[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a battery-powered sharpener for fish hooks or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a battery powered sharpener for fish hooks or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

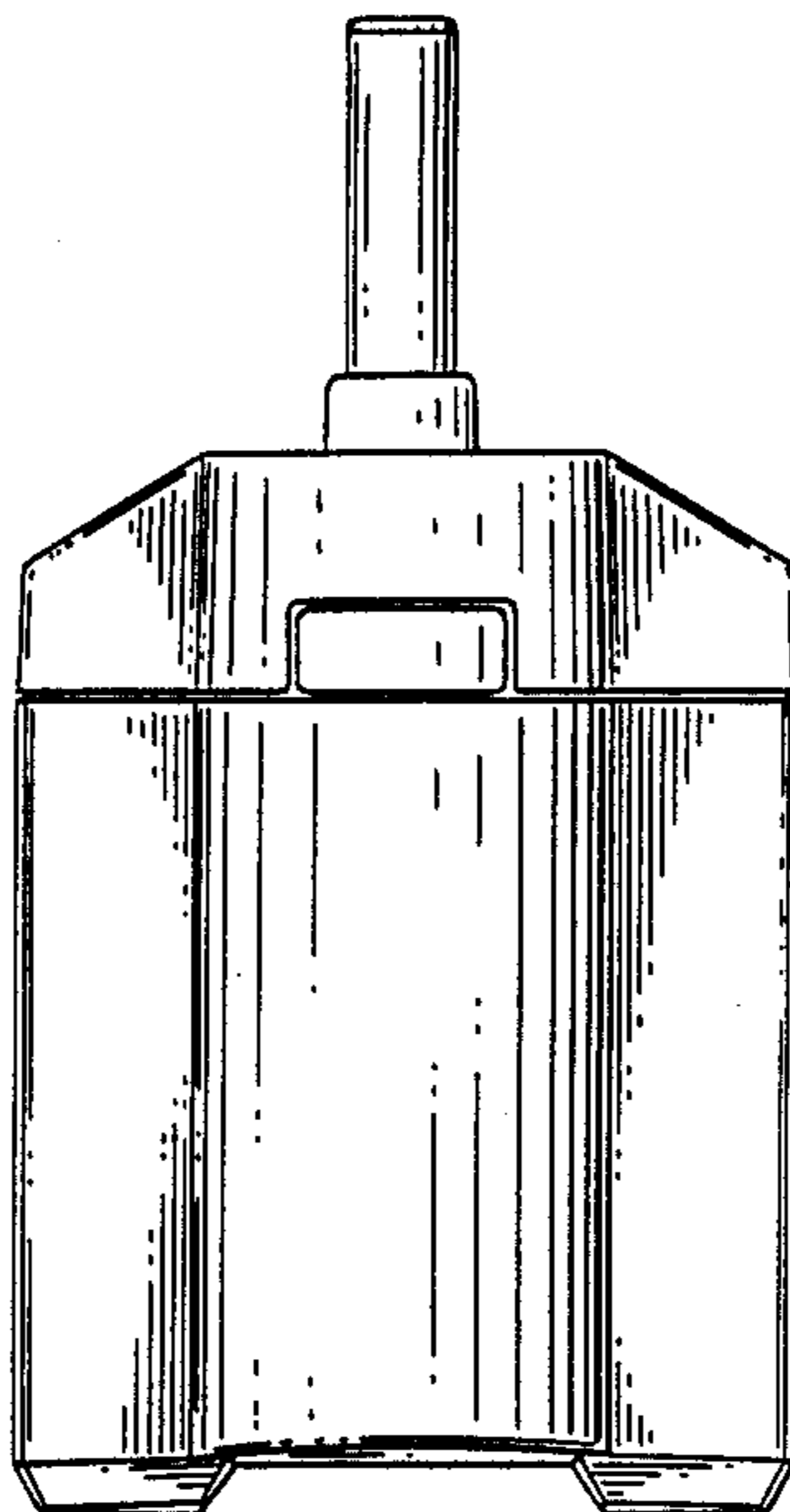

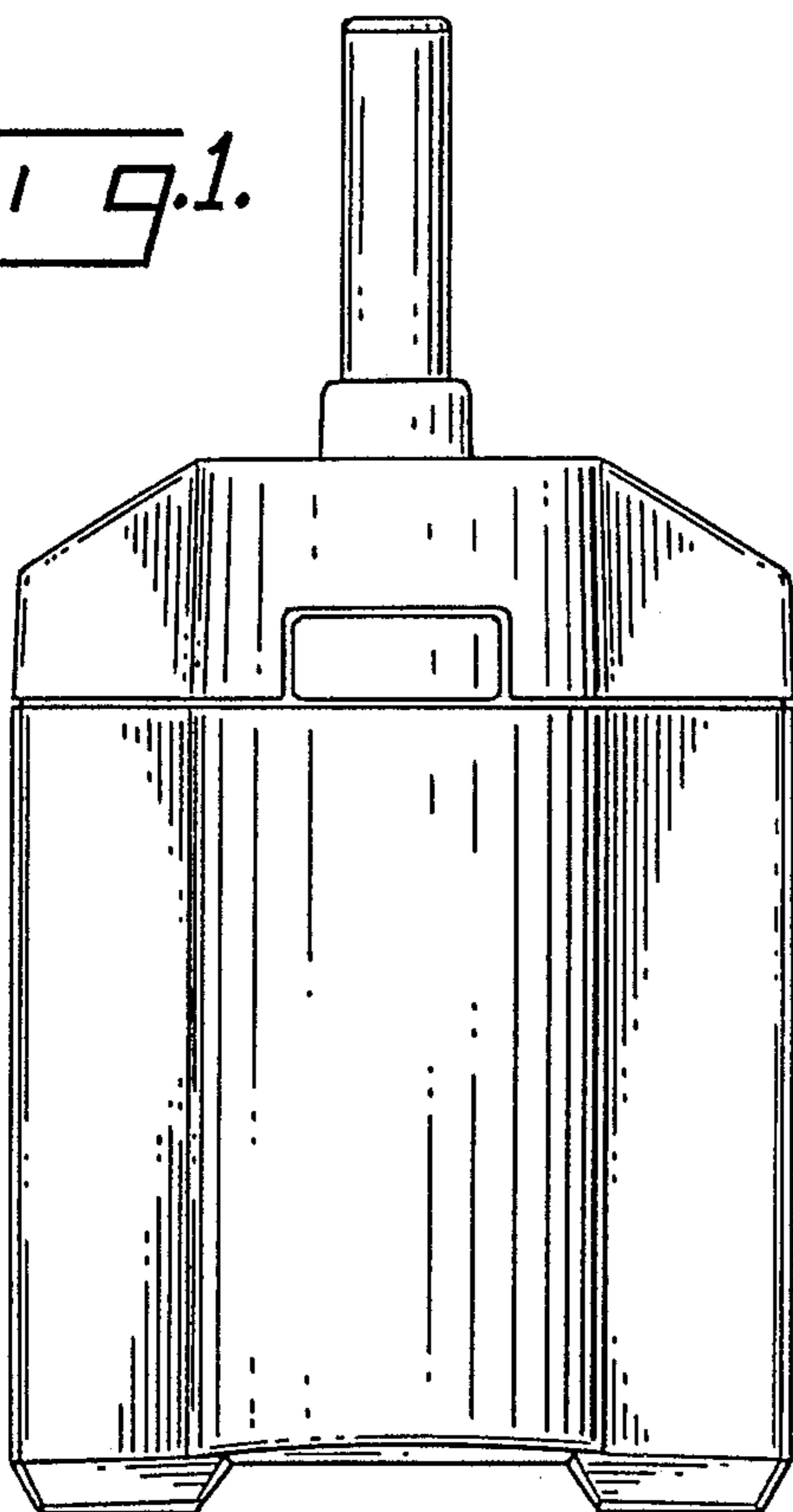

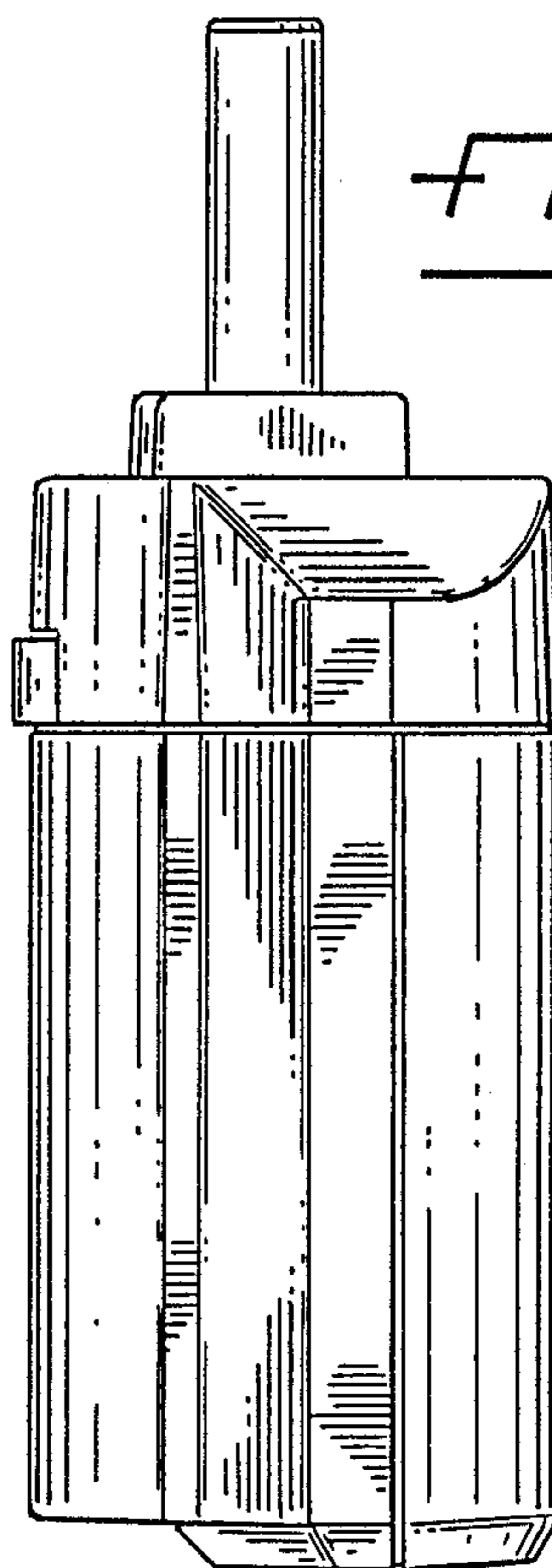

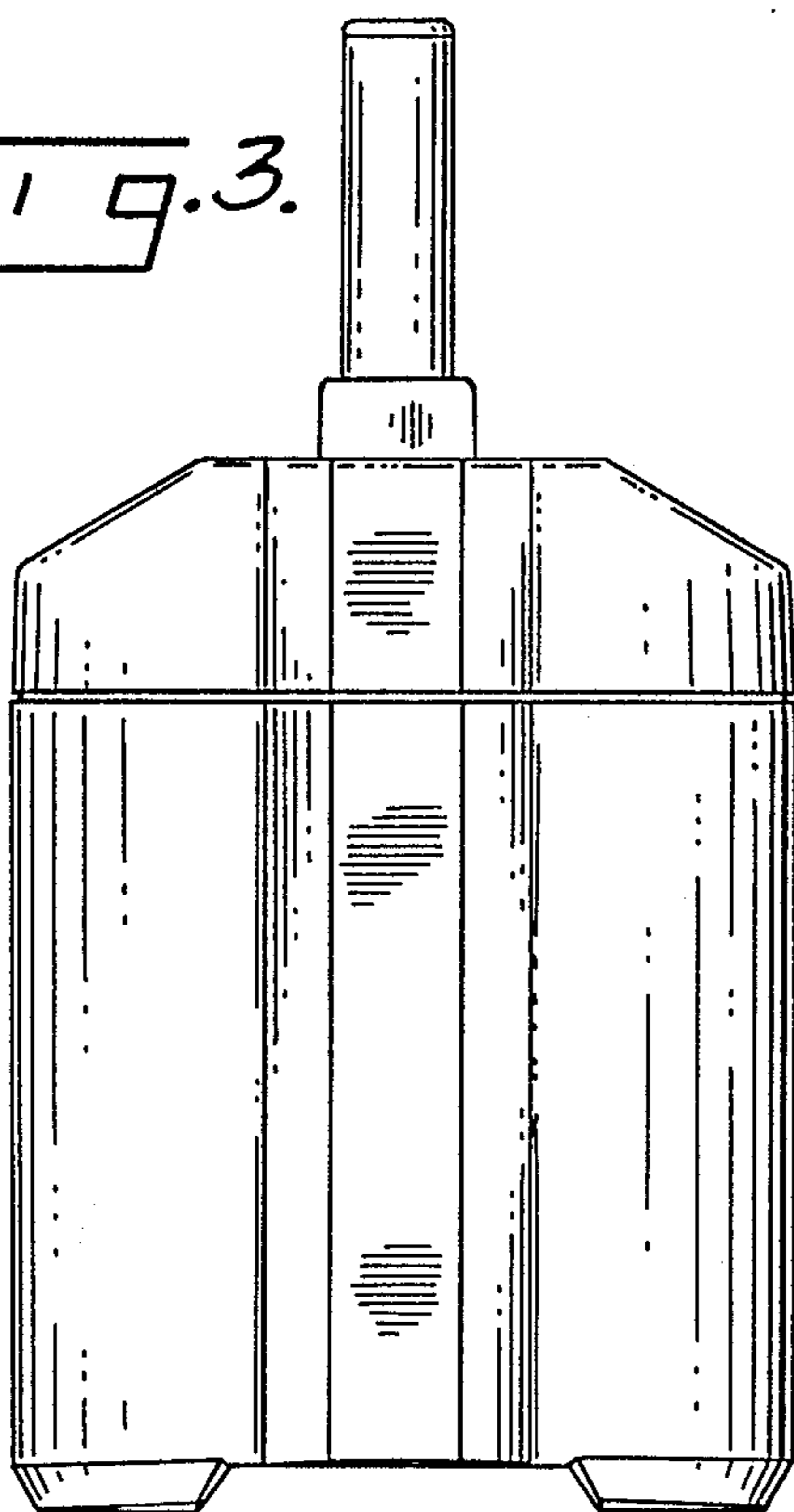

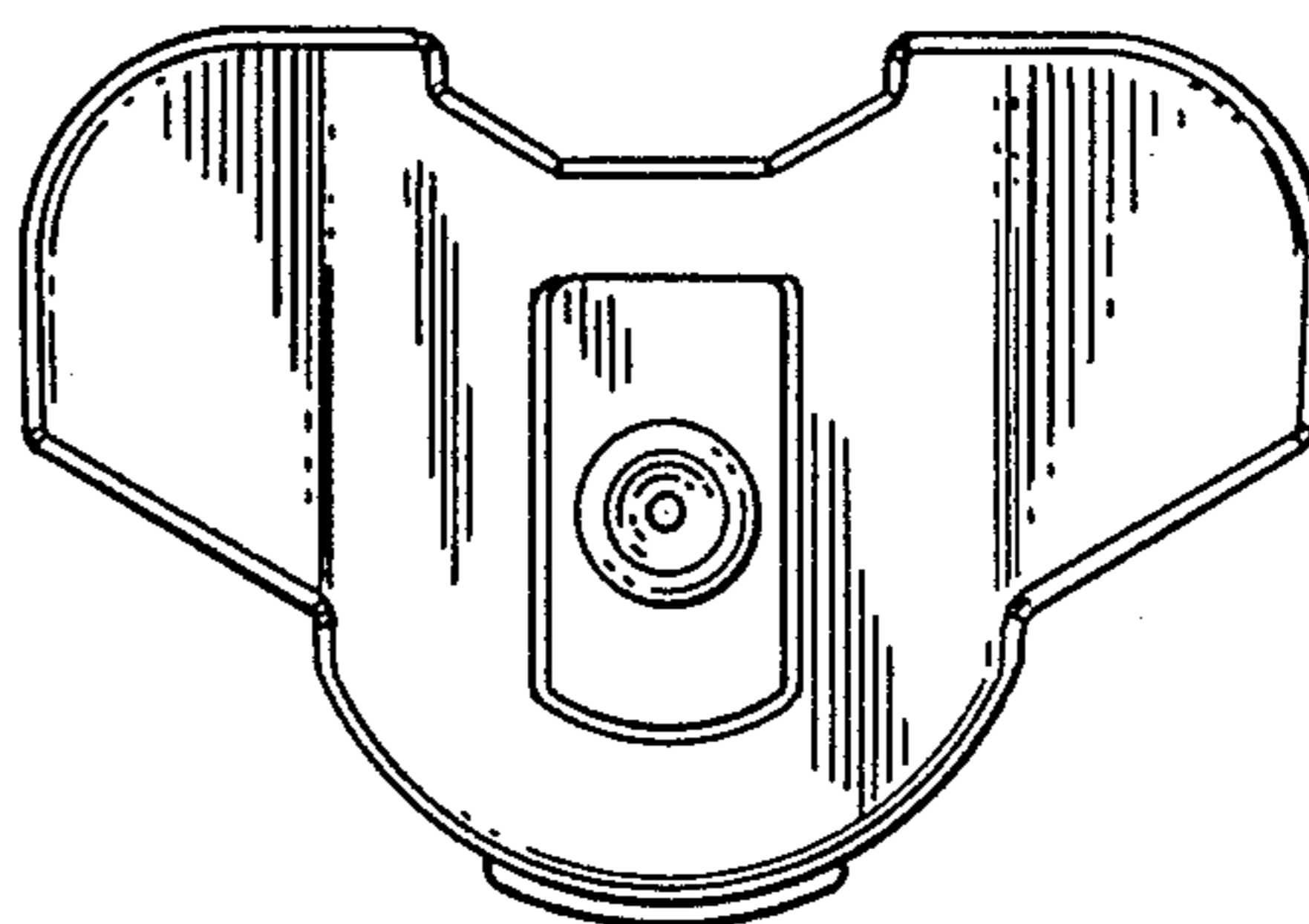
