[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a covered sliding glass door handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a covered sliding glass door handle showing my new design, the top being a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 6.

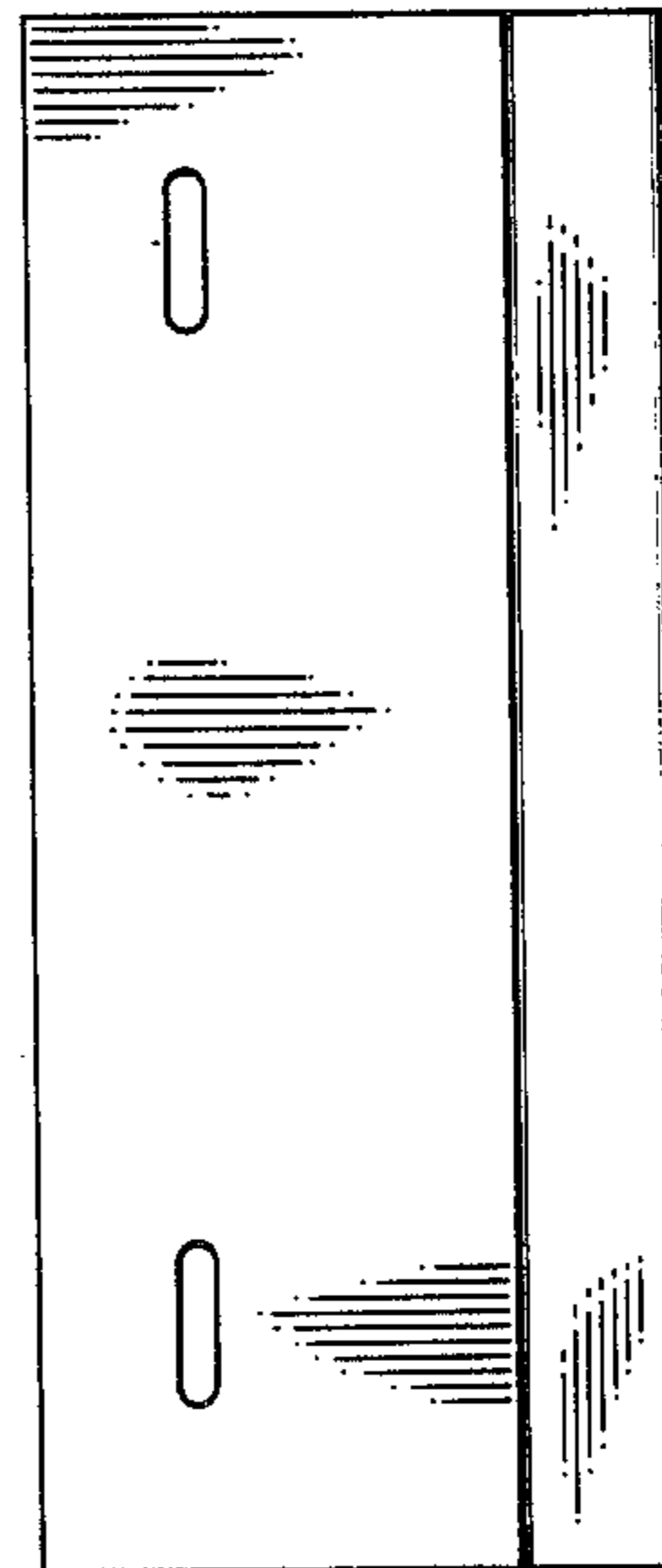

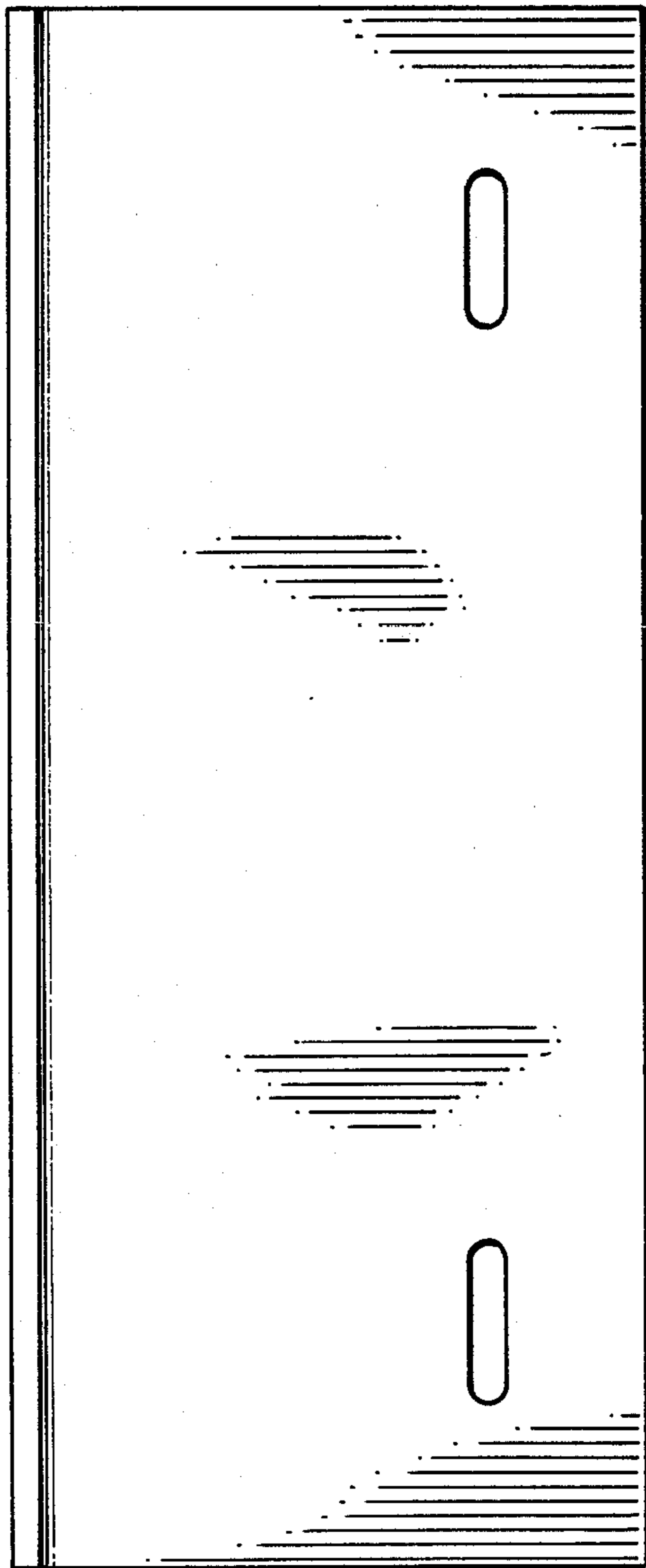

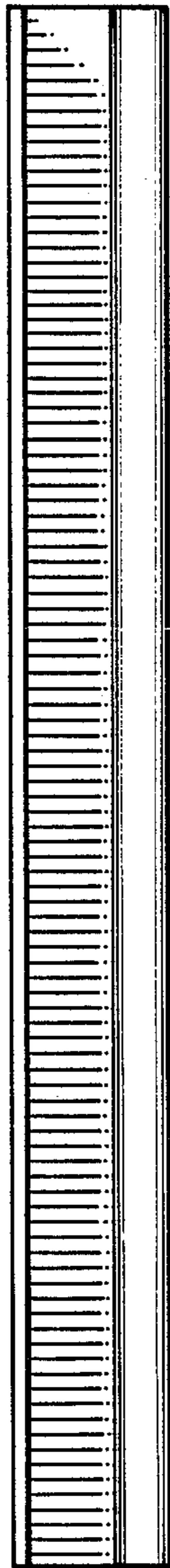

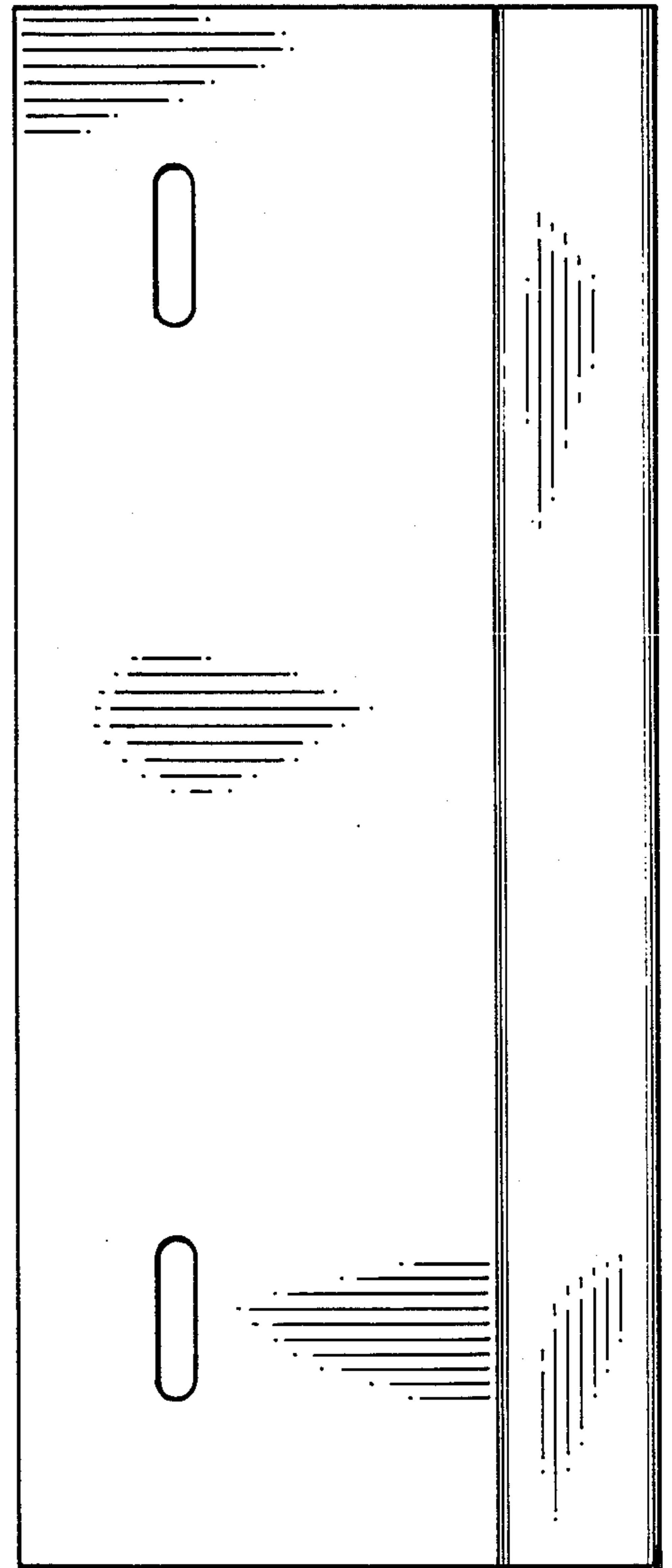

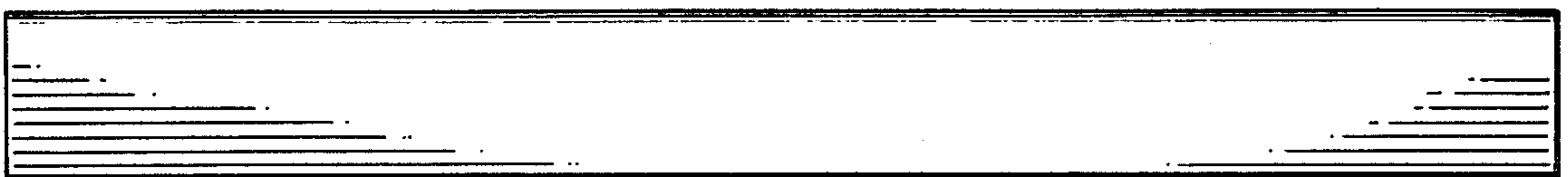

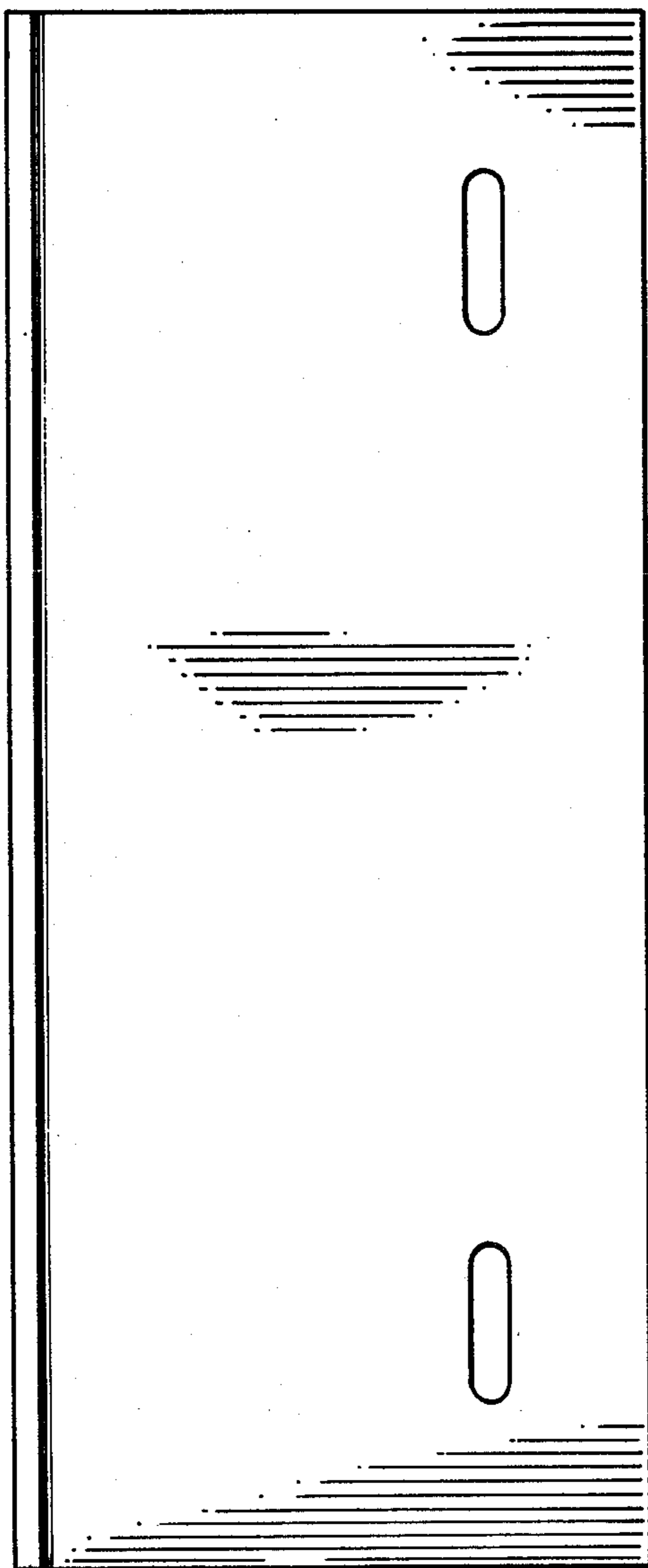

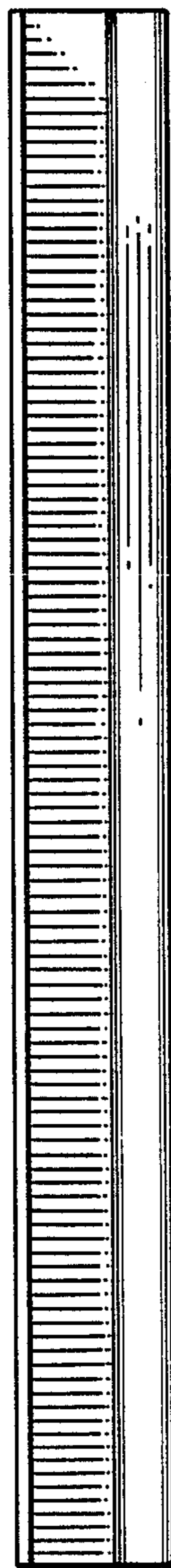

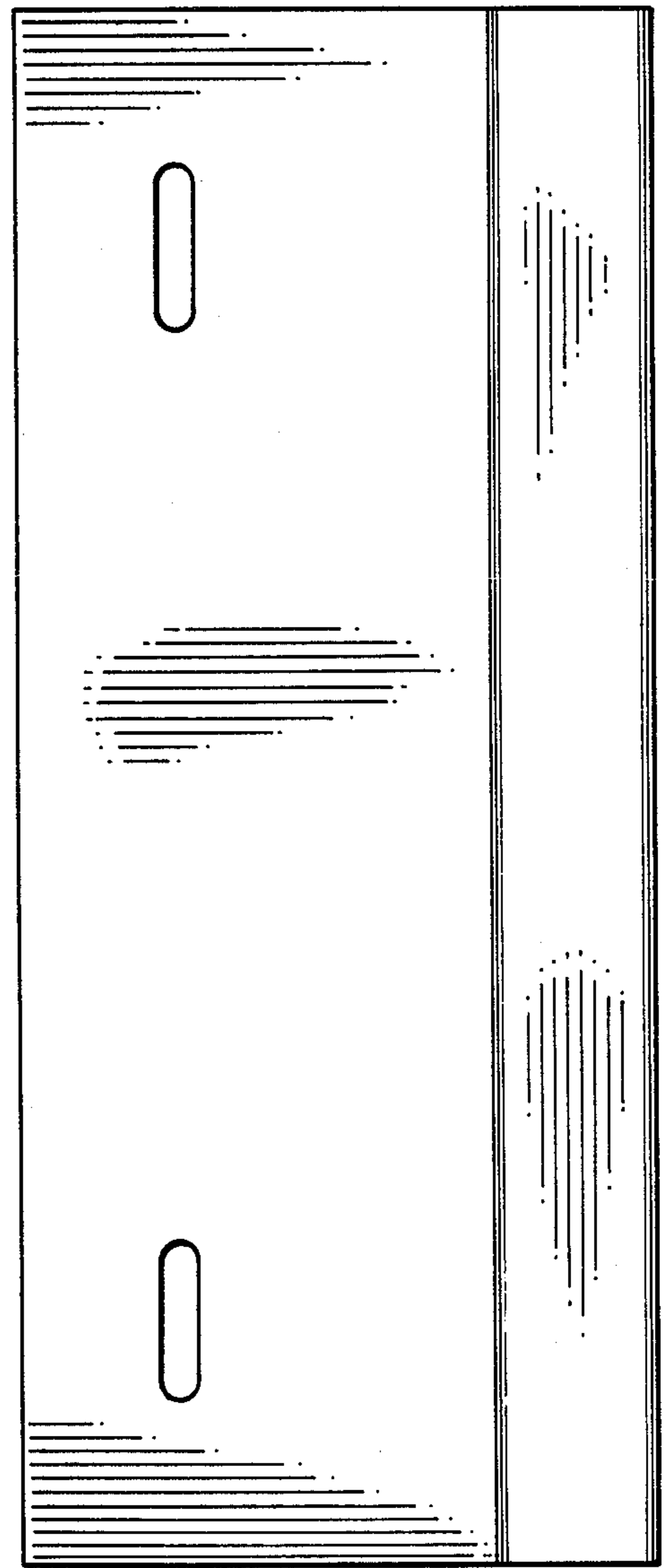

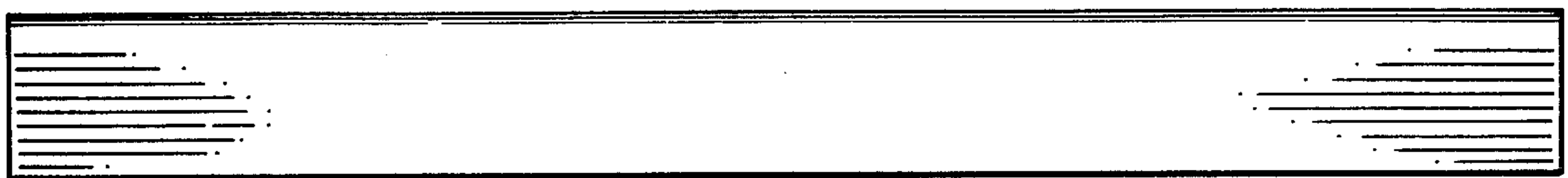
