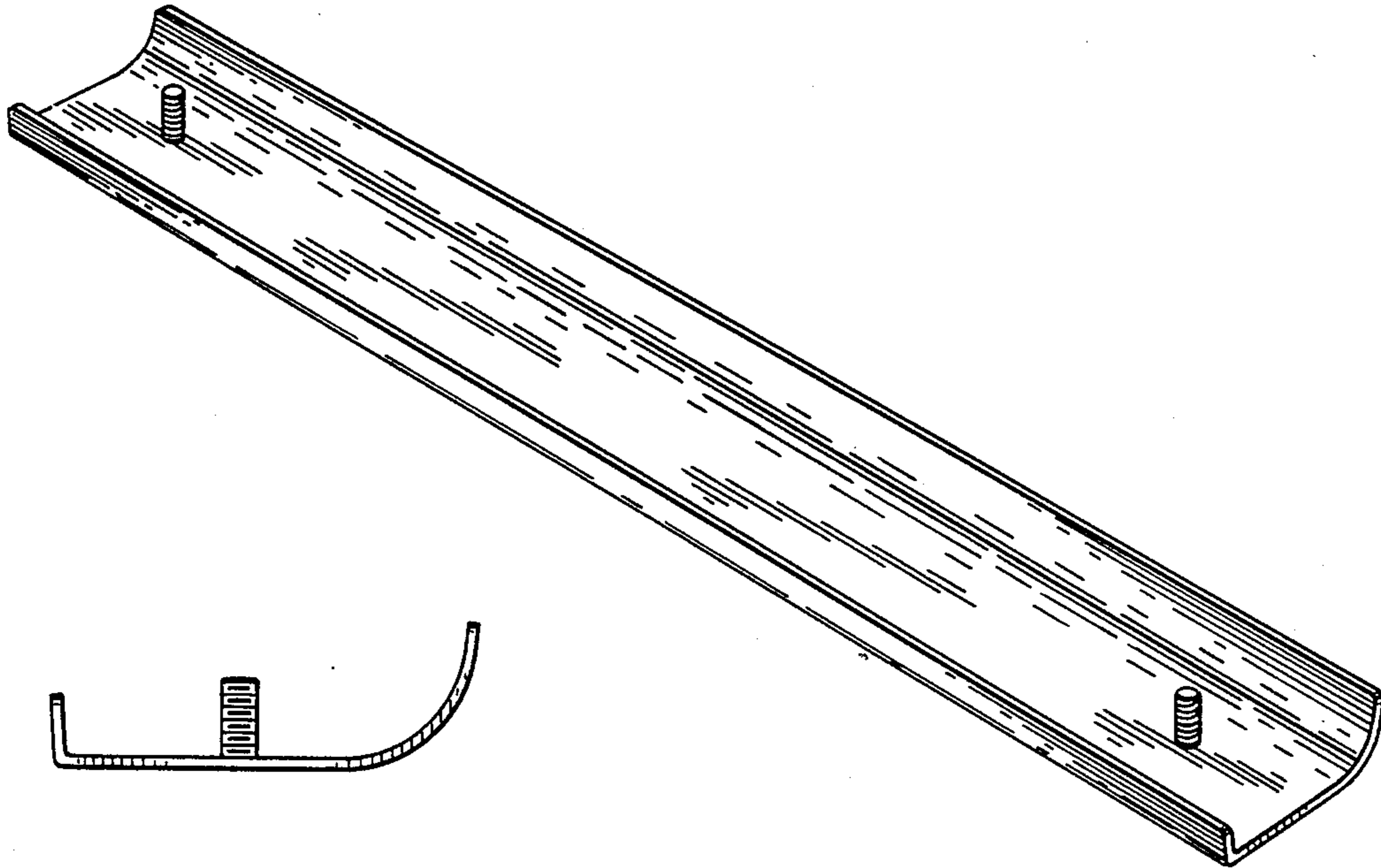

The ornamental design for a file board shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a file board shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



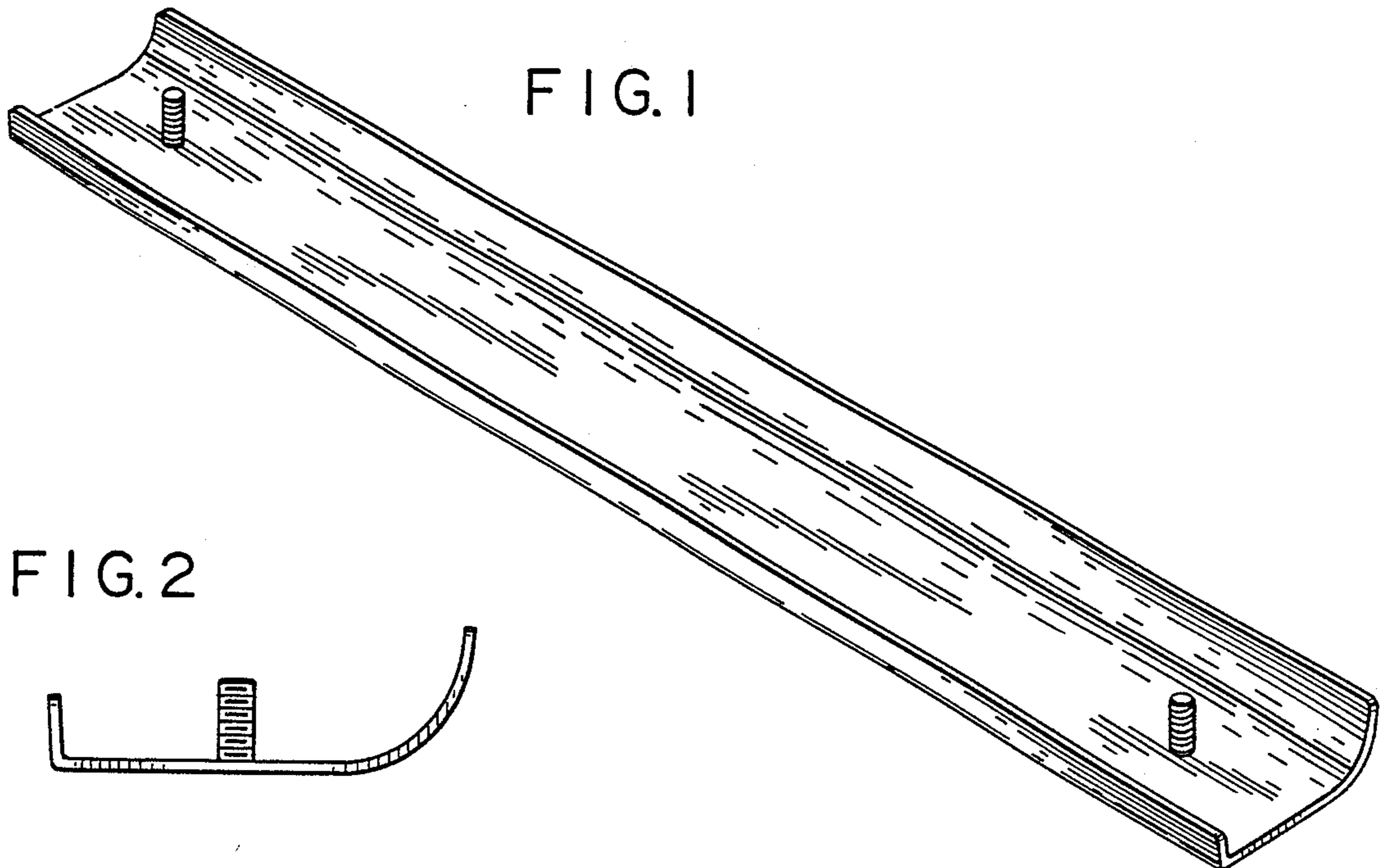

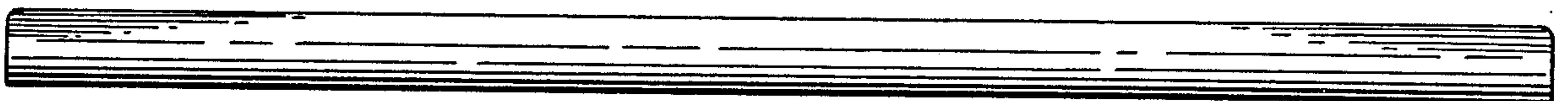

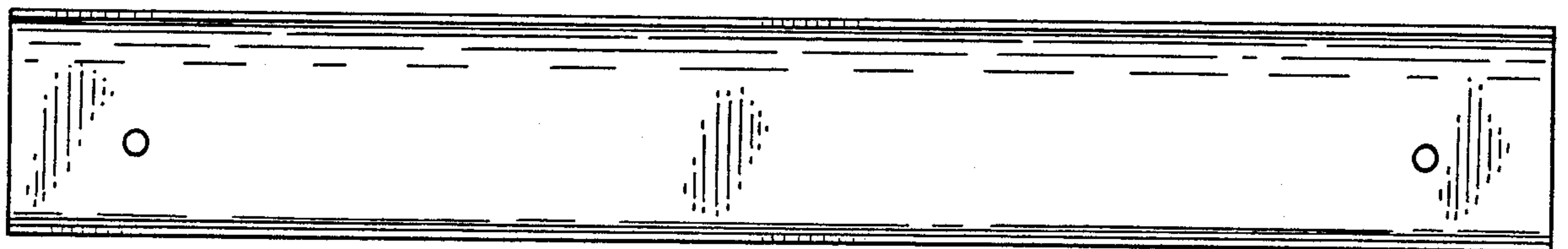

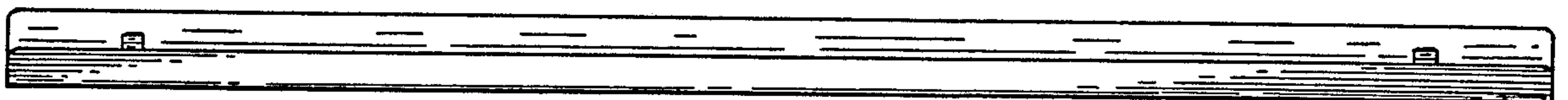
