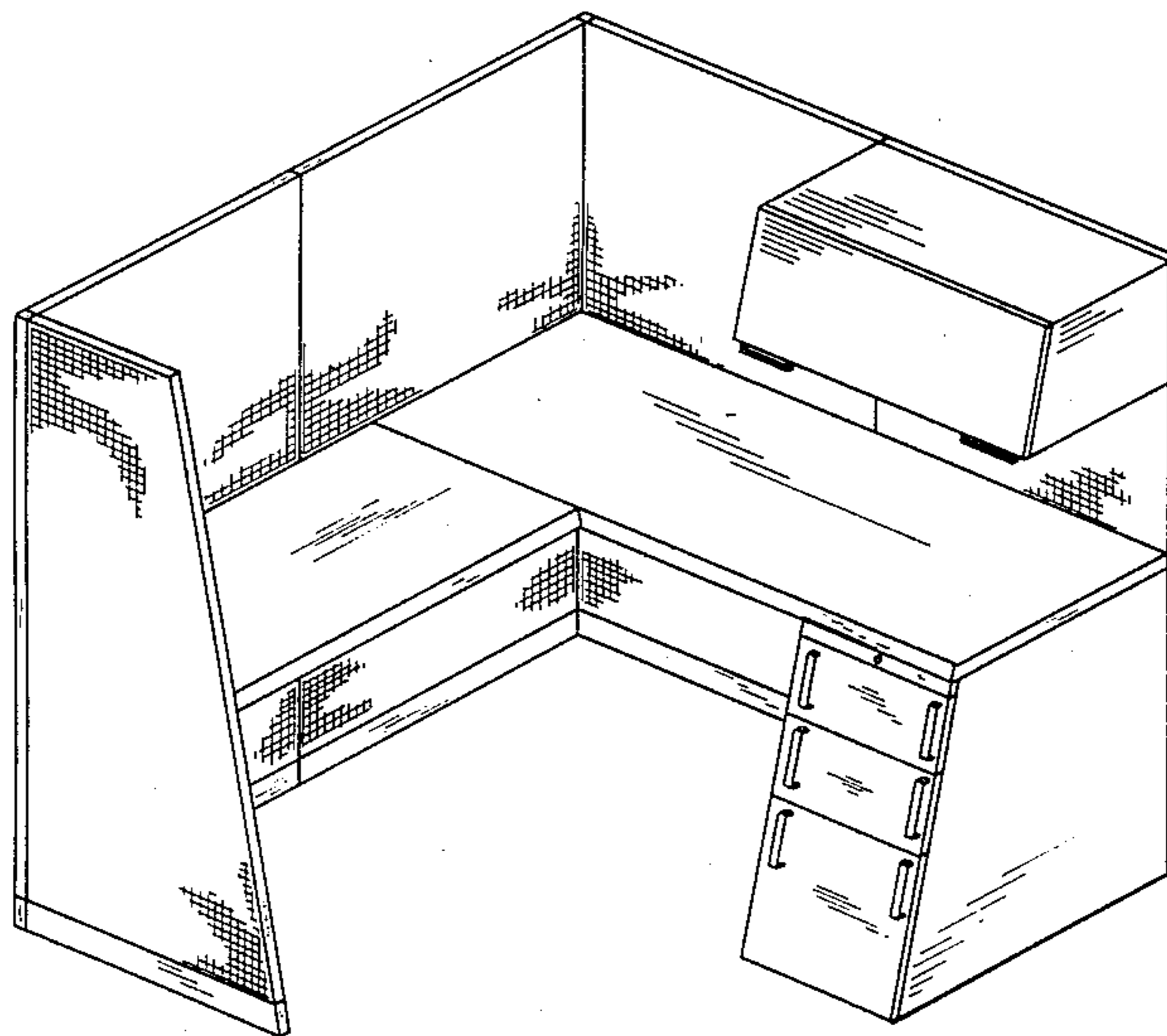

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof.



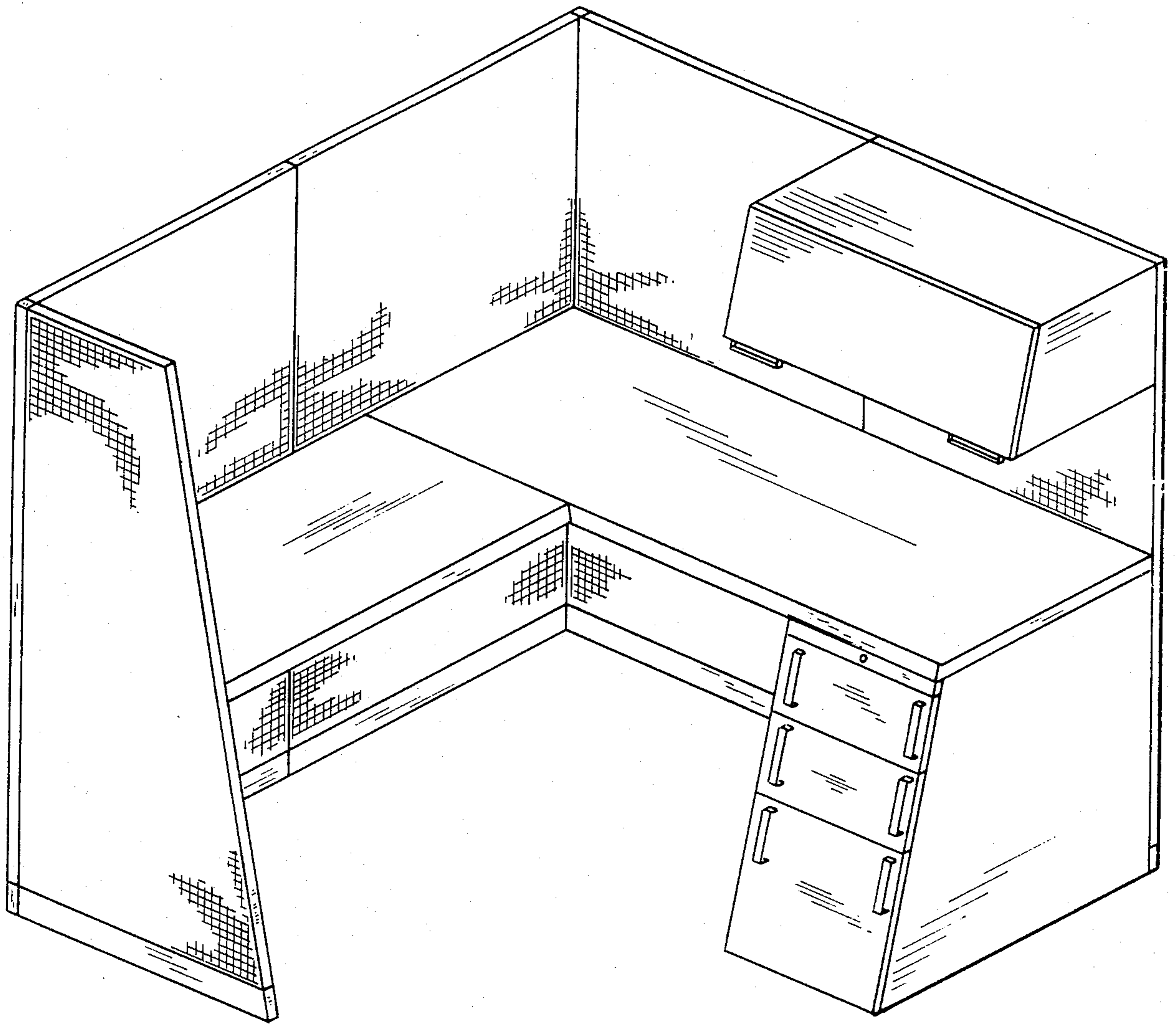

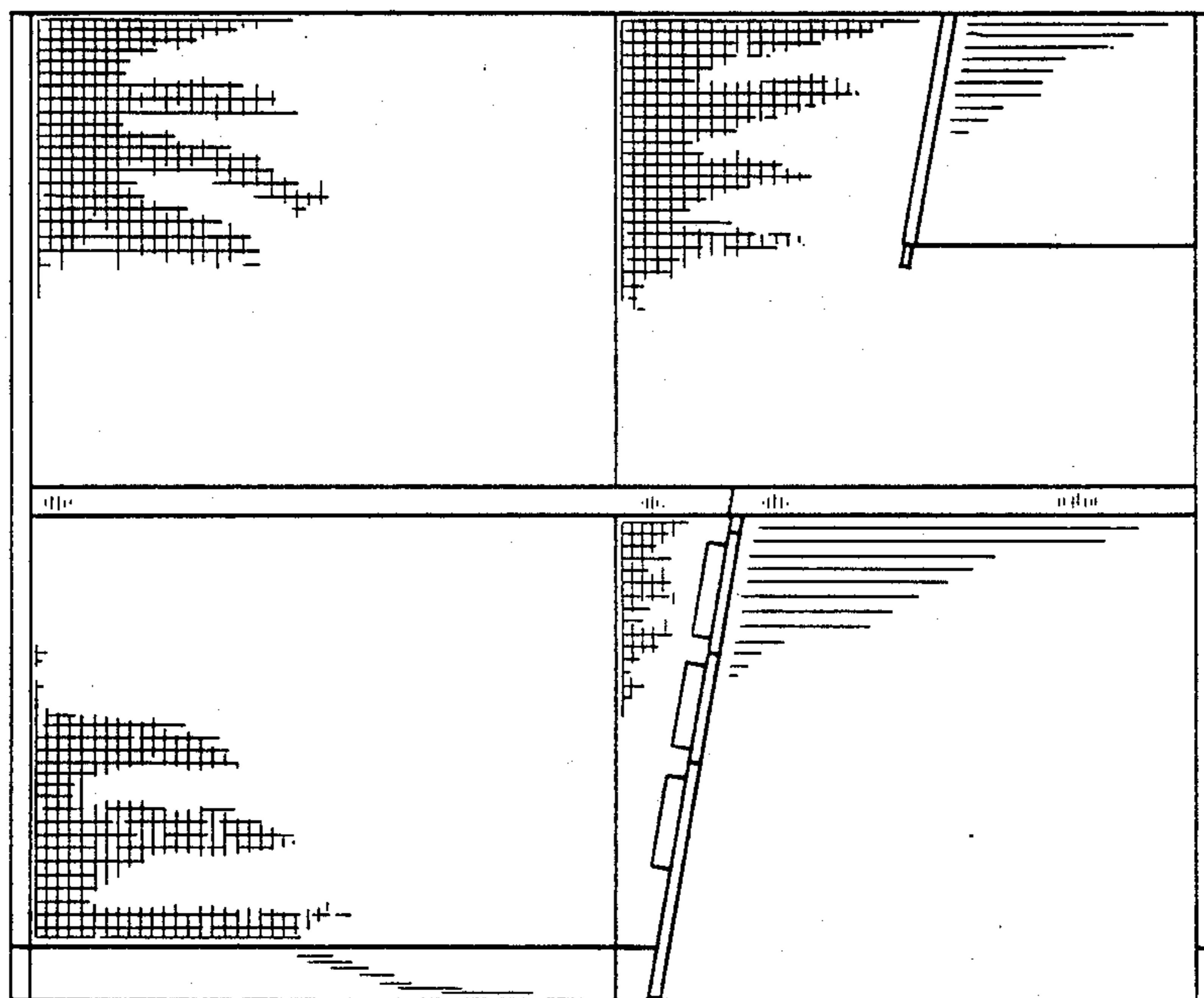

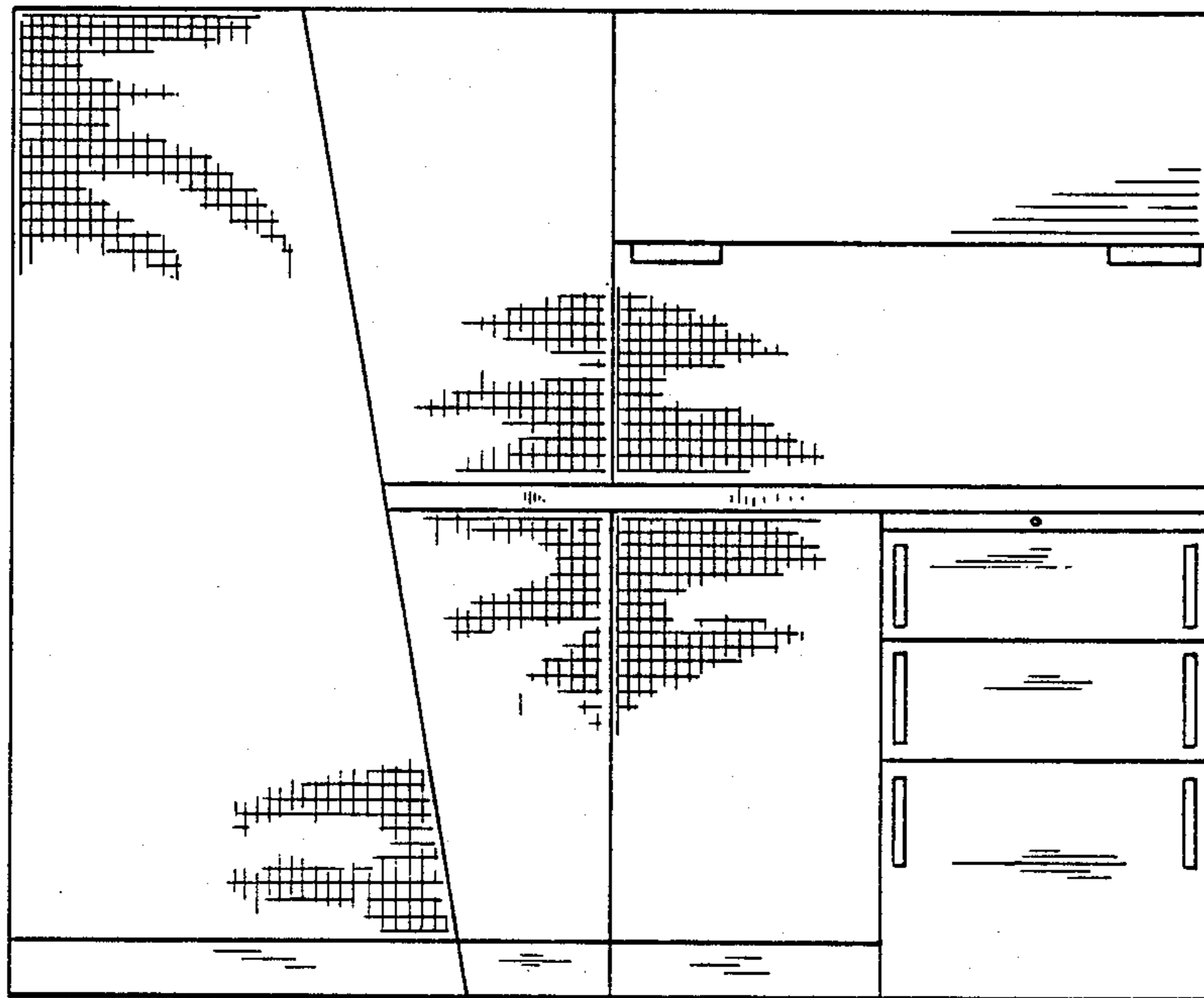
