The ornamental design for a jar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a jar embodying our new design; the rear being identical;  
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; both sides being identical;  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1; the rear being identical;  
 FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 5, both sides being identical.

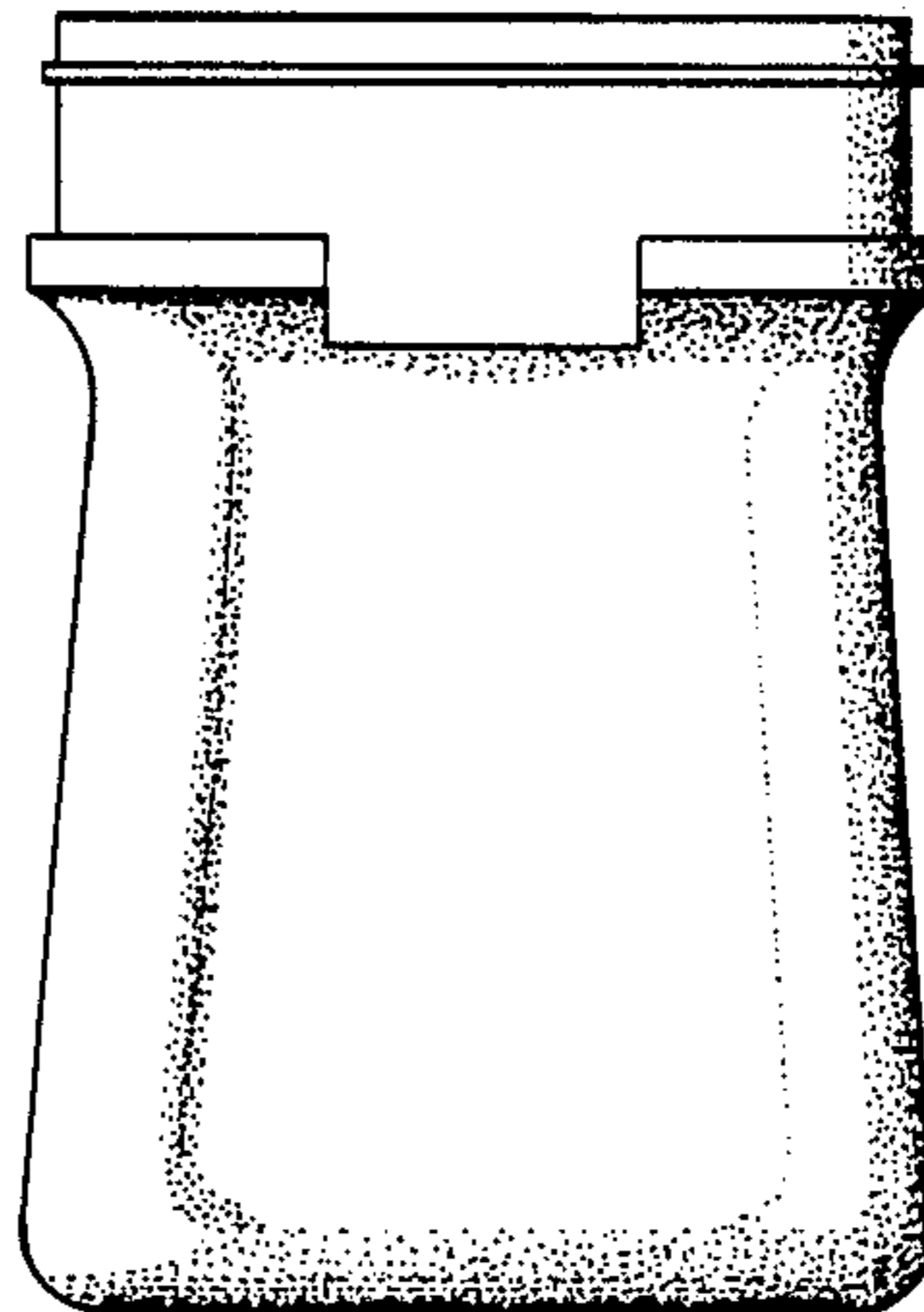
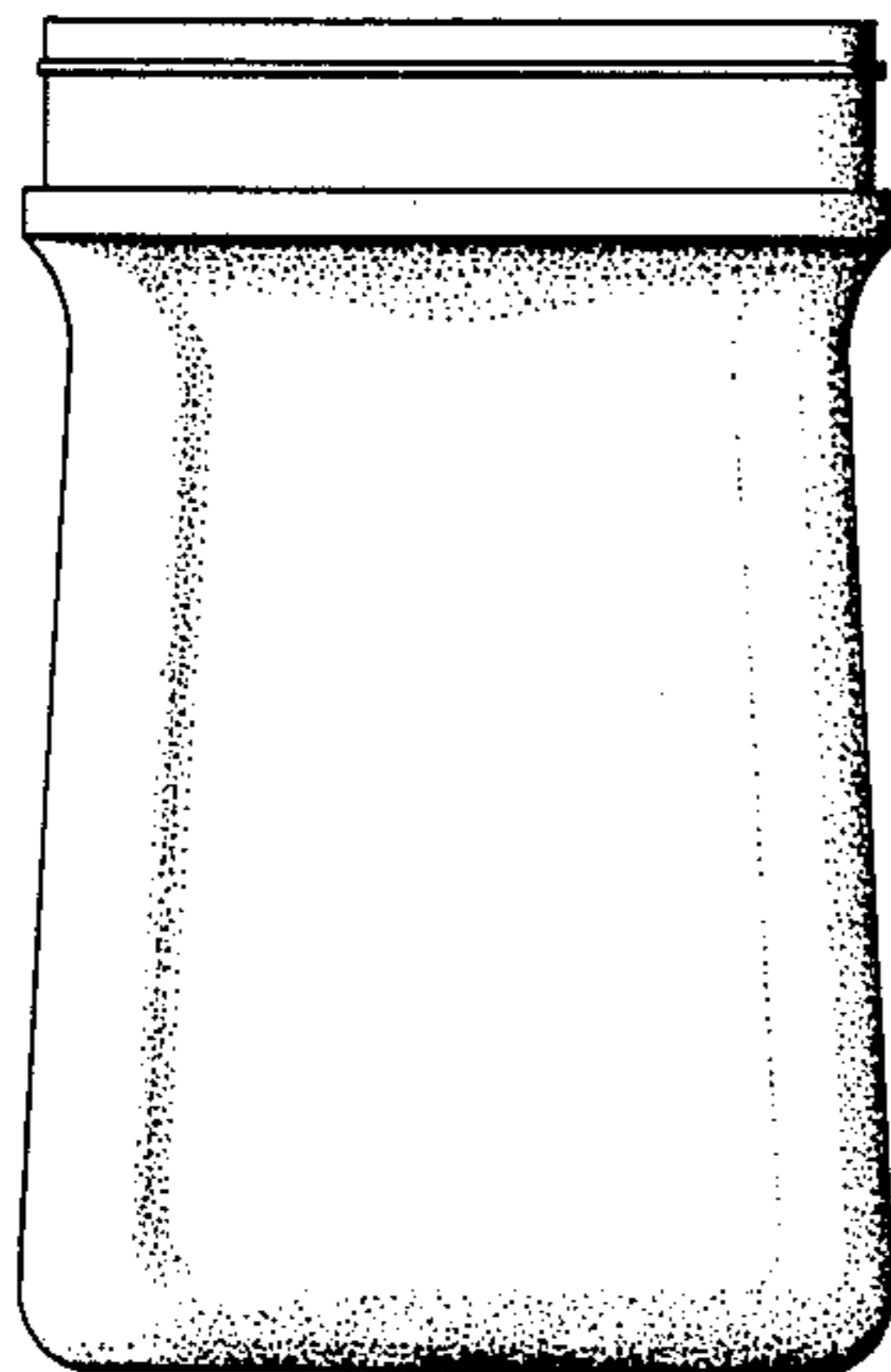
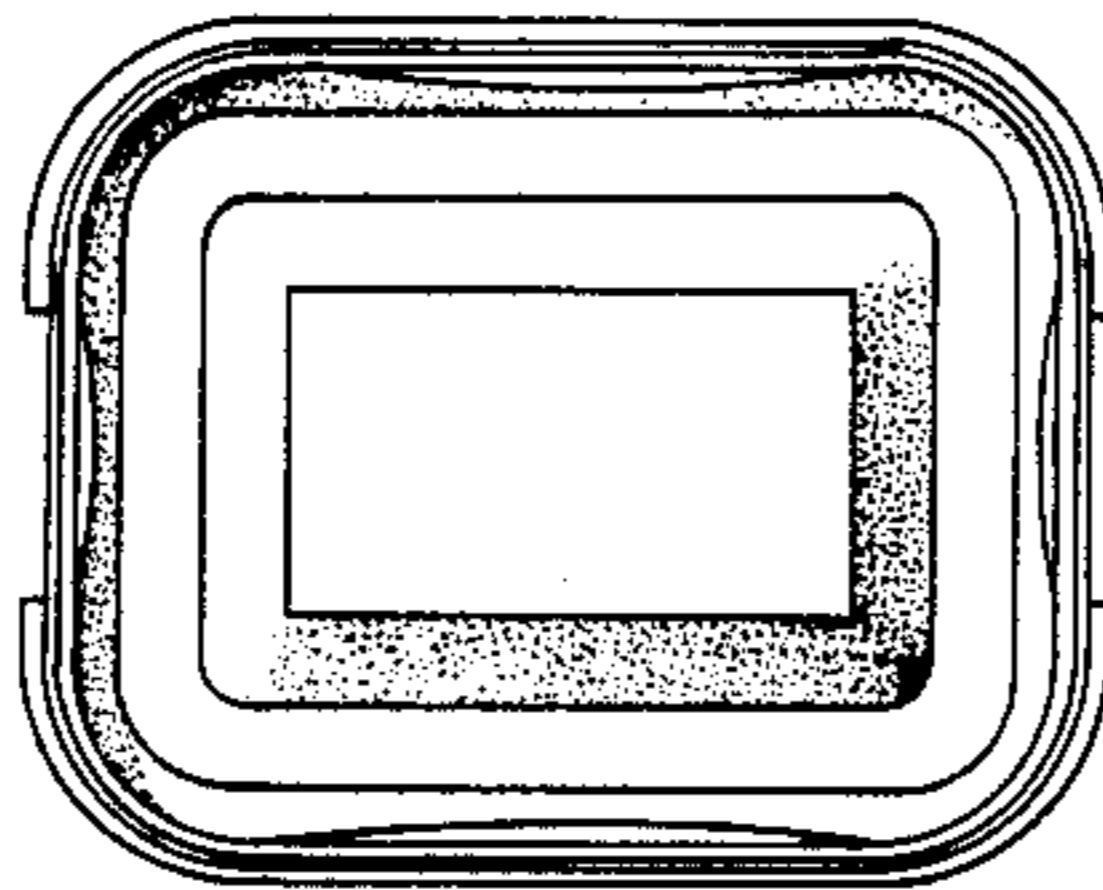

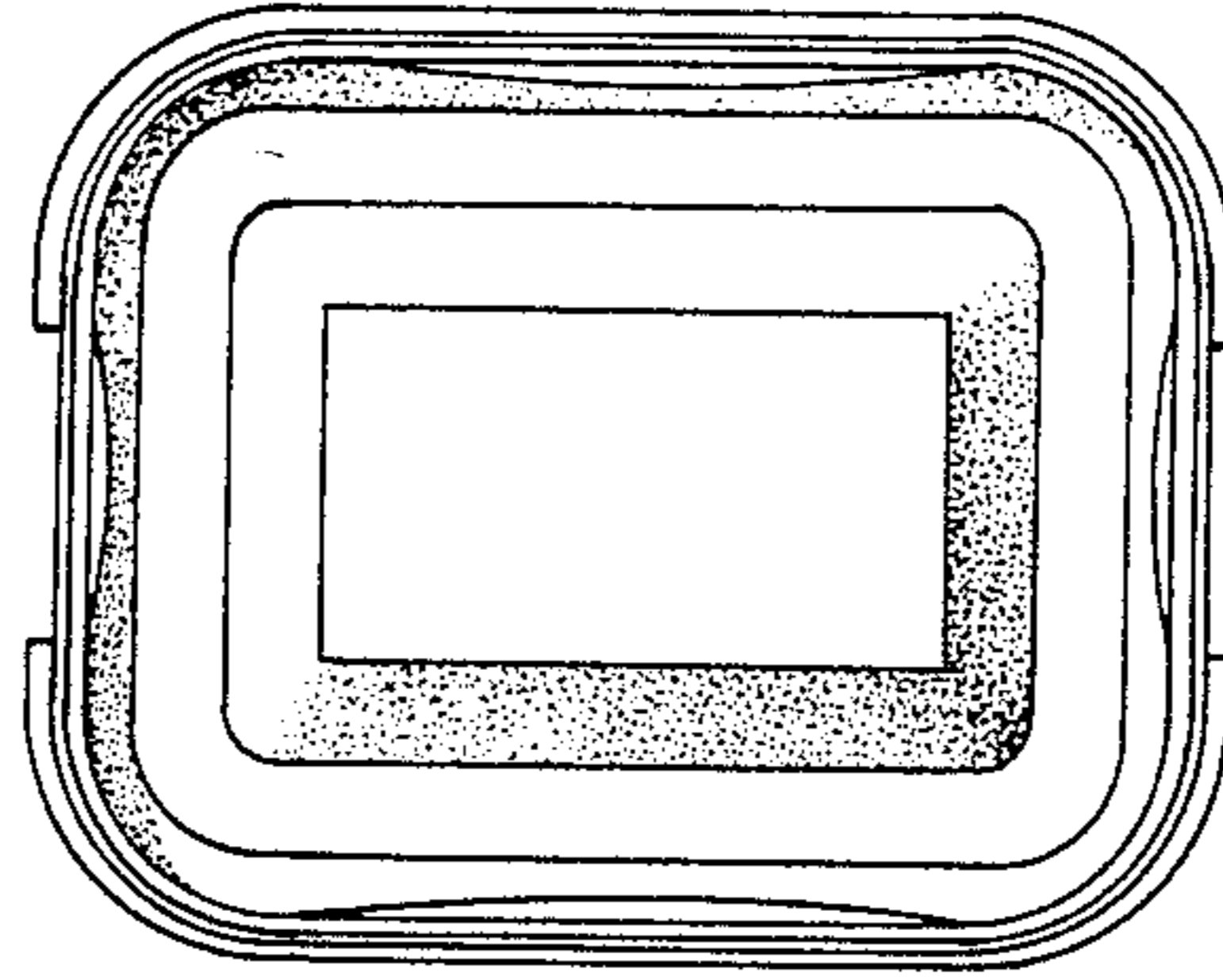

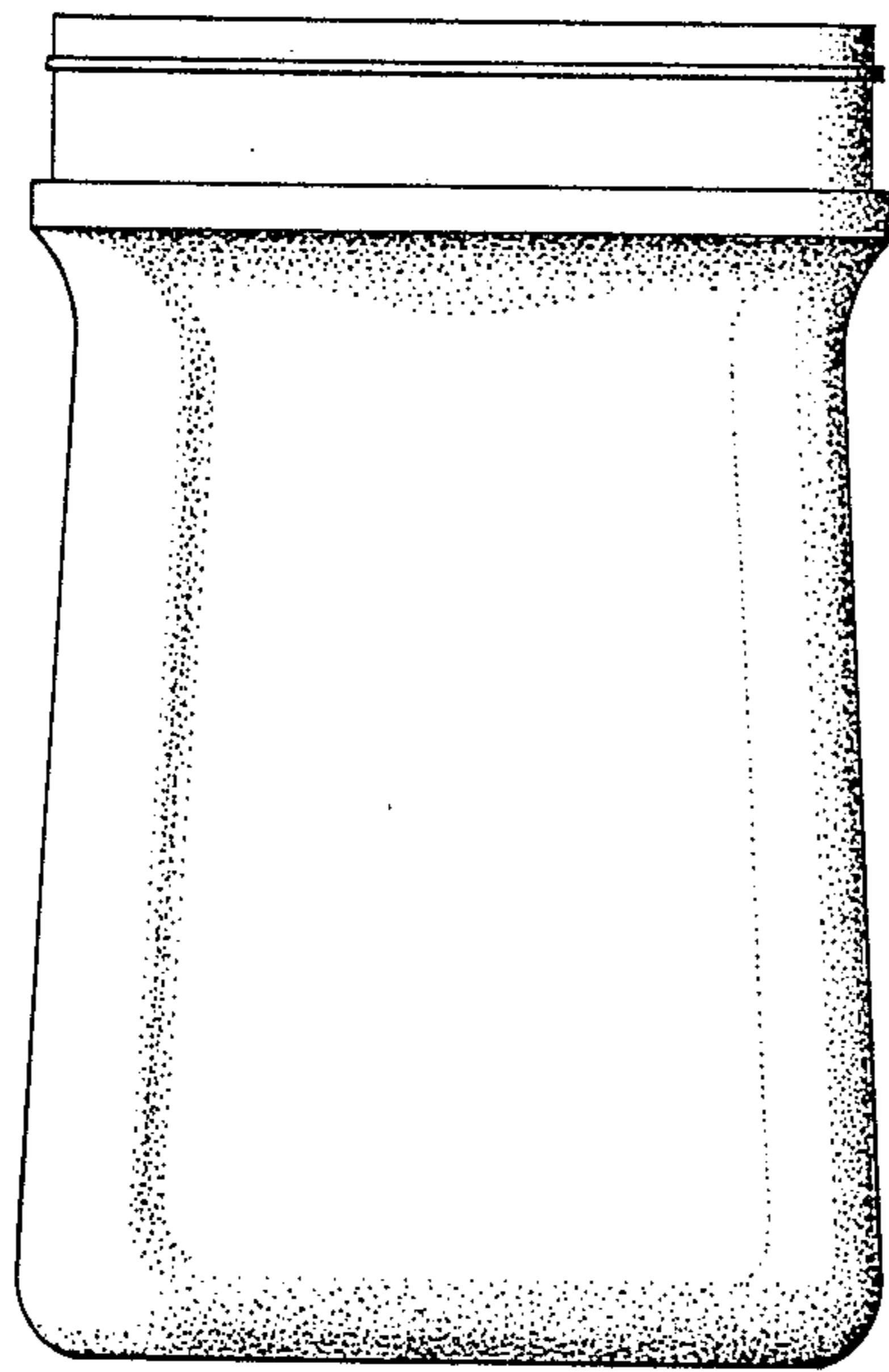

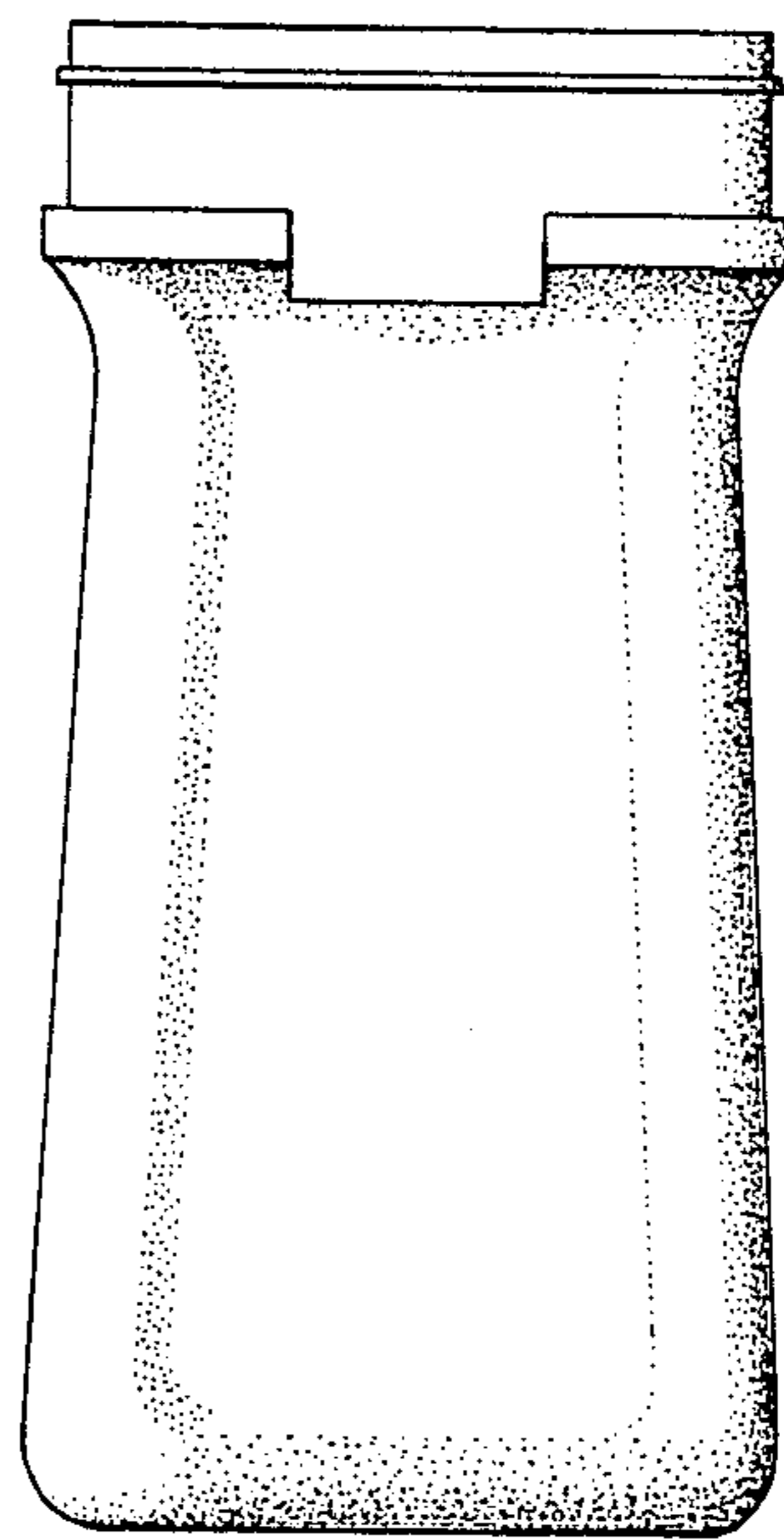

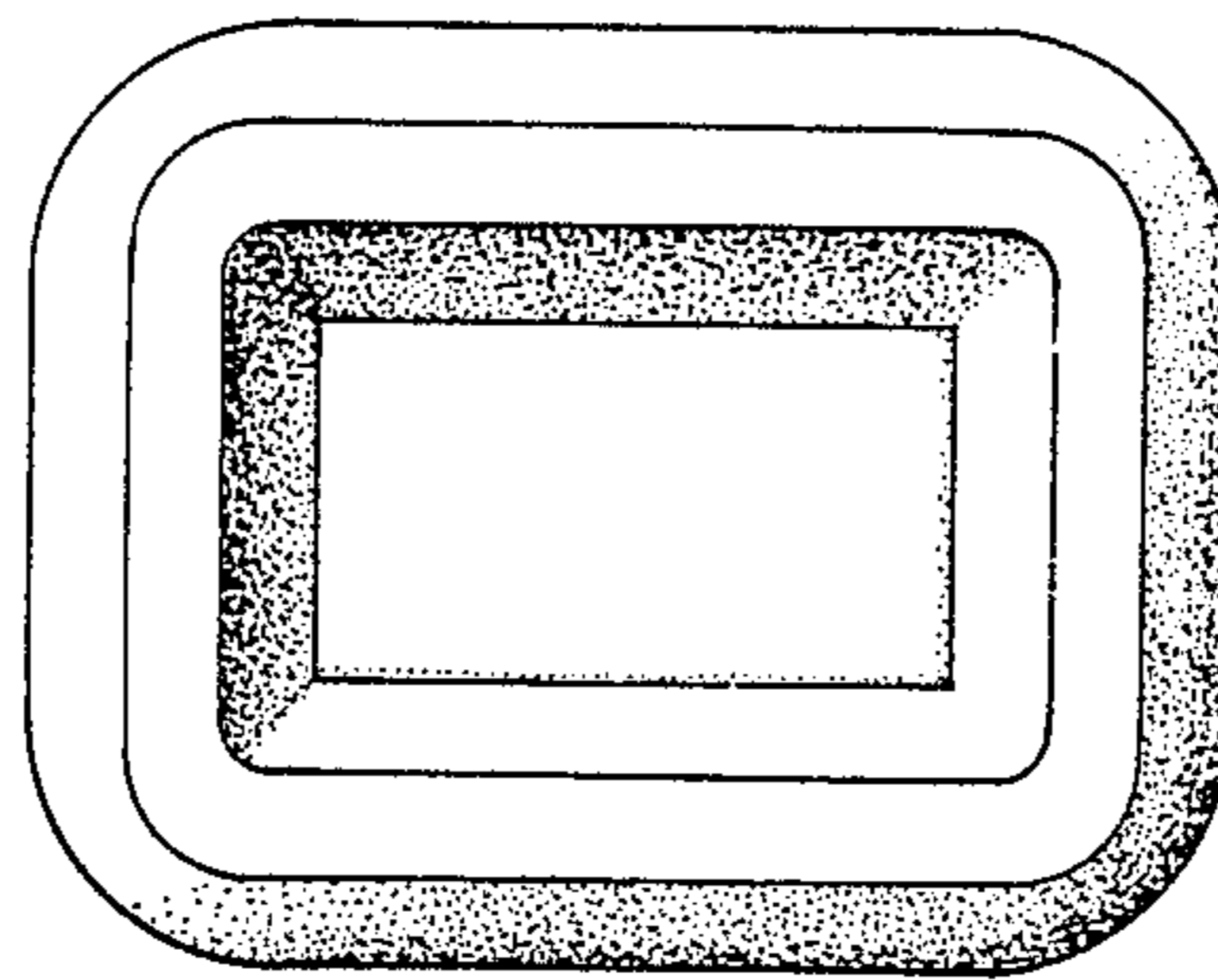

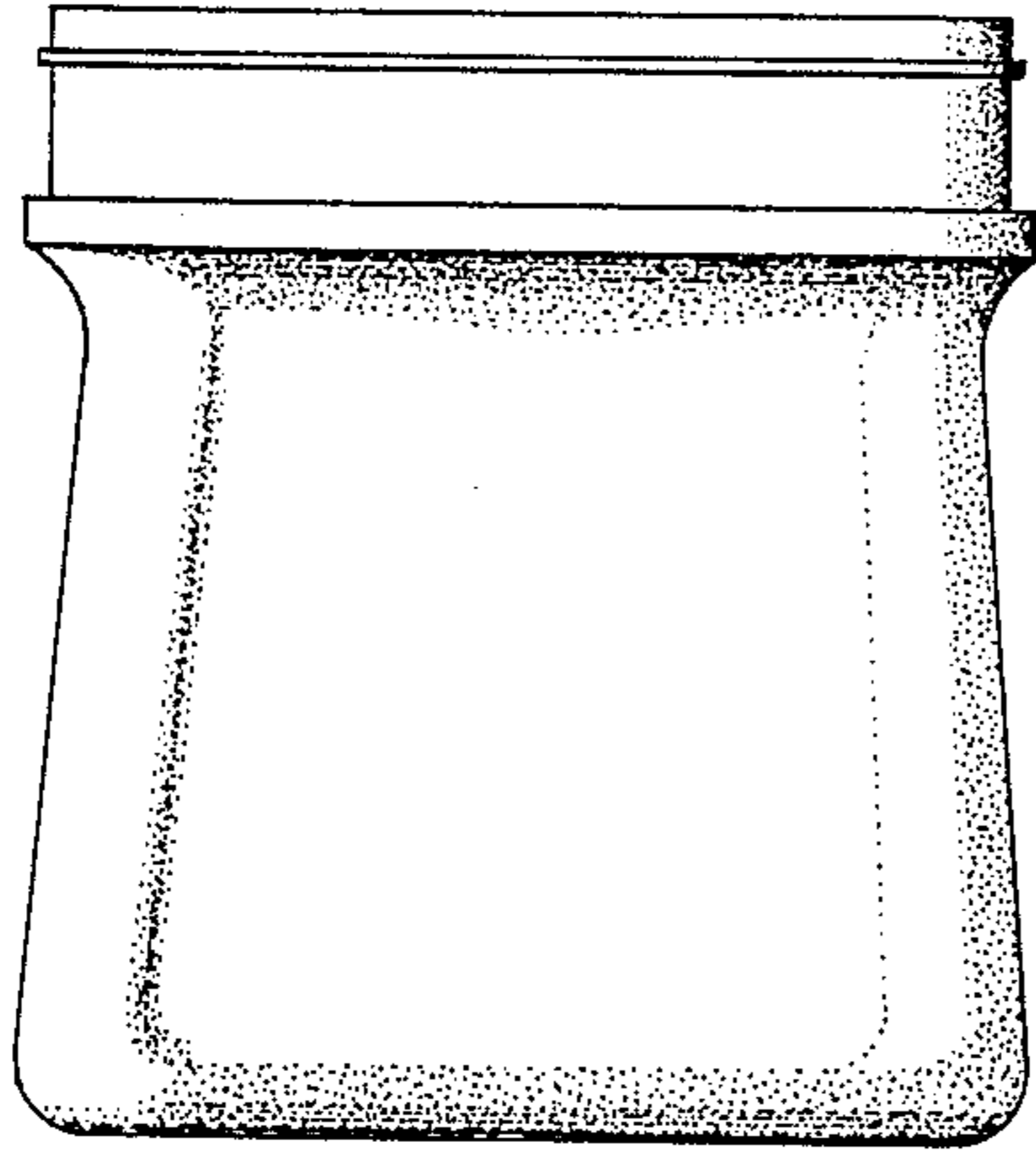
