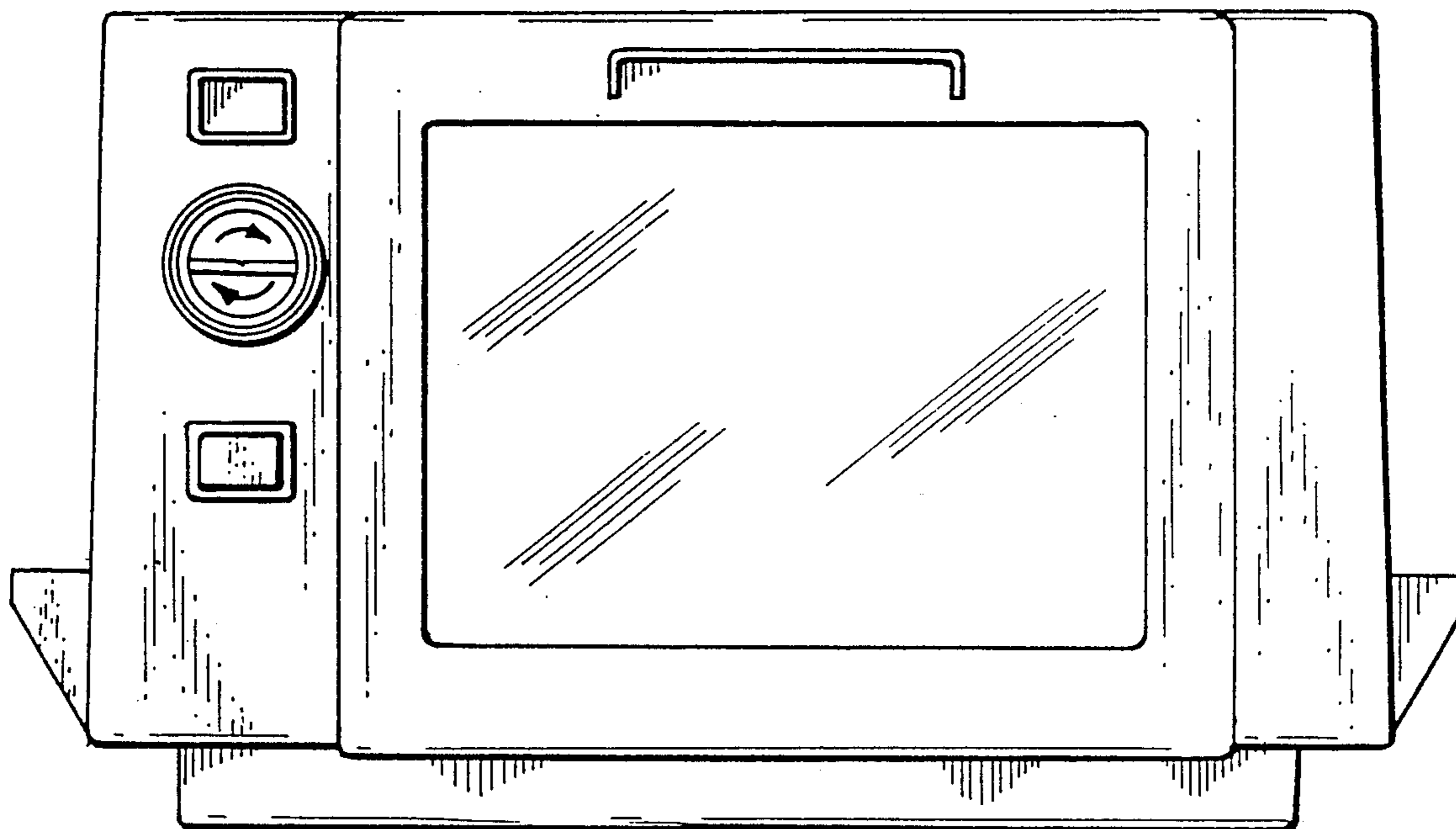

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front-elevational view of a toy oven showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



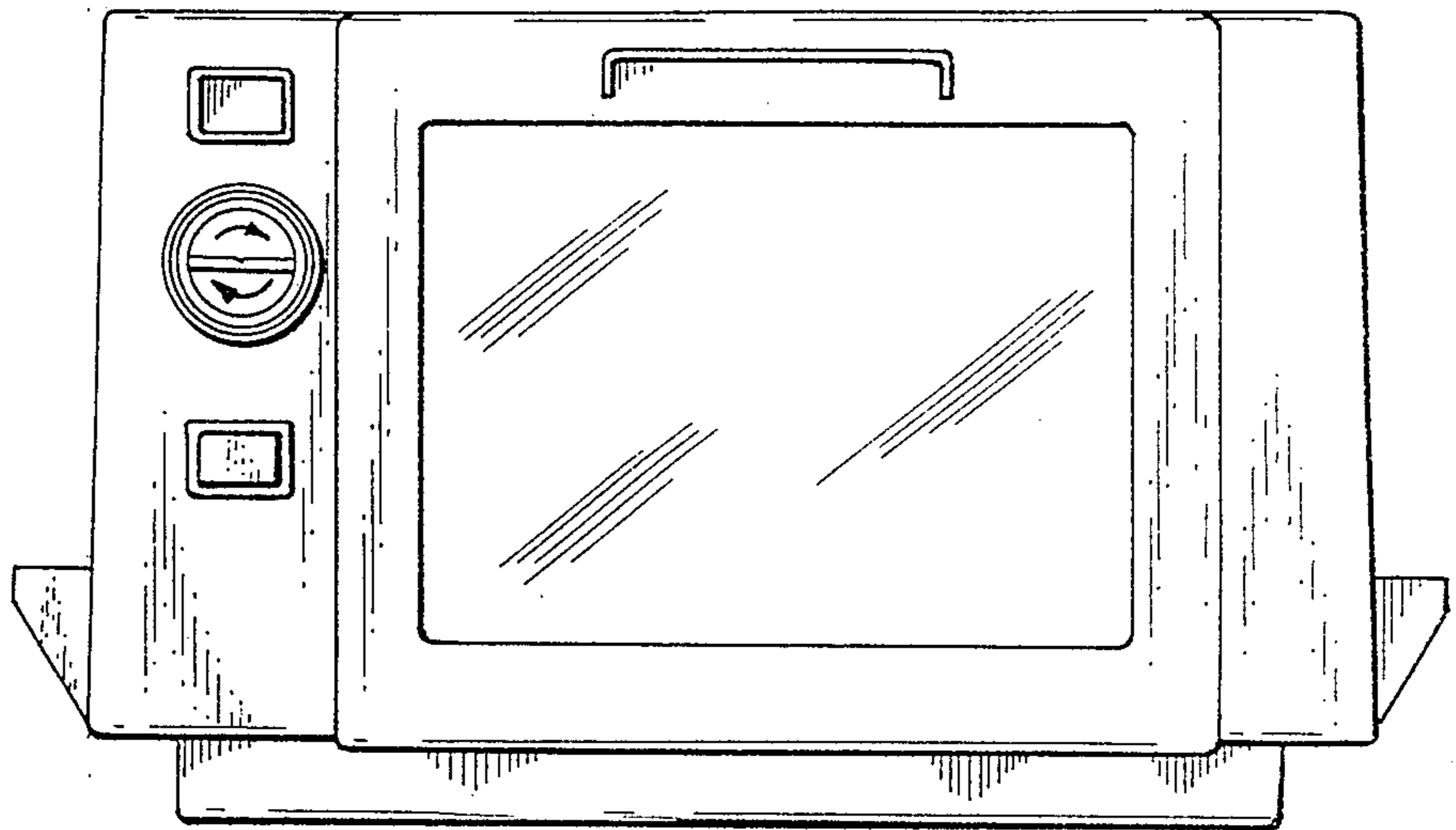

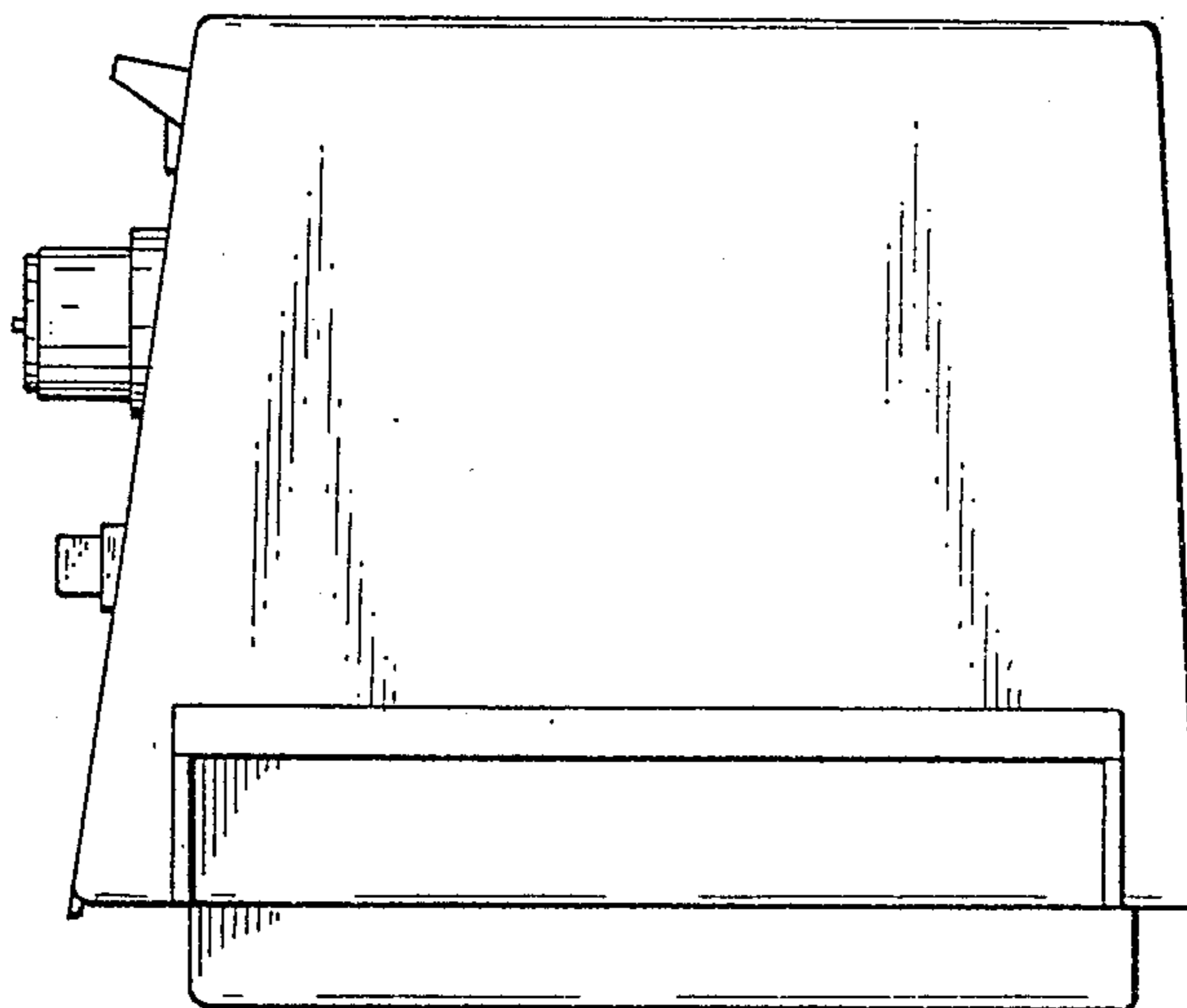

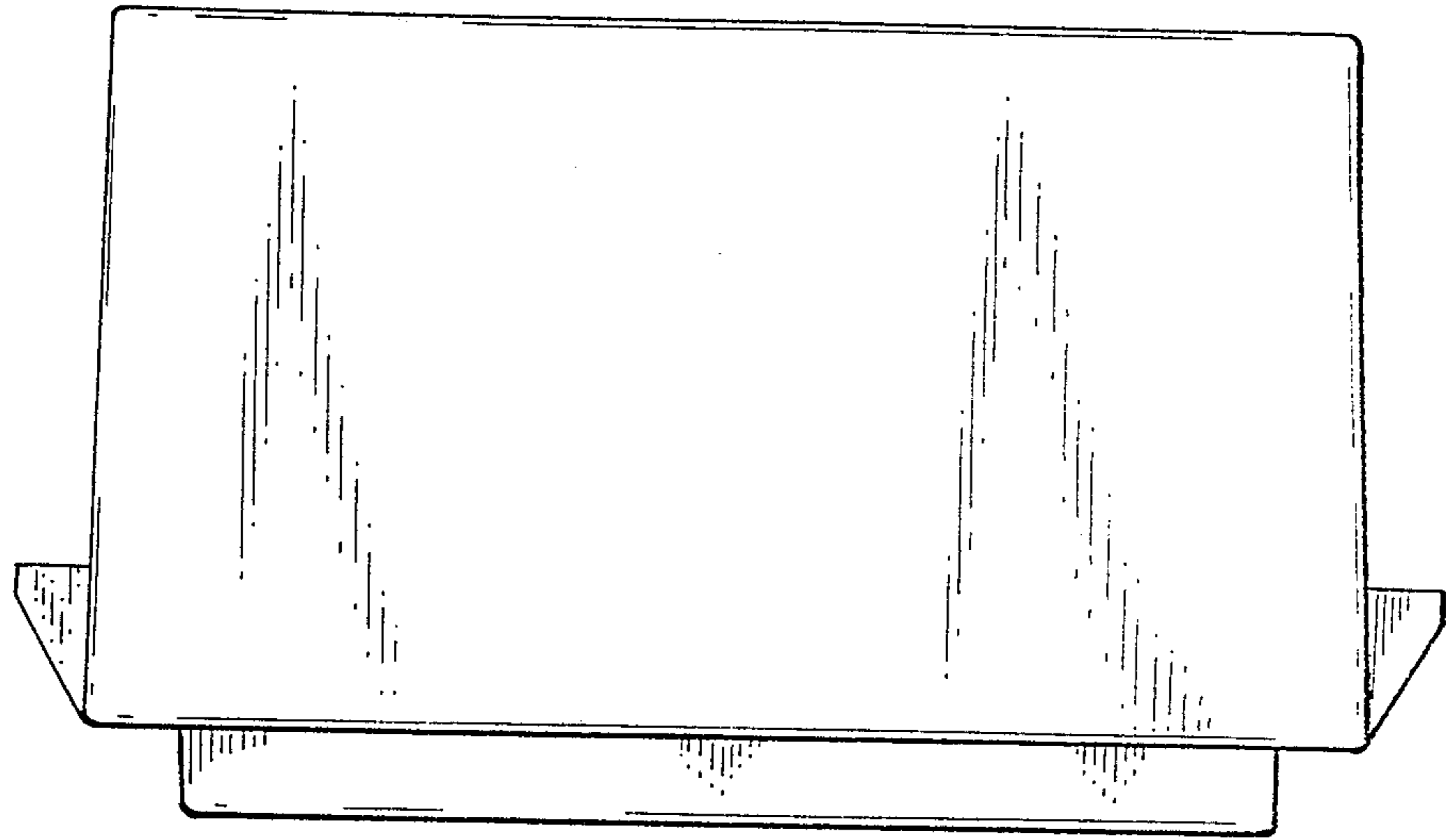

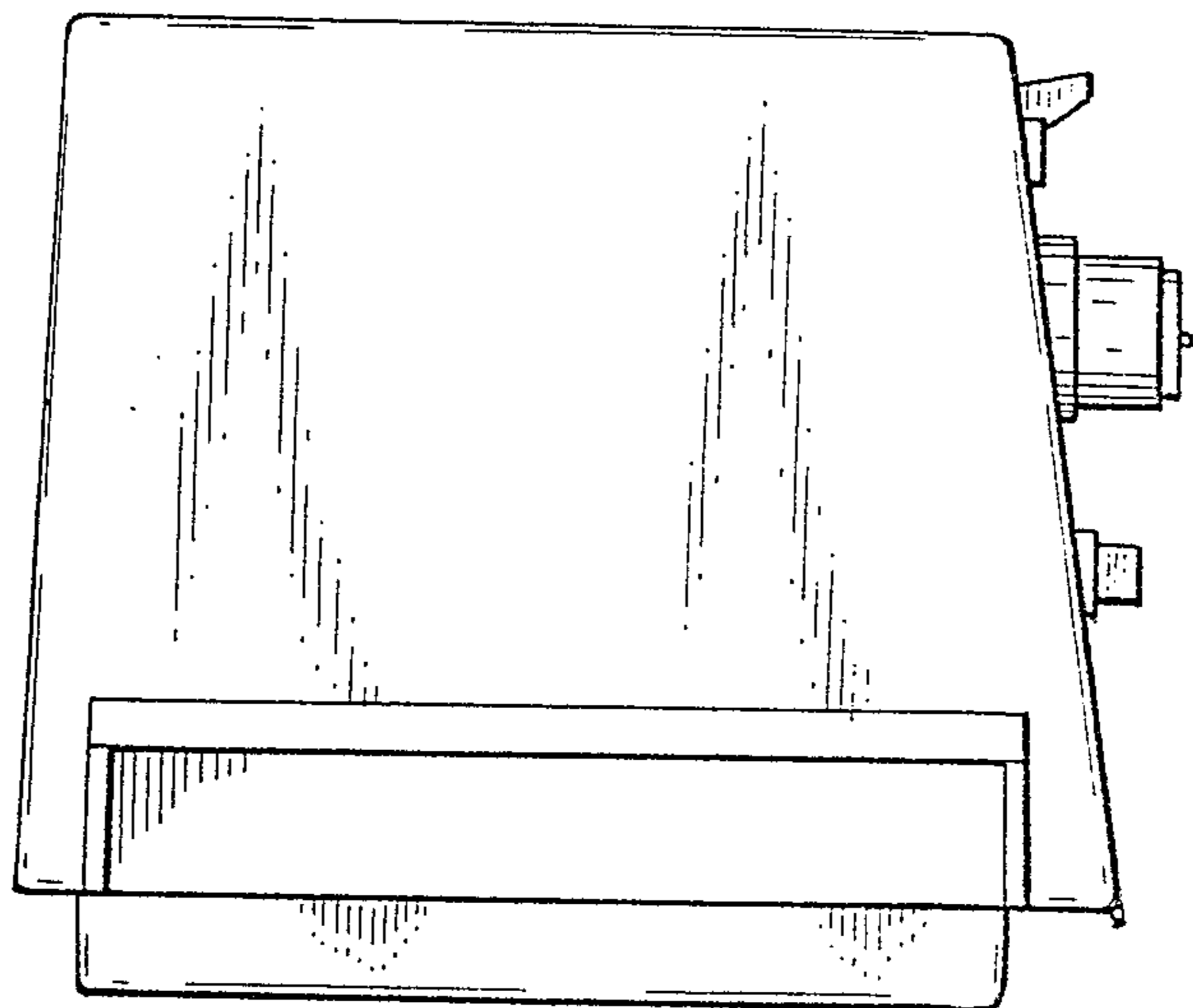

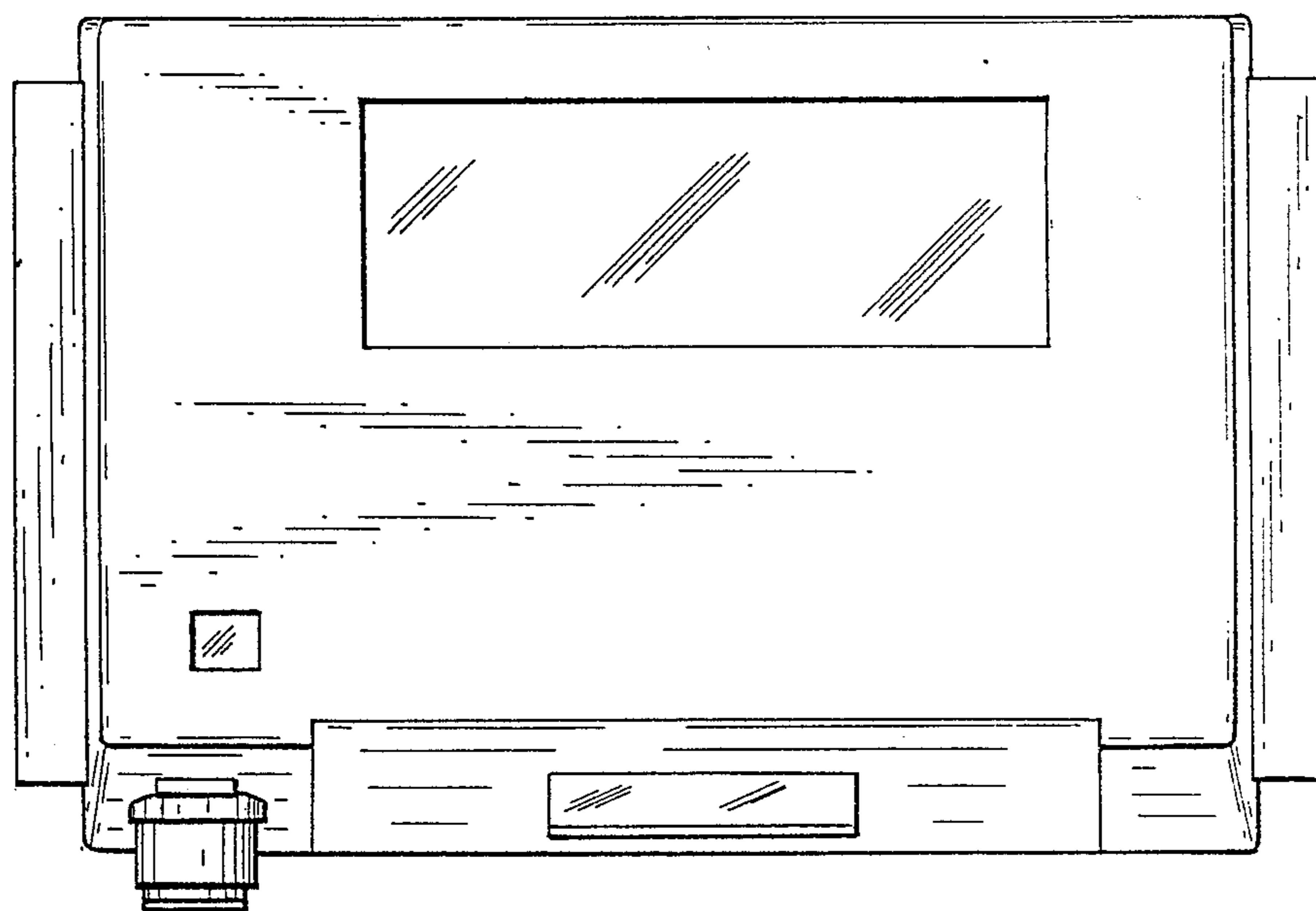

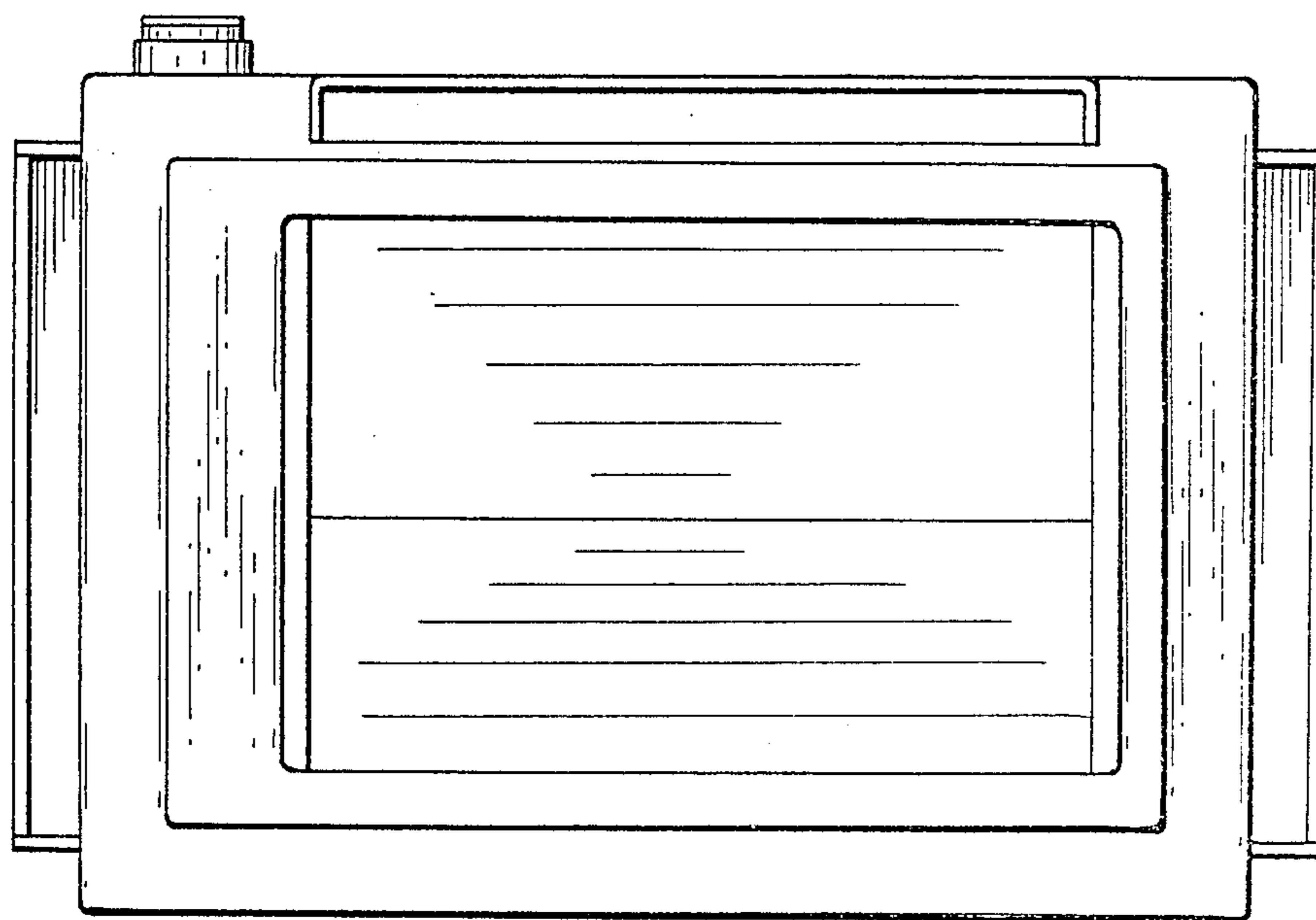
