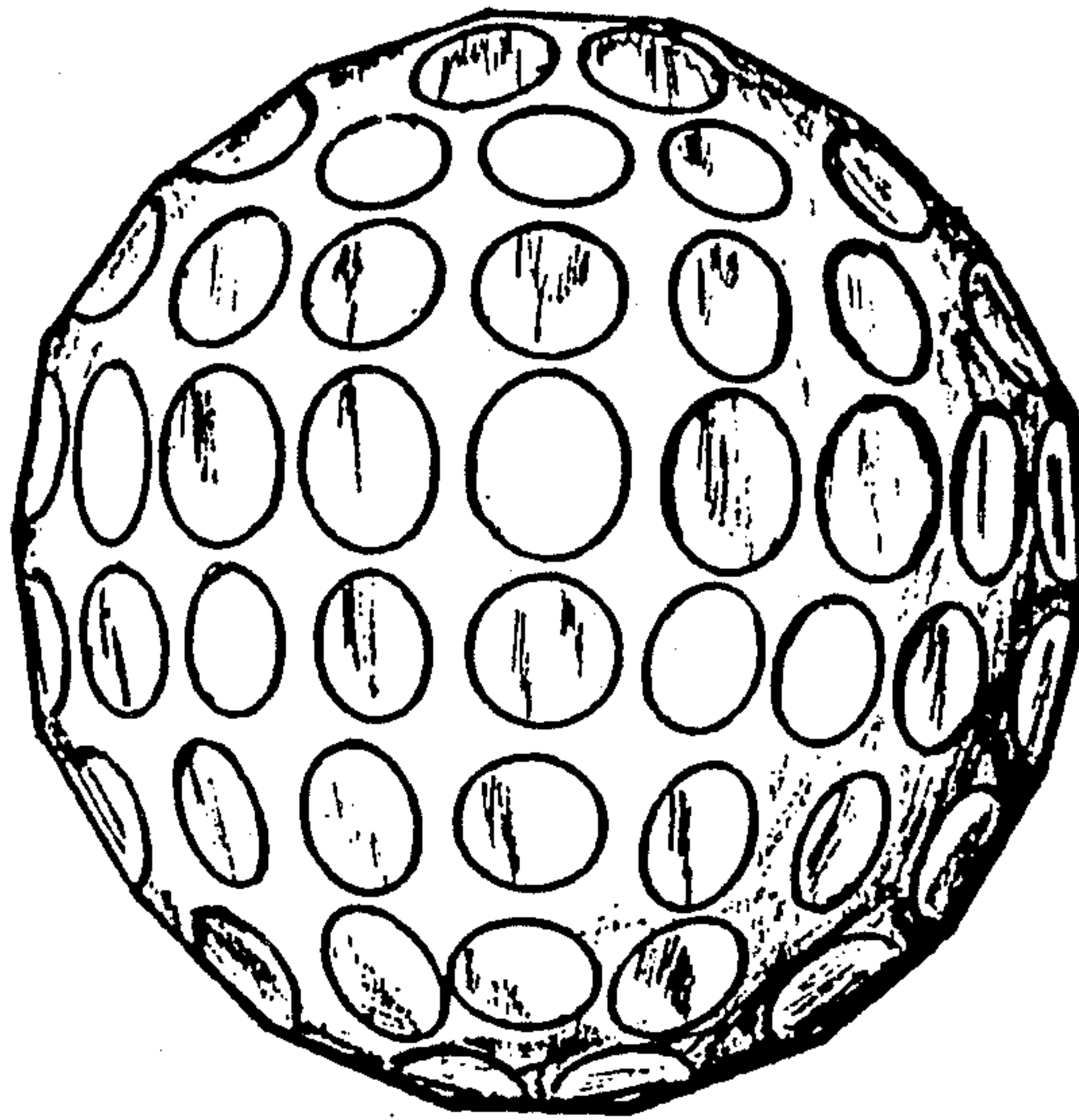
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spherically shaped game die as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the spherically shaped game die showing my new design; the rear is a mirror image of the front.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view, in which a portion of the facets have been omitted for ease of illustration, of the spherically shaped game die shown in FIG. 1; the bottom is a mirror image of the top.



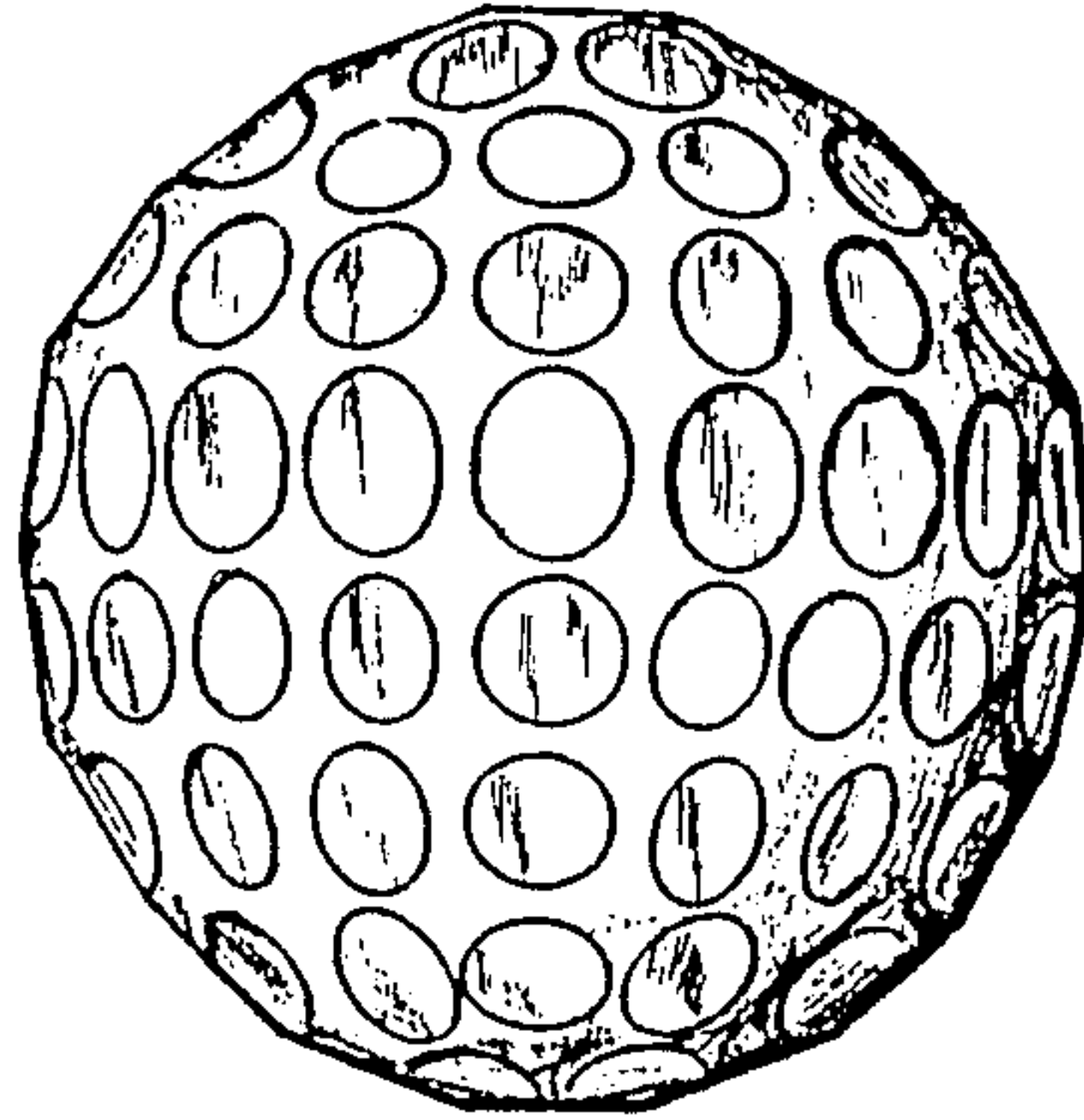

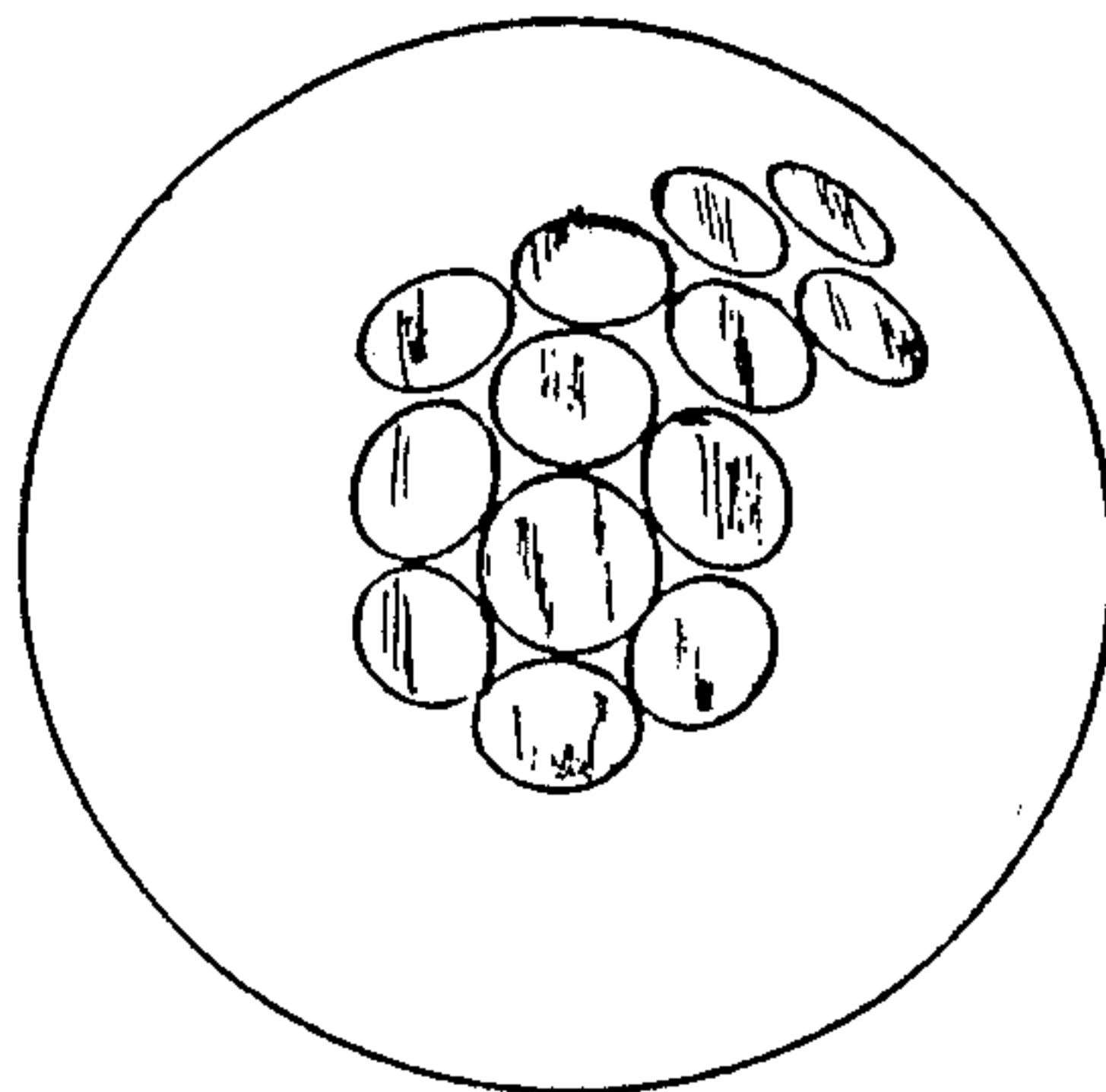
