FIG. 5 is a rear side elevation thereof.

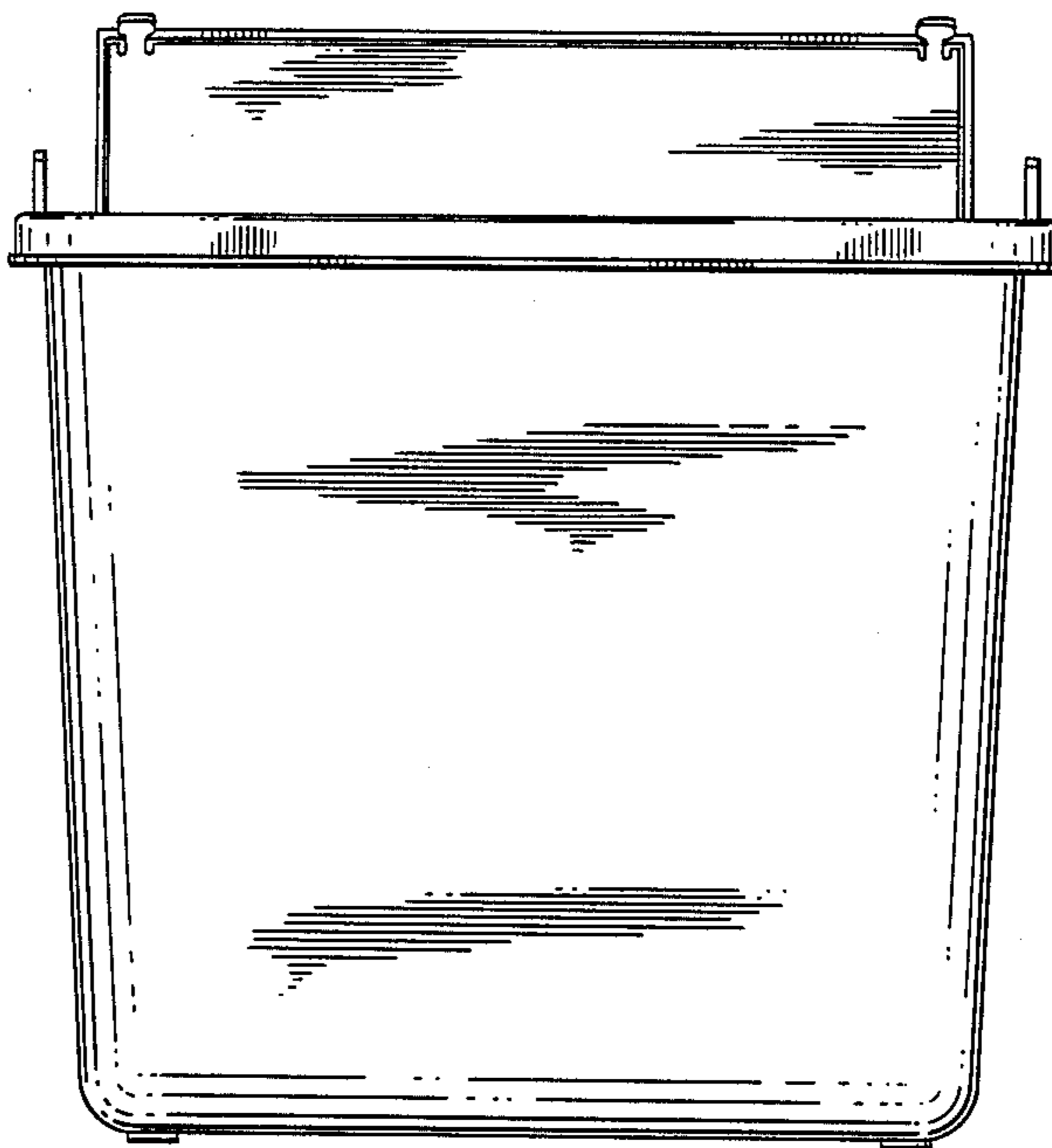

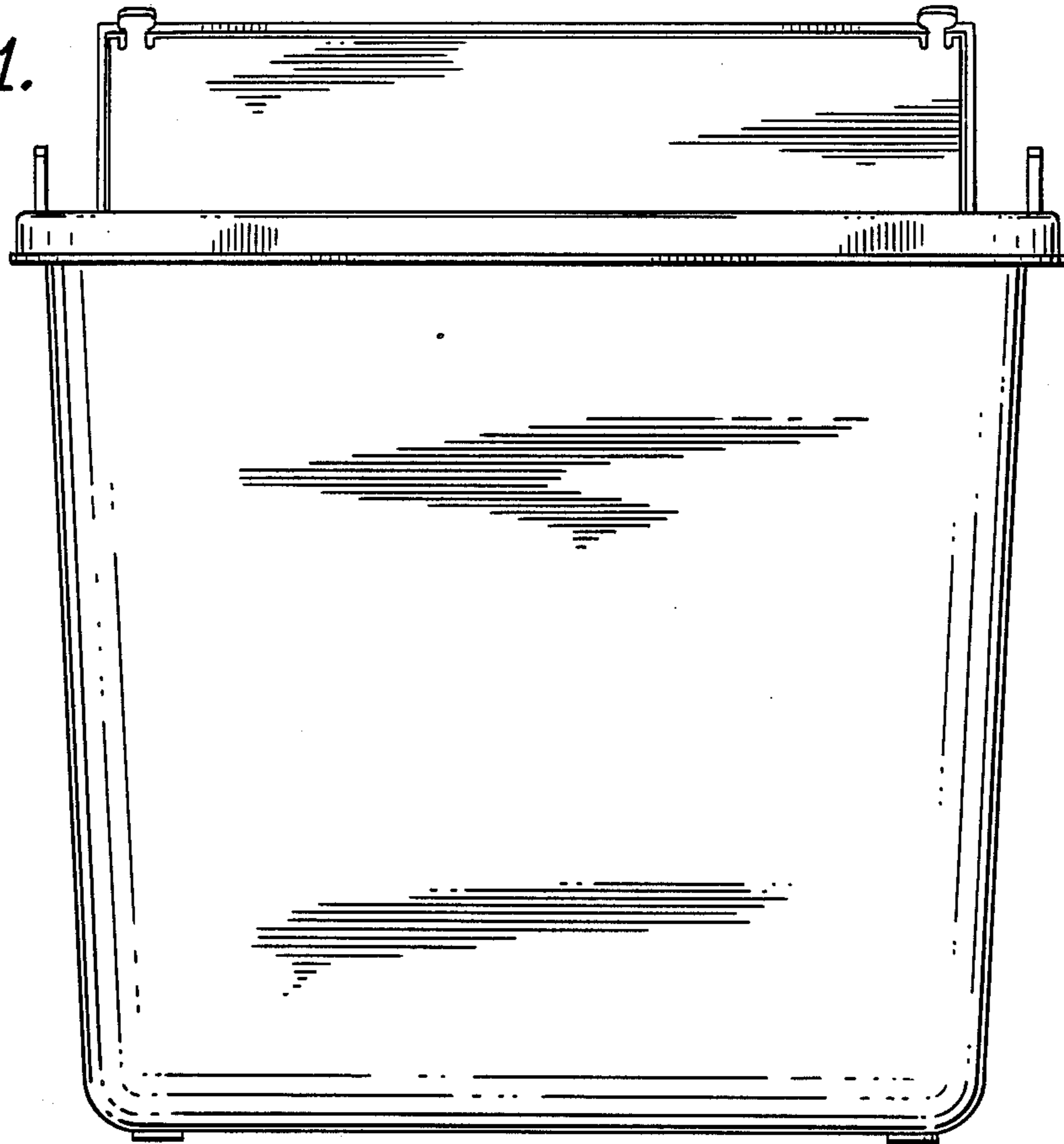

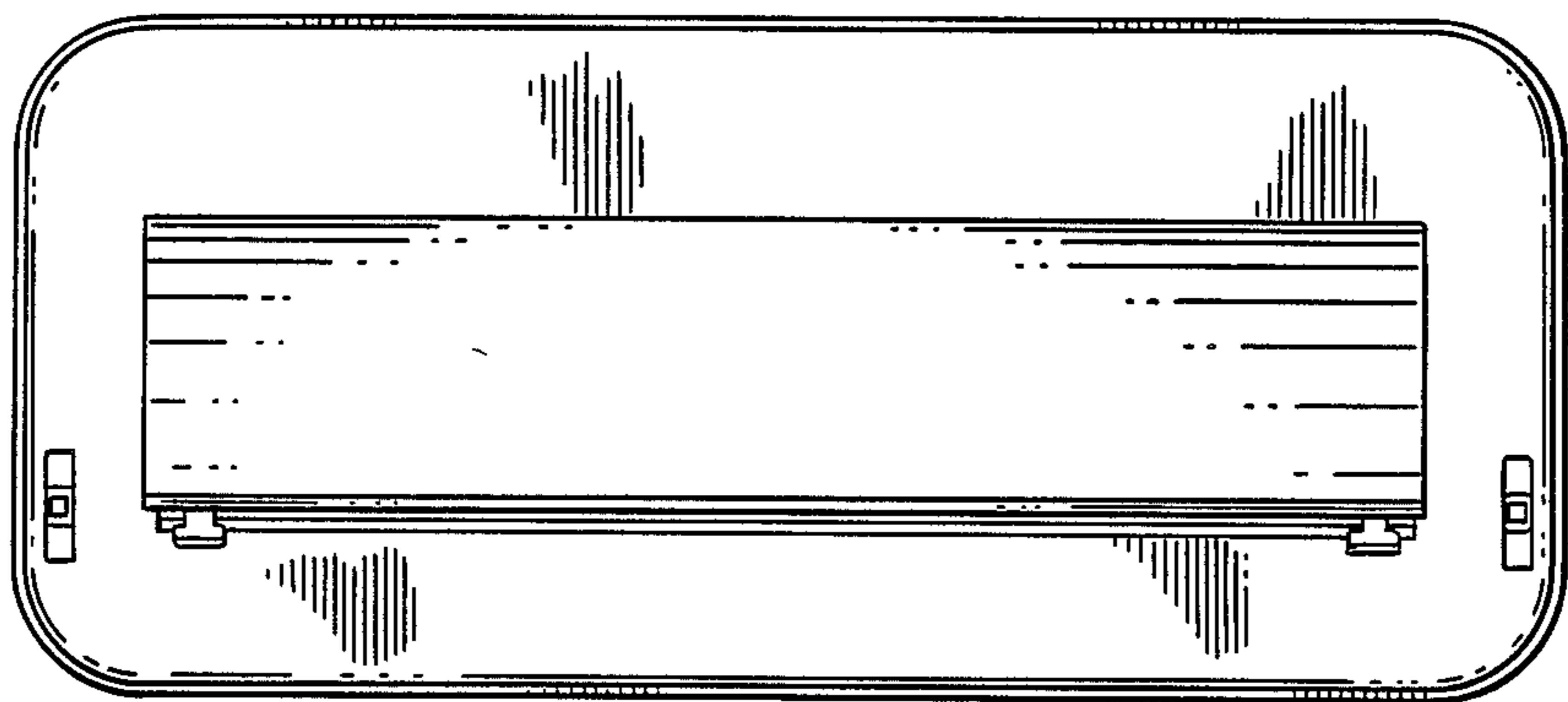

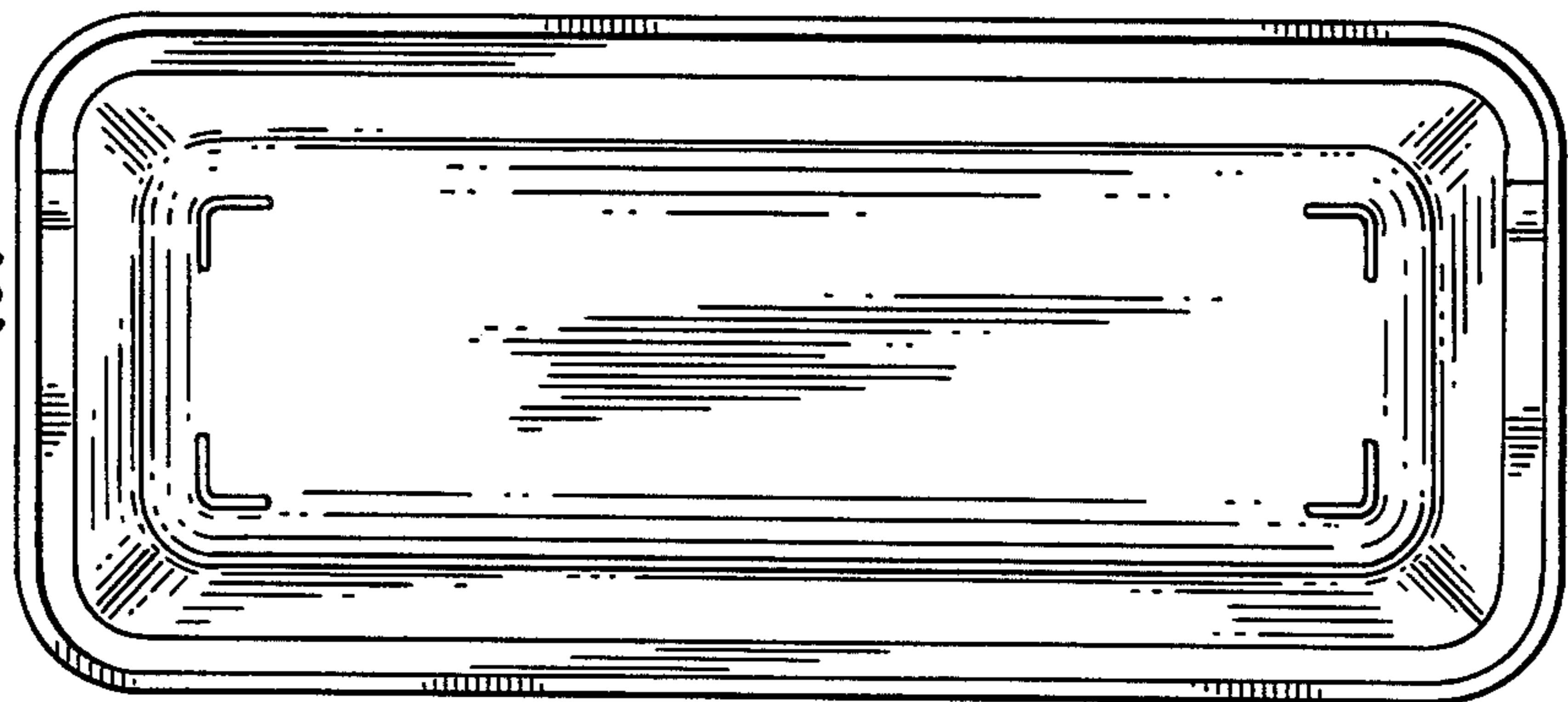

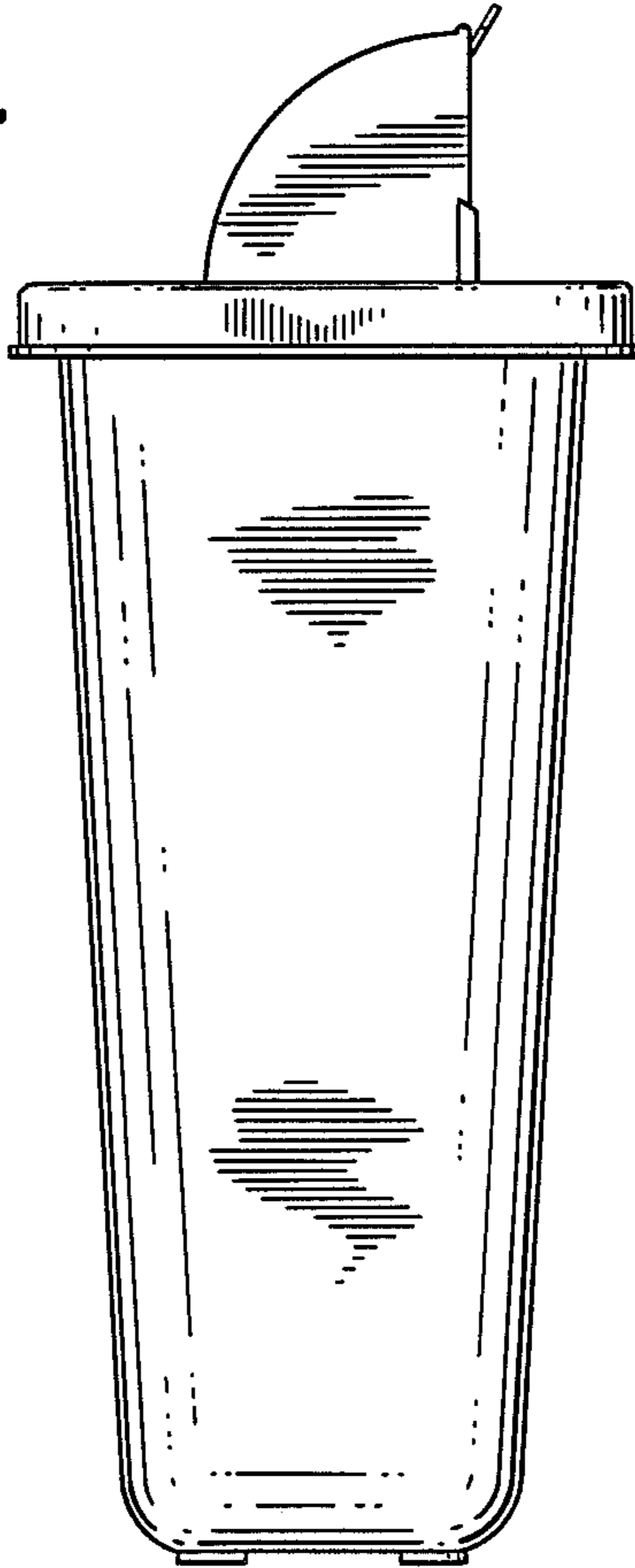
