FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view showing the opposite end thereof.



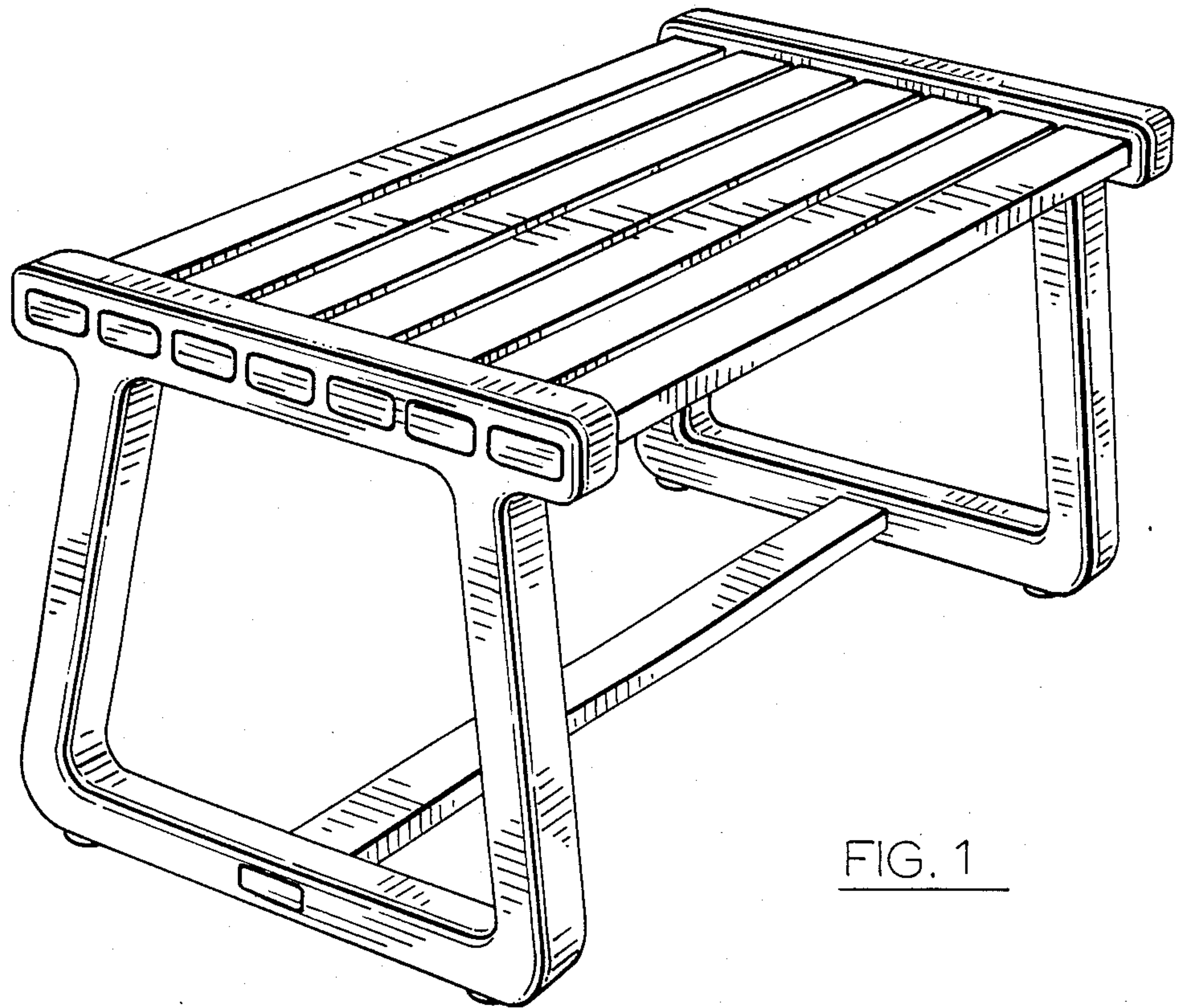

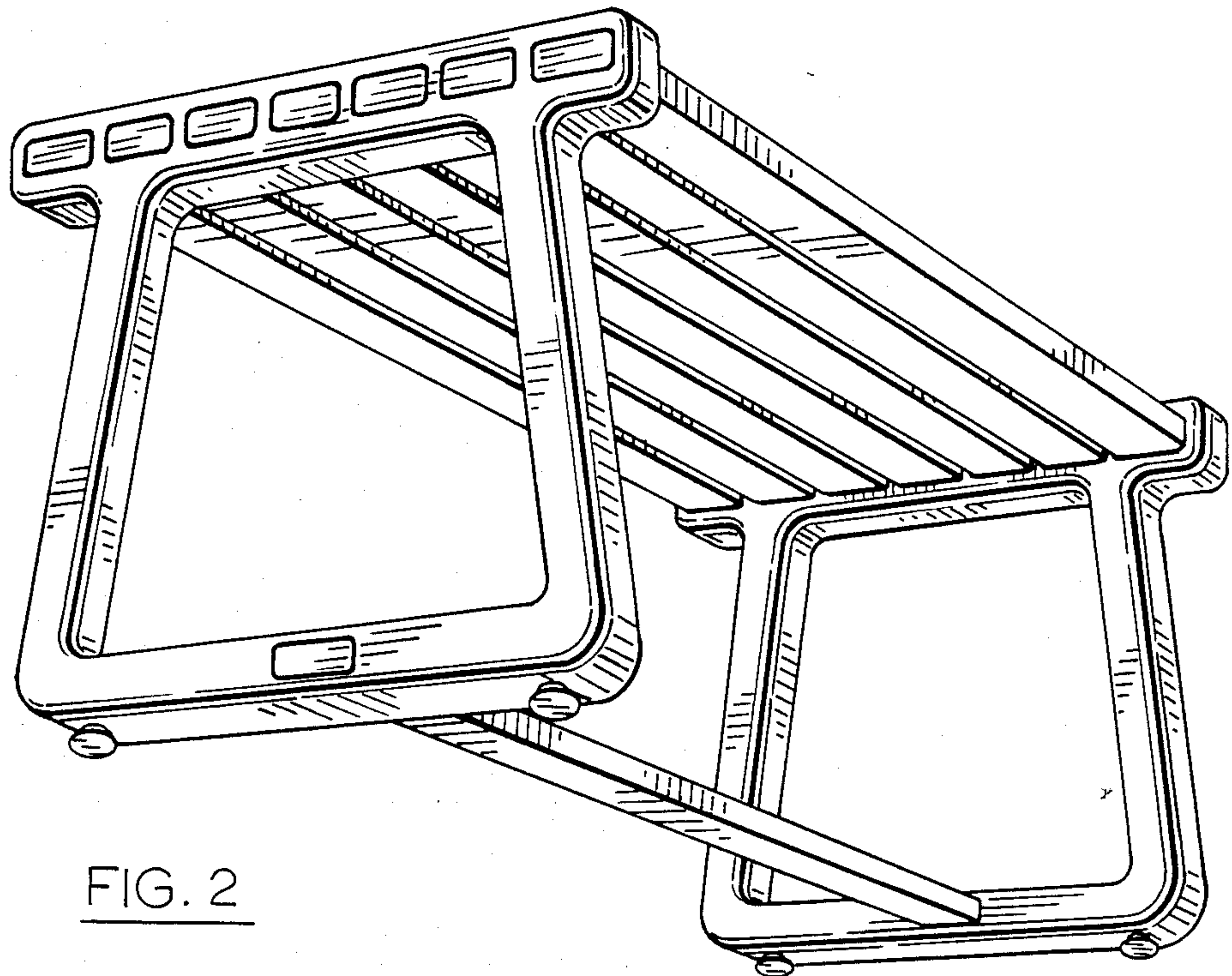

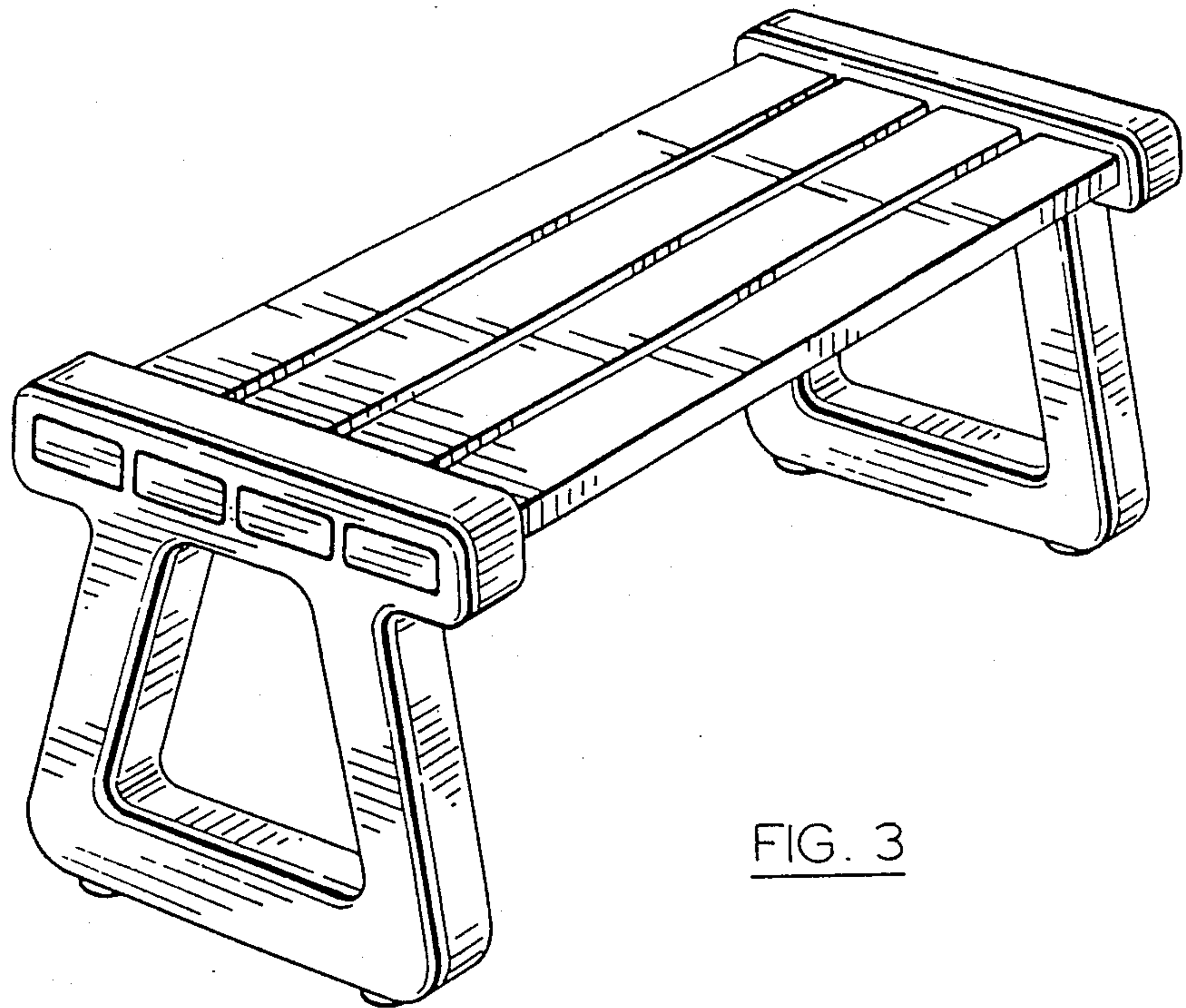

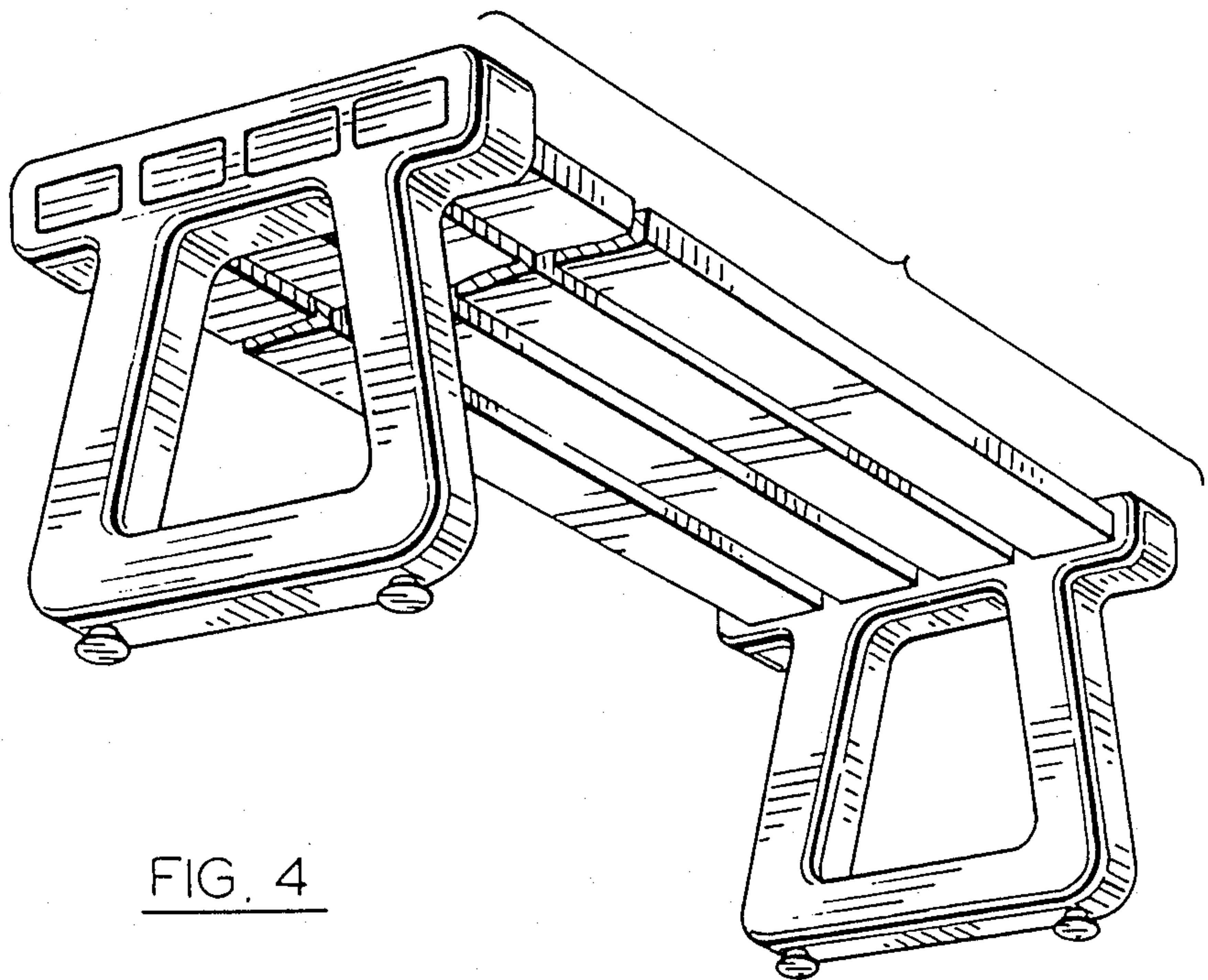
