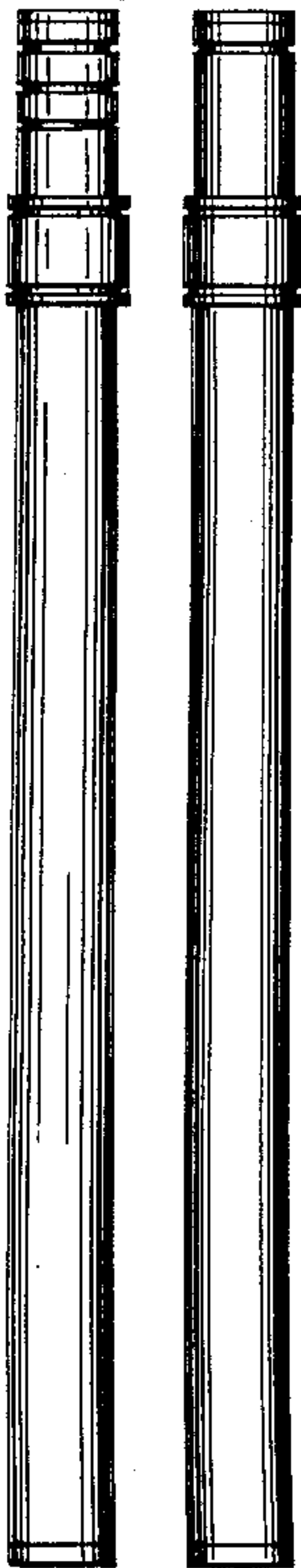

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a table leg or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a table leg or the like showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the side elevational views being identical thereto;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a typical side elevational view of an alternative embodiment of my table leg or the like shown in FIG. 1 the top and bottom views being identical to that shown in FIGS. 4 and 5 respectively.
The broken line showing of attachment holes in FIGS. 3 and 5 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



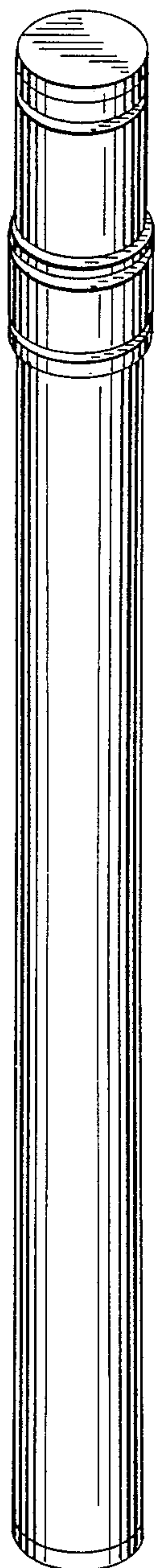

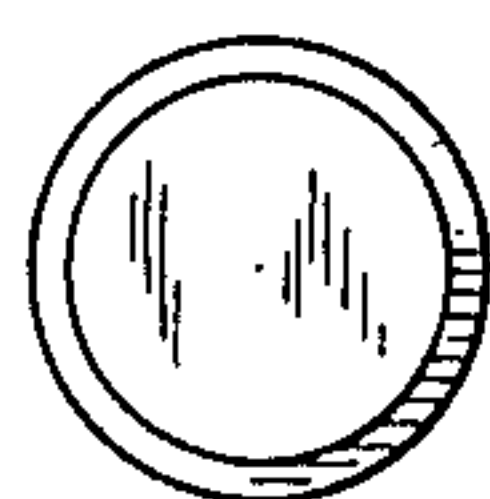
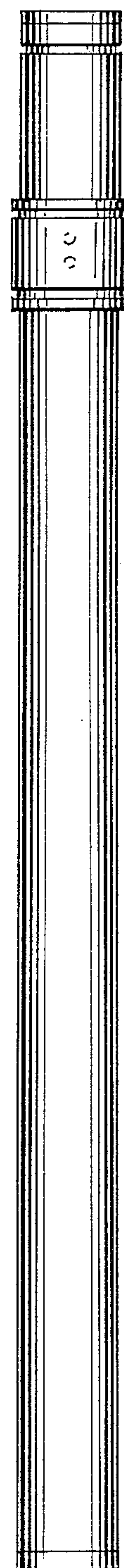
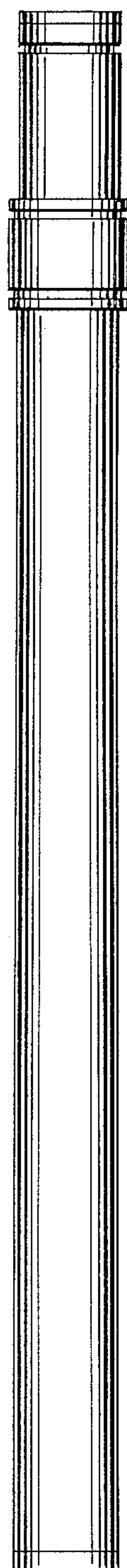
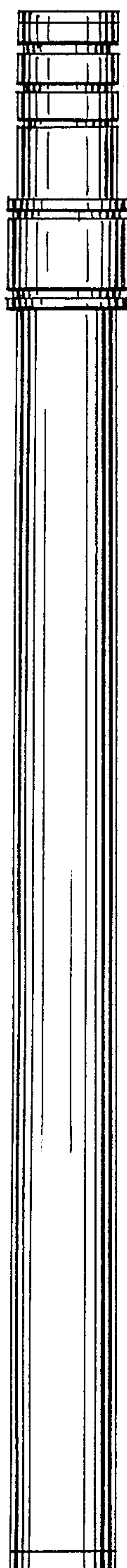

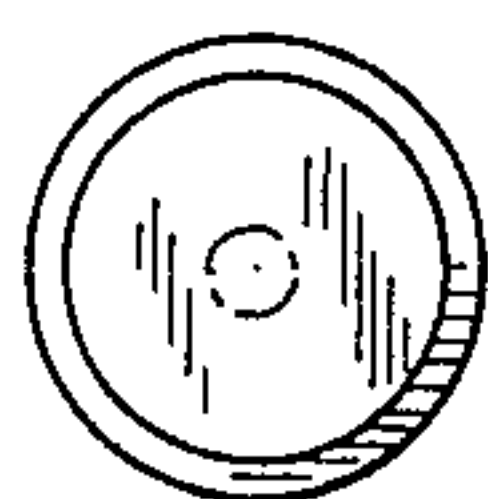
