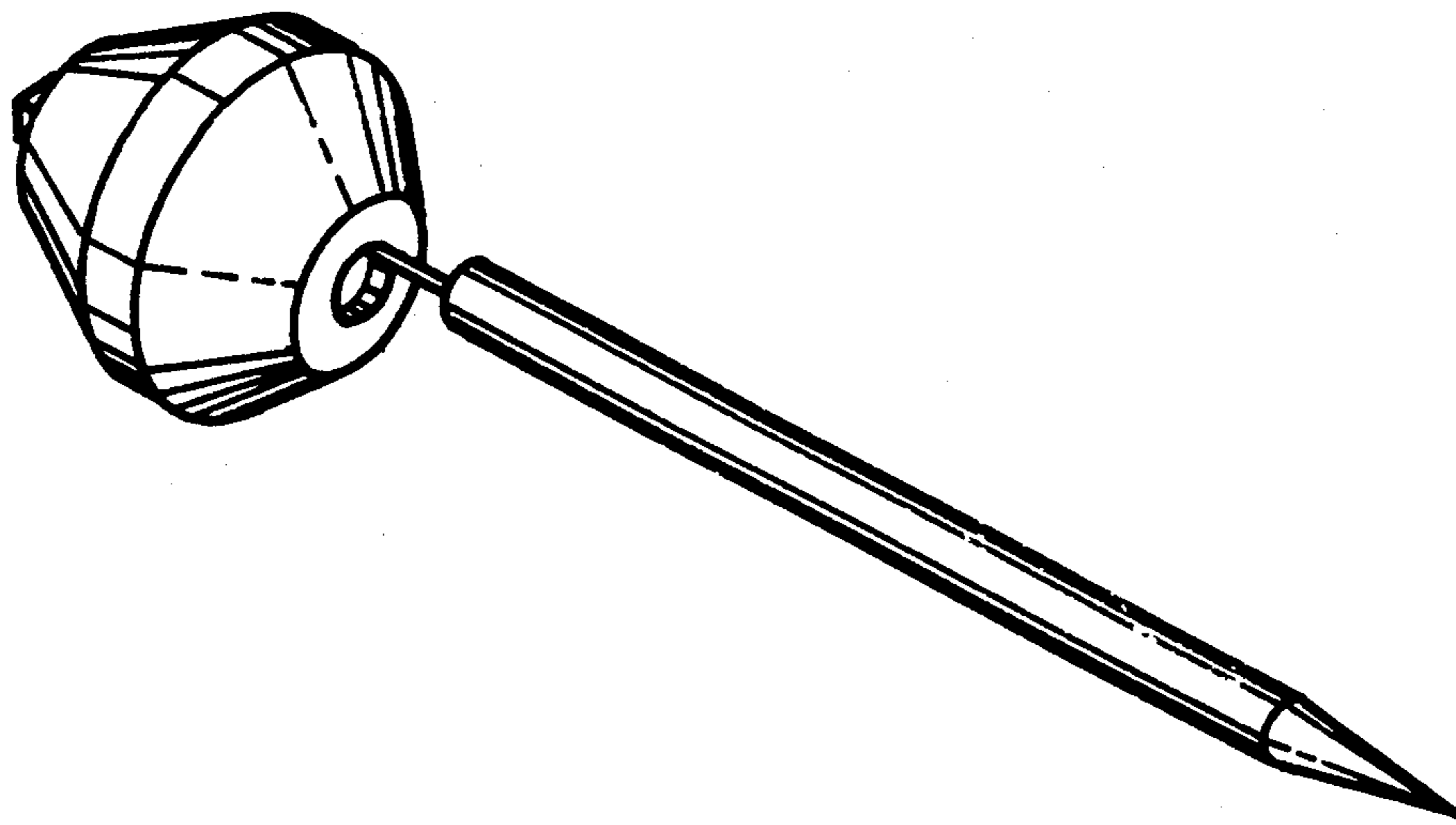

FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof on a reduced scale.



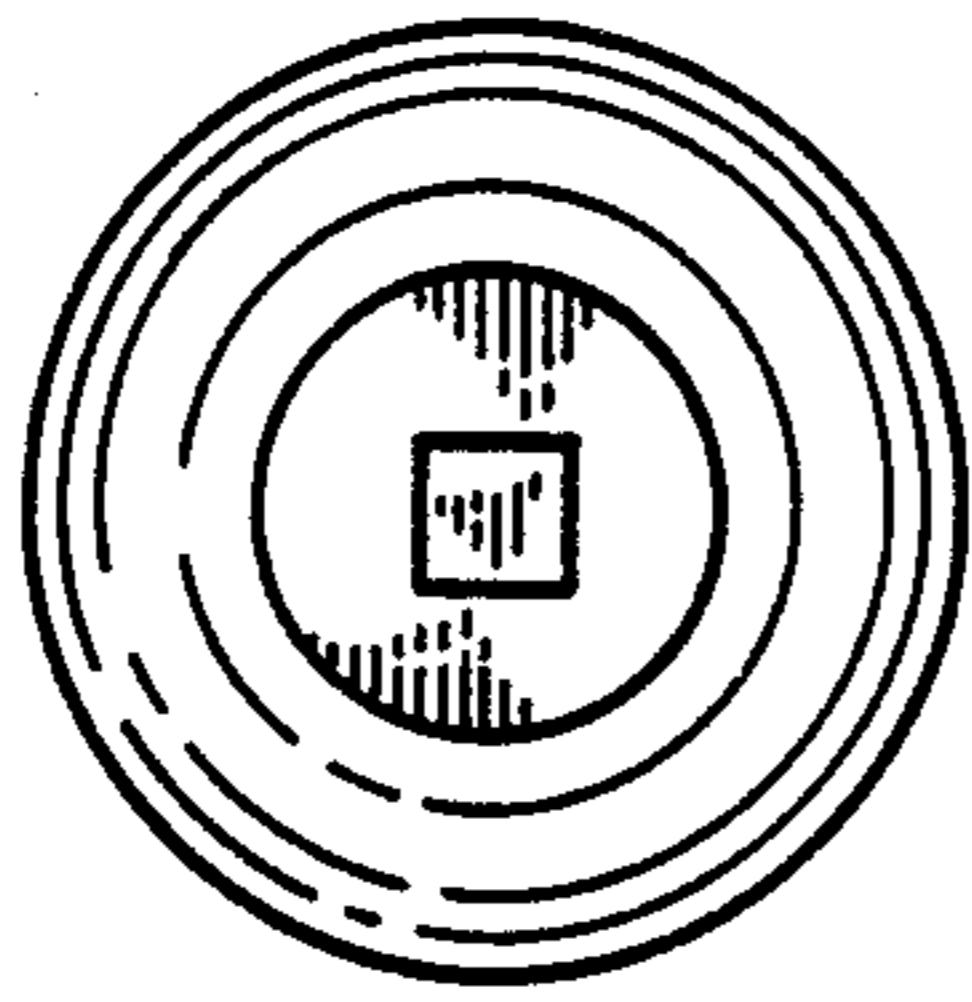

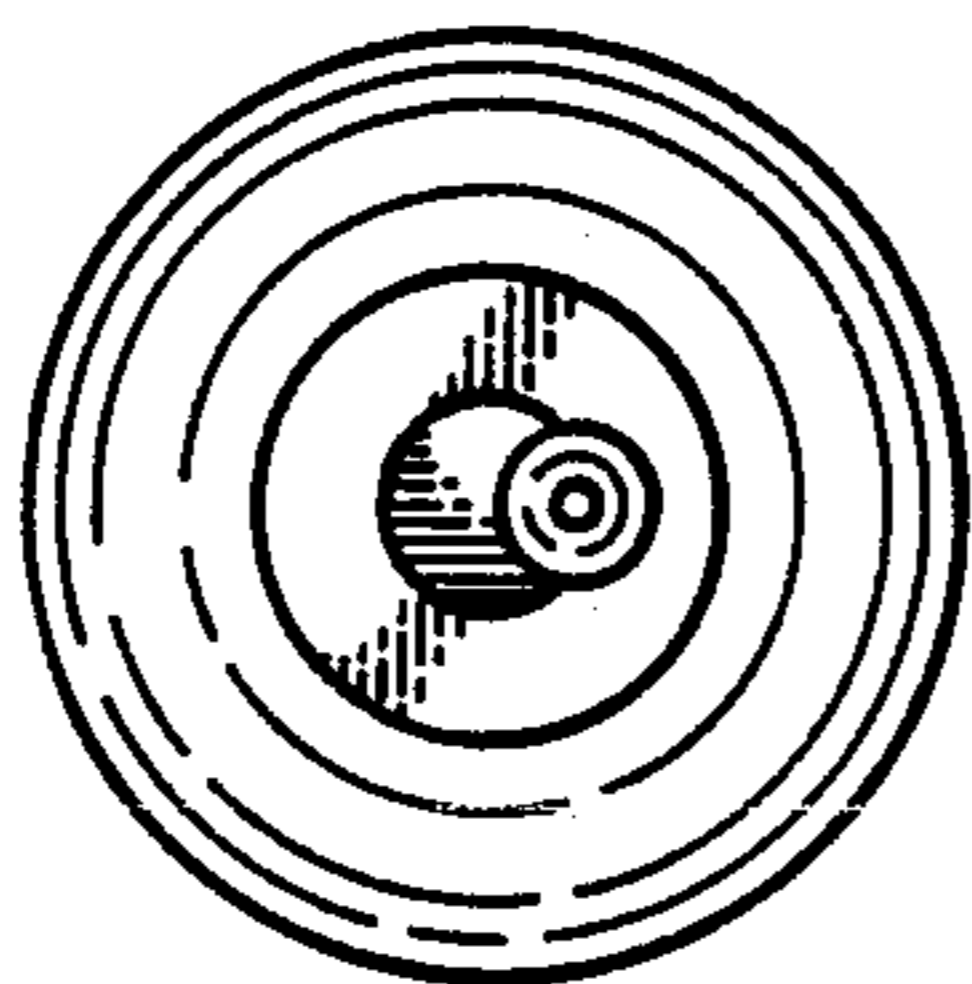

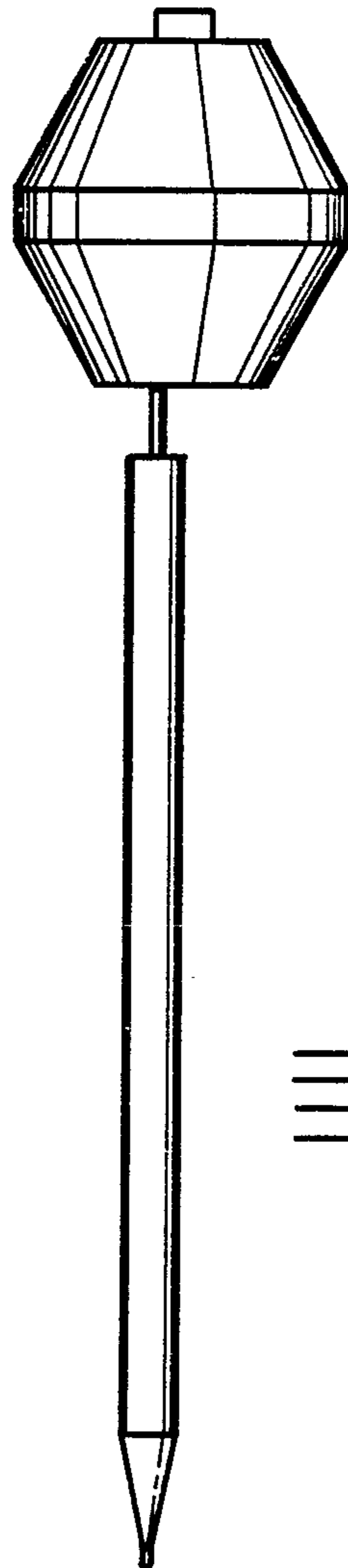
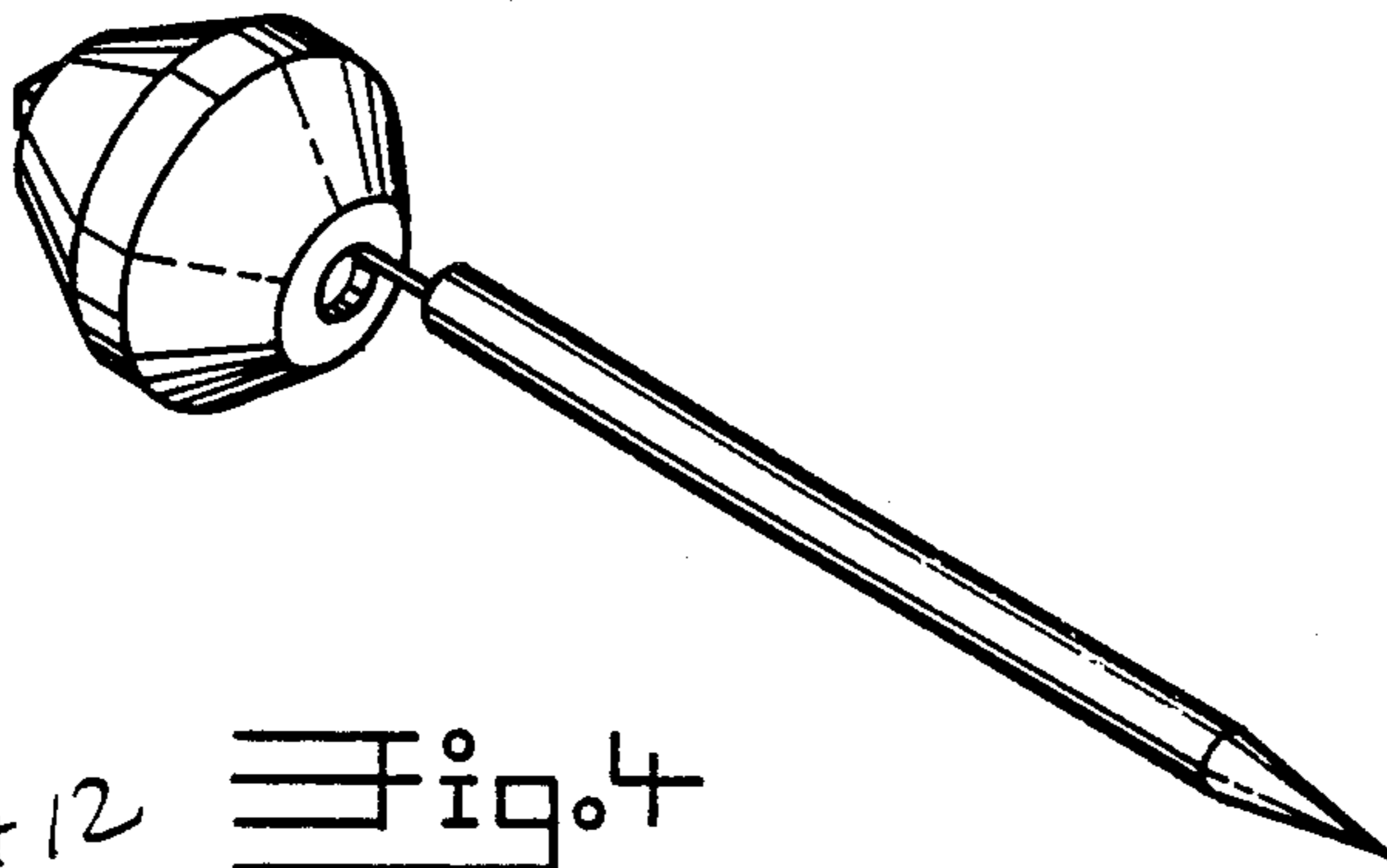
