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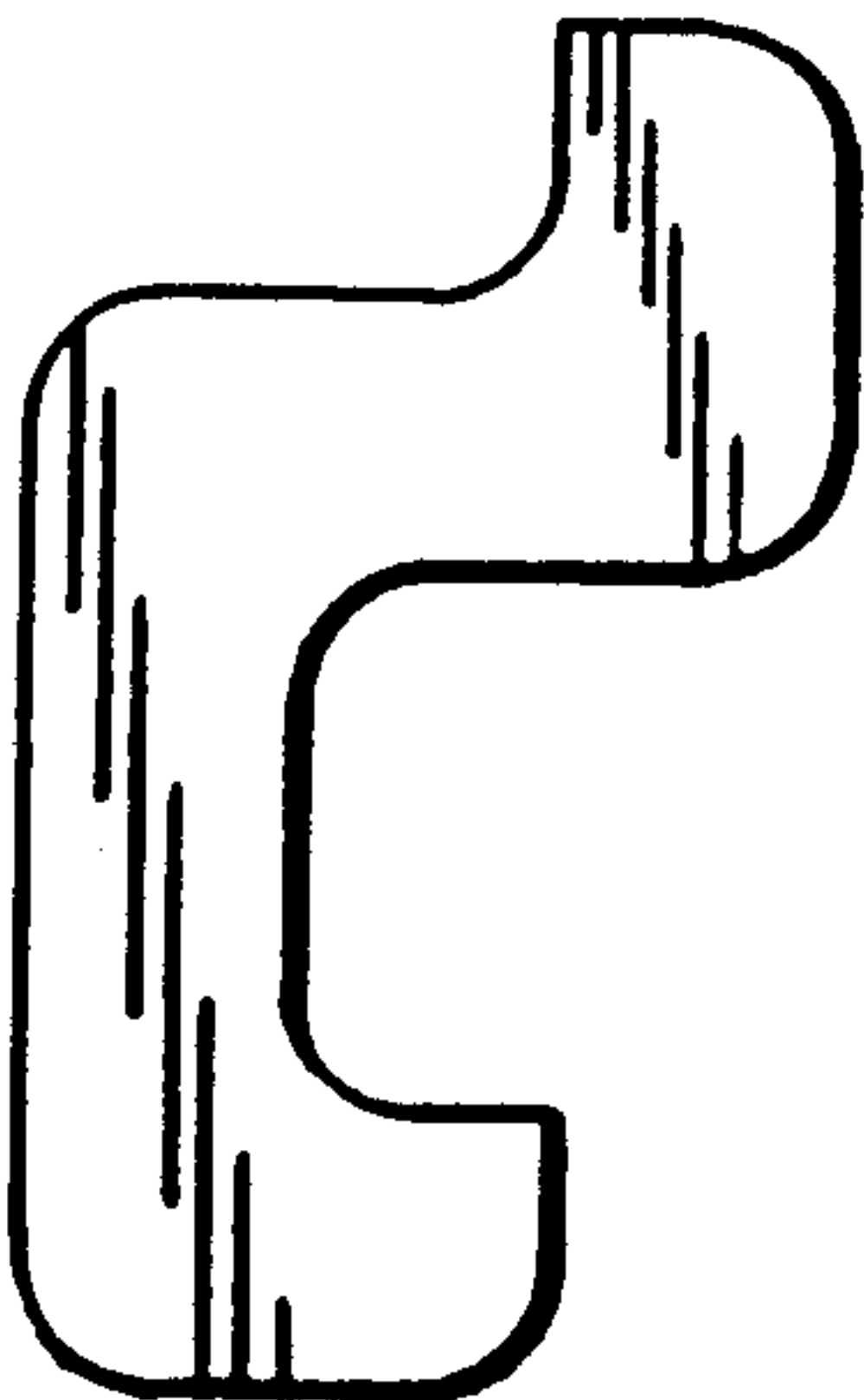
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CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a puzzle piece showing my new design, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.



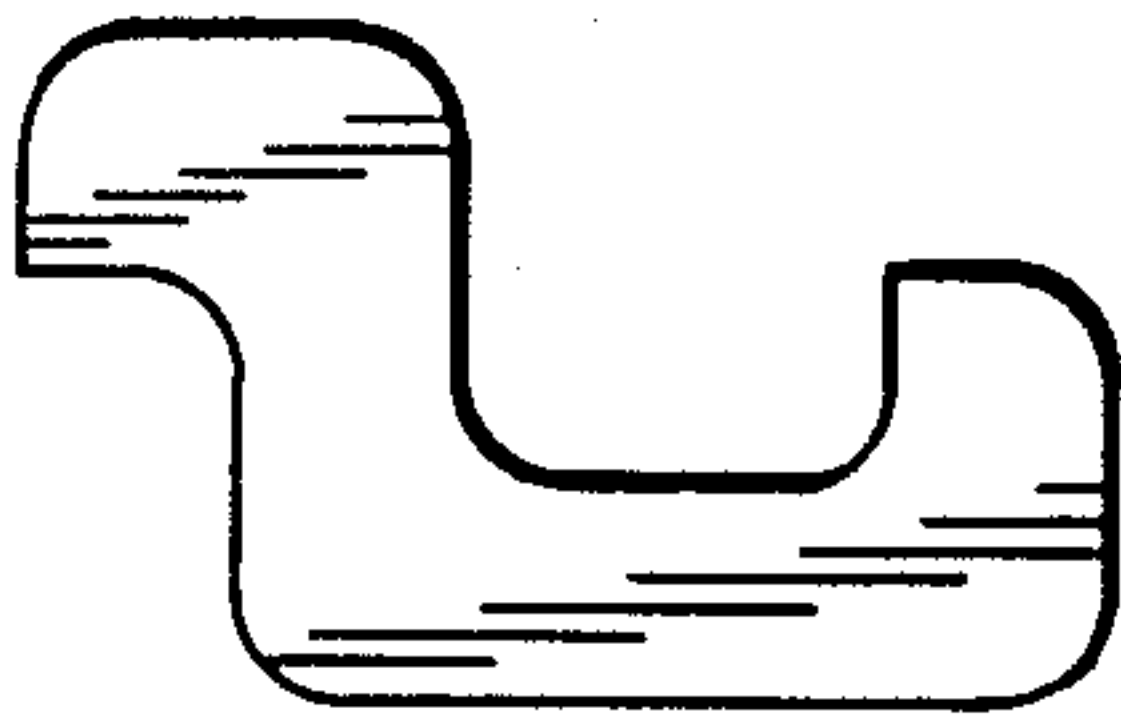
