FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof showing the integral hinged lid over the mouth piece in the closed position;

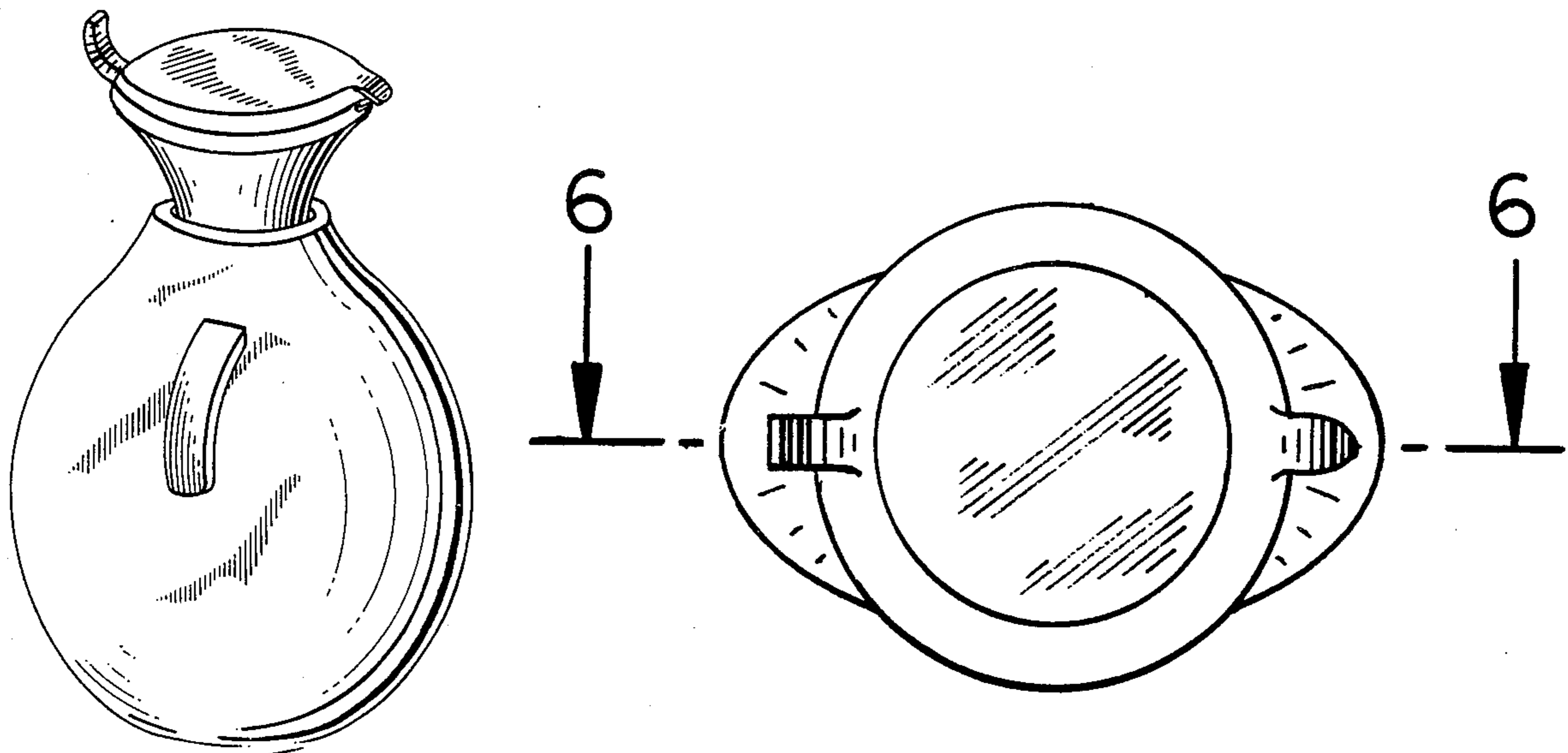
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

The broken line showing of a logo symbol is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



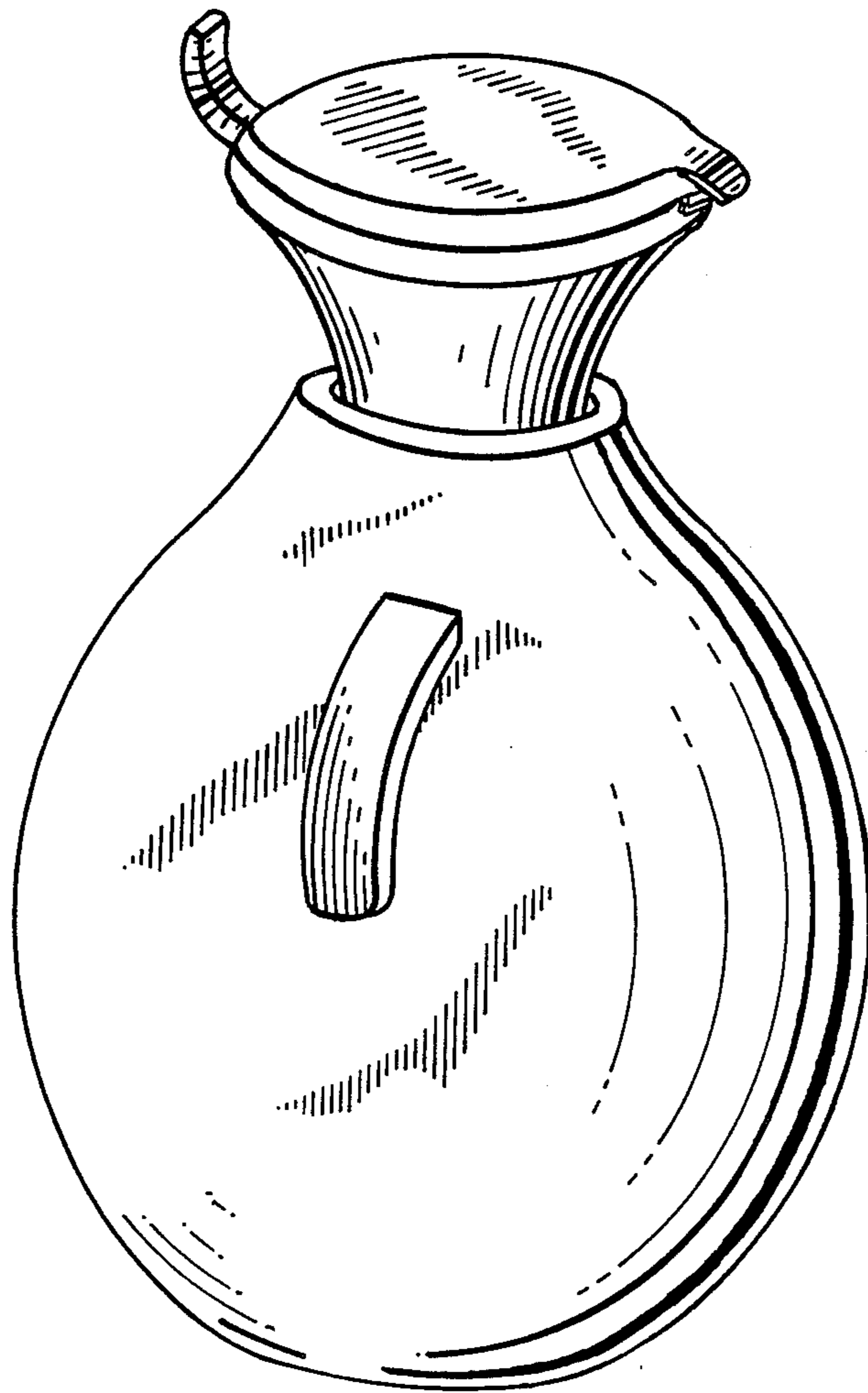

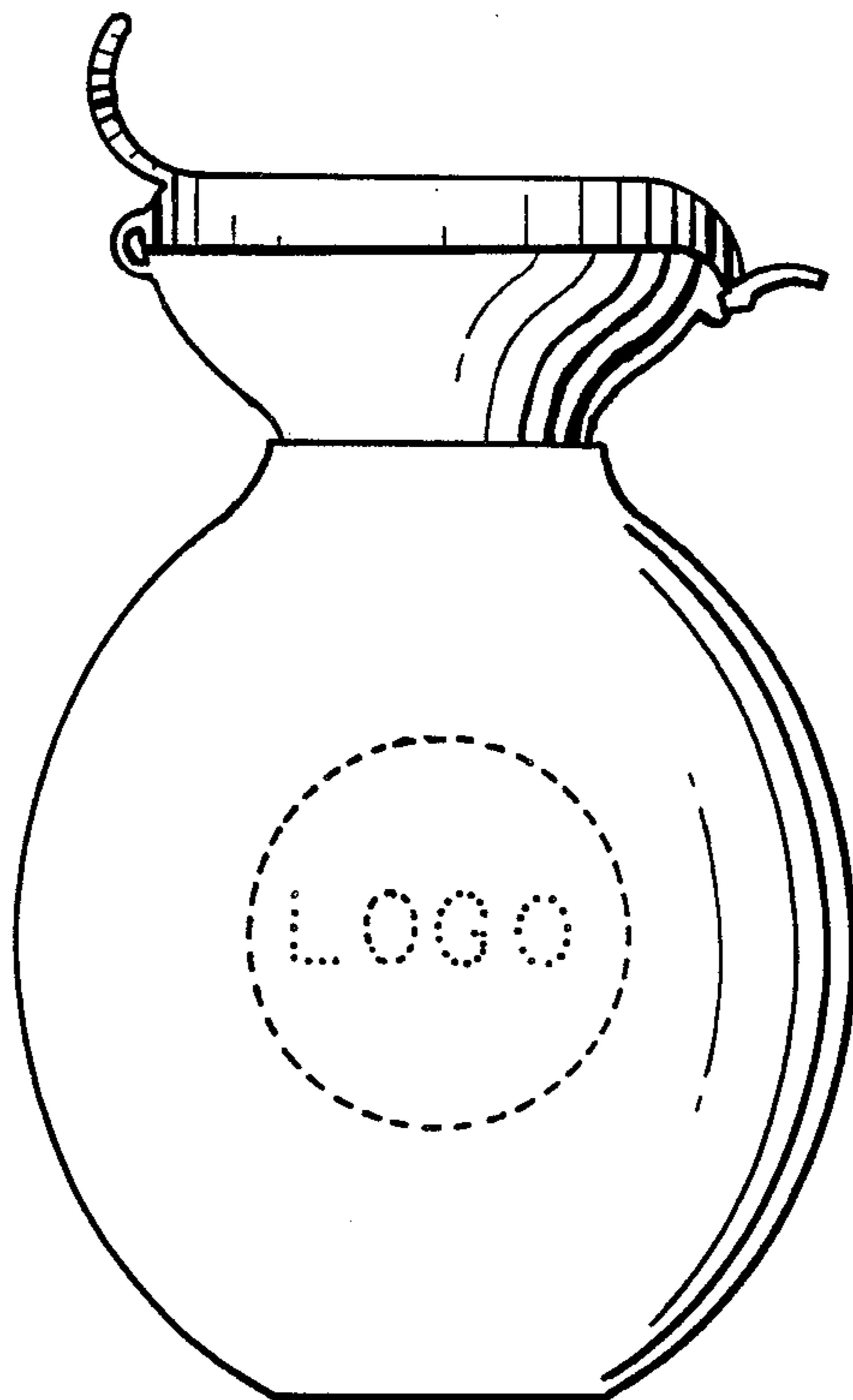

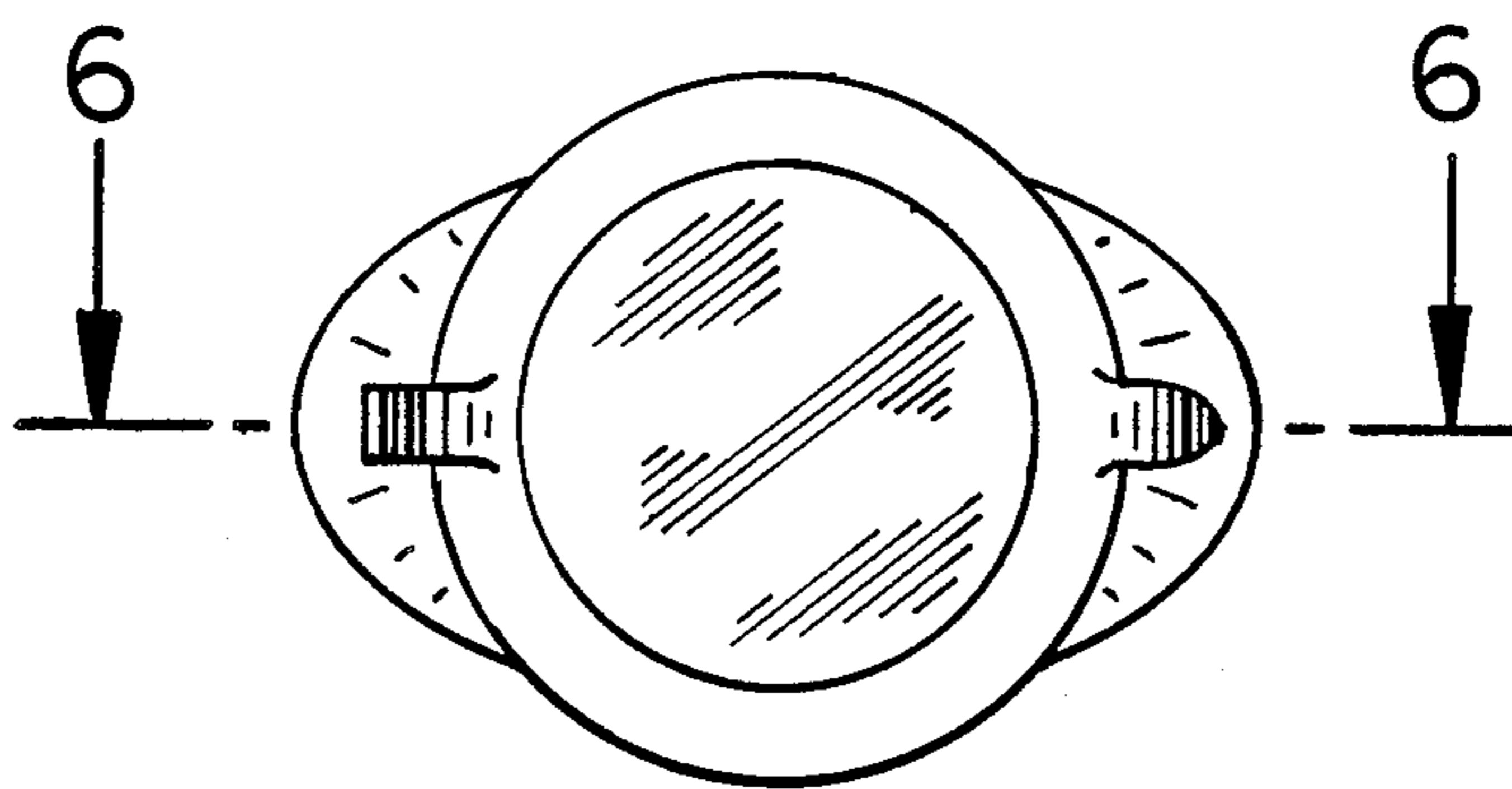

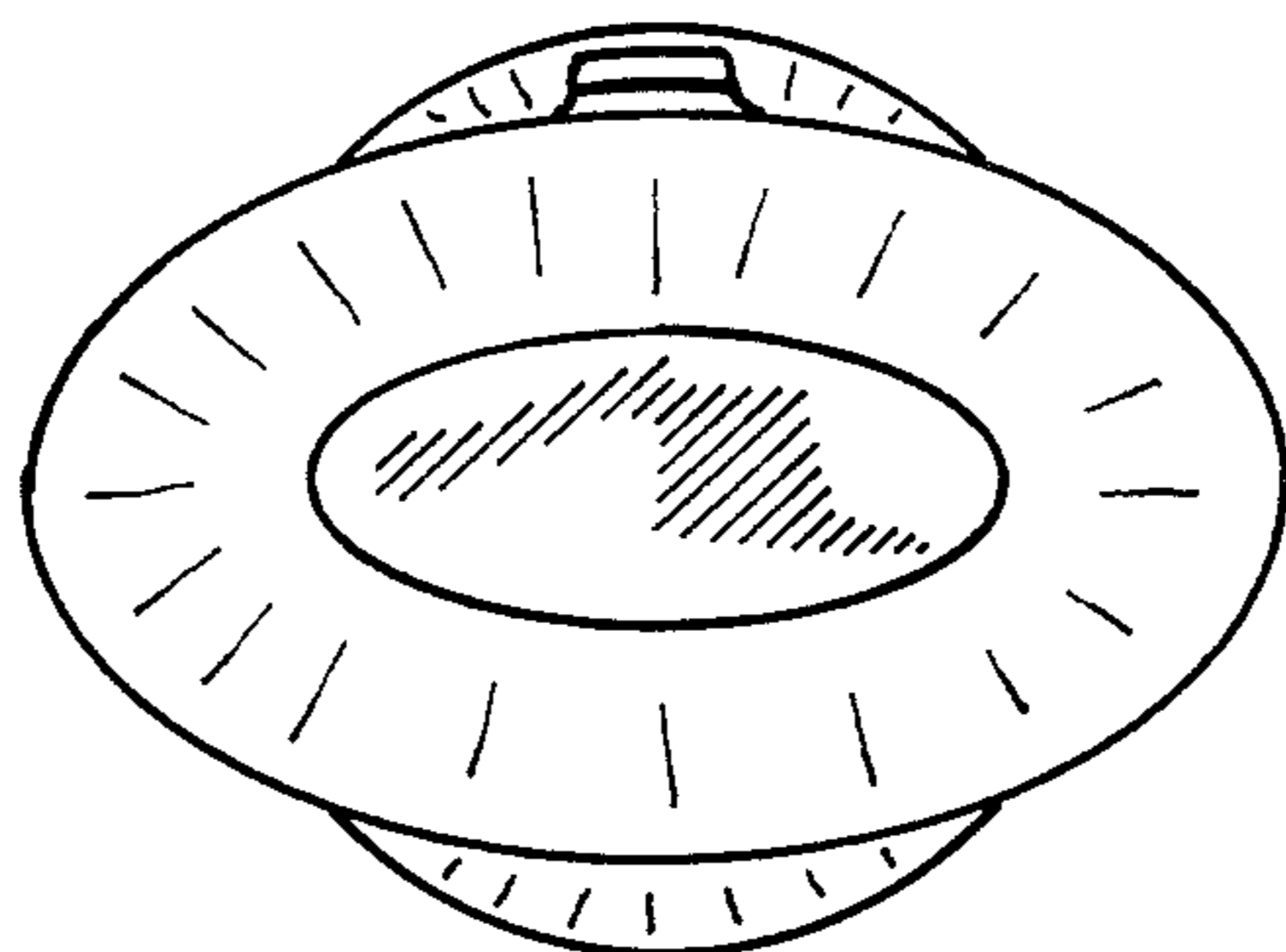

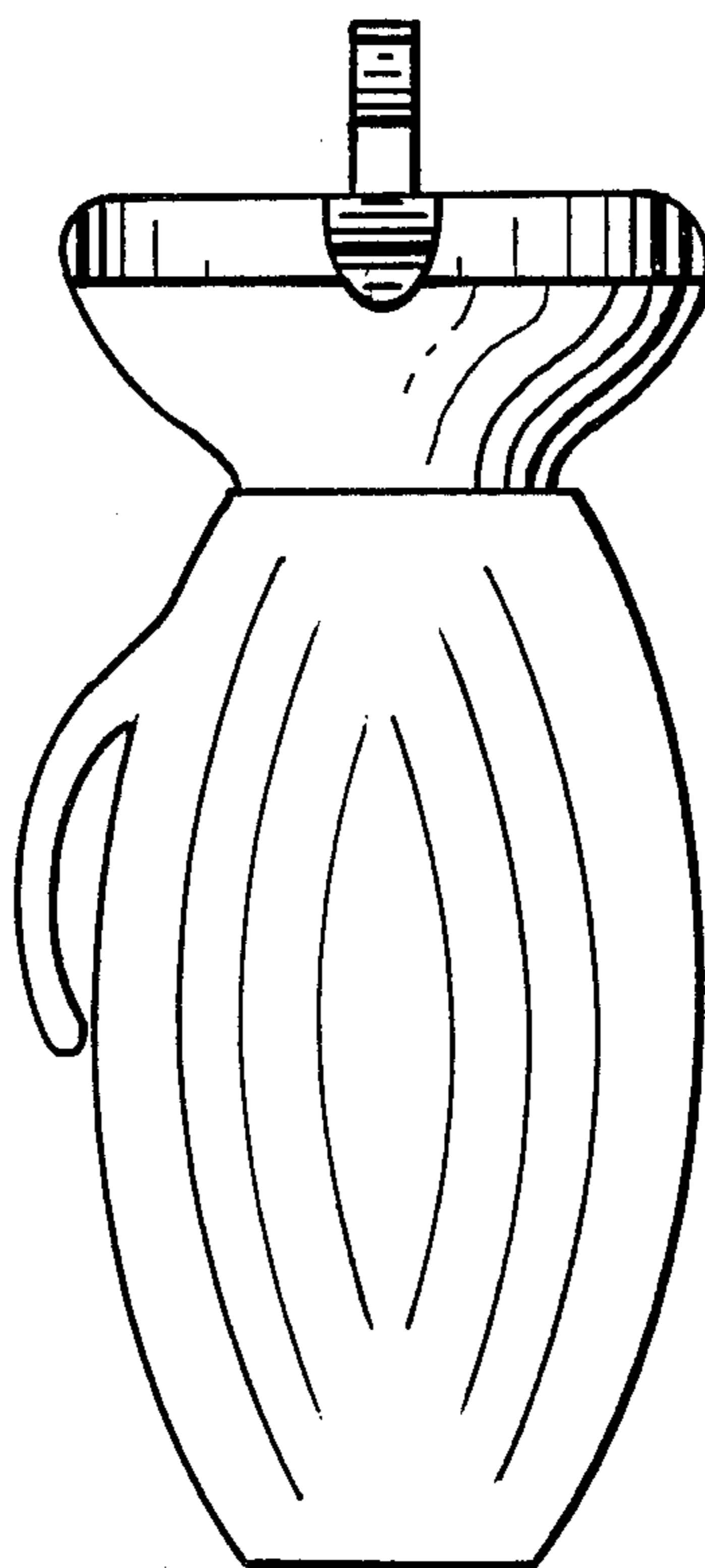

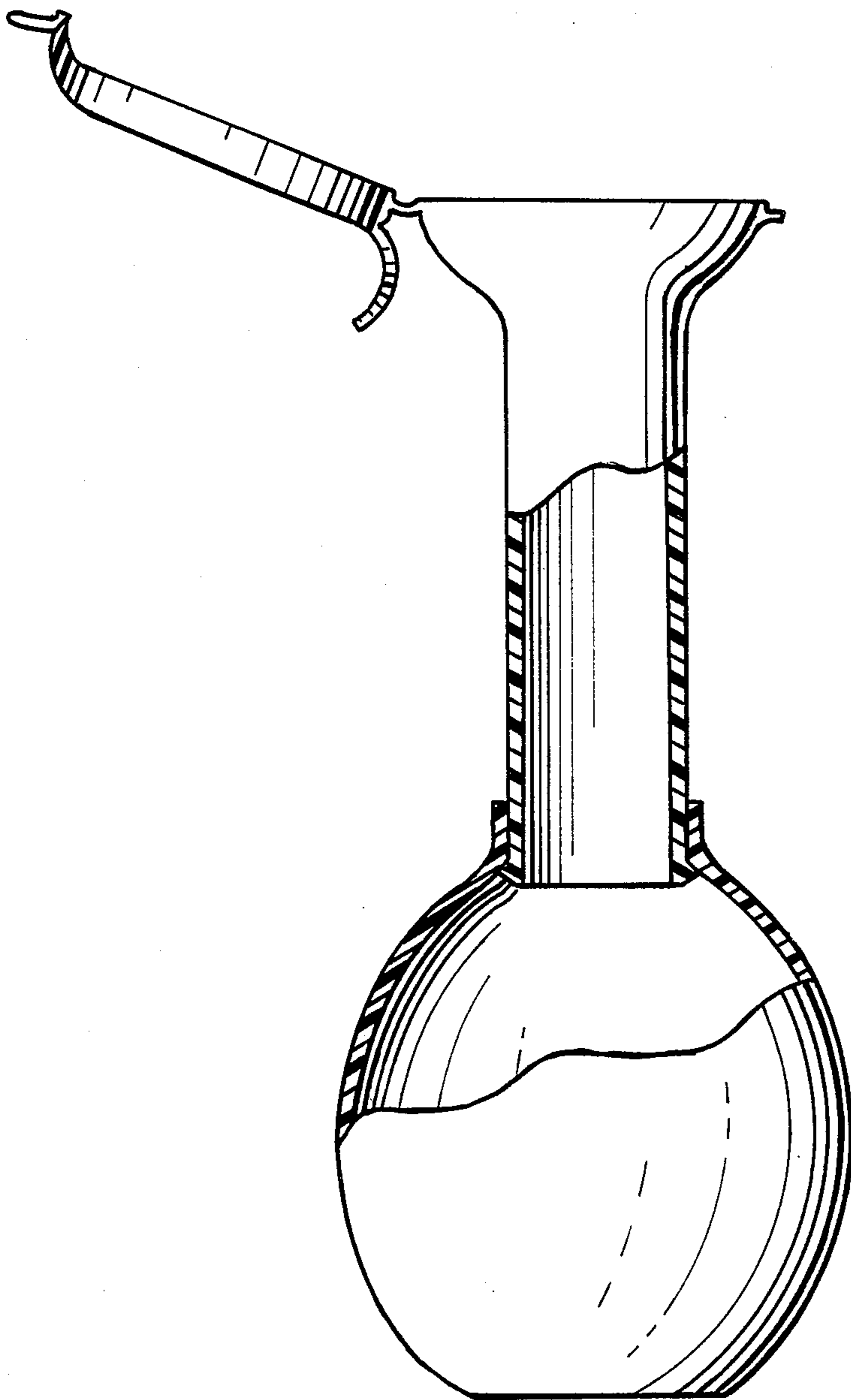
