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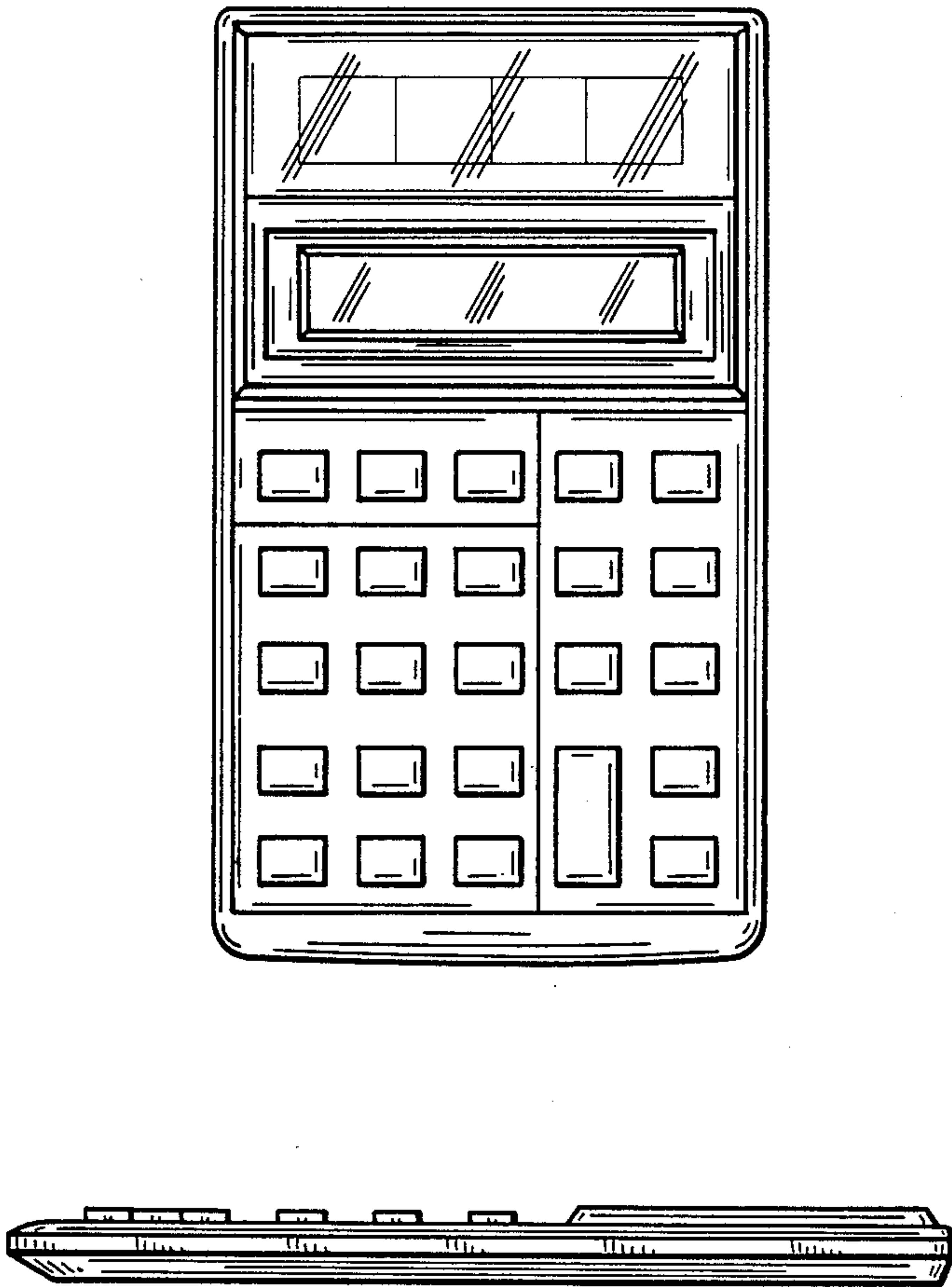

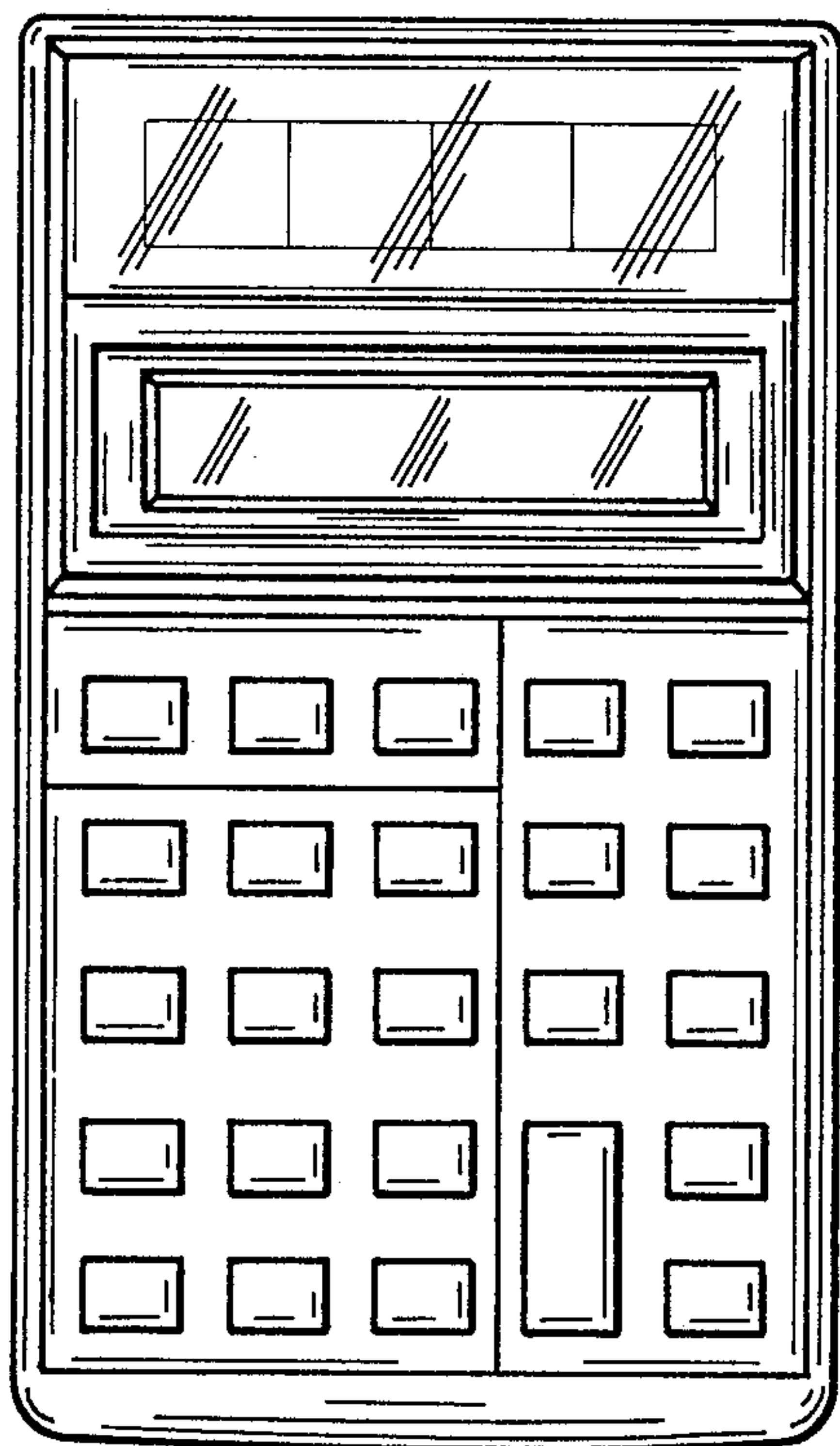

The ornamental design for an electronic calculator, as shown and described.

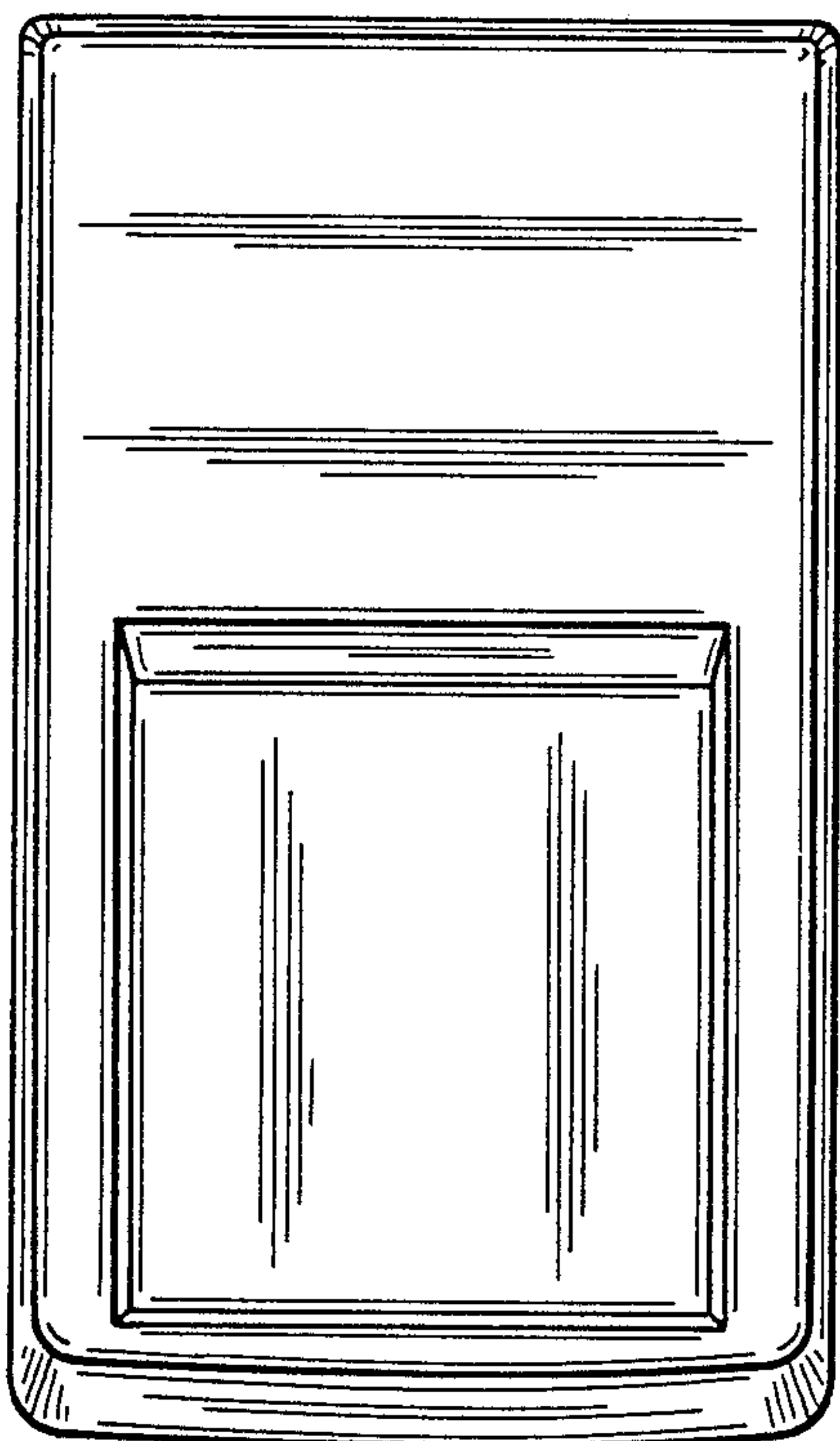
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

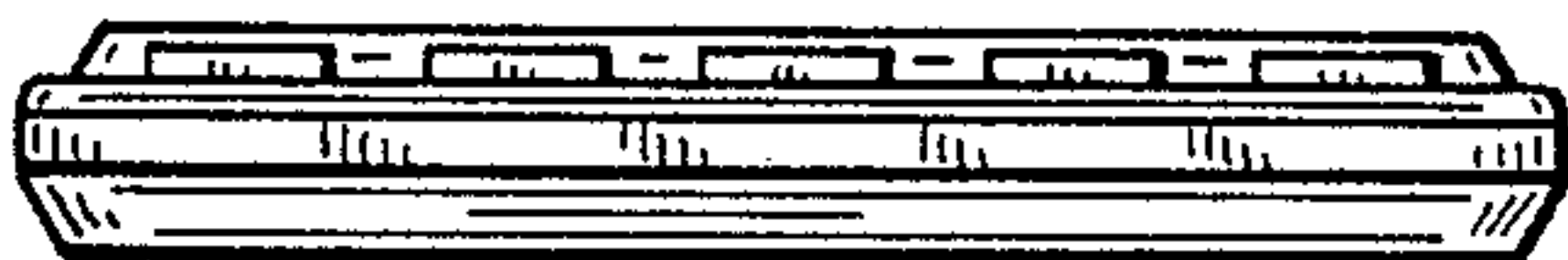




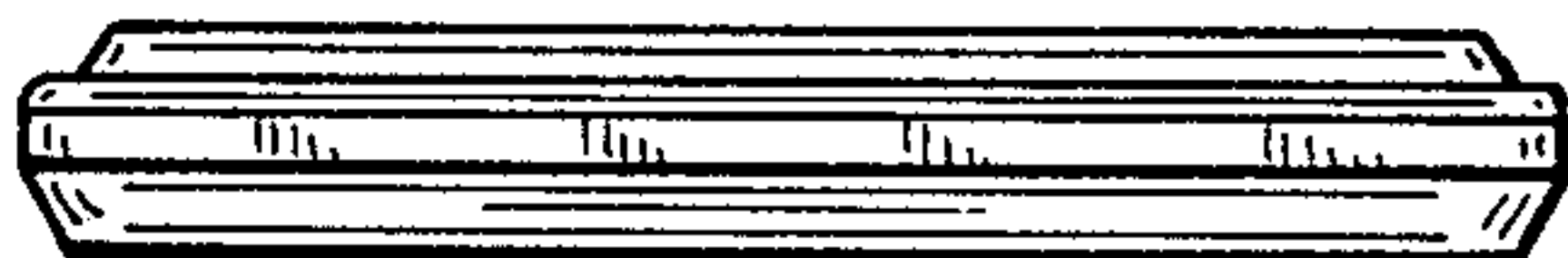

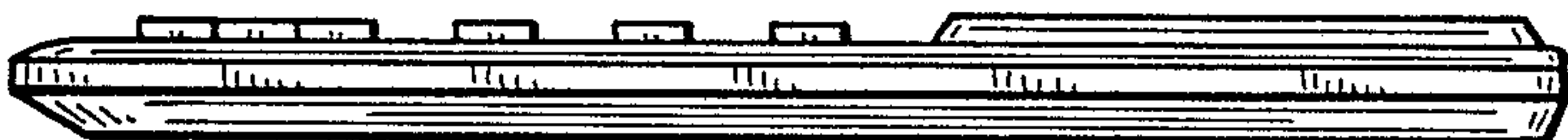
