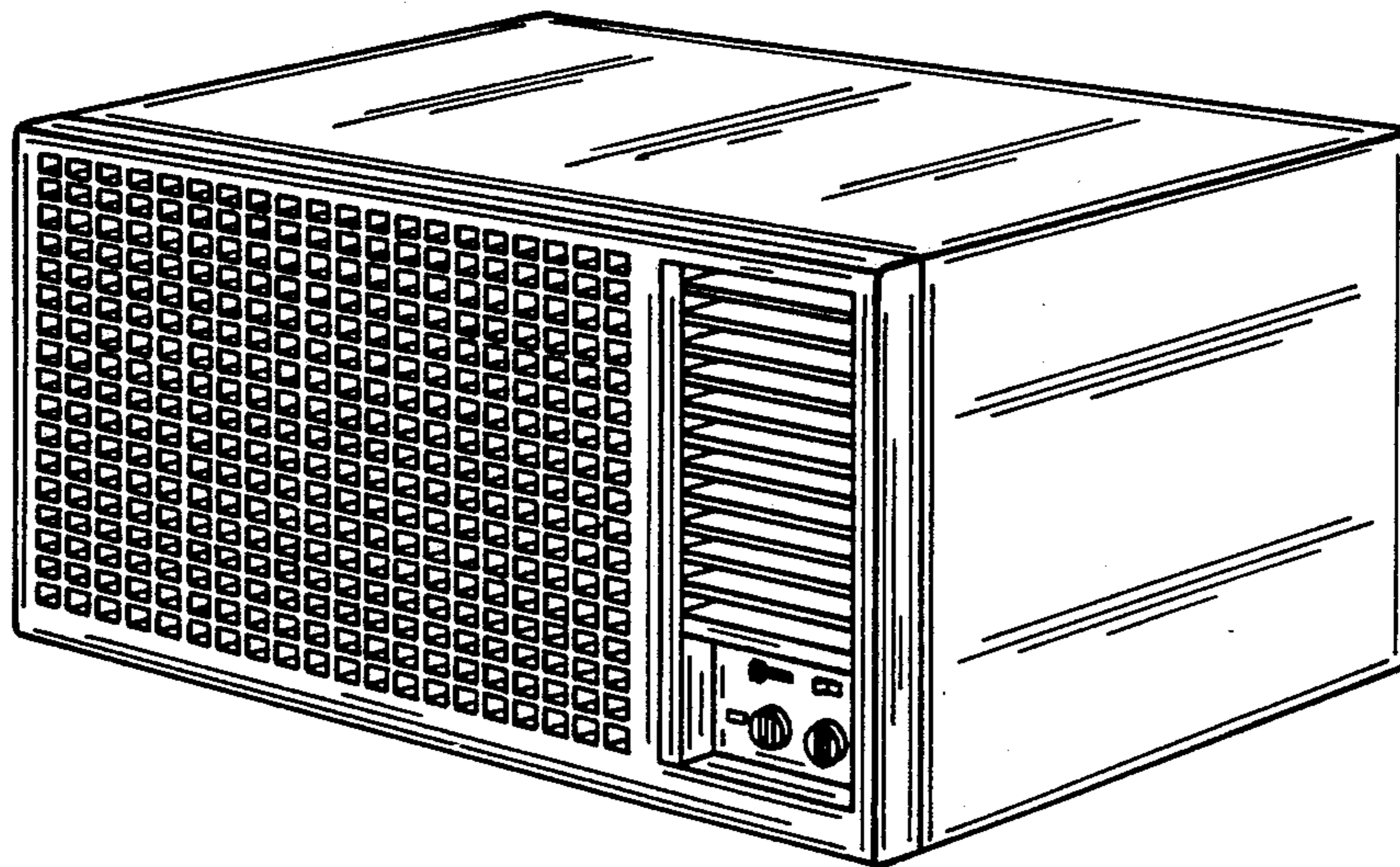

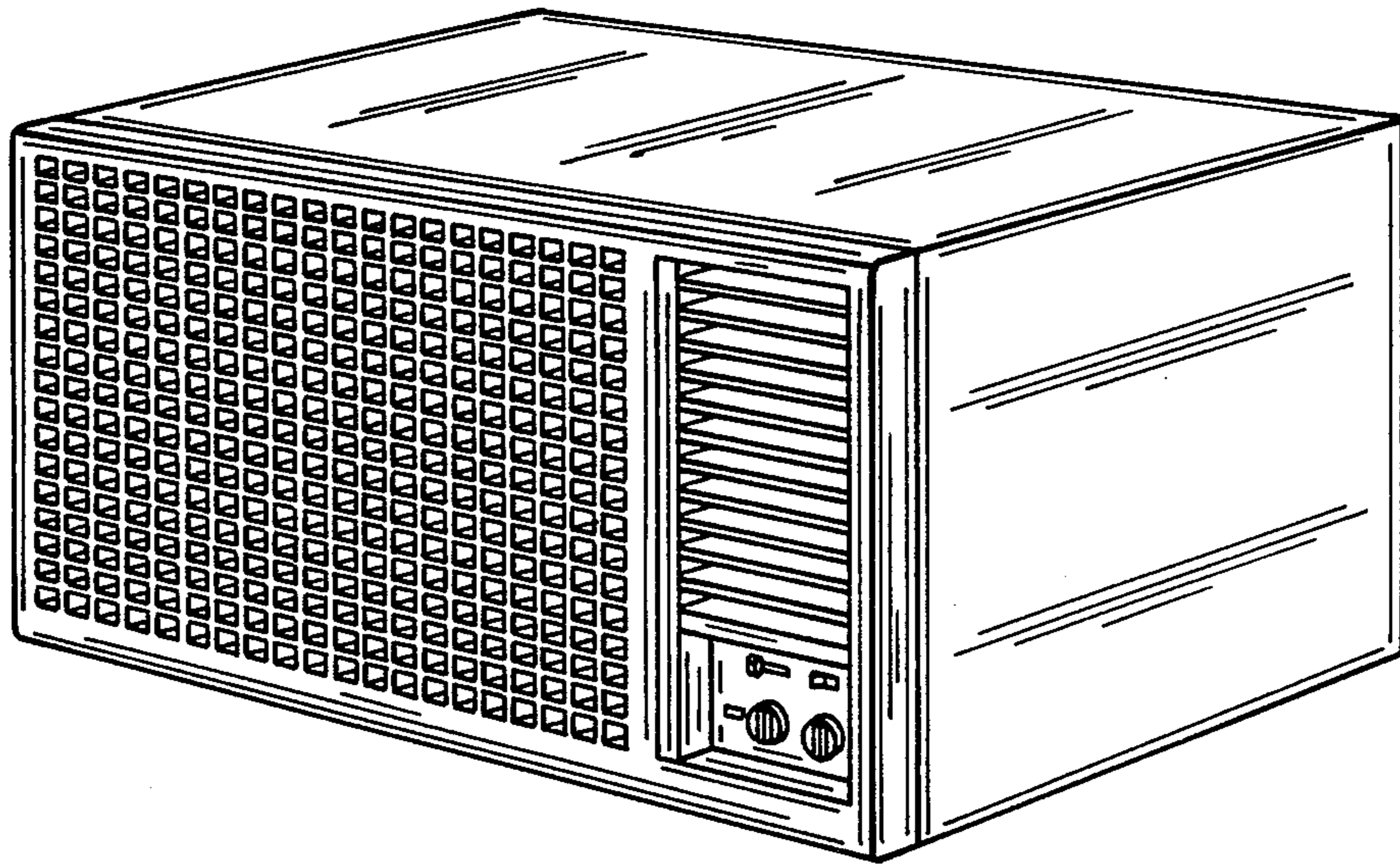

The ornamental design for an air conditioner, as shown.

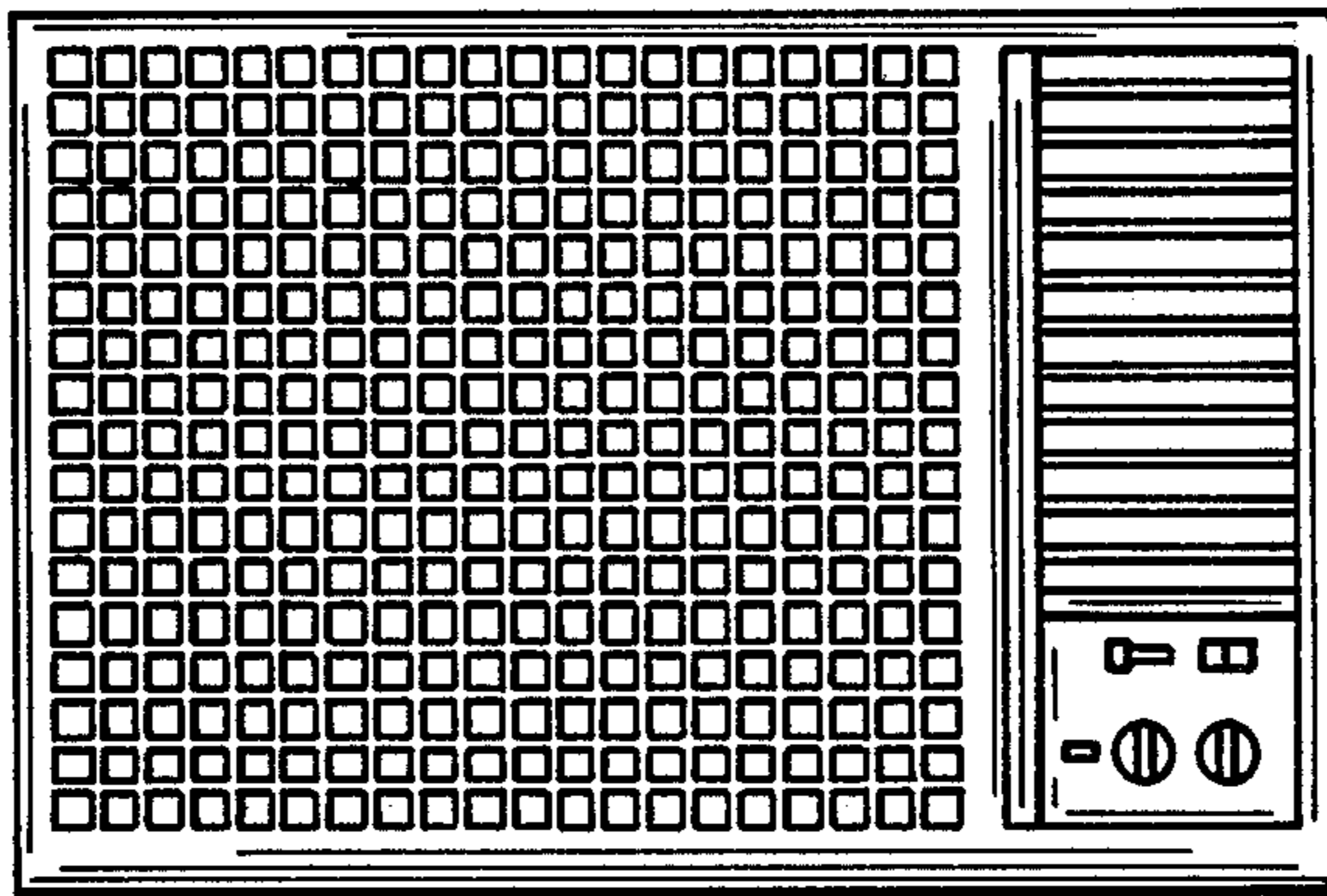
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

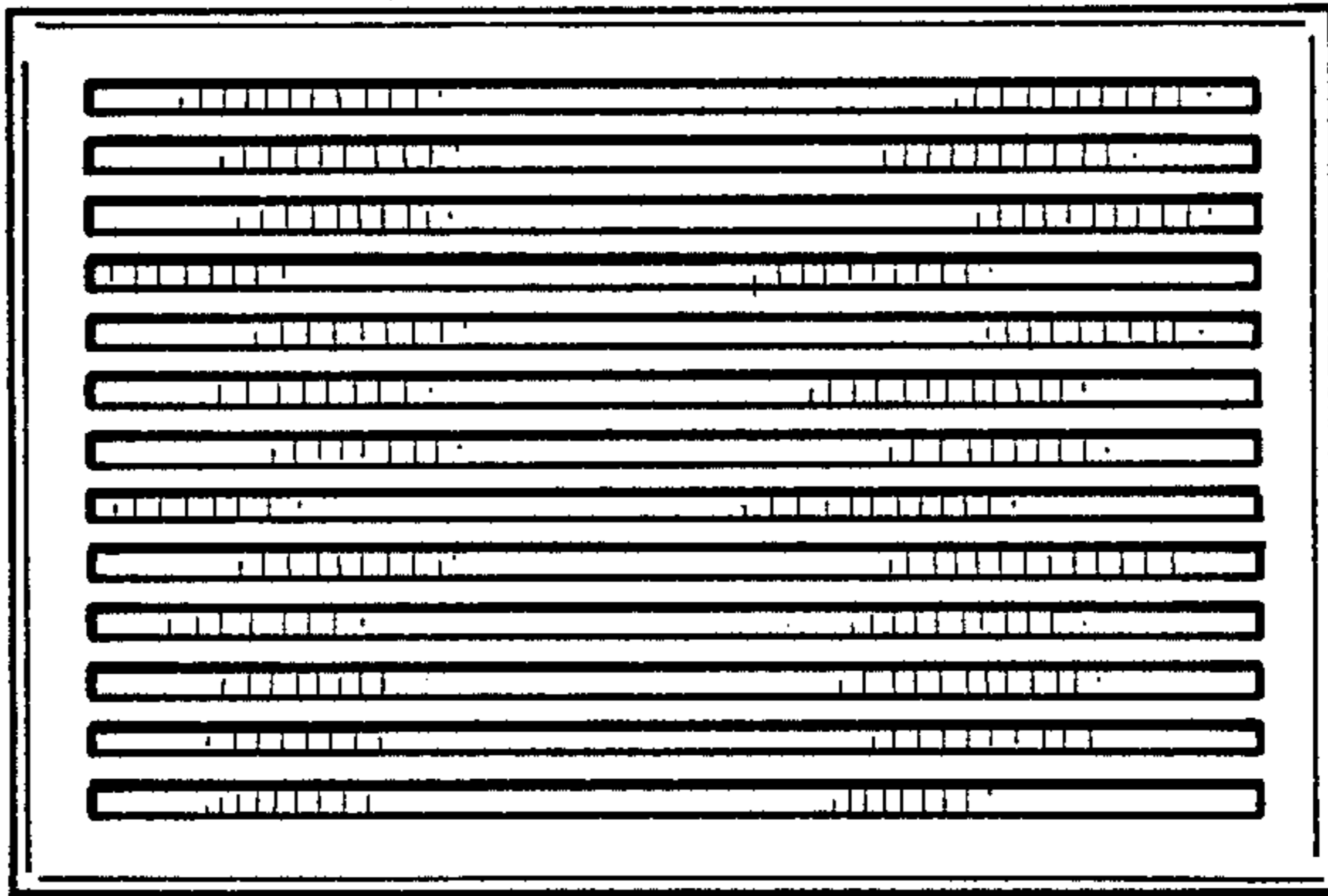




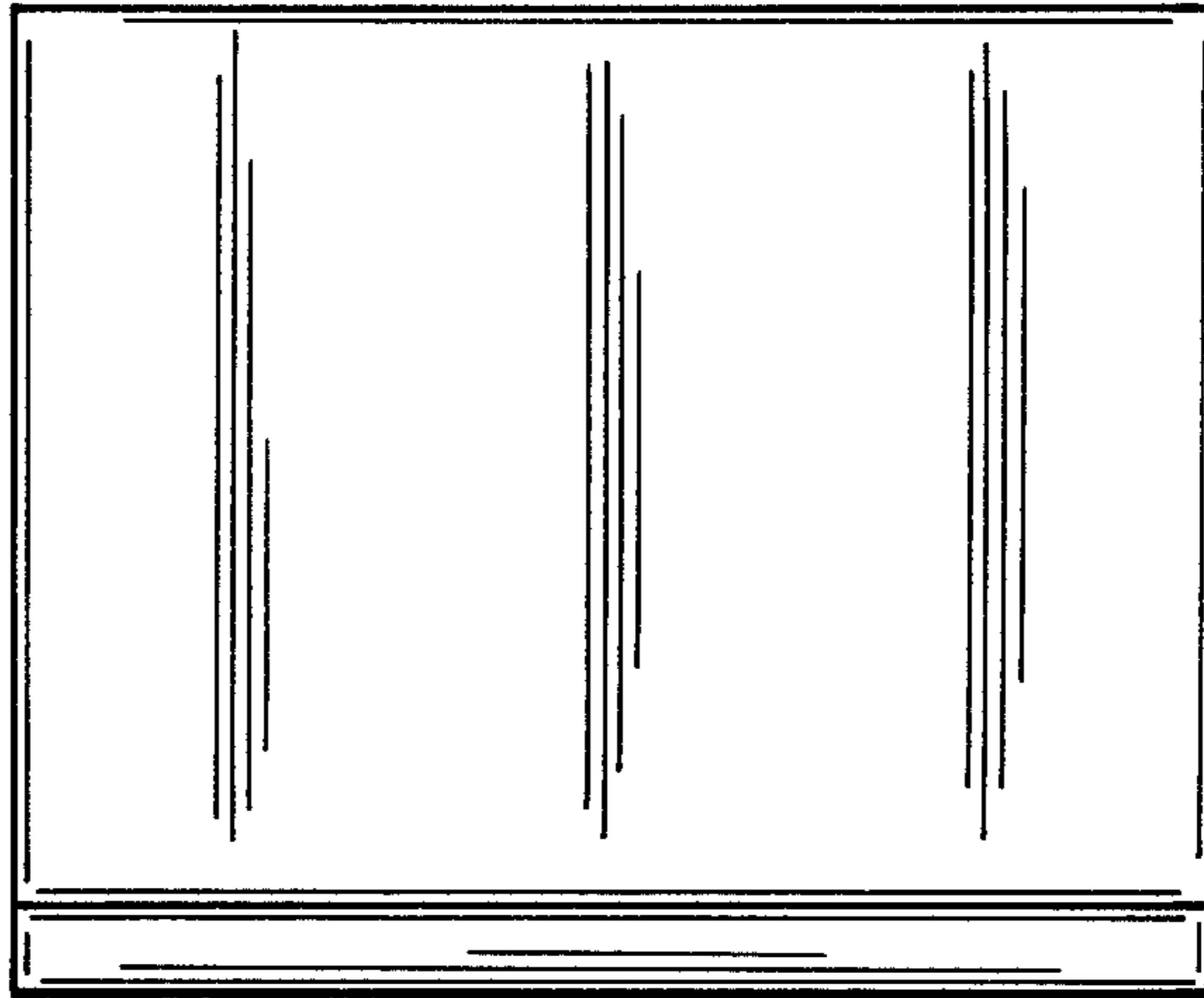

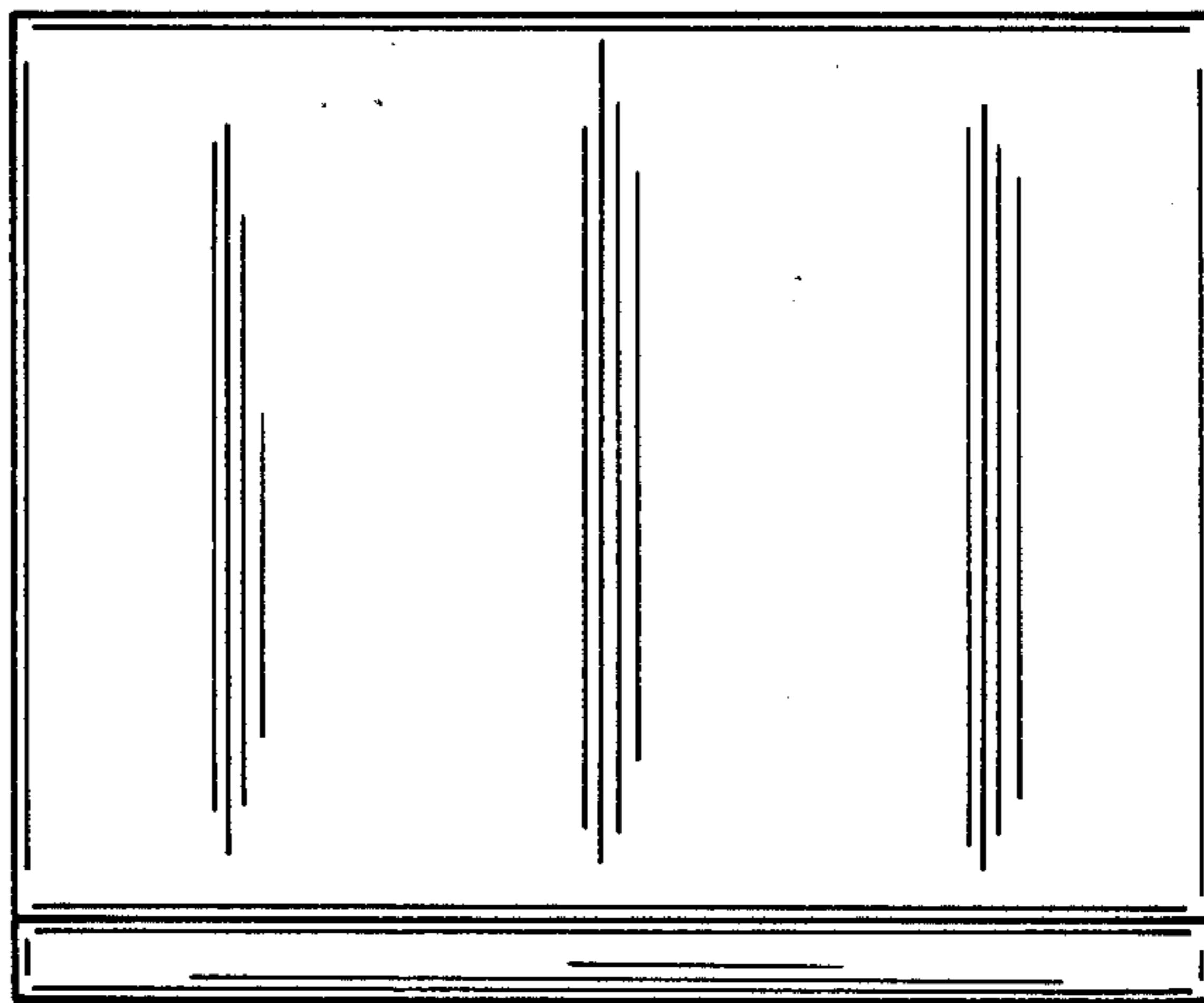

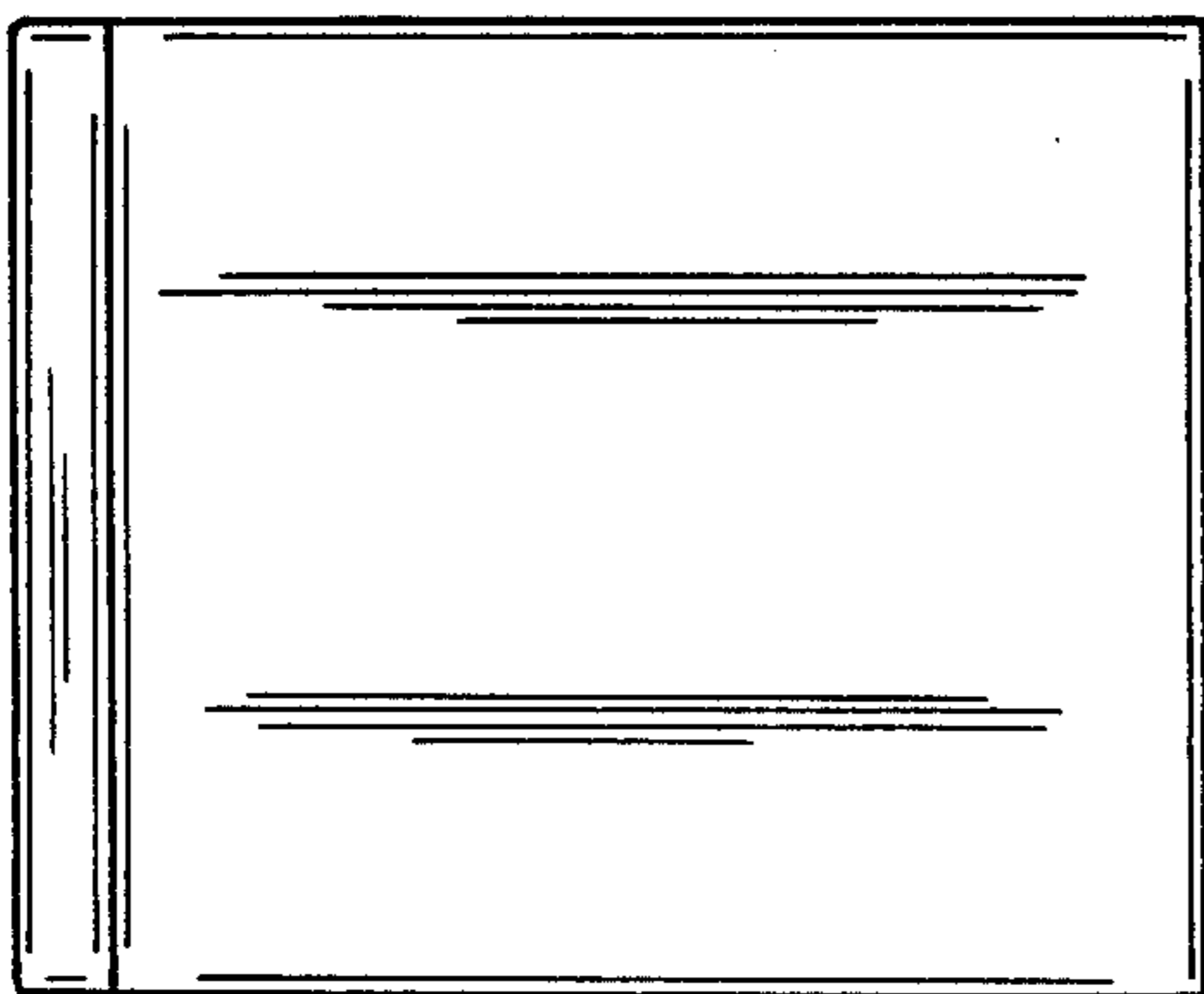

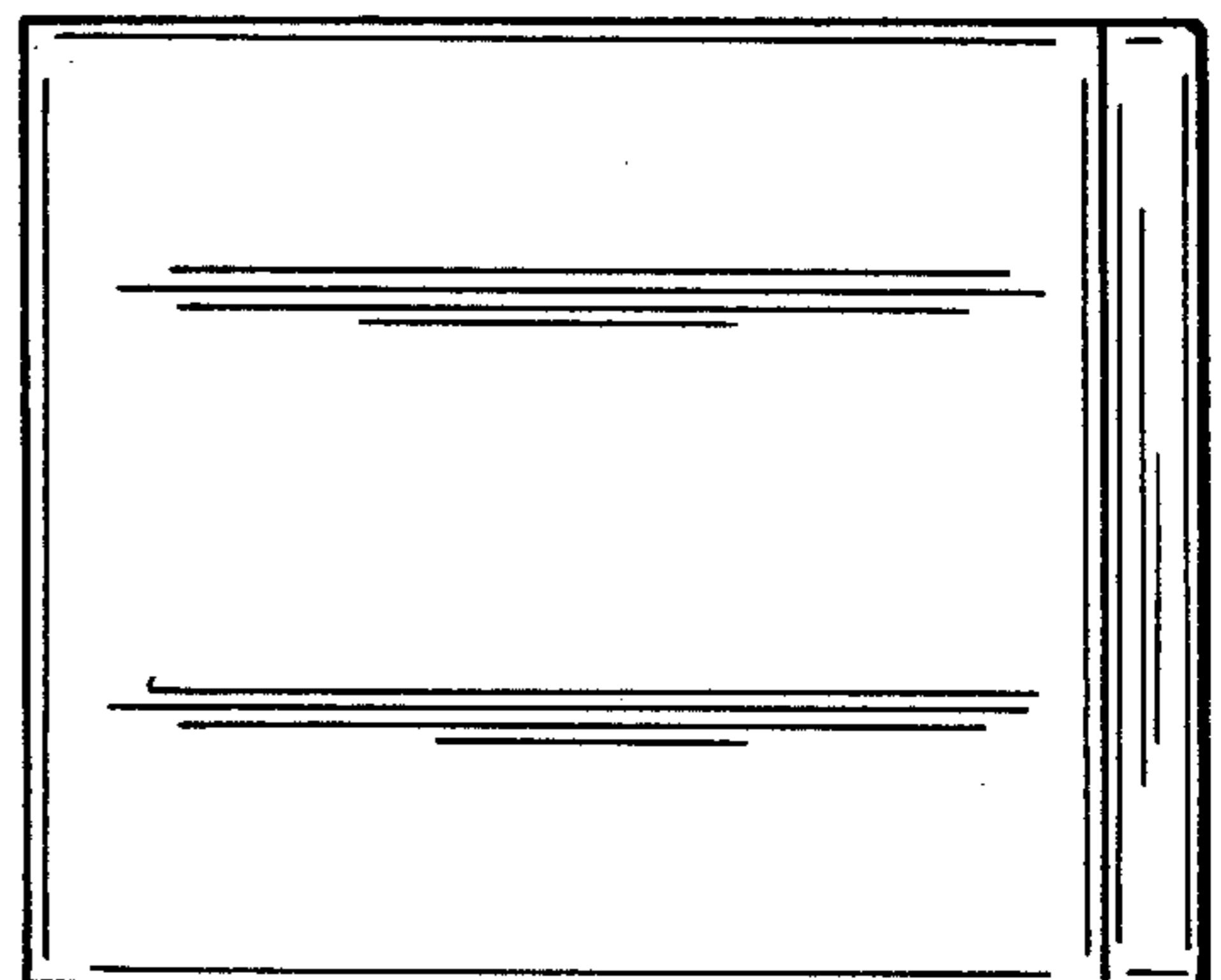
