FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a cassette for a video tape recorder showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 8 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof, shown with the front cover in an open position.

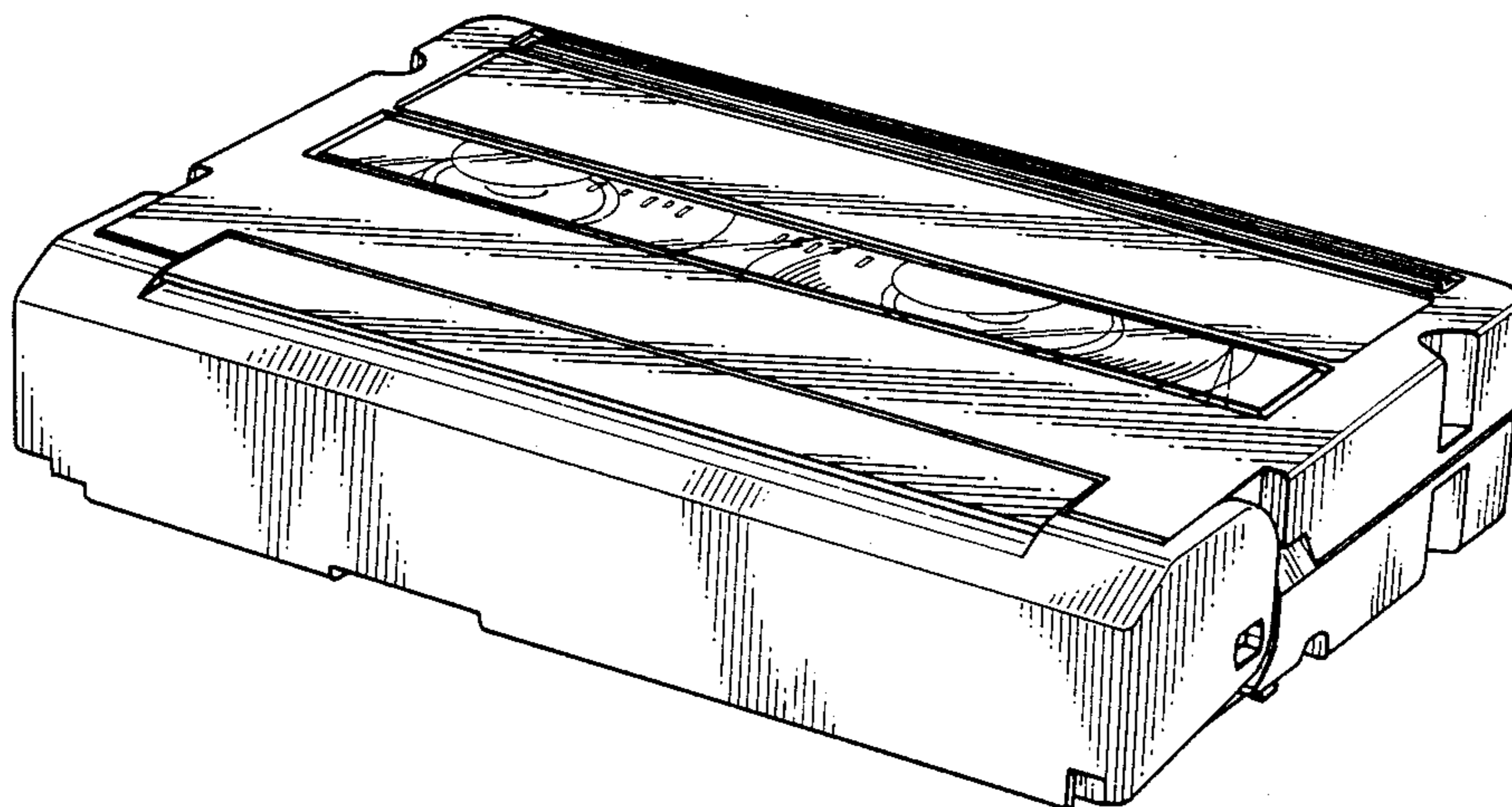

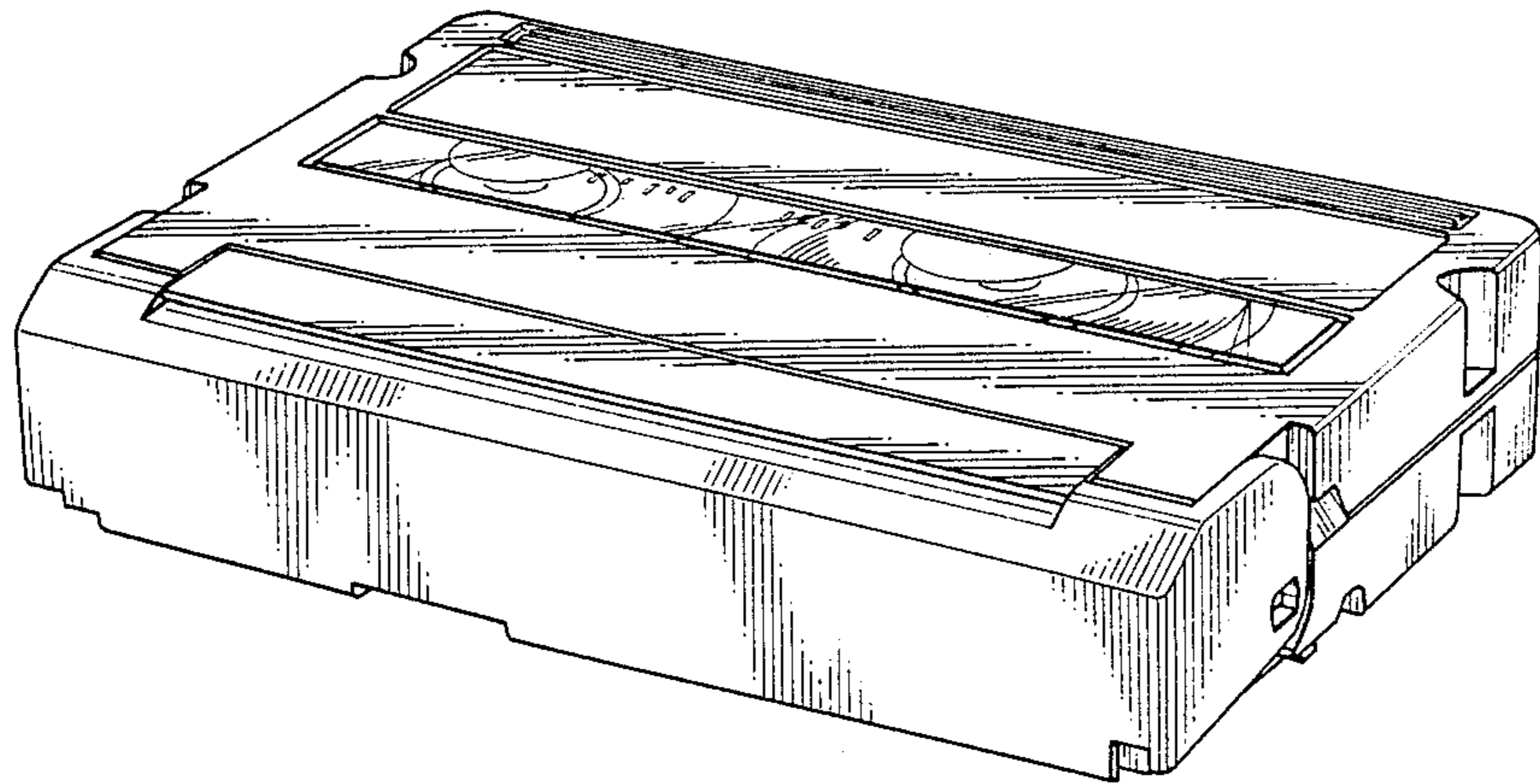

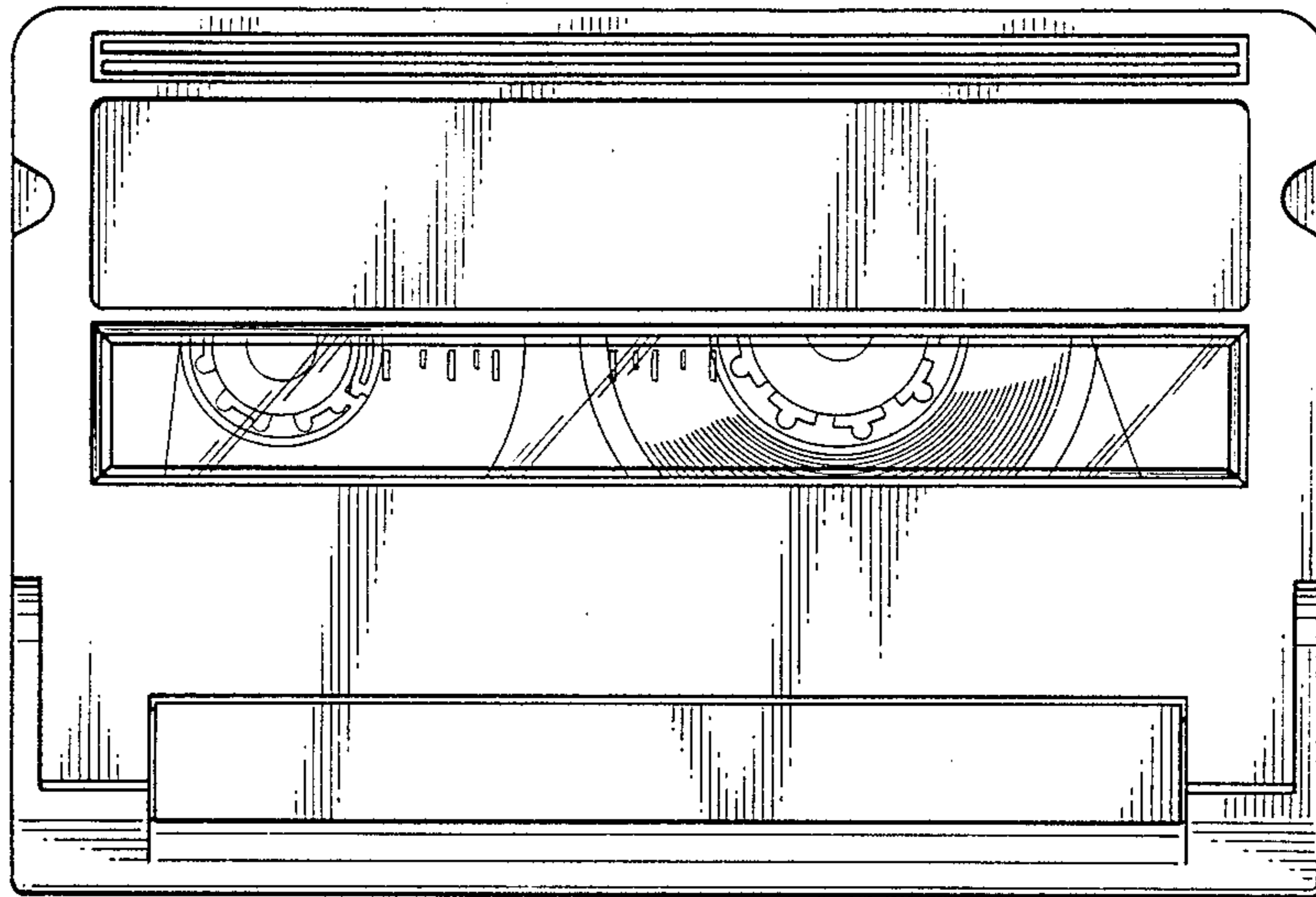

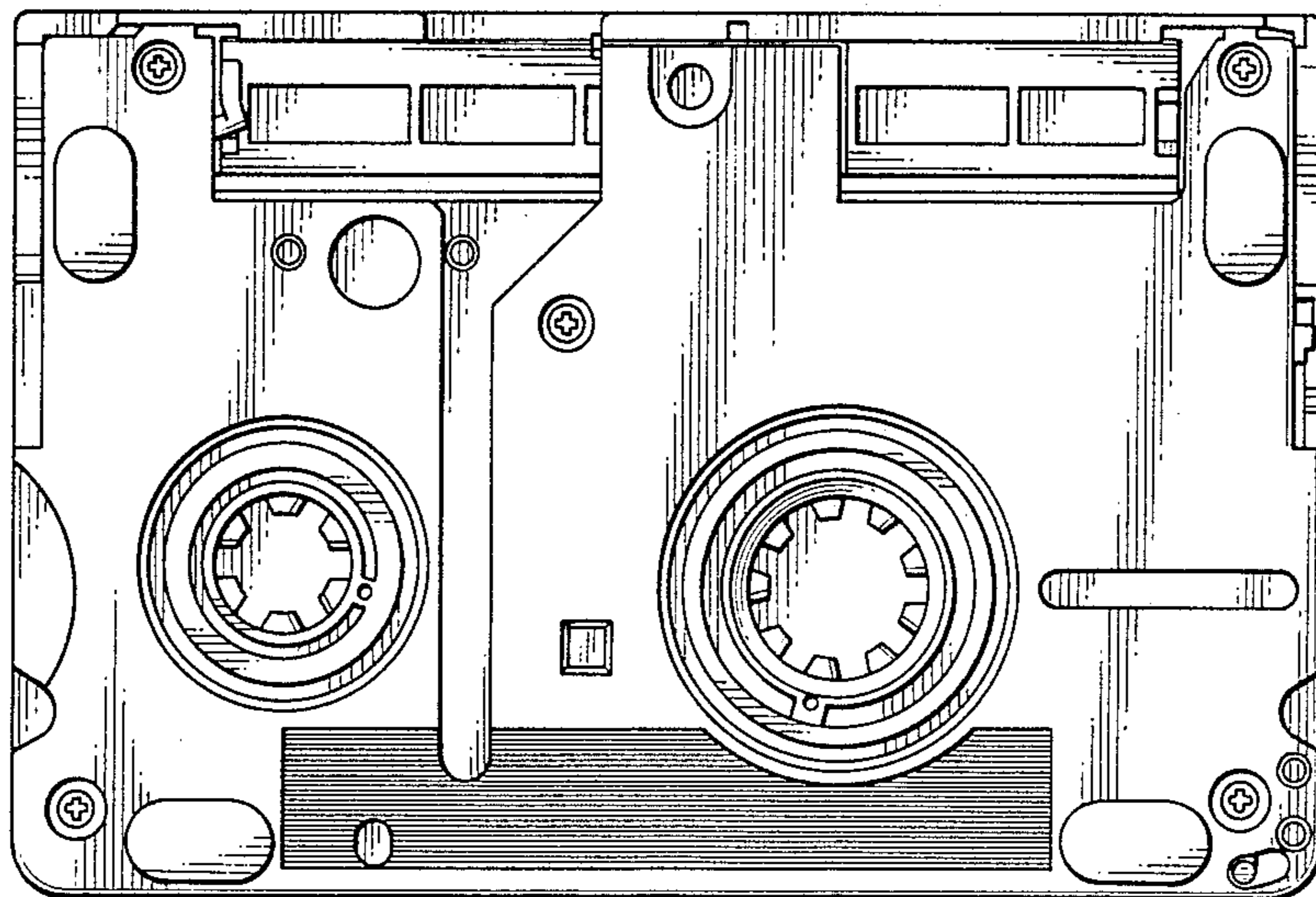

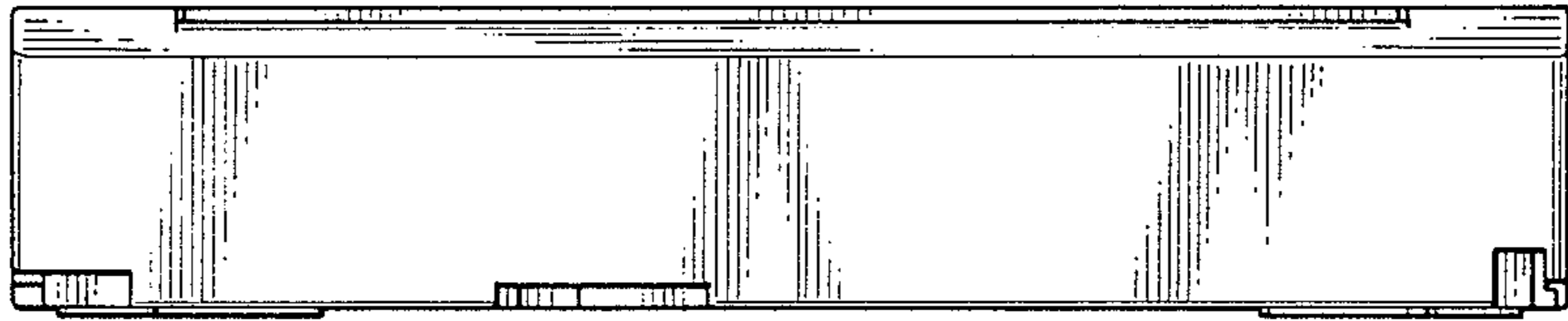

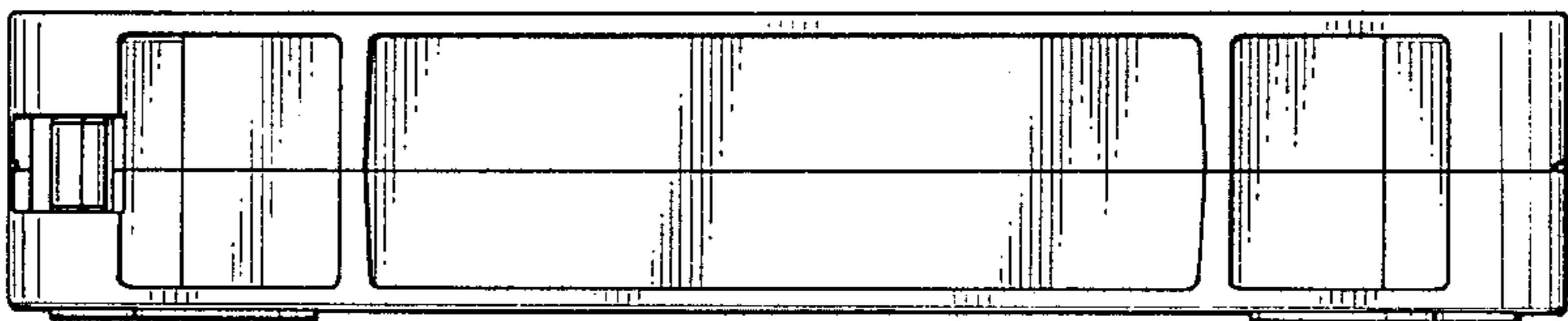

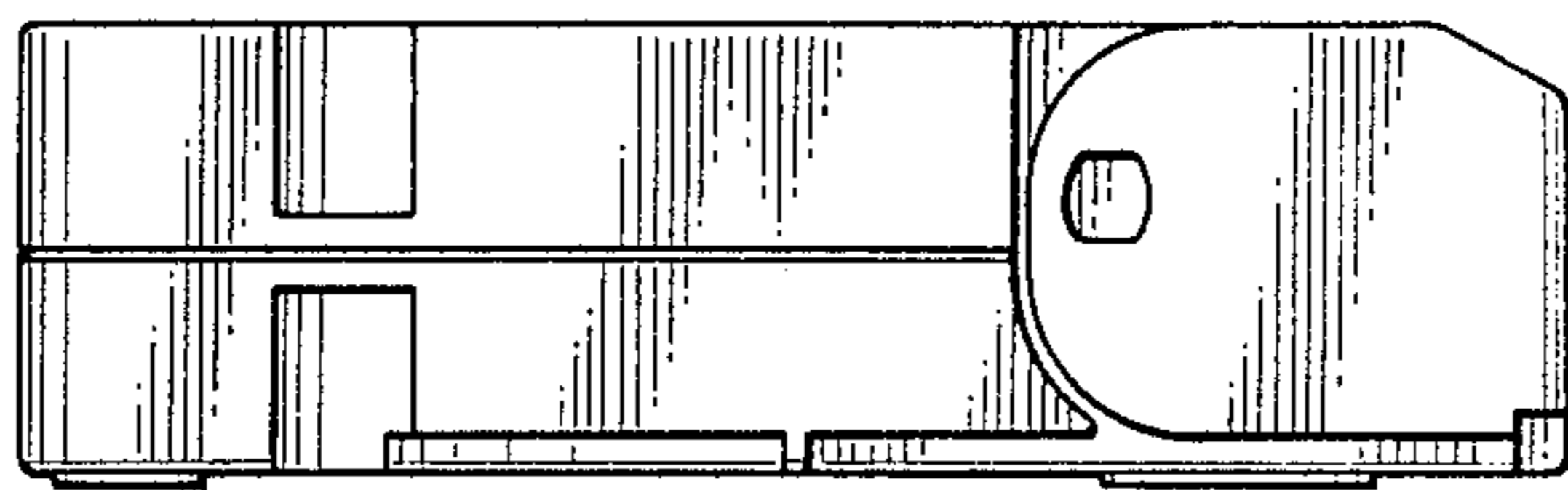

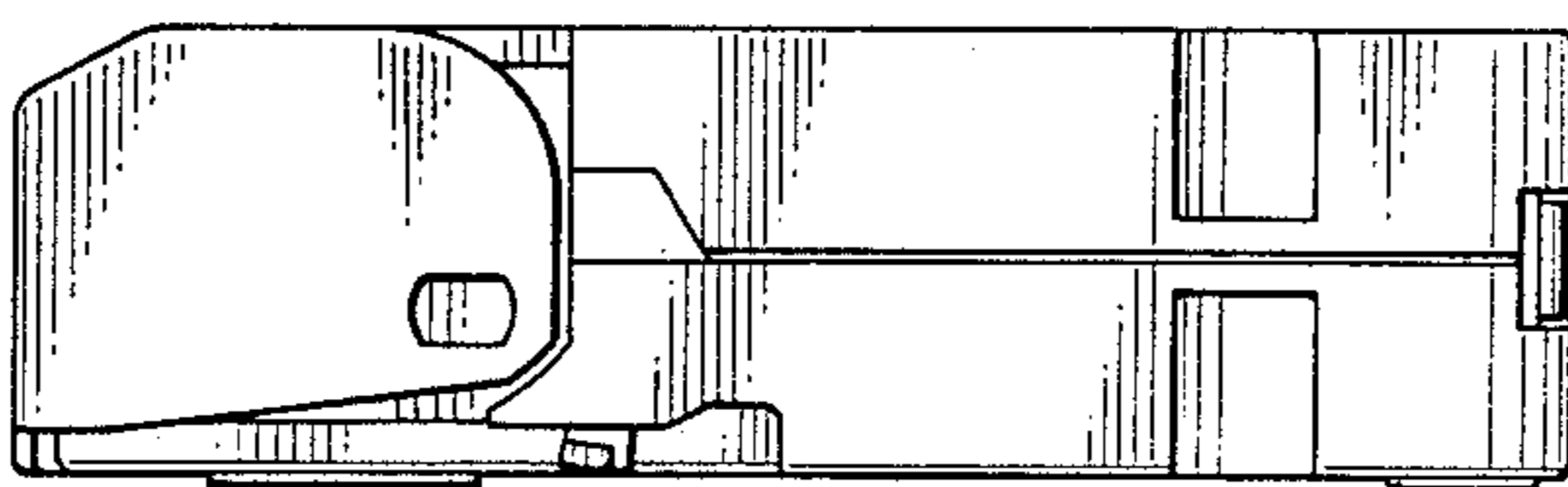
