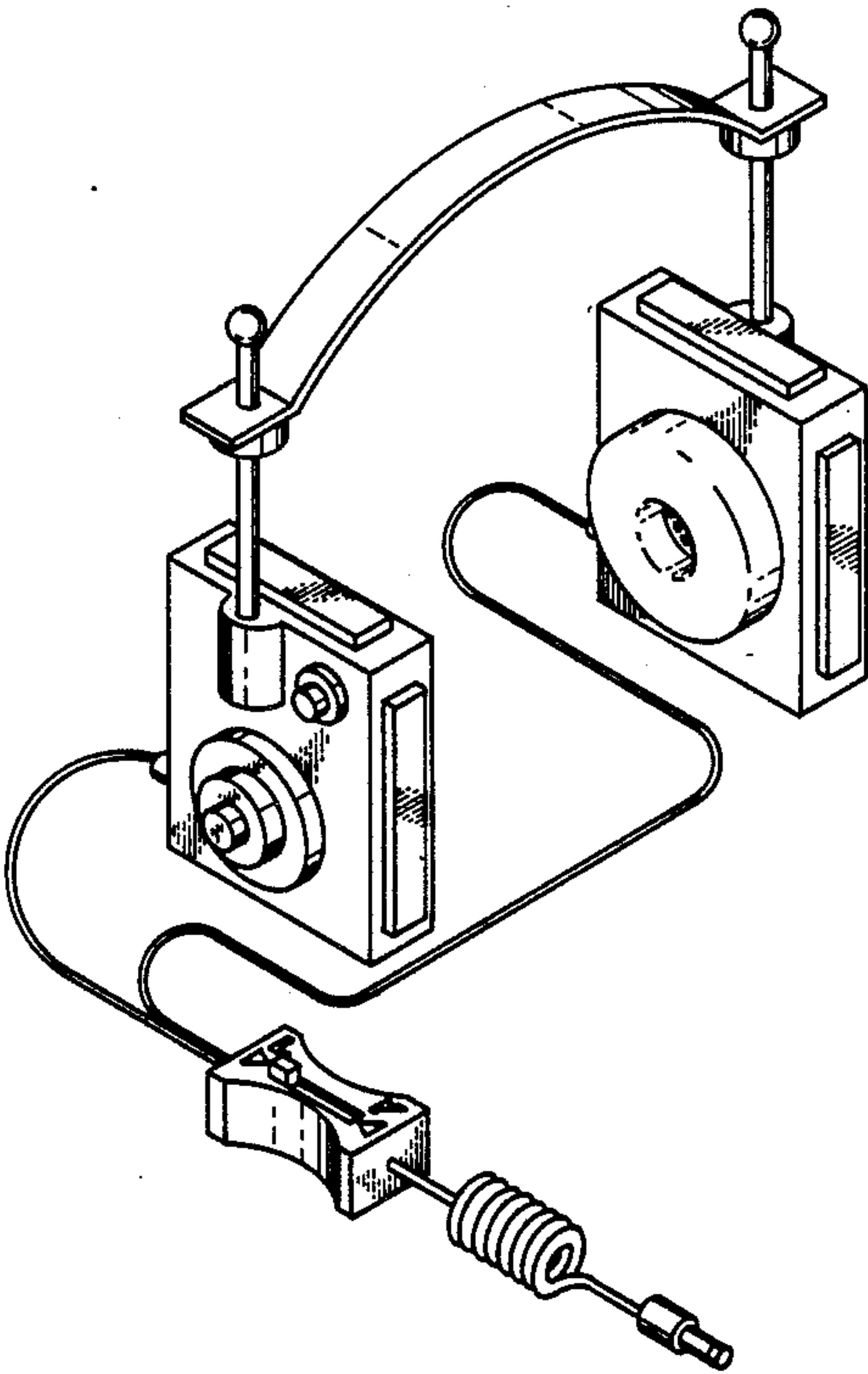

FIG. 2 is an opposite isometric view thereof.



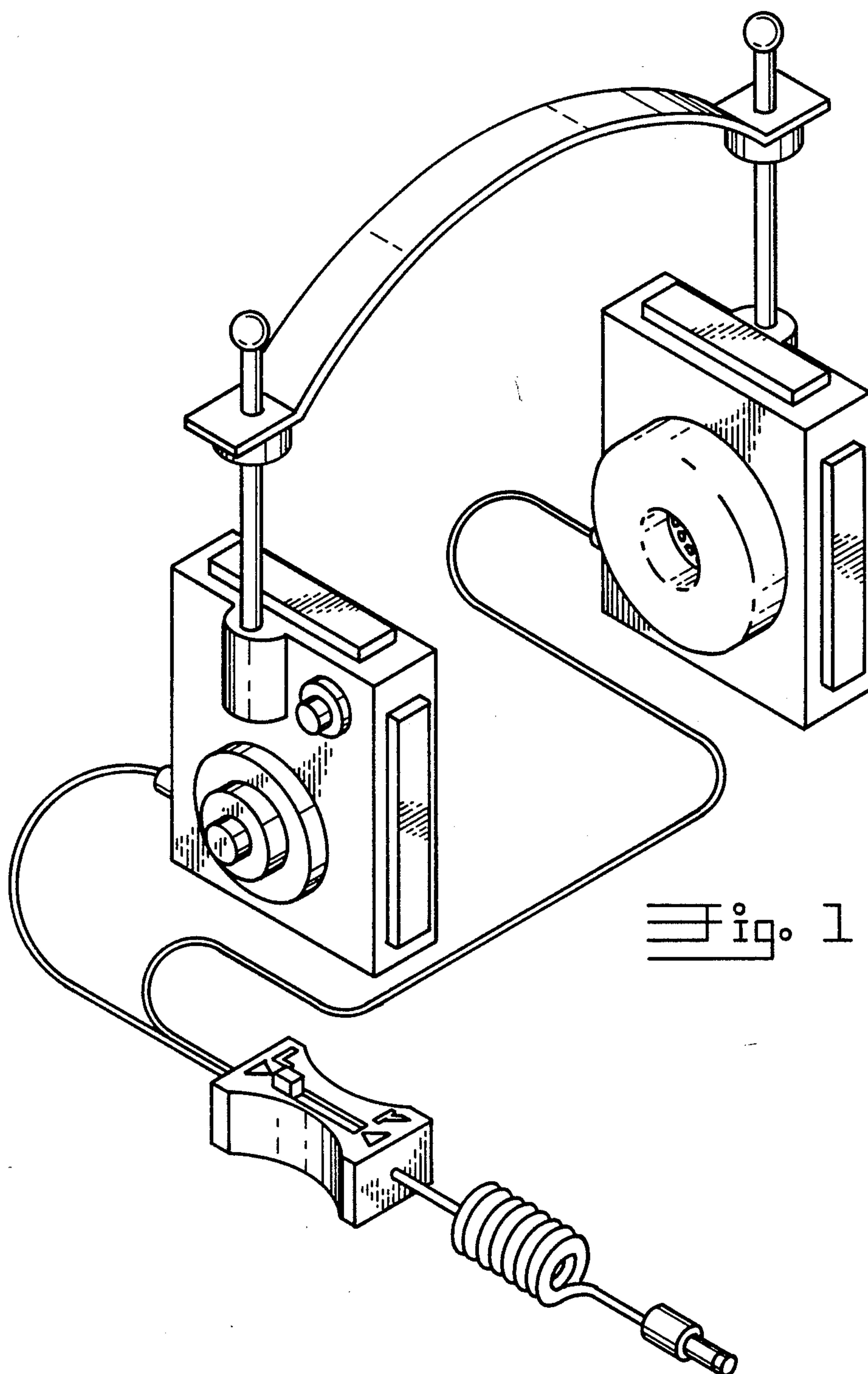
